- » Auburn wraps up its three-game homestand with a non-conference contest against in-state foe UAB.
- » The Tigers have started the season 7-1 for the first time since the 2011 season. Auburn has won seven of its first eight games just two other times since 2000 (2003, 2007).
- » Auburn has outrebounded its opponents in all eight of its games this season - a feat that was only accomplished 10 times a season ago. The Tigers lead the SEC and rank seventh in the nation with an average rebounding margin of +11.8 per game. Auburn also leads the SEC and ranks 13th by pulling down 43.0 rebounds per tilt.
- » The Tigers are currently on a 10-game winning streak in non-conference home games, dating back to the first game of the 2016-17 season. The 10-game streak is the longest of its kind since Auburn won 14 consecutive non-conference games at home between the 2010 and 2012 season.

GAMEDAY EXPERIENCE: AUBURN ARENA

» Built at a cost of \$86 million, Auburn Arena seats 9,121 fans for basketball games. Auburn Arena replaced the old Beard-Eaves Memorial Coliseum as home of Tiger basketball for the 2010-11 season. The furthest seat in Auburn Arena is just 43 feet away from the court. A full two-thirds of the seats in the facility are less than 27 feet in elevation from courtside. The Arena features a team store, six concession stands, three elevators, 94 HD televisions plus family restrooms and customer service kiosks on all seating levels. For special events, 12,000 square feet of banquet space, including tailgate and super suites, is available. For the teams, Auburn Arena offers an office suite for the coaches, locker rooms and a 13,970-square foot practice facility and weight room.

BRUCE PEARL » HEAD COACH

- Has advanced to postseason play in 18 of 22 years as a head coach
- Set single-season wins records at three different schools (29 at Southern Indiana in 1995; 26 at Wisconsin-Milwaukee in 2005; 31 at Tennessee in 2008)
- Bruce Pearl's teams have led their conference in scoring 16 of the 22 years that he has been a head coach. His squads were the SEC's scoring champion in four of his six seasons at Tennessee, averaging 77.4 ppg while allowing 70.5 ppg
- One of just seven active head coaches who has led his teams to at least 10 NCAA Sweet 16 appearances (10 total)
- Bruce Pearl is ranked second in the SEC among current head coaches in career winning percentage (.718), fifth in winning percentage as a SEC head coach (.622), fifth in average wins per year as a SEC head coach (21.0) and fifth in SEC games only win pct. (.540, 81-70)
- Bruce Pearl's 506-199 (.718) overall record is the second-best winning percentage out of the 14 current SEC head coaches
- Bruce Pearl's 189-115 (.622) record as a SEC head coach is the third-best winning percentage out of the current SEC head coaches
- Under Bruce Pearl, Auburn has had 12-of-13 graduating players in Malcolm Canada, Chris Denson, Asaun Dixon-Tatum, KT Harrell, Allen Payne, Cinmeon Bowers, Jordon Granger, Josh Dollard, Dylan Spencer, C.J. Holmes, Jonathan Walker and Tahj Sham-sid-Deen
- Auburn had a perfect 1000 APR in Bruce Pearl's first season in 2014-15
- Auburn reached its first tournament final since winning the 2002 San Juan Shootout in this season's Cancun Challenge
- In 2015-16, for the first time in 48 years since 1967-68, Auburn defeated Kentucky, Alabama, Tennessee, Georgia and Arkansas in the same season
- Auburn defeated Kentucky and Alabama in back-to-back games for the first time since 1967 in 2016 and for only the third time in its 110 seasons of basketball
- Auburn has sold out of season tickets for the third straight time in 2016-17, all under Pearl, to continue the school record streak. Prior to Pearl, the only other time the Tigers sold out of season tickets came in the 1999-2000 season
- Auburn averaged 8,216 in its 15 home games in 2015-16, which is 90 percent capacity at Auburn Arena. Auburn ranked second in the SEC in percent capacity behind Kentucky for the second straight season
- In 22 full years as a head coach, Bruce Pearl's teams have finished either first or second in conference play 15 times
- In the 2015 SEC Tournament, Auburn won three games in three days for the first time in 30 years and reached the semifinals for the first time since 2009. The Tigers defeated Mississippi State and two postseason teams Texas A&M (NIT) and LSU (NCAA) before falling to undefeated Kentucky
- At the Division I level, Pearl's teams have topped the 100-point mark 16 times, including a high of 124 in 2009 as well as 121 in the 2007 NCAA Tournament. In his second year as a coach at Southern Indiana the team averaged 101.7 ppg
- Has coached a league's leading scorer 3 times: KT Harrell, Auburn, 18.5 ppg – 2015; Dylan Page, UWM, 20.9 ppg – 2004; Chris Lofton, UT, 20.8 ppg - 2007

• Bruce Pearl has raised \$1 million in only four golf tournaments at Auburn. Pearl and his wife, Brandy, have remarkably raised \$770,000 in the last three years benefitting Children's Harbor in Birmingham through the Bruce Pearl For the Children Golf Classic. The mission of Children's Harbor is to help children with serious illness and their families. Over \$200,000 was raised in the Bruce, Barkley & Basketball Golf Classic Oct. 23-24, 2016, benefitting the Auburn Basketball program.

