TOURNAMENT FIELD

» The 2017 NCAA Championship will feature 20 teams ranked in the Golfstat rankings out of the 30 competing.

AUBURN AT THE NCAA CHAMPIONSHIP

» The Tigers are making their sixth consecutive and 22nd overall appearance in the NCAA Championship after finishing t-19th last season. Auburn finished 12th in 2016, fourth best in school history. This is the sixth time Auburn has advanced to the NCAA Championships under the current format, and sixth appearance under head coach Nick Clinard. This is Clinard's seventh NCAA Championship appearance as he led Central Florida to a tie for 10th at the 2009 NCAA Championship.

ONE OF ONLY SIX

» Auburn is one of only six teams to make six consecutive NCAA Championship appearances with Florida State, Illinois, Oklahoma, Southern California and Texas.

AUBURN AT THE NCAA REGIONAL

» Auburn finished second in the NCAA West Lafayette Regional to advance to the 121st NCAA Championship in Sugar Grove, Ill., 46 miles west of Chicago. The Tigers shot a 11-over 292-287-296--875 while senior Matt Gilchrest finished tied for third at 2-under 74-70-70--214 as winds gusted to 40 mph during the final round.

The Tigers made their 26th overall appearance in the last 28 years as eighth-year head coach Nick Clinard has led the Tigers to eight-straight NCAA Regional appearances.

NCAA CHAMPIONSHIP FORMAT

» Finals play for both championships will consist of three days of stroke play on Friday thru Sunday (54 holes), after which the top 15 teams and nine individuals not on an advancing team will be determined. That is followed by a final day of 18 holes of stroke play on Monday to determine the top eight teams that will advance to match play as well as the 72-hole individual champion. The team national champion will be determined by a match-play format that will consist of quarterfinals and semifinals conducted on Tuesday, followed by the finals on Wednesday. The Golf Channel will televise the NCAA Championship from May 29-31.

GOLF CHANNEL COVERAGE OF NCAA CHAMPIONSHIP

» Golf Channel will dedicate its full suite of production resources to the NCAA Division I Men's and Women's Golf Championships, featuring more than 25 combined hours of live tournament coverage as well as more than 50 hours of primarily prime-time replays. In addition, Golf Central will feature nearly 25 hours of combined pre-and post-event news coverage produced on location, as well as daily news updates on Morning Drive and online at GolfChannel.com.

Golf Channel's live tournament coverage of the men's championships will begin on Monday, May 29 to crown the individual national champion, as well as track the team's attempting to qualify for the eight-team match-play tournament. And this year, Golf Channel's coverage will include all three rounds of the team match-play tournament on Tuesday, May 30 and Wednesday, May 31. All rounds on Golf Channel will include prime-time replays.

RANKINGS

» Auburn has been ranked in the top 25 polls throughout the season, including a No. 2 ranking at one point during the fall and enters the NCAA Regional ranked No. 20 in the Golfstat rankings and the GCAA Coaches poll.

AGAINST THE FIELD THIS SEASON

» The Tigers have faced 22 of the 30 teams in the NCAA Championship, compiling a 20-23 (.465) mark. Auburn's record against the field: Clemson (2-0), Kennesaw State (2-0), Purdue (2-0), Illinois (1-0), Alabama (2-1), LSU (2-1), Virginia (3-2), Florida State (1-0), New Mexico (1-0), Penn State (1-0), Baylor (1-1), Duke (1-1), UNLV (1-1), Arizona State (0-1), Oklahoma (0-1), Southern California (0-2), Oklahoma State (0-2), Vanderbilt (0-2), Stanford (0-2), Oregon (0-2), Texas (0-2) and Ole Miss (0-2).

GOLF COURSE

» Rich Harvest Farms is a superb masterpiece that is a natural wonder and provides a unique experience that celebrates the ebb and flow of the geography. Wetlands, mature trees and Illinois prairie grasses offer boundaries, definition and charm to the entire property. Rich Harvest Farms is an experience all its own.

