#### AUBURN LOOKS FOR SECOND STRAIGHT WIN, HOSTS MURRAY STATE

The Auburn basketball team will play host to Murray State as it looks to grab its second straight win and its third win overall. Auburn goes into the contest averaging 82.0 ppg, which is fifth in the SEC, while the team is allowing 73.0 ppg.

#### SCOUTING MURRAY STATE

A member of the Ohio Valley Conference's West Division, Murray State heads into Saturday's match-up 2-2 with a pair of home wins and a pair of road losses.

Murray State entered the 2013-14 season looking for its fifth straight 20-win season. MSU is averaging 26.5 wins per season over the last four seasons. Murray State also boasts 26 straight winning seasons, which is tied with Connecticut for the fourth-longest in the nation (Syracuse - 43 straight). Murray State was a co-favorite in the OVC West Division along with Southeast Missouri.

#### DENSON THE DAMAGER

Senior guard **Chris Denson** has turned in three straight double-digit scoring games to start the season and six-straight dating to last season. His 64 points scored are the most by an Auburn player to open the first three games of a season since Wesley Person scored 77 points and Aaron Swinson 75 to open the 1993-94 season. Person went on to average 22.2 ppg that year while Swinson averaged 20.7 ppg.

Denson has a career scoring average of 9.3 ppg on .466 percent shooting and has scored in double-digits in 36 of the 73 games he has played in.

#### **HIGH-FLYING TIGERS**

Auburn goes into Saturday's contest averaging 82.0 ppg as a team, which is the highest the team has averaged three games into a season since it averaged 85.7 ppg to open the 2004-05 season.

#### HARD 2 GUARD(S)

Senior guard **Chris Denson** and junior guard **KT Harrell** have led Auburn in scoring in each of the first three games, with Denson averaging 21.3 ppg and Harrell 18.7 ppg. The duo join Missouri's Jabari Brown (19.7 ppg) and Jordan Clarkson (19.3 ppg) as the only set of SEC teammates to both be in the top-10 in the league in scoring, Harrell and Denson are averaging a combined 40.0 ppg to Brown and Clarkson's 39.0 ppg.

#### ADT, ALWAYS HOME

Senior center **Asauhn Dixon-Tatum** has led Auburn in rebounding in each of the first three games, pulling down an average of 7.0 rpg, tied for 13th in the SEC. Of his 21 total rebounds, 13 have come on the offensive end of the floor. The 7-footer has also blocked 6 shots (2.0 bpg), which is tied for fourth in the league.

#### BENCH POINTS

Auburn scored 32 points off its bench in the win over Jacksonville State, led by junior point guard **Malcolm Canada** (10) and freshman guard **Dion Wade** (9). Freshman **Benas Griciunas** also added 8.

#### FRESHMAN IMPACT

Auburn's freshman class has already made big contributions this season. **Tahj Shamsid-Deen** has been the starting point guard in all three games and is averaging 6.0 ppg. Fellow frosh **Dion Wade** and **Benas Griciunas** are both averating 4.7 ppg off the bench. **Alex Thompson** saw his first action of the season against Jacksonville State and logged nine minutes, scoring a point.

#### AUBURN AT THE LINE

Auburn is hitting .678 percent of its free throws, fifth in the SEC, having taken 90, sixthmost in the league, and hitting 61.

Coach **Tony Barbee** wants his team to hit more free throws than the other team attempts, which Auburn accomplished in the opener against Nicholls (AU made 28, Nicholls shot 22) and was one shy of meeting against Jacksonville State (AU made 23, JSU attempted 24).

#### ASSIST-TO-TURNOVER RATIO

Auburn enters the week leading the SEC in assist-to-turnover ratio at 1.4, dishing out 49 assists (16.3 apg) against 34 turnovers (11.3 per game). Senior guard **Chris Denson** is third in the SEC at 3.3 (10 assists, 3 turnovers) while freshman point guard **Tahj Shamsid-Deen** is tied for fifth at 2.4 (12 assists, 5 turnovers).

#### GRIFFIN TO TAKE LEAVE FROM TEAM

Junoir forward **Chris Griffin** will take an indefinite leave from the Auburn basketball team to deal with a personal family issue, head coach **Tony Barbee** announced before the game against Jacksonville State.

"Chris is a very important part of this basketball team and I look forward to him rejoining the team when he and his family are ready," Barbee said.

#### **DENSON GOES BIG AGAINST DEMONS**

Senior guard **Chris Denson** had a career night against Northwestern State, going 12-for-18 from the floor en route to a career-high 29 points. The two-guard also matched his career highs in both rebounds (9) and assits (5).







"A little bit of everything. Our defense got better but we spent the two days going into the (Jacksonville State) game working mainly defense and then our offense slipped. Even though we scored a lot of points and we shot a high percentage, our execution wasn't as sharp as it needed to be. We are going to try and keep our defense sharp and get our offense back to where we want it."

Senior forward **Allen Payne** is currently sixth among active SEC players in career rebounds with 334 and career steals with 85. In 86 career games, he averages 3.9 rebounds per game and 1.0 steal per game while chipping in 6.1 points per game. During his three-plus years at Auburn, he has been the team's leading rebounder 14 times, it's leading scorer seven times and the assists leader five times. He has also collected 17 double-digit scoring games.

#### POINT, POINT, PASS!

Auburn's point guard duo of **Tahj Sham-sid-Deen** and **Malcolm Canada** are combining for 11.7 ppg and 2.8 apg. Canada is also chipping in 3.3 rebounds per game, with all 10 of his rebounds coming on the defensive boards.

#### AUBURN IN THE AUBURN ARENA

Guards KT Harrell and Chris Denson combined for 41 points as the Auburn men's basketball team opened the 2013-14 season with a 76-54 win over Nicholls on Friday night at the Auburn Arena.

Harrell, a transfer from Virginia who sat out last season, scored 21 points on 7-for-13 shooting, hitting a pair of 3-pointers and five free throws. The junior from Montgomery had 15 points at the half and scored Auburn's first five points of the game, hitting a 3-pointer just 15 seconds into the contest and then a layup just 40 seconds later.

Denson, a senior from Columbus, Ga., did most of his damage from the free throw line. He hit a career-high 11 free throws on 14 attempts while shooting 4-for-8 from the floor to finish with 20 points.

Auburn (1-0) led by eight at the half, 37-29, but used a 14-2 run midway through the second half to put the game away. Denson would score a total of 8 points during the run, hitting a 3-pointer and three free throws to go along with his layup.

Tahj Shamsid-Deen, who became Auburn's first freshman to start a season-opener at the point since Quantez Robertson in 2005-06, finished with 5 points and 4 assists.

Center Asauhn Dixon-Tatum finished with 8 points, 8 rebounds and 4 blocks.