• Pearl started AUTLIVE at Auburn in 2015-16 to benefit cancer patients in the fight to beat cancer. AUTLIVE raises the awareness of cancer prevention and detection while t-shirt sales and donations raise money to benefit cancer patients. He initiated the OUTLIVE program in 2009 at Tennessee in recognition of former Vol Chris Lofton, who beat testicular cancer through early diagnosis and treatment and went on to play the entire 2007-08 season while recovering from his battle with the disease.

• Pearl donated \$250,000 to the Auburn University comprehensive campaign in September 2016, helping push it over the ambitious \$1 billion goal ahead of schedule.

• The Bruce Pearl Family Foundation in conjunction with L5 Foundation, an organization dedicated to addressing the essential and basic needs of cancer patients, donated \$20,000 to five charities in a ceremony in Knoxville in August 2015. Pearl accepted a \$10,000 donation to an endowed scholarship in his name to Camp Koinonia, an outdoor education program for children with disabilities.

• The Pearl family announced on Feb. 27, 2007, a \$100,000 donation to endow a scholarship in the name of former Tennessee player Dane Bradshaw. The Dane Bradshaw Athletic Scholarship Endowment is awarded to the male or female student-athlete at UT who best epitomizes the characteristics of the 2006-07 senior captain.

INSIDE THE SERIES: UAB

» The Tigers and Blazers are set to meet for the 20th time in series history Saturday afternoon. The two teams have sparked up the rivalry in the last two seasons after not meeting from 2000-2014. They met on a regular basis from 1982-1999 except in 1987, 1988 and 1992.

» UAB owns a 10-9 advantage in the series all-time, but Auburn has taken the last four matchups by a total of 21 points.

» Auburn is 42-23 all-time against teams from the currently constructed Conference USA. The Tigers also face Middle Tennessee, along with UAB, this season.

BOARD UP

» Auburn has outrebounded all eight of its opponents so far this season. The Tigers are one of just three teams in the country to accomplish the feat, joining Albany (10) and Duke (11).

» Auburn is tied with Kentucky with the most underclassmen in the nation with 12 on the roster and only one senior. The Tigers are one of just seven teams in the country to have 10 or more on their roster.

TOP BLOCKER

» According to KenPom.com, sophomore Anfernee McLemore leads the nation in block percentage with an impressive .212 clip. The percentage means that McLemore produces a block one out of every five defensive possessions while he is on the court.

» The sophomore leads the SEC and ranks fifth nationally with 3.75 blocks per game. In the team's eight games, McLemore has swatted 30 shots, good for first in the SEC and sixth in the country.

ON THIS DATE

» On Dec. 9, 1993, Auburn scored the 10th-most points in a game in program history in a 113-86 triumph over then Troy State. The Tigers scored a record 73 points in the second half to key the 27-point victory.

» The Tigers are 9-3 on this date all-time and won the last four tilts.

The Philadelphia native has three games with five or more rebounds so far this season.

HAPPY HELPER

» Sophomore Jared Harper has been the floor general for the Tigers in his second season on The Plains. Harper has a team-high 42 assists in eight games and has produced four games of at least seven assists this campaign.

» In the win against Gardner-Webb on Wednesday, Harper dropped a career-best 10 dimes, marking the first time a Tiger has notched 10 assists in a game since Kareem Canty did it in 2015 vs. Northwestern State.

BIG SPLASH FROM DOWNTOWN

» Junior Bryce Brown, who set an Auburn freshman record with 78 made 3-pointers in 2015-16, has netted 157 career trifectas, putting him just three shy of cracking Auburn's top 10. For his career, he is 157-of-419 (.375) from long range.

» Brown has drained multiple 3-point shots 43 times through his junior season. The marksman has also tallied five or more buckets from downtown eight times, including a career-best nine at Arkansas (2016).

MUSTAPHA NO. 5

» Sophomore Mustapha Heron scored in double figures in his first 25 collegiate games last season, breaking the record for the most for a freshman to begin a season previously held by All-American Wesley Person, who did it in his first 14 games in 1990-91. Heron has reached double figures in 36 of 39 games in his career (vs. Florida, 2017; vs. Temple, 2017; vs. Gardner-Webb, 2017).