It has played host to the 2015 Palmer Cup, 2012 Ryder Cup Captains Challenge, 2009 Solheim Cup and NCAA Men's Golf Regionals in 2007 and 2014.

TIGERS IN NCAA CHAMPIONSHIPS IN ILLINOIS

» This marks Auburn's second NCAA Championship to be played in the state of Illinois, both in Chicagoland. The Tigers tied for 16th at the 1997 NCAA Championship at Conway Farms in Chicago while Bryant MacKellar tied for sixth individually.

GILCHREST: ALL-NCAA REGION

» Senior Matt Gilchrest was named to the All-NCAA West Lafayette Region team tying for third at 2-under 74-70-70--214. It marked the Southlake, Texas, native's best finish of the season. He is one of five finalists for the Byron Nelson Award.

ALL-SEC TIGERS

» Two Auburn golfers received All-SEC honors as sophomore Trace Crowe was named to the All-SEC second-team and senior Matt Gilchrest was a SEC Men's Golf Community Service Team selection.

PERFECT 1000 APR

» Auburn men's golf received a perfect 1000 Academic Progress Rate score for the 2015-16 scoring period, released on May 10, 2017.

WINNING WAYS

» Since 2009 when Nick Clinard took the helm, Auburn has won 25 team titles including four wins this season at the Inverness Intercollegiate, Jerry Pate National, Tiger Invitational and Gary Koch Invitational. He has coached the Tigers to eight wins in the last two seasons alone.

Under Clinard's tutelage, Auburn has had 27 individual medalists including Trace Crowe this year at the Gary Koch Invitational.

AS THE CROWE FLYS

» Sophomore Trace Crowe was named to the All-SEC second team and has a team-best 71.50 stroke average. He won his first career tournament at the Gary Koch Invitational with pair of 66s in the final two rounds to finish 9-under. The Bluffton, S.C., native tied for fourth in the Tiger Invitational at 7-under.

BIG EASY 2

» True freshman Jovan Rebula, a nephew of Ernie Els, has followed the recent trend of Clinard-coached freshmen to have outstanding seasons. Following Ben Schlottman and Jacob Solomon, Rebula, has a 72.24 stroke average. The George, South Africa, native has earned SEC Fresh-

man of the Week honors twice, first following an eighth-place finish at the Tiger Invitational and then following a top five finish at the Gary Koch Invitational. He has three top 10 finishes this season.

IN THE SPOTLIGHT

» Several Tigers were named finalists or to prestigious award watch lists throughout the season. Senior Matt Gilchrest is one of five finalists for the Byron Nelson Award. Fellow senior Will Long was named to the Ben Hogan Award Watch List and was ranked in both the fall and spring Palmer Cup rankings. Gilchrest, along with sophomore Trace Crowe were also in consideration for the Palmer Cup.

RYAN BENTON, NO. 11 AUBURN RUNNERS-UP AT CARPET CAPITAL COLLEGIATE

» Senior Ryan Benton finished a shot back in a three-way tie for second to lead No. 11 Auburn men's golf to a runner-up finish at 25-under in the Carpet Capital Collegiate at The Farm Golf Club. Benton was 10-under. Benton, who finished a shot behind Georgia Tech's Luke Schniederjans after entering the final round tied, had three birdies on Nos. 3, 9 and 11 and tied with Virginia's Derek Bard and North Florida's Phillip Knowles. Senior Will Long tied for ninth at 7-under 209 with a final round 3-under 69. The Gastonia, N.C., native recorded five birdies. Sophomore Trace Crowe, competing as an individual, fired a 5-under 67 to finish 6-under 210 in a tie for 11th.

