FOR STARTERS

Louisiana dropped a 64-53 decision to Tulsa in its first road test of the season on Monday, but gets a quick turnaround for another opportunity at a road win on Friday when it travels to Auburn for a game to be broadcast on FSN South with Bernie Guenther providing the play-by-play and Daymeon Fishback adding color commentary.

THE LAST TIME OUT

The Louisiana Ragin' Cajuns erased a double-digit halftime lead early in the second half, but a late scoring drought was too much to overcome as Tulsa picked up a 64-53 win in its home opener on Monday at the Reynolds Center.

Louisiana trailed 32-21 at the half, but went on a 14-2 run to open up the second period, taking its final lead of the night on a jumper from J.J. Davenport; however, Tulsa responded with a run of their own and held the Cajuns without a field goal for a 6:52 stretch late in the second half to pull away.

The Cajuns were plagued throughout the night by the turnover bug, giving it up 13 times in the first half and 25 times on the night to lead to 20 Tulsa points. Shawn Long scored 12 of his teamhigh 15 points in the second half as the only Cajun to reach double figures. Brian Williams had nine points and six rebounds for UL, while Hayward Register hit two of the Cajuns' five threes on the night for his six points.

UP NEXT

Louisiana heads to Las Vegas for the neutral-site portion of the MGM Grand Main Event, beginning Monday against Milwaukee, immediately followed by a Tuesday game against Oral Roberts. UL will not be at home again until a December 3 meeting against Jackson State, starting a stretch of three of four games in the Cajundome.

Last Meeting

The Ragin' Cajuns dropped their road opener of the 2000-01 season at Beard-Eaves Coliseum in Auburn, 93-86, despite a 22-point effort from Anthony Johnson. It was his second straight game to go for better than 20 points, hitting 10-for-12 from the foul line. Kenneth Lawrence added a pair of three-point buckets and a career-high 12 points, but Jamison Brewer hit 11 of his 14 shots for the Tigers, going for a game-high 26 points as one of four Tigers in double figures to help erase a 43-39 halftime lead for the Cajuns.

Series Notes

This will be the first meeting between the Cajuns and Tigers since 2000, and the second time head coach Bob Marlin has faced them. The Cajuns have not won against Auburn since the 1985-86 season, and its lone victory at Auburn came in an 80-76 decision on Dec. 18, 1968.

NEW WAVE: With seven newcomers on the roster, the Ragin' Cajuns knew their new faces would have an immediate impact. Through two games this year's newcomers have accounted for 79 of UL's 127 points – (62.2 percent) – coming from six of those newcomers. In fact, each of UL's double-digit scorers in its season opener vs Louisiana College were newcomers with Devonta Walker leading the way with 20, and Brian Williams and Johnathan Stove adding 11 each.

THE HOT STOVE: Freshman Johnathan Stove provided a spark off the bench for the Ragin' Cajuns in the season opener against Louisiana College, going for 11 points on 4-for-6 shooting, with three boards and a pair of assists. Stove is the first UL true freshman to reach double digits in his collegiate debut since Travis Bureau did so when he debuted against ULM on Dec. 16, 2007 with 11 points.

HIGH-OCTANE CAJUNS: Louisiana basketball has a history of high scoring, averaging at least 80 points per game 10 times from 1971 to 1992; however, since then the Cajuns had scored better than 75 points per game just six times entering the 2013-14 campaign. But last year's Cajuns ramped up the offense, averaging 81.0 points per game and eclipsing the 100-point mark four times. That average was the highest by a Cajun team since the 1990-91 squad put up 91.1 points per game.

BOARDING PASSES: The 2013-14 Ragin' Cajuns were one of the top rebounding teams in the Sun Belt Conference, tying for the league lead with Western Kentucky with a +3.4 rebounding margin at the end of the season. In 18 conference games, the Cajuns owned the edge on the glass 15 times, only being out-rebounded twice in league play both times to UALR. They are +8.0 in rebound margin through two games this year.

LONG NEARING TOP 30: Junior Shawn Long turned in a solid offensive showing against Tulsa, going for 15 points in the loss to the Golden Hurricane. It was the 62nd double-figure scoring game of Long's career in 69 games played. He now 1,165 points for his career and needs 29 more points to move past Michael Southall into the No. 30 spot at UL in all-time scoring. With 335 more points this year he would become just the 13th 1,500-point scorer in UL history.

