UCFACTS

DAWKINS ERA AT UCF

- Johnny Dawkins has made an immediate impact as head coach for the UCF men's basketball team, winning 83 games in four years at the helm.
Dawkins is 83-48 since starting with the Knights in 2016, a win percentage of .634, the second best of any UCF coach (Torchy Clark, .754 from 1969-83).
He has the third most wins over any UCF coach, trailing Clark's 274 and Kirk Speraw's 247 from 1993-2010.
Dawkins has led UCF to its first NIT Final Four (2017), first at-large berth to the NCAA Tournament (2019) and first NCAA Tournament win (2019).

COVID-19 SHORTENED 2019-20 SEASON

- After making its first trip to the NCAA Tournament in over a decade in 2019, UCF finished 16-14 overall and 7-11 in a shortened 2019-20 season.
It was an up-and-down season as the Knights finished just over .500, but had key victories over Cincinnati and Tulsa, who tied for the regular season title in The American.
Collin Smith led the Knights with 12.6 points per game, while freshman Darin Green Jr. was second with 10.1 points per game and led The American with 41.7 percent 3-point shooting and 2.3 threes made per game.

WHO IS BACK?

- Most notably, Green. The now sophomore returns to potentially take on a larger role in year two at UCF.
Green averaged 10.1 points per game, shot 41.7 percent from long distance and set a UCF freshman record with 68 threes made in 2019-20.
Additionally, senior Brandon Mahan, redshirt sophomore Dre Fuller Jr., senior Avery Diggs, redshirt junior Ibrahim Famouke Doumbia and sophomore Tony Johnson Jr. are all back for the 2020-21 campaign.

WHO IS GONE?

- Again, most notably, it's Smith. The team's leading scorer had one year of eligibility left, but announced prior to the season that he had to step away from the game of basketball after conversations with his doctors.
Ceasar DeJesus also moved on to start his professional career, while Dazon Ingram, Matt Milon and Frank Bertz are also gone after exhausting their eligibility.
Smith was second on the team with 6.3 rebounds and led the way with 19 blocked shots.
Ingram was the team's leader in rebounding (6.9) and assists (109), while Milon 43 shots from beyond the arc in his only season with the Knights.

## KNIGHT NOTES

#### WHO IS NEW?

- Let's start with the immediately eligible transfers. C.J. Walker is a sophomore forward from Sanford, Fla., who spent his freshman season at Oregon, while Darius Perry is a senior guard, who played three seasons at Louisville before graduating.
- Next there are the two transfers who sat out last season, practicing with the Knights. Sean Mobley is a redshirt junior forward from Orlando, who played two seasons at VCU, including an NCAA Tournament game against UCF. Moses Bol, a distant cousin of the late Manute Bol and current NBA Player Bol Bol, played at Colby Community College prior to arriving in Orlando.
- Finally, there are the two true freshmen looking to make their mark. Isaiah Adams, a 6-foot-6 forward was named Mr. Basketball in the state of Florida out of Paxon in Jacksonville. Jamille Reynolds, out of St. Petersburg, is a 6-foot-9, 285-pound forward.

#### CHALLENGING NON-CONFERENCE SLATE

- While one of their four non-conference games has already been canceled due to COVID-19 issues, the Knights had put together one of the most challenging non-conference schedules in the country for 2020-21.
- UCF originally had out of league games slated at home with Oklahoma and this game against Auburn, while playing on the road at Michigan and Florida State.
- It marks the first time UCF will play only non-conference games against major conference opponents and the Knights are the only team in The American to do so in 2020-21.

#### GREEN IS GOOD

- Darin Green Jr. made quite an impact as a true freshman last season. He was the team's second leading scorer with 10.1 points per game, starting 14 times and playing in all 30 games.
- He set a UCF freshman record with 68 made 3-pointers and led The American with 41.7 percent shooting from 3-point range and 2.3 threes made per game.
- Green was even better during league play, also leading the AAC with 45.5 percent shooting from distance and 2.5 made 3-pointers per game against conference opponents.
- He also shot 83.3 percent from the free throw line, was named the league's Freshman of the Week once and earned a spot on the AAC's Weekly Honor Roll once.
- His best outing of the year was a 26-point, six 3-pointer night in a win over Tulsa. It was the most points by a UCF freshman since B.J. Taylor had 33 against Tulane on Jan. 14, 2015.

#### FULLER FEELING FINE

- Dre Fuller Jr. said in a recent media availability that he was feeling 100 percent for the first time in a long time.
- Fuller sat out his true freshman season while dealing with an injury and then missed 10 games last season due to injury.
- The 6-foot-5 multi-faceted guard averaged 6.3 points, 3.1 rebounds and 1.5 assists per game while averaging just 19.0 minutes per contest a season ago.
- He was impressive in the month of December as a redshirt freshman, scoring in double figures in four straight games, which included 13 points and eight rebounds at Oklahoma.

#### MORE OF MAHAN

- Back for his second year in the black and gold, you could see even more of Brandon Mahan this season.
- The Texas A&M transfer played in all 30 games as a junior in 2019-20, starting 14 times.
- Mahan averaged 7.5 points and 3.7 rebounds per contest while knocking down 31 three-pointers and shooting 73.8 percent from the free throw line a season ago.
- His best outing as a Knight was in the win at Cincinnati on Feb. 19, matching his career high with 20 points.