NO. 11 AUBURN WINS INVERNESS INTERCOLLEGIATE

» No. 11 Auburn men's golf won the Inverness Intercollegiate carding a 2-under 282 for a final score of 9-under 843 at the Inverness Club. The Tigers (280-281-282-843) defeated No. 23 Duke (277-281-288-846) by three strokes. Senior Will Long finished third at 3-under 73-68-69-210, one stroke behind co-medalists Nick Carlson of Michigan (69-73-67-209) and Jake Shuman of Duke (70-71-68-209). The Gastonia, N.C., native had four birdies on the back nine in the final round on Nos. 13, 15, 17 and 18. Seniors Matt Gilchrest and Ryan Benton were part of a five-way tie for fourth a shot back at 2-under. Gilchrest (64-72-75-211), a two-time All-SEC performer, held the lead after the first two rounds after carding the second-lowest round in school history with his opening round 64. Benton (69-72-70-211), a native of Dothan, Ala., closed out his tournament with a 1-under 70 final round with birdies on Nos. 5, 6, 13 and 18.

NO. 2 AUBURN WINS JERRY PATE NATIONAL INTERCOLLEGIATE

» No. 2 Auburn men's golf won the Jerry Pate National Intercollegiate, carding a 2-over 282 at the Old Overton Club for a final even par 840. The Tigers have won two-straight tournaments with the Inverness Intercollegiate and were runner-up at the Carpet Capital Collegiate. Auburn (284-274-282-840) held off UNLV (283-284-274-841) to win by one stroke. Senior Will Long led the way for the Tigers for the second consecutive tournament, tying for fifth at 2-under 70-70-68-208. The Gastonia, N.C., native carded three birdies as part of a near bogey-free final round. It is Long's second top-five finish in as many tournaments. Freshman Jovan Rebula finished a shot back of Long at 1-under 68-68-73-209 to tie for eighth. The George, South Africa, native had four birdies in the final round on Nos. 3, 8, 15 and 16. All-American junior Ben Schlottman delivered a 1-under 69 final round to tie for ninth at even-par 70-71-69-210. The Advance, N.C., native tallied five birdies for the day with four coming on the front nine on Nos. 2, 3, 5 and 9.

NO. 15 AUBURN FINISHES FIFTH AT ALL AMERICAN INTERCOLLEGIATE

» No. 15 Auburn finished fifth at the All American Intercollegiate carding a 1-over 289 at the par 72, 7,067-yard AAI Course at the Golf Club of Houston to finish at 2-under 293-280-289-862. No. 8 Baylor won the title at 28-under 284-268-284-836 while No. 1 Vanderbilt was the runner-up at 23-under 288-276-277-841. All-SEC senior Matt Gilchrest led the Tigers at 3-under 72-71-70-213 to t-13th. The Southlake, Texas, native birdied three-straight on the back nine on Nos. 12-14 to finish the day at 2-under.

NO. 17 AUBURN WINS TIGER INVITATIONAL

» No. 17 Auburn Men's Golf won the Tiger Invitational presented by Jason Dufner, carding a 4-under 284 in the final round at the Grand National Lakes Course to finish at 13-under 279-288-284-851. The Tigers held off a late surge by Troy, who carded a 10-under 278 and finished at 280-299-278-856, to win by five strokes. Sophomore Trace Crowe carded a 7-under 67-72-70-209 to t-4th. The Bluffton, S.C., native tallied six birdies as part of his 2-under final round on Nos. 1, 4, 5, 12, 14 and 17. It his best finish of the season and his fourth top 25 finish this season. Freshman Jovan Rebula finished two shots back to t-8th for the second time this season. The George,

South Africa, product carded a 2-under 70 with seven birdies on Nos. 1, 5 and 7 on the front and 11, 12, 14 and 16 on the back in the final round to finish at 5-under 69-72-70-211. Sophomore Jacob Solomon and senior Will Long t-13th at 2-under 214. Solomon, a native of Dublin, Calif., eagled the par-5 14th and added a trio of birdies as part of an even-par final round. He finished at 71-71-72-214. Long, playing as an individual, used four birdies on Nos. 6, 12, 14 and 16 to finish at 2-under in the final round and finish at 72-72-70-214 overall.

