I, the undersigned, wish to voluntarily participate in the above referenced event on the dates and times as indicated above and, in consideration of the mutual covenants and conditions contained in this Agreement, I hereby agree as follows:

I acknowledge, understand and appreciate that as part of my participation in this event there are dangers, hazards and inherent risks to which I may be exposed, including the risk of serious physical injury, temporary or permanent disability, and death, as well as economic and property loss. The dangers, hazards and risks may arise from my own actions, inactions, or negligence as well as from the actions, inactions or negligence of others, or the condition of the premises. I also acknowledge and understand that there may be other dangers, hazards or risks not presently known or reasonably foreseeable. Therefore, I voluntarily accept and assume all risk of injury, loss of life or damage to property arising out of participating and traveling to or from this event.

I agree to be accountable in all respects for my own conduct and all actions, claims and demands for damages, loss and injury which may arise as a result of my own conduct. While Auburn will provide a designated natural grass, covered restroom space (“dog relief zone”) for my dog and will provide dog waste bags, I agree to be responsible for picking up, disposing and cleaning any of my dog’s waste at all times while on Auburn premises. _____ INITIALS

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed under the laws of Alabama. I agree that any legal action or proceeding relating to this Agreement, or arising out of any injury, death, damage or loss as a result of my participation in any part of the event, shall be brought only in Lee County, Alabama.

Rules for Bark in the Park:

- Each fan who brings their dog must turn in a completed Bark in the Park waiver form upon entry to the stadium. Completed forms will be taken at the right field gate.
- Waiver forms will be available at the right field gate on Tuesday.
- All Bark in the Park participants must enter at the right field gate off Donahue Dr. Participants may not enter at the main gate or at the Tiger Terrace gate.
- Dogs are not allowed in the Tiger Terrace.
- Participants are limited to one dog per person. Each dog must be on a leash at all times upon entry to Plainsman Park.
- A Comfort Zone will be located in the green space directly in front of the indoor hitting facility. A water station with waste bags will be provided.
- Participants may bring pet supplies, water bowl, treats, etc.
- For fans who do not wish to sit next to a dog, please go to the ticket booth located at the front gate for seating relocation.
- Participants may not enter prior to 5 p.m., one hour prior to first pitch.
- Dogs are allowed in the Plainsman Patio tent.