TURNOVERS HURTING THE CAJUNS: The Cajuns turned the ball 20 or more times just twice in 35 games a year ago, but have already totaled 46 miscues in just two games this season. In fact, the 25 turnovers in Monday's loss at Tulsa is the most in the Bob Marlin era and the first time UL has had at least 25 turnovers in a game since surrendering the ball 31 times in a the 2006-07 season opener against Ouachita Baptist.

VIVA LAS VEGAS: Monday's game vs Tulsa will serve as the first of four games for

the Ragin' Cajuns as part of the MGM Grand Main Event. Lasting from Nov. 17-25, the event includes a pair of campus-site games, with Louisiana's coming at Tulsa and at Auburn (Nov. 21). The Main Event culminates the week of Thanksgiving in Las Vegas when the Cajuns take on Milwaukee (Nov. 24) and Oral Roberts (Nov. 25) at the MGM Grand in Las Vegas, UL's only neutral-site games of the year prior to the conference tournament in New Orleans at season's end.

STAYING IN THE PELICAN STATE: The Ragin' Cajuns are scheduled for 11 non-conference games leading up to Sun Belt Conference play; however, it will be rare for them to leave Louisiana's borders. In fact, UL's only games played outside of Louisiana are as part of the MGM Grand Main Event, ending Nov. 25 in Las Vegas. Additionally, five of the 11 non-conference games played will be against fellow Louisiana schools.

CLOSE WAS ENOUGH: After posting a 3-8 record in games decided by five points or less in 2012-13, the Ragin' Cajuns reversed course last season en route to their first 20-win season in over a decade. The Cajuns were 7-3 in games decided by five points or less in 2013-14, beginning with a 73-69 win over Coastal Carolina and ending with an 82-81 win over Georgia State in the Sun Belt Conference Tournament finals.

TROPHY MARLIN: Head coach Bob Marlin entered his fifth season at the helm of the Ragin' Cajuns and one year removed from a 23-win season that was the team's most victories since winning 25 in 1999-2000. He is 67-64 at UL and ranks second among active head coaches in the Sun Belt Conference with 415 victories. Last season Marlin took his second team to the NCAA Tournament, having done so twice at Sam Houston State in 2003 and 2010.

LIFE WITHOUT ELFRID: Louisiana will have its hands full replacing the production of three-year point guard Elfrid Payton, who was selected as the No. 10 pick in last summer's NBA Draft after a junior season that saw him be named the SBC Defensive Player of the Year and first team all-SBC selection after averaging 19.2 points, 6.0 rebounds, 5.9 assists and 2.3 steals per game. Cocah Bob Marlin has put a trio of players to work at the point in the first two games of this season, with Tiremone Williams providing the most steady hand. Williams played 21 minutes off the bench in Monday's loss at Tulsa, pulling in a team-high six rebounds. In two games Williams has played 37 minutes, dishing out five assists without a turnover.

100-POINT GAMES: The Ragin' Cajuns have scored 100 points in 127 games going into its 102nd season of basketball. Four of those came last season against Northwestern State, South Alabama, Centenary and Louisiana College. In all, UL is 124-3 in games in which it has scored 100 points, while the four 100-point games was the most in a single season since the 1989-90 team had nine games over 100 points.

SHEPHERD'S RETURN: Kasey Shepherd was having a solid sophomore campaign a year ago before it was cut short midway through the season due to a knee injury against Western Kentucky, causing him to miss the final 15 games of the season. Prior to his injury, Shepherd was averaging 8.2 points per game and shooting lights out with a .535 percentage from three-point range and a .939 percentage at the foul line. Both of those marks would top the Cajun record books, however, UL records require a minimum of 1.5 makes per game to qualify, with Shepherd's totals falling just shy of those minimums.

FRESH FISH: Bob Marlin and his staff reeled in arguably his most heralded freshman class of his tenure last year, and welcome all three to the roster for the 2014-15 season. The Cajuns successfully raided the South Louisiana region for the trio of Johnathan Stove (Baton Rouge, Christian Life Academy), Scott Plaisance (New Orleans, Country Day HS) and Bryce Washington (New Orleans, St. Augustine HS). All three put together stellar prep careers with Stove and Plaisance having claimed the last two LSWA Class 1A Player of the Year awards in the state of Louisiana.