NO. 20 AUBURN TIES FOR THIRD AT HOOTIE

» No. 20 Auburn Men's Golf finished in a tie for third at the Hootie at Bulls Bay, carding an 11-under 277 at the Bulls Bay Golf Course to finish at 10-under 284-293-277--854. Three Tigers finished in the top 10 as Jacob Solomon and Matt Gilchrest tied for seventh and Ryan Benton t-10th. South Carolina finished at 20-under 279-286-279--844 to win the title while Ole Miss finished runner-up at 16-under 848. NC State tied Auburn for third at 10-under 287-281-286--854. Auburn's 277 final round tied Georgia State's opening round for the lowest team score of the tournament. The Tigers tallied 27 birdies in the round led by Solomon's nine. Solomon, a sophomore from Dublin, Calif., birdied four of the first five holes on Nos. 2-5 in addition to Nos. 9, 10, 14, 15 and 18 as part of a career-low 6-under 66. The Freshman All-SEC selection finished at 5-under 75-70-66--211. All-SEC senior Matt Gilchrest tied Solomon at 5-under 69-72-70--211. He carded five birdies on Nos. 2, 4, 6, 10 and 13 as part of a 2-under 70 final round. The Byron Nelson Award finalist now has two top-10 finishes for the season and 16 for his career. Benton, playing as an individual, recorded his third top-10 finish of the season. The Dothan, Ala., native carded a 2-under 70 with four birdies on Nos. 2, 10, 13 and 14 on Tuesday to finish at 3-under 71-72-70--213.

NO. 20 AUBURN, TRACE CROWE WIN GARY KOCH INVITATIONAL

» No. 20 Auburn Men's Golf won the Gary Koch Invitational, carding a 1-under 287 at the Gaston Country Club to finish at 18-under 282-277-297-846. Sophomore Trace Crowe won medalist honors for the first time this season at 9-under 75-66-66-207 as four Tigers finished in the top-10. Auburn defeated North Carolina State (276-288-290-854) by eight strokes. It is the Tigers' fourth win of the season following the Inverness Intercollegiate, Jerry Pate National and the Tiger Invitational presented

by Jason Dufner, and ties the mark from last season. Crowe, a native of Bluffton, S.C., carded a 6-under 66 in the final round, tying his career-low set just one round prior. His round consisted of four birdies and an eagle on the par-5 No. 1. He tallied 11 birdies and an eagle as opposed to just four bogeys over 54 holes. It is Crowe's first individual win of the season and the second of his career. He won the 2016 USA Individual Tournament as a freshman. Freshman Jovan Rebula had a career-best finish tying for fifth at 4-under 69-72-71-212. The George, South Africa, product carded a trio of birdies in the final round and 13 total for the week. It's his third top-10 finish of the season.

GILCHREST LEADS TIGERS IN SEC CHAMPIONSHIP

» All-SEC senior Matt Gilchrest tied for 18th at the SEC Championship, carding a 3-over 73 Saturday at the Seaside Course to finish at 2-over 71-68-73-212. No. 19 Auburn (278-287-291-856) finished in a tie for ninth, four strokes off the cutline as the top eight teams advanced to match play.

AUBURN ADVANCES TO 6TH STRAIGHT NCAA CHAMPIONSHIP

Nick Clinard is in his 16th year overall as a head coach and eighth season with the Auburn men's golf team in 2016-17.

Auburn is one of six teams in the nation ... Florida State, Illinois, Oklahoma, Texas and USC the others ... who have made at least six-straight NCAA Championship appearances.

Auburn has been ranked as high as No. 2 nationally this season while winning four team titles: Inverness Intercollegiate, Jerry Pate Intercollegiate, Tiger Invitational and Gary Koch Invitational.

Trace Crowe, who was an All-SEC second-team selection, won medalist honors at the Gary Koch. Matt Gilchrest was a Byron Nelson Award finalist and an All-Region selection.

Under Clinard, the Tigers have reached five-straight NCAA Championships while earning 25 team and 27 individual titles and bringing in the strongest recruiting classes the Tigers have seen in years.