#### BEATING RANKED OPPONENTS

- Prior to Johnny Dawkins' arrival at UCF, the program had won three games against ranked opponents from 1984-2016. Since Dawkins has taken over, the Knights have won four games against ranked opponents in just four seasons.
- UCF had never won two games against ranked opponents in a single season, and the Knights did it in a span of five days, taking down no. 6/8 Houston and no. 19/20 Cincinnati late in the 2018-19 season.
- The Knights are now 7-46 all-time against ranked opponents, with the other two wins under Dawkins coming at home against no. 15 Cincinnati in 2016-17 and on the road at no. 24 Alabama in 2017-18.

# JOHNNY DAWKINS

head coach | fifth season



Johnny Dawkins was named UCF's seventh head men's basketball coach on Mar. 23, 2016 and in just four seasons he has led the program to new heights, including the Knights' first NCAA Tournament victory in 2018-19.

Under Dawkins, UCF earned its first at-large berth to the NCAA Tournament in 2018-19. The Knights were a nine seed in the tourney, their highest seed in five all-time NCAA Tournament appearances, and defeated eighth seeded VCU, 73-58 in first-round action.

UCF then came inches away from upsetting top overall seed Duke in the second round, ultimately falling 77-76 to Mike Krzyzewski, Zion Williamson, RJ Barrett and company as BJ Taylor's floater rimmed out and Aubrey Dawkins' tip-in barely missed at the buzzer.

The Knights were stellar down the stretch to secure their at-large NCAA Tournament berth winning on the road at No. 6/8 Houston to snap the Cougars' 33-game home win streak, and then topping No. 19/20 Cincinnati in Orlando on Senior Knight. It marked the first time UCF had earned multiple victories over ranked opponents in the same season, and the Knights did it in back-to-back games.

UCF finished the year 24-9, tied for the fourth most wins in a single season in program history. The Knights' 23 regular season wins marked a new record in UCF's Division I era. The team went 13-5 in American Athletic Conference play, the team's most league wins since joining The American, and earned the four seed in the conference tournament for the second time in three seasons.

Known for their defense under Dawkins, the Knights ranked 11th in the nation in defensive field goal percentage, holding opponents to just 39.4 percent from the floor in 2018-19. UCF was also 27th in scoring defense, allowing 64.5 points per game.

UCF cracked the Associated Press Top 25 Poll for the first time since 2011, earning a ranking of 25th late in the regular season. It was the latest into a season that the Knights have ever been ranked. The home finale against Cincinnati marked the first matchup of ranked teams at Addition Financial Arena.

Dawkins led UCF back to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2005, and the first time as an at-large selection. The previous four NCAA Tournaments were as champions of the Atlantic Sun Conference Tournament in 1994, 1996, 2004 and 2005.

He helped three individuals earn all-conference accolades from The American in 2018-19, as UCF led the league with three honorees. B.J. Taylor became the first Knight to earn first team honors from The American, while Aubrey Dawkins was named second team and Tacko Fall added third team honors.

Following the end of the regular season, Dawkins was named a finalist for the Skip Prosser Man of the Year Award and the Ben Jobe National Coach of the Year Award.

In four years, Johnny Dawkins has led UCF to new heights on the basketball court, including four straight winning seasons, but he has done an even better job with his players in the classroom. With Dawkins at the helm, the Knights men's basketball program recorded an average semester team GPA over 3.0 for the first time in recorded history. They then did it again, setting a new program record with an average semester GPA of 3.03 in the spring of 2019.

Dawkins took over at UCF after the Knights had gone 12-18 and hadn't finished above .500 since 2012-13. He led the Black and Gold to a 24-12 record in his first season at the helm, the sixth best turnaround in the nation. With just seven scholarship players due to transfers and injuries, the Knights earned the fourth seed – their highest ever – in the American Athletic Conference Tournament, eventually falling to league champion SMU in the semifinals.

It was a season full of firsts in 2016-17, as UCF hosted its first NIT game, defeating Colorado for the program's first win in an NIT or NCAA Tournament game. The Knights went on to defeat top seeded Illinois State on the road, before coming home to the first sell-out crowd at Addition Financial Arena and winning 68-58 over Illinois to earn a spot in the NIT Final Four.

Under Dawkins' leadership, UCF led all NCAA Division I teams in defensive field goal percentage in 2016-17, holding opponents to just 36.5 percent from the floor. The Knights were also sixth in the nation, allowing only 61.2 points per game, and gave up 45 or less points in four games over the course of the year. Dawkins was named a finalist for both the Jim Phelan and Ben Jobe National Coach of the Year awards his first season at UCF.

In year two at the helm, Dawkins had to deal with significant injuries to his three best players. His son, Aubrey Dawkins, missed the entire season with a shoulder injury, B.J. Taylor missed the first half of the season, and Tacko Fall missed the second half of the year. Taylor and Fall only played one game together.

