» The Tigers hit the road for the first time in 2017 with three neutral-site games at the Gildan Charleston Classic.

» Sunday's third-place game is the first meeting between the two programs all-time. However, Auburn has a record of 10-3 against teams currently in the Colonial Athletic Conference, with the latest matchup coming against Charleston in 2012.

» Auburn is set to compete in its 75th non-conference tournament in program history. The Tigers are a combined 92-76 in non-conference tournament games, including Thursday's win and Friday's defeat, and have captured 20 tournament titles with the most recent coming in 2002 at the San Juan Shootout.

» Auburn put up 100 points in the season opener for the fourth time under head coach Bruce Pearl. Before Pearl arrived, the Tigers had not reached triple figures since Nov. 29, 2003 against Grambling State (105). Auburn first accomplished the feat in the third game under Pearl, snapping a streak of 339 games.

GAMEDAY EXPERIENCE: AUBURN ARENA

» Built at a cost of \$86 million, Auburn Arena seats 9,121 fans for basketball games. Auburn Arena replaced the old Beard-Eaves Memorial Coliseum as home of Tiger basketball for the 2010-11 season. The furthest seat in Auburn Arena is just 43 feet away from the court. A full two-thirds of the seats in the facility are less than 27 feet in elevation from courtside. The Arena features a team store, six concession stands, three elevators, 94 HD televisions plus family restrooms and customer service kiosks on all seating levels. For special events, 12,000 square feet of banquet space, including tailgate and super suites, is available. For the teams, Auburn Arena offers an office suite for the coaches, locker rooms and a 13,970-square foot practice facility and weight room.

BRUCE PEARL » HEAD COACH

- Has advanced to postseason play in 18 of 22 years as a head coach
- Set single-season wins records at three different schools (29 at Southern Indiana in 1995; 26 at Wisconsin-Milwaukee in 2005; 31 at Tennessee in 2008)
- Bruce Pearl's teams have led their conference in scoring 16 of the 22 years that he has been a head coach. His squads were the SEC's scoring champion in four of his six seasons at Tennessee, averaging 77.4 ppg while allowing 70.5 ppg
- One of just seven active head coaches who has led his teams to at least 10 NCAA Sweet 16 appearances (10 total)
- Bruce Pearl is ranked second in the SEC among current head coaches in career winning percentage (.718), fifth in winning percentage as a SEC head coach (.622), fifth in average wins per year as a SEC head coach (21.0) and fifth in SEC games only win pct. (.540, 81-70)
- Bruce Pearl's 506-199 (.718) overall record is the second-best winning percentage out of the 14 current SEC head coaches
- Bruce Pearl's 189-115 (.622) record as a SEC head coach is the third-best winning percentage out of the current SEC head coaches
- Under Bruce Pearl, Auburn has had 12-of-13 graduating players in Malcolm Canada, Chris Denson, Asaiah Dixon-Tatum, KT Harrell, Allen Payne, Cinmeon Bowers, Jordon Granger, Josh Dollard, Dylan Spencer, C.J. Holmes, Jonathan Walker and Tahj Sham-sid-Deen
- Auburn had a perfect 1000 APR in Bruce Pearl's first season in 2014-15
- Auburn reached its first tournament final since winning the 2002 San Juan Shootout in this season's Cancun Challenge
- In 2015-16, for the first time in 48 years since 1967-68, Auburn defeated Kentucky, Alabama, Tennessee, Georgia and Arkansas in the same season
- Auburn defeated Kentucky and Alabama in back-to-back games for the first time since 1967 in 2016 and for only the third time in its 110 seasons of basketball
- Auburn has sold out of season tickets for the third straight time in 2016-17, all under Pearl, to continue the school record streak. Prior to Pearl, the only other time the Tigers sold out of season tickets came in the 1999-2000 season
- Auburn averaged 8,216 in its 15 home games in 2015-16, which is 90 percent capacity at Auburn Arena. Auburn ranked second in the SEC in percent capacity behind Kentucky for the second straight season
- In 22 full years as a head coach, Bruce Pearl's teams have finished either first or second in conference play 15 times
- In the 2015 SEC Tournament, Auburn won three games in three days for the first time in 30 years and reached the semifinals for the first time since 2009. The Tigers defeated Mississippi State and two postseason teams Texas A&M (NIT) and LSU (NCAA) before falling to undefeated Kentucky
- At the Division I level, Pearl's teams have topped the 100-point mark 16 times, including a high of 124 in 2009 as well as 121 in the 2007 NCAA Tournament. In his second year as a coach at Southern Indiana the team averaged 101.7 ppg
- Has coached a league's leading scorer 3 times: KT Harrell, Auburn, 18.5 ppg – 2015; Dylan Page, UWM, 20.9 ppg – 2004; Chris Lofton, UT, 20.8 ppg - 2007

• Bruce Pearl has raised \$1 million in only four golf tournaments at Auburn. Pearl and his wife, Brandy, have remarkably raised \$770,000 in the last three years benefitting Children's Harbor in Birmingham through the Bruce Pearl For the Children Golf Classic. The mission of Children's Harbor is to help children with serious illness and their families. Over \$200,000 was raised in the Bruce, Barkley & Basketball Golf Classic Oct. 23-24, 2016, benefitting the Auburn Basketball program.