The Tigers were ranked No. 1 nationally for the much of the 2015-16 fall season while senior Michael Johnson was ranked No. 1 nationally in the Golfweek individual rankings and second in the Palmer Cup rankings.

Through May 19, 2017, Clinard has posted a .757 winning percentage at Auburn with a record of 1121-352-21. Auburn has made the NCAA Regionals each of his eight seasons and have advanced to the NCAA Championship six straight years.

Auburn won four tournaments in 2015-16 including the Carpet Capital Collegiate, U.S. Collegiate Championship, Mobile Sports Authority Intercollegiate and the Seminole Intercollegiate while finishing as runner-up in four others. Auburn had a perfect 1000 APR score.

The Tigers had five medalists with Michael Johnson winning three, the Primland Collegiate, Mobile Sports Authority Intercollegiate and the Schenkel Invitational. Freshman Graysen Huff won the ASU Fall Beach Classic while Will Long was co-

medalist at the U.S. Collegiate Championship.

Michael Johnson was named first-team All-SEC and was a semifinalist for both the Jack Nicklaus Award and Ben Hogan Award and was on the Haskins Award Watch List. Jacob Solomon was a Freshman All-SEC selection in 2016.

The Tigers had the fourth best NCAA Championship finish in school history by finishing 12th in 2015 and the Tigers are one of only eight teams to appear in four consecutive NCAA Championships.

Since Clinard came to Auburn in 2009, Auburn has produced six All-Americans, eight Academic All-Americans, 15 NCAA All-Region selections and 19 All-SEC selections, including five All-SEC first-team selections, six All-SEC second team picks, seven Freshman All-SEC selections and one SEC Freshman of the Year.

Auburn won three consecutive tournaments with three straight medalists, all different, in the Mobile Sports Authority Intercollegiate, Tiger Invitational Presented by Jason Dufner and the Schenkel Invitational in 2015.

Ben Schlottman was named Golfweek honorable mention All-American, the first freshman in school history to receive All-America honors.

Five Tigers were named to the NCAA All-Southeast Region team as No. 1 Illinois and No. 2 Texas were the only three schools in the nation to have five players named NCAA All-Region.

Schlottman and Matt Gilchrest were both named first-team All-SEC while Michael Johnson was a second-team selection. Schlottman also became the first Auburn freshman to be named All-SEC first-team in history while also being tabbed SEC Freshman of the Year.

Auburn destroyed the school's team single-season stroke average record by averaging 283.23 strokes per round in 2015 with the previous mark being 285.30 set in 2011-12. In fact, Clinard-coached teams

have the four lowest averages in Tiger history.

Schlottman recorded the fourth lowest single season stroke average in school history and set the Auburn freshman record averaging 70.96.

Auburn climbed to being ranked fourth nationally in 2014-15 after winning two consecutive tournaments in the Mobile Sports Authority Intercollegiate and the Tiger Invitational Presented by Jason Dufner by 28 shots, the largest margin of victory in school history. Auburn then won the Schenkel Invitational at 41-under, edging No. 5 Vanderbilt by a stroke, for its third-straight win.

Clinard coached the Tigers to their third-straight NCAA Championship appearance in 2014 as the Tigers had three tournament wins and eight top three finishes, including thirds in both the NCAA Regional and SEC Championship. Auburn, which was 136-60-1, finished 23rd in the NCAA Championship in Hutchinson, Kan., and finished ranked 19th overall.

Auburn's three tournament wins in 2013-14 came in the Tiger Invitational Presented by Jason Dufner, the Mobile Bay Intercollegiate and the Hootie at Bulls Bay Intercollegiate as Niclas Carlsson tied for first with a 70-73-66-209 and Matt Gilchrest finished a stroke behind with a 71-73-66-210.

Senior Niclas Carlsson was named honorable mention All-American in 2013-14.

