NO. 14 AUBURN KICKS OFF 2018 AT ARIZONA STATE

The No. 14 Auburn gymnastics team opens the 2018 season in the desert, traveling to Tempe, Ariz., for a quad meet at No. 31 Arizona State. The Tigers will take on the Sun Devils, No. 21 Iowa, and No. 29 Iowa State Saturday, Jan. 6, at 5 p.m. CT in Wells Fargo Arena.

"This is a completely different team from last year with a lot of young people," head coach Jeff Graba said. "We are going to use the month of January to move some people around to make sure that we're doing a good job putting the best people in the best spot to maximize our success. I'm looking forward to seeing how this young team performs under pressure and how they react in a meet environment. It'll be a very important opening weekend to get some experience and solidify what we know we have."

IN THE RANKINGS

The Auburn gymnastics team will enter the 2018 season at No. 14 as the National Association of College Gymnastics Coaches/Women (NACGC/W) released its yearly preseason poll.

"Obviously, we're more concerned with the final results than the preseason polls," Graba said. "But, I'm very happy to see that other coaches around the country think we'll improve this year. We have a lot of talented young people and I already see us improving on last year's finish."

GAMEDAY EXPERIENCE: AUBURN ARENA

» The Auburn gymnastics program has enjoyed five sellouts (7,424) in the last three seasons at Auburn Arena. The Tigers have reached new heights already in 2017 as season ticket holder numbers have risen yet again.



Three Southeastern Conference teams rank in the Top 5, while all eight league schools rank in the Top 20. Defending national champion Oklahoma is No. 1 with Florida (2), LSU (3), Alabama (4), and Utah (5) following. Kentucky comes in at No. 10, while Georgia (16), Missouri (17), and Arkansas (19) close out the other ranked conference teams.

SCOUTING ARIZONA STATE

The No. 31 Arizona State Sun Devils return 12 from the 2017 squad that finished at No. 41 overall, including lone senior Nichelle Christopherson and five juniors. In addition, the squad added a pair of transfers in Anne Kuhm (Michigan) and Kaitlyn Szafranski (LSU). Kuhm competed for the French national team at the 2012 London Olympics.

SERIES HISTORY - AUBURN VS. ARIZONA STATE

The Sun Devils are 6-2-1 in the series history vs. Auburn. The Tigers and ASU last met in a dual meet in 2016, where AU topped the visiting Sun Devils, 197.175-193.275. The meeting was just the second time the two squads have gone head-to-head in a dual meet format.

SCOUTING IOWA

The No. 20 Iowa Hawkeyes were selected to finish third in the Big Ten Women's Gymnastics Preseason Coaches' Poll after returning 14 from last year's team. Senior Lanie Snyder and sophomore Clair Kaji were named to the 2018 Big Ten Women's Gymnasts to Watch list.

SERIES HISTORY - AUBURN VS. IOWA

The Tigers are 8-2 vs. the Hawkeyes in the series history. Auburn has won the last three meetings in which two were held at a neutral site. Auburn and Iowa last faced off in 2015 in Auburn Arena at the NCAA Regional where the Tigers advanced to the NCAA Championship with a second-place finish.

SCOUTING IOWA STATE

The No. 29 Iowa State Cyclones concluded the 2017 season in fifth place at the NCAA Lincoln Regionals with a 195.250. The squad returns 13 letterwinners, including NCAA Championship qualifier Haylee Young. In addition, the team returns every routine from last season as the squad did not have a senior in 2017.

SERIES HISTORY - AUBURN VS. IOWA STATE

The series history between the Tigers and the Cyclones dates back to 1988 with ISU holding a 9-4 overall mark. The

last meeting had Iowa State top the Tigers in the 2014 NCAA Regional. The two teams last met in the regular season in 2011 with the Cyclones topping the Tigers in Ames, Iowa.

AUBURN LINEUP

Depth is the name of the game for the Tigers in 2018 as each event is expected to be at least 10 gymnasts deep. The tentative lineup for Saturday's meet features one senior, five juniors, three sophomores, and four freshmen. (Lineups are subject to change prior to the meet)

Picking up where she left off last year in the all-around is sophomore Katie Becker. The Boone, N.C., product represented the Tigers in the category at the 2017 NCAA Championship as a freshman.