Through the injuries, Dawkins led the Knights to a 19-13 record, at that point second only to his first season record in the last five years of UCF Basketball. The team also had a number of firsts in year two under Dawkins.

And the defense was as good as ever in Dawkins' second year coaching the Black and Gold.

### STANFORD STINT

Stanford put together four 20-win seasons in Dawkins' tenure as head coach. He is only the second coach in Stanford history with at least four 20-win seasons. Stanford's success on the court came against some of the toughest schedules in the nation. During the 2015-16 season, the Cardinal faced the sixth-most difficult slate in the country. A nation-leading 17 of Stanford's 30 games came against RPI Top 50 squads. Stanford's strength of schedule was rated in the top 50 each of the past four seasons, including two in the top 20, with an average rank of 27.75.

The Cardinal basketball program also excelled in the classroom during Dawkins' tenure, earning at least three Pac-12 All-Academic selections for five consecutive seasons and producing back-to-back Pac-12 Scholar-Athlete of the Year recipients (2014, 2015). Stanford also received annual national academic recognition, with three players earning National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) Honors Court status in 2015. The Cardinal was one of 20 NCAA Division I teams to earn an NABC Team Academic Excellence Award last season.

In 2012, Dawkins mentored Chasson Randle to become the consummate student-athlete. Randle finished that season as Stanford's all-time leading scorer and earned the program's first Academic All-America First Team selection since 2006. Under Dawkins, Stanford recorded back-to-back perfect Academic Progress Rate scores of 1000 in both the 2012-13 and 2013-14 reports, the two most recent to be released by the NCAA.



Player development was also markedly improved at Stanford under Dawkins' tutelage. Four Cardinal players were selected in the NBA Draft following their collegiate careers.

LEARNING FROM A LEGEND

The Washington, D.C. native coached for 10 years under the legendary Mike Krzyzewski at Duke. During Dawkins' decade as a coach at Duke, the Blue Devils won a national championship (2001), tallied six ACC regular season championships, recorded seven ACC Tournament titles and posted a 330-60 record. In four consecutive seasons from 1999-2002, Duke finished the regular season ranked No. 1 in both national polls, a first in college basketball history. Duke reached a No. 1 national ranking in seven of the 10 seasons with Dawkins on the coaching staff.

While at Duke, he also served as the Player Personnel Director for the USA Basketball Senior National Team from 2006-08.

DECORATED DUKIE

Following a prolific high school career at Mackin Catholic in Washington, D.C., Dawkins made his way to Duke, where he would become one of the most decorated players to step foot in Durham, North Carolina.

He played for the Blue Devils from 1983-86, earning Consensus All-America honors twice (1985, 1986). Dawkins was also voted as the 1986 Naismith National Player of the Year and named a Freshman All-American in 1983. During his collegiate career, he helped lead Duke to three NCAA Tournament berths, including an NCAA National Championship Game appearance in 1986. He was listed as an All-ACC honoree in all four seasons as a Blue Devil.

Dawkins finished his career as the school's all-time leading scorer and held that honor until 2006 when J.J. Redick surpassed his mark of 2,556 points. He recorded double-figure point totals in 129-of-133 collegiate games. Dawkins led the Blue Devils in scoring all four years, recording the fourth-highest season point total in school history with 809 in 1986. Dawkins remains Duke's career record-holder in field goals (1,026) and field goals attempted (2,019) while also owning the school's best single-season mark for field goals (331) during the 1986 campaign.

Dawkins was inducted into the Duke Sports Hall of Fame in September 1996. His jersey number 24 was retired by the school.

PROFESSIONAL EXPERIENCE

A 1986 first-round draft pick (10th overall) by San Antonio, Dawkins saw action in nine NBA seasons with the Spurs, Philadelphia 76ers and Detroit Pistons. He averaged 11.1 points and 5.5 assists over 541 career NBA games.

GIVING BACK TO THE GAME

Dawkins has served as a member of the National Association of Basketball Coaches Board of Directors since 2012. He also currently serves on the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Ethics Coalition, an independent committee of current and former coaches, charged with promoting ethical conduct through leadership, education and mentoring opportunities, while identifying key issues challenging the coaching community.

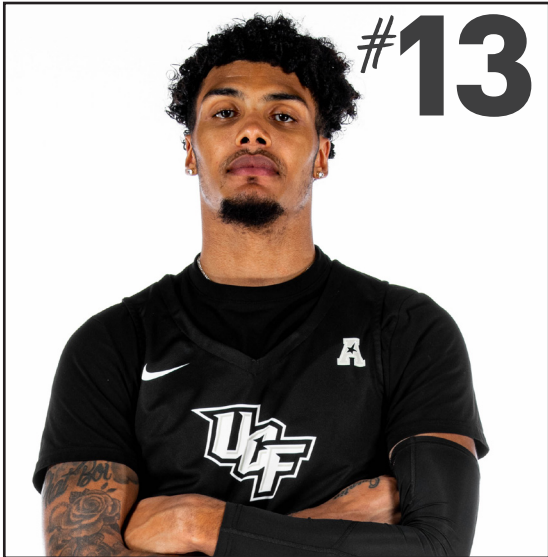