PRESEASON ACCOLADES: Junior Shawn Long and senior Xavian Rimmer were each

named to the preseason all-Sun Belt Conference teams prior to the start of the 2014-15 season in a vote by league coaches. Long was a first-team choice after earning first team all-SBC honors following a 2013-14 season that saw him average 18.6 points and 10.4 rebounds per game with 18 double-doubles. Meanwhile, Rimmer was a second-team choice by the coaches after finishing sixth in the SBC with a 43.2 percentage from beyond the three-point arc in his first season with the Ragin' Cajuns. He averaged 8.8 points per game a year ago, and landed on the all-SBC Tournament team.

CAJUNS PICKED SECOND IN SBC: The Sun Belt Conference also released its preseason poll prior to the start of the season with league coaches picking the Ragin' Cajuns to finish second in the league behind unanimous league favorite and defending champion Georgia State. Louisiana will be in search of its first official league regular season title since the 1999-2000 season.

HOME SECURITY: In each of the past five seasons, the Ragin' Cajuns have posted double-digit win totals in the friendly confines of the Cajundome. During the 2013-14 season, the Cajuns posted a 13-2 record - their best win total in the Dome since going 13-4 in 1990-91. The 13 wins marked the third time that has occurred (1989-90, 1990-91). The Ragin' Cajuns record for single-season wins in the Cajundome is 14, set in 1988-89. Louisiana is 44-15 at the Cajundome in four-plus seasons under current head coach Bob Marlin

SITTIN' ON 20s: The Ragin' Cajuns 23-12 record last season was the first 20-win season for the program since the 2002-03 squad finished 20-10. The 23 wins was the most in a single season since posting a 25-9 record in 1999-2000. Louisiana has officially procuced 22 seasons with 20 or more victories, with a school-record 25 coming twice (1970-71 and 1999-2000).

CAJUNS IN MID-MAJOR TOP 25: Louisiana checked in at No. 16 in the latest Mid Major Top 25, sponsored by CollegeInsider.com. The Ragin' Cajuns received 258 points in the poll released Nov. 17, checking in between UC Irvine and Murray State. Georgia State sits at No. 9 in the poll as the only other Sun Belt Conference team in the field.

CHARITY CASES: One of the primary areas of point production a year ago for the Ragin' Cajuns came at the free throw line. Despite hitting at a .671 mark from the line, the Cajuns took 913 shots from the charity stripe, a total that was 128 more than any other team in the SBC. That led to 613 made foul shots, another mark that was tops in the league. Through games on Nov. 18, the Cajuns ranked third in the SBC in free throw attempts (47), but rank 10th in free throw percentage (.574).

LOUISIANA LOCALS: The Ragin' Cajuns coaching staff has done a great job of making sure its roster is filled with local talent. Of the 16 players on the roster, 11 players hail from the state of Louisiana, with just three calling somewhere outside of the Texas-Louisiana-Mississippi tri-state region home. That total ties the Cajuns with UT Arlington for the highest percentage of in-state talent among Sun Belt programs.

FROM STILLWATER TO LAFAYETTE: Senior forward Brian Williams joins the Ragin' Cajuns for the 2014-15 season with one year of eligibility remaining after a three-year career at Oklahoma State. Williams originally hails from Baton Rouge, La., but signed with the Cowboys out of Glen Oaks HS and played a big role for Travis Ford's club for three years, helping OSU to the NCAA Tournament each of the past two seasons. He played in 80 games there, making 46 starts in Stillwater and averaging 7.2 points and 3.1 rebounds for his career. His graduation from OSU with a degree in education freed him up to return to his home state where he is pursuing a graduate degree in kinesiology.

COUNTDOWN TO 1,000: Shawn Long has been a rebounding machine for the Cajuns in his first two seasons in Lafayette, and is now averaging 10.1 rebounds per game for his career. With 700 career boards to date, another similar season will push him over the 1,000-rebound mark for his career. He needs 300 rebounds to join Roy Ebron and Marcus Stokes as the only players in Ragin' Cajuns history to pull in 1,000 rebounds at UL.