The Tigers start the quad meet on bars and will feature an experienced group starting with juniors Abby Milliet and Samantha Cerio. Milliet holds a career-high 9.95 under her belt, while Cerio qualified for the 2017 NCAA Championship in the event. Becker will be joined by classmates Gracie Day and Kendal Moss. Day competed in the event in all meets last year. Earning her first-career start is senior Cara Stricklin.

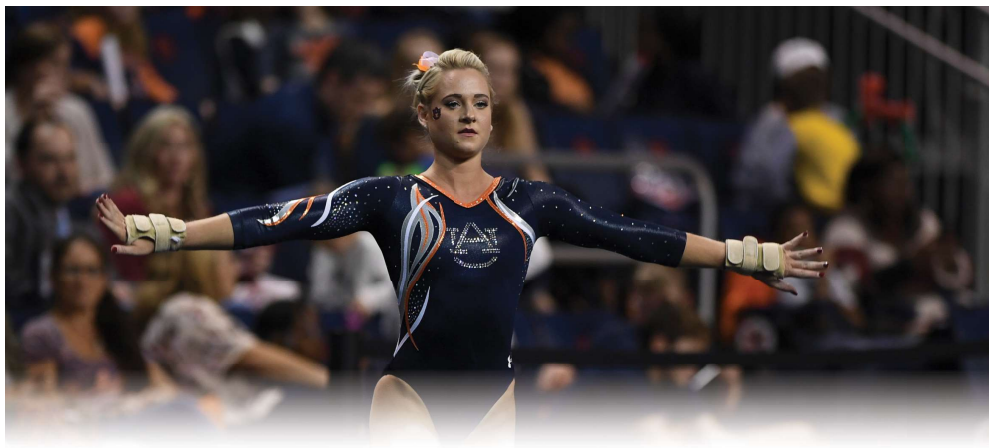
The second rotation has the team move to beam where the squad will once again feature a lineup full of juniors and sophomores. Becker will lead off and is set to be followed by freshman Allie Riddle. Cerio and redshirt sophomore Emma Slappey will hold down the middle of the lineup with Milliet following and junior Taylor Krippner closing out in the anchor spot. Krippner led the Tigers last year in the event, reaching a career-best 9.925 in February.

Rotation three will have Auburn go on floor where the squad lost three rotations from 2017. Becker will kick things off before freshman Ashley Smith makes her collegiate debut. Cerio, Day, Slappey, and Milliet will all showcase their routines for the Tigers as well.

Auburn concludes the meet with vault and will feature two new faces in freshmen Jada Glenn and Drew Watson. Becker will once again lead off, while junior A'Miracal Phillips makes her first appearance of the season. Day, a sophomore from San Antonio, will anchor the team.

STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE

Auburn's 2018 schedule once again ranks in the Top 10 among the toughest schedules in the nation.

Auburn will face eight teams ranked in the Top 25 of the NACGC/W Preseason Poll. Those include match ups with four teams who competed in last year's Super Six - Georgia (Jan. 19), Florida (Feb. 2), Alabama (Feb. 23 & March 9), and LSU (March 4).

HOME SWEET HOME

Home advantage has been and will continue to be a big factor for the Tigers this season as the squad hopes to add more sellouts (7,424) to its growing list. The program once again reached new heights in season ticket sales, eclipsing 1,625 so far. That totaled bested the 2017 record of 1,591.

"Anyone who has been to one of our home meets knows that we have a phenomenal home advantage," Graba said. "This is the biggest benefit we can bring when we go up against perennial powers like Florida and Alabama. Our crowd is so fun for us to compete in front of and can be so intimidating for the opposing team. The SEC is the toughest in the country as every team finished 2017 in the Top 18 and therefore, we need every advantage we can get."

The Tigers will host four of its seven SEC meets at home in Auburn Arena, including contests against three Top 15 teams in Florida, Alabama, and Kentucky.

EXPERIENCED JUNIORS

The Auburn roster boasts seven gymnasts in this year's junior class with all bringing a wealth of experience to the table. Highlighting the group is redshirt junior Abby Milliet, who returns follow a season-ending injury early in 2017. Joining her is Taylor Krippner, Emma Engler, and Samantha Cerio. The trio competed in three events each last season.

"I think our junior class is well prepared to lead this young team," Graba said. "They have a lot of competition under their belts and have a chip on their shoulder at this point. The actual athletic ability of the junior class is amazing and they will do a great job of leading us this year."