Carlsson and freshman Matt Gilchrest were both All-SEC second-team selections, and Gilchrest was also named to the Freshman All-SEC team. Three Tiger freshmen were named SEC Freshman of the Week, including Gilchrest, Blake Messer and Will Long. Gilchrest was named SEC Player and Freshman of the Week following his four-stroke win at the UK Bluegrass Invitational. Messer won the USA Individual Tournament in Mobile while Long finished 10th in the USF Invitational.

Auburn men's golf received the NCAA Public Recognition Award for placing in the top 10 percent in the most recent multi-year Academic Progress Rate scores with a perfect 1000 APR. Auburn placed 10 on the 2014 SEC Spring Academic Honor Roll five on the 2014 SEC First-Year Honor Roll.

In 2012-13, Auburn finished 13th in the 2013 NCAA Championship in Milton, Ga., after finishing tied for second at the NCAA Regional in Columbus, Ohio. The Tigers finished the season ranked 14th nationally while having a record of 149-61-3.

Auburn won three tournament titles at The McLaughlin, Mobile Bay Classic and Samford Intercollegiate. The Tigers had three individual medalists with redshirt freshman Jake Mondy at The McLaughlin in his first career tournament, Dominic Bozzelli at the Ameri Ari Invitational and Niclas Carlsson at the Mobile Bay Intercollegiate.

Senior Michael Hebert was selected to the All-SEC second team while Mondy was a Freshman All-SEC selection.

Auburn was ranked No. 1 nationally in the Coaches' Poll after two events in the 2011-12 season for the first time since the poll began in 2001. It marked the first time Auburn received a No. 1 ranking since the fall of 1996.

The Tigers finished the 2011-12 season ranked a school-best fifth nationally in the Golfweek/Sagarin rankings with three team victories and three individual wins and a record of 148-28-4 (.833), the second best winning percentage in school history. Auburn advanced to the NCAA Championship for the first time under Clinard, finishing 15th at historic Riviera Country Club in Pacific Palisades, Calif.

Auburn won the Carpet Capital Collegiate for its first opening season victory since the 1978 Alabama Intercollegiate. The Tigers also won the Gator Invitational and Hootie at Bulls Bay.

Dominic Bozzelli became the first Auburn golfer in history to win back-to-back tournaments with the U.S. Collegiate and the Gator Invitational. Niclas Carlsson won the Hootie at Bulls Bay, a shot ahead of Blayne Barber.

The Tigers were the No. 1 seed in the NCAA Greensboro Regional for the first time in school history. At the regional, Auburn had an incredible final four holes as it went 8-under par over that span to jump from seventh to finish third to qualify for the NCAA Championship for the first time since 2008.

Five Auburn golfers earned All-SEC and NCAA All-Southeast Region honors, including first-team Blayne Barber, second-teamers Will McCurdy, Dominic Bozzelli and Niclas Carlsson and Freshman All-SEC Michael Johnson. The five All-SEC honorees are the most in program history, breaking the record of four in 2005.

Junior All-American Blayne Barber finished the campaign with a scoring average of 70.76, which snapped the 36-year-old Auburn record that was set by Buddy Gardner in 1976. The Lake City, Fla., native finished the year with seven top-5 finishes including back-to-back runner-ups at the E-Z-GO Schenkel Invitational and the Hootie at Bulls Bay. Barber finished the season ranked No. 7 in the nation in the Golfweek/Sagarin Rankings and became the first Auburn golfer to be named a first-team All-American since Chip Spratlin and Iain Steel in 1995. Dominic Bozzelli was an All-America honorable mention selection in 2012.

In 2010-11, Auburn finished with a school record winning percentage of .907 with a 122-12-1 record as the Tigers won back-to-back titles at the Chris Schenkel Invitational in 2010 and 2011 while also winning the 2010 Jerry Pate National Intercollegiate, 2010 Tiger Shootout and 2011 UK Bluegrass Invitational.

The Tigers finished the season ranked 11th nationally and advanced to the NCAA Colorado Regional. Three Tigers were PING All-Southeast Region selections in sophomores Blayne Barber, Michael Hebert and freshman Niclas Carlsson. Only three NCAA Div. I programs had more selections than Auburn.