» In addition, Heron has reached the 20-point plateau nine times in his young career. The Waterbury, Conn. native scored 20-plus points six times during his freshman campaign and has already accomplished the feat three times during the 2017-18 season (22 vs. Hofstra, 31 vs. Winthrop, 21 at Dayton).

PRE-GAME QUOTES

Head coach Bruce Pearl

On the opponent...
"Three games in six days has definitely had its challenges. Fortunately the games are all at home and right before finals. The stress on the players from the standpoint of preparation and for the coaching staff, it is really challenging. So here we are getting ready for UAB, an opponent we have great respect for and a series that we are really excited about being involved in. It matters to the players, it matters to our fans, and the last couple of years we have managed to get a couple of wins by a total of five points. It has been as good of an environment as I have seen at Auburn.

On the front court matchup...
"Our front court will be challenged, probably, in this game as much as they have all season. I think that would be fair so Desean, Chuma, Anfernee, and Horace will be as challenged against (Chris) Cokely and (William) Lee and the guys they bring off the bench as any game. 

AN EARLY CHRISTMAS PRESENT?

» Auburn will be looking to do something it has only accomplished once since the 1999-2000 season, and that would be winning 10 or more games.

» Last year, the Tigers won 10 games before Christmas to break a 16-year streak without accomplishing the feat.

» This season, Auburn plays 12 games before the annual holiday and is off to a 5-1 start through the opening five contests.

HOW ABOUT THAT OPENER?

» Auburn defeated Norfolk State by a score of 102-74. The Tigers improved to 81-31 all-time in season openers, including 59-9 at home.

» Bryce Brown had a career night on the floor with 31 points on 12-of-16 shooting, including 4-of-8 from 3-point range. Brown became the third player to tally 30-plus points in a season opener in Auburn history.

» The Tigers went 24-of-30 from the free throw line. Auburn's 80.0 free throw percentage was its highest in a game in which it made at least 20 free throws since Feb. 15, 2014 vs. Mississippi State (37-of-41).

LEADING THE WAY OFF THE COURT

» Mustapha Heron, an SEC Community Service Team member, created the Mustapha Heron Skills Academy and Reading Program for students at his high school, Sacred Heart, and students in surrounding counties.

» His foundation teaches students in the importance of balancing academics and sports and rewards students who read a certain number of books with incentives like shoes and bags. Heron obtained sponsorships from shoe companies to assist with his efforts.

» Additionally, he has worked with the police department in his hometown on a weapons buyback program.

» Heron and his AAU team wore orange emblems to make a statement against gun violence and was highlighted in Sports Illustrated. He is involved with the Fellowship of Christian Athletes and donates to Toys for Tots Holiday Program through Auburn University's SAAC Program.

ALL-TIME IN OVERTIME

» Auburn has a 49-53 (.480) record in overtime games in its history. The Tigers were 1-1 in overtime last season, winning 70-67 at UConn on Dec. 23 and losing 86-83 to Missouri in the SEC Tournament.

» Auburn is 2-2 under Coach Pearl when entering extra time. The Tigers have had at least one overtime game in all three seasons with Pearl at the helm.

» Under Pearl, Auburn is a perfect 12-of-12 of seniors graduating players in Malcolm Canada, Chris Denson, Asauhn Dixon-Tatum, KT Harrell, Allen Payne, Cinmeon Bowers, Jordon Granger, Josh Dollard, Dylan Spencer, C.J. Holmes, Jonathan Walker and Tahj Shamsid-Deen.

FOREVER 34: CHARLES BARKLEY

» After retiring his jersey in 2001, the Tigers went a step further in honoring Charles Barkley's legacy on The Plains. On Nov. 25, 2017, Auburn Athletics unveiled a statue of the NBA Hall of Fame basketball player in front of Auburn Arena. Barkley, from Leeds, Ala., played at Auburn from 1981-84 and won All-American honors on his way to becoming an Olympic gold medal winner and being named one of the NBA's 50 greatest players in the league's 50th anniversary season. A first-round draft pick by the Philadelphia 76ers, Barkley was the 1993 league's Most Valuable Player, and an 11-time All-Star. He is one four NBA players who had 20,000 points, 10,000 rebounds and 4,000 assists, joining Kareem Abdul-Jabbar, Wilt Chamberlain and Karl Malone.

- » The ceremony took place outside of Auburn Arena, Nov. 25, 2017.
- » Sculpting was completed by artist Brian Hanlon.
- » The final version of statue will not be completed until spring, therefore the current statue features a full-size replica until the final 2,500 pound fixture can be installed.
- » Barkley is the fourth former Tiger to have a statue erected in his honor, joining former Heisman Trophy winners Bo Jackson, Pat Sullivan and Cam Newton.
- » The statue unveiling featured speeches from Director of Athletics Jay Jacobs, former Auburn football great Bo Jackson, former head coach Sonny Smith and Barkley himself.