A'Miracal Phillips and Telah Black will once again bring power to

vault for the Tigers. Phillips held a spot in the lineup in all meets last year, while Black returns from a season-ending injury after competing in three meets as a sophomore.

In addition, the Tigers picked up transfer Skyler Sheppard. The junior came to Auburn from Arizona where she competed on vault, beam, and floor for the Wildcats. Auburn expects Sheppard to be a contributor in all three events this year.

SUPER SOPHOMORES

The sophomore quartet of Katie Becker, Gracie Day, Kendal Moss, and Emma Slaphey also brings a wealth of experience to the lineup. Day and Slaphey were All-SEC performers, while Becker competed in the All-Around at the 2017 NCAA Gymnastics Championship in St. Louis.

"This class had to compete in some high-pressure situations as freshmen and did a great job," Graba said. "They really found their stride at the end of the last season. I expect them to share in the leadership role of this team and they will need to continue to rise to the occasion."

NEWBIES

Auburn added six freshmen for 2018 and the group is expected to not only bring a new level of talent to the team, but also a new level of competition in practice.

"I'm very excited for this class," Graba said. "They are very talented and bring a lot of big meet experience to the table. They are a great mix of power, poise and personality and will be fun to watch."

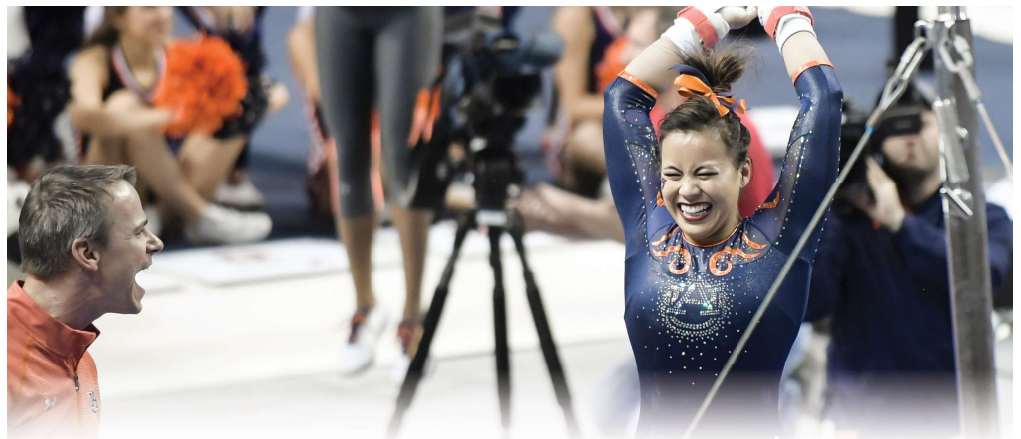

Three-time SEC Coach of the Year Jeff Graba enters his eighth season at the helm of the Auburn gymnastics program in 2018 and has guided the Tigers record heights during his time on The Plains.

For his efforts over the past seven seasons, the Minnesota native was named SEC Coach of the Year in 2014 and 2015 and SEC co-Coach of the Year in 2012.

Graba and the 2016 team added to the list of firsts for the program under his guidance. The Tigers snapped the 117-meet losing skid to Alabama in February of that season, defeating the Crimson Tide at home (197.275-197.250). Auburn also defeated Georgia in Athens for the first time in program history, setting a new program-high road score on the way (197.325).

In addition, the Tigers earned the program's first No. 1 NCAA regional seed and captured the NCAA Ann Arbor Regional title with a 196.525.

Auburn enjoyed a breakout season in 2015 as Graba led the Tigers to the NCAA Championship Super Six for the first time in 22 years. That season, Auburn broke or tied 52 program records that season.

Auburn's sixth place finish at the Super Six was the Tigers' second best in history and highest since 1993 with a NCAA nationals record score of 197.075. The Tigers also had a program record Super Six score of 195.625.

Auburn reached the 2015 NCAA Championship for the first time since 2003 and for only the fourth time overall as the Tigers tied a school-best with a runner-up finish at the NCAA Regional with a regional record score of 196.900. Auburn's No. 2 regional seed was the highest in history.

Graba was named Auburn head coach on August 16, 2010. He came to The Plains after spending five years as an assistant coach at Utah. While with the Utes, he was named the 2009 West Region Assistant Coach of the Year while coaching bars, collaborating on floor routines and serving as the recruiting coordinator.