Auburn also had three All-SEC selections as Ben Hogan Award semifinalist Blayne Barber was named second-team All-American and first-team All-SEC leading the Tigers with a 70.93 scoring average as Hebert as an All-SEC second team pick while Carlsson was a Freshman All-SEC selection. It marked the first time since 2005 that three Tigers earned All-SEC honors. Barber was also selected to play in the prestigious Palmer Cup.

In 2009-10, Kyle Kopsick was named All-SEC second-team while David Zickler was named to the Freshman All-SEC team. Alongside Barber in 2010-11, Michael Hebert was named All-SEC second team while Niclas Carlsson was named Freshman All-SEC after he became to first freshman since Jimmy Green in 1988 to earn individual medalist honors.

In his first two recruiting classes, Clinard

signed a pair of recruits ranked top-10 in the world - Sweden's Niclas Carlsson and Michael Johnson of Birmingham, Ala. Clinard also signed the No. 1 recruit out the state of Alabama two seasons in a row in Michael Johnson and Ryan Benton.

As swing coach for Barber, Clinard helped the Lake City, Fla., native become just the second golfer in school history to earn the honor of representing the United States at the Walker Cup. Barber also represented the United States at the 2011 and 2012 Palmer Cup. Barber earned his PGA Tour card for 2015 by finishing seventh on the 2014 Web.com Tour by earning \$269,111. Clinard also coached Barber and David Johnson, who both were Florida State Amateur Golfer of the Year, the highest award in the state of Florida.

In his career, Clinard has 36 tournament victories including two conference championships, coached nine All-Americans, 14 Academic All-Americans, two conference players of the year, three individual conference champions and 28 all-conference selections.

UCF won the NCAA Southeast Regional title by defeating No. 2 Georgia and No. 13 South Carolina in 2009 along with claiming the school's first Conference USA Championship. The Knights also won The Hummingbird Intercollegiate and the Rio Pinar Invitational as Clinard was named Conference USA Coach of the Year and the NCAA Southeast Regional Coach of the Year.

Clinard played professional golf for five seasons from 1996-2001 on the NGA Hooters Tour as well as several Nike Tour and Canadian Tour events prior to becoming head coach of UCF. He was also the assistant tournament director of the Jim McLean Future Collegians World Tour from 1998-2001 and worked as an assistant golf professional at the Hank Haney Golf Ranch in McKinney, Texas, from 1997-2000.

The Gastonia, N.C., native graduated from Wake Forest University in 1995 with a Bachelor's degree in speech communication. He played one year of collegiate golf at SMU before playing his final three years at Wake Forest from 1992-95, where the Demon Deacons were ranked in the top 10 in the nation all three seasons. Clinard is married to the former Susan Roberts, and they have two daughters, Chloe and Peyton.



Corey Maggard

Associate Head Coach • Third Season • Alma Mater: Transylvania (2008)

Corey Maggard is in his third season at Auburn under head coach Nick Clinard, and his first as Associate Head Coach in 2016-17. The Tigers had the fourth best NCAA Championship finish in school history by finishing 12th in 2015 in his first season.

Maggard was a finalist for the Jan Strickland Award for the National Assistant Coach of the Year in 2017 as selected by the Golf Coaches Association of America and was a semifinalist in 2016.

Auburn, which finished tied for 19th at the NCAA Championship, won four tournaments in 2015-16 including the Carpet Capital Collegiate, U.S. Collegiate Championship, Mobile Sports Authority Intercollegiate and the Seminole Intercollegiate while finishing as runner-up in four others.

The Tigers had five medalists with Michael Johnson winning three, the Primland Collegiate, Mobile Sports Authority Intercollegiate and the Schenkel Invitational. Freshman Graysen Huff won the ASU Fall Beach Classic while Will Long was co-medalist at the U.S. Collegiate Championship.

