#### **Auburn Head Coach Gus Malzahn**

## Opening statement...

"First of all, I'm really excited about the win tonight. The way the game started, our fans were electric and really got into the game and helped us. Our defense and special teams gave the offense some short fields and they capitalized with touchdowns. It really gave us some momentum. Overall, I'm proud of our team. We had a big, emotional win last week on the road and it could have been easy to let up or look forward to the next game, and our guys didn't do that. We played our best football game as a team to date tonight. Now, we still have things we have to improve on. We had three turnovers and that's unacceptable and has to be corrected. Overall, it was a really good team win. I'm excited about where we're going. Obviously, we have a big-time opponent on the road next week, but we're 5-0 and it looked like we got through the game pretty healthy. There were a lot of good things and there are still areas we have to improve on as well. I said the teams that improve each game throughout the year have a chance to be there at the end. We're improving right now but there are still things we have to work on."

## On Bo Nix's night...

"I think you see him getting more comfortable every game and every snap. The game gets slower and was really accurate with his throws. He made some very good throws on intermediate and deep routes. He hurt them with his feet. Anytime a quarterback can hurt you with his feet and throw like he did tonight, that's a good thing. The way he's carried himself in practice he's been the same every week. Getting out in games is where you learn. The good thing is things are starting to slow down for him. There are still things he has to work on, but every game it looks like he's getting more comfortable."

### On having consistent receivers...

"That's probably the number one thing. He has the same receivers, they are finally healthy and we can get some timing. Hopefully, that can continue, and I think that'll be a huge factor. In his defense, I don't think we've had a lot of that up until this past week."

#### On the defense...

"The defense did an outstanding job. We were able to play our twos and threes starting in the late third quarter, which is pretty unique for a league game. (MSU) They are a solid team. I'm impressed with them. Every time we play, it's always physical. Last year, they were more physical than us. This year, we flipped the switch on them and won both lines of scrimmage."

# On Seth Williams...

"First of all, Seth is a tough guy. He came back two weeks after a shoulder injury and he kind of dinged it up in the Texas A&M game. He played tonight and made play after play. He played really well. He's an impact player and a guy where you have to know where he's at."

## On Nix keeping the football...

"That opens up everything. When your quarterback makes plays with his feet, it opens up everything. It opens things up inside, the passing game, all the above. He made some good decisions. He's starting to get more comfortable. He's seen a lot of looks and he's learning as he goes. When he makes a mistake, he usually doesn't make that same mistake twice."

#### Daniel Thomas, DB, Sr.

On the team's confidence headed to Florida...

"It's big. We take one game at a time, but this game against Mississippi State is huge. Our coaches asked us to come out here and play hard and we did that."

On the defense's performance today...

"We have that bad feeling from last year and we didn't like it. We came in this week with a chip on our shoulder. We refused to let the quarterback run, and so we played ball and did what coach asked us to do."

On Kylin Hill...

"It was good to stop the run. We played ball and played fast."

# Bo Nix, QB, Fr.

On how important is it to have played well...

"I think it's really important because now I've got the feel of things. I can start playing like I'm comfortable playing and play like I'm used to."

On how he can help the running game by keeping the ball...

"Once the quarterback starts to run, they (the defense) have to account for you, so they have to be ready for you to pull it. So, they never really know, and they are always off-balance a little bit. That way, you can block less people and run on others."

### Jeremiah Dinson, DB, Sr.

On the feeling he has going home next week to play against Florida...

"We haven't gotten into game plan and things like that, but I'm excited to go home to the state of Florida. I don't really get to go home during the season, but I'm going to be hype for that one. It'll be a good one, but we still have to go and watch film and things like that. I'm not worried about going to Florida or anything, but when the time comes, I'll be pretty hype about that."

On how the secondary has improved...

"There's improvement. We still have to go to work, though. We need to work on our technique during the week and things like that. I can see the improvement. We take a step each week. That's the goal - to take a step and improve each and every week."

On if he prefers to play at home...

"I love playing at home. The crowd gets loud on third downs. I love playing on the road too, but it's nothing like playing in Jordan-Hare. There's nothing like it."

# Mississippi State Head Coach Joe Moorhead

Opening statement...

"Against a good football team like this, we went into the week talking about how small the margin of error is. We come out and spot them 21 before the band even gets in their seats. You don't give yourself a chance. You're fighting out of a corner the whole game. I thought some of our warts got exposed today - our deficiencies and weaknesses - and they took advantage of them. The first and biggest thumb goes back to me. Myself and our coaches have to make sure to put the kids in position to be successful with the calls. We've got to make sure that we're out there making them play. Too many penalties. I think we won the turnover battle. We didn't win third-down, we didn't win the red zone and we certainly didn't win the explosive play battle. And when those things happen against a team like Auburn, you're not going to win the football game and that's what happened. So we were 0-1 this week. We're going to learn from it. We're going to correct it. We're headed into the bye week and move on and we'll be 1-0 next week against Tennessee."

On what made Bo Nix so difficult to defend tonight...

"He's obviously a coach's son. Very poised and polished. And well coached for a true freshman/early enrollee. He can beat you with his arms and his legs, and he demonstrated that tonight. He's got time back there patting the ball, counting Mississippis, throwing down the field. We have to make sure we're doing a good job of across the board. The kid's a good player and he's going to be a really good player in the future, too.

On the tough start to the game...

"I thought the clock was getting run when we came off the sideline early. We had the delay of game. And then we took the sack. And then we punt and gave them a position on the 30 and get a one-run play. It's not ideal. And then the next drive, we have third down and whatever and we have the little dig route coming from the backside and we catch it, it's a conversion and the ball gets dropped. That leads straight to points and it kind of snowballs from there. Against this team, you can't spot them 21 off the bat. It's less than ideal."

# Darryl Williams, OL, Sr.

On the difficulty in the run game...

"It wasn't anything different. It was more of the offensive line not being on the same page during certain points of the game."

On being down 21-0 so early...

"We need to claw and dig back in. Auburn did an excellent job of playing on defensive."

On getting guys refocused...