• Pearl started AUTLIVE at Auburn in 2015-16 to benefit cancer patients in the fight to beat cancer. AUTLIVE raises the awareness of cancer prevention and detection while t-shirt sales and donations raise money to benefit cancer patients. He initiated the OUTLIVE program in 2009 at Tennessee in recognition of former Vol Chris Lofton, who beat testicular cancer through early diagnosis and treatment and went on to play the entire 2007-08 season while recovering from his battle with the disease.

• Pearl donated \$250,000 to the Auburn University comprehensive campaign in September 2016, helping push it over the ambitious \$1 billion goal ahead of schedule.

• The Bruce Pearl Family Foundation in conjunction with L5 Foundation, an organization dedicated to addressing the essential and basic needs of cancer patients, donated \$20,000 to five charities in a ceremony in Knoxville in August 2015. Pearl accepted a \$10,000 donation to an endowed scholarship in his name to Camp Koinonia, an outdoor education program for children with disabilities.

• The Pearl family announced on Feb. 27, 2007, a \$100,000 donation to endow a scholarship in the name of former Tennessee player Dane Bradshaw. The Dane Bradshaw Athletic Scholarship Endowment is awarded to the male or female student-athlete at UT who best epitomizes the characteristics of the 2006-07 senior captain.

» The Tigers and Pride will meet for the first time in series history Sunday evening. Auburn is 10-3 against teams currently in the Colonial Athletic Association.

CHARLESTON CLASSIC QUICK WRAP

» Auburn won its quarterfinal matchup against Indiana State (83-64) before falling to Temple in the semifinal (88-74).

» The Tigers have averaged 78.5 points per game with five players averaging double figures. Anfernee McLemore leads the team with 14.0 points per game, while Bryce Brown (12.5), Desean Murray (12.0), Chuma Okeke (11.0) and Jared Harper (10.0) are all in double figures. Mustapha Heron is just shy of the mark with 9.5 points per game.

» Auburn has made rebounding a priority and has out-boarded its opponents 44.5-38.5 per game. Desean Murray has 11.5 boards per game, with Horace Spencer (7.0), Mustapha Heron (5.0), Anfernee McLemore (5.0) and Chuma Okeke (5.0) are close behind.

YOUNG ROSTER

» Auburn is tied with Kentucky with the most underclassmen in the nation with 12 on the roster and only one senior. The Tigers are one of just seven teams in the country to have 10 or more on their roster.

ON THIS DATE

» On Nov. 19, 2000, Auburn defeated Jacksonville State by a score of 91-51. It was the first 40-point victory since Dec. 19, 1999 when the Tigers took down Puerto Rico Mayaguez, 109-52.

HOW ABOUT THAT OPENER?

» Auburn defeated Norfolk State by a score of 102-74. The Tigers improved to 81-31 all-time in season openers, including 59-9 at home.

» Bryce Brown had a career night on the floor with 31 points on 12-of-16 shooting, including 4-of-8 from 3-point range. Brown became the third player to tally 30-plus points in a season opener in Auburn history.

» The Tigers went 24-of-30 from the free throw line. Auburn's 80.0 free throw percentage was its highest in a game in which it made at least 20 free throws since Feb. 15, 2014 vs. Mississippi State (37-of-41).

BIG SPLASH FROM DOWNTOWN

» Junior Bryce Brown, who set an Auburn freshman record with 78 made 3-pointers in 2015-16, has netted 141 career trifectas, putting him just 16 shy of cracking Auburn's top 10. For his career, he is 141-of-377 (.374) from long range.

MUSTAPHA NO. 5

» Sophomore Mustapha Heron scored in double figures in his first 25 collegiate games last season, breaking the record for the most for a freshman to begin a season previously held by All-American Wesley Person, who did it in his first 14 games in 1990-91. Heron has reached double figures in 33 of 35 games in his career (vs. Florida, 2017; vs. Temple, 2017).

PLAYER TO WATCH: DESEAN MURRAY

» Desean Murray made his first game in an Auburn uniform a memorable one as the junior touted 13 points and also paced the team with seven rebounds. The Presbyterian College transfer went 5-of-7 from the field and 3-of-3 from the charity stripe. Murray also dished out three assists and had two steals in 23 minutes of play as a forward.

Head coach Bruce Pearl

On rebounding...

"Rebounding has been an area that we have worked on and we've talked about a couple of things. We talked about our defense, we talked about transition defense, we talked about rebounding and free throw shooting. Those are four primary areas that we felt like we had to improve on in order to be successful. I think that we have had the right focus in that area, but we have to rebound as a team. We don't have a dominant 10-rebound-a-game guy. We have to do it by committee. I think our guards have to do a better job of perimeter check outs and not letting guards run to the boards. But rebounding is one way to be able to end possessions and I thought we rebounded the ball pretty well against Norfolk State. They were spread out. Indiana State will put a little bit more pressure on us to rebound the ball, but it's definitely been a focus."

On the full-court press...

"[Norfolk State] beat us twice on the full-court press. It's risk-reward. For us, we extend over 94 feet. We do play nine or ten guys. We want to wear people down. It won't be a big factor the first night against Indiana State. But maybe it will be a factor in the second game or the third game. We are definitely extending and sometimes you may not notice a turnover, but if we can get a different guard to bring the ball up the floor and after they get done breaking our pressure, they only have 22 seconds to shoot, we have accomplished something as well as making them work to get it in and getting their offense established."