Michael Johnson was named first-team All-SEC and was a semifinalist for both the Jack Nicklaus Award and Ben Hogan Award and was on the Haskins Award Watch List. Jacob Solomon was a Freshman All-SEC selection in 2016. Johnson and Solomon were both named to the PING All-Southeast Region team.

Auburn won three consecutive tournaments with three straight medalists, all different, in the Mobile Sports Authority Intercollegiate, Tiger Invitational Presented by Jason Dufner and the Schenkel Invitational in 2014-15.

Ben Schlottman was named Golfweek honorable mention All-American, the first freshman in school history to receive All-America honors.

Five Tigers were named to the NCAA All-Southeast Region team as No. 1 Illinois and No. 2 Texas were the only three schools in the nation to have five players

named NCAA All-Region.

Schlottman and Matt Gilchrest were both named first-team All-SEC while Michael Johnson was a second-team selection. Schlottman also became the first Auburn freshman to be named All-SEC first-team in history while also being tabbed SEC Freshman of the Year.

Auburn destroyed the school's team single-season stroke average record by averaging 283.23 strokes per round in 2015 with the previous mark being 285.30 set in 2011-12. In fact, Clinard-coached teams have the four lowest averages in Tiger history.

Schlottman recorded the fourth lowest single season stroke average in school history and set the Auburn freshman record averaging 70.96.

Auburn climbed to being ranked fourth nationally in 2014-15 after winning two consecutive tournaments in the Mobile Sports Authority Intercollegiate and the Tiger Invitational Presented by Jason Dufner by 28 shots, the largest margin of victory in school history. Auburn then won the Schenkel Invitational at 41-under, edging No. 5 Vanderbilt by a stroke, for its third-straight win.

Prior to coming to Auburn in 2014-15, Maggard won four-straight Old Dominion Athletic Conference Championships in his four years as head men's golf coach at Div. III Guilford College.

Maggard, who led Guilford to 16 tournament wins in his four seasons, was named the Jack Jensen ODAC Coach of the Year three-straight seasons from 2011-13. Guilford spent time ranked No. 1 in the nation by Golf World and in the Golfstat.com rankings in 2011 and 2012 as the Quakers finished ninth at the 2011 NCAA Div. III Championship, 11th in 2012 and 17th in both 2013 and 2014.

Guilford's Noah Ratner was selected a three-time first-team PING All-American and ODAC Golfer of the Year from 2011-13 and received the 2012 Jack Nicklaus Award as the Div. III National Player of the Year.

Maggard coached three All-Americans

and had 11 golfers earn 18 All-ODAC awards, including Tanner Gross, who was a second-team PING All-American in 2014 and won the Golf Coaches Association of America's Phil Mickelson Award as Div. III's top rookie.

Prior to Guilford, Maggard spent two seasons as the assistant golf coach at Transylvania under Brian Lane. He was one of 10 semifinalists for the GCAA's 2010 Jan Strickland Award, which is given annually to the assistant from all levels in college golf who excels in working with student-athletes on the course and in the classroom.

Transylvania won the Heartland Collegiate Athletic Conference title and earned the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Div. III Tournament in 2009 and 2010. The Pioneers featured the HCAC's top golfer both seasons and had nine all-conference selections during his coaching tenure.

Maggard was a four-year letterman at Transylvania from 2005-08, was a three-time All-HCAC selection and helped lead the Pioneers to the HCAC Championship and a pair of NCAA Championship appearances in 2007 and 2008. He was the runner-up at the 2006 HCAC Tournament while finishing third as both a junior and senior.

The London, Ky., native won the 2007 Anderson Spring Invitational and the 2005 Transylvania Spring Invitational and served four years on the student-athlete advisory committee.

Maggard spent four years as an assistant golf professional at the Man O'War Golf Learning Center in Lexington, Ky., and is a Level Two Titleist Performance Institute Certified Golf Professional and Power Coach. He also worked as a golf operations assistant at the Gulf Stream Golf Club in Delray Beach, Fla.

Maggard earned his B.A. degree in business management from Transylvania in 2008. He is married to the former Katie Young of Lexington, Ky.
