- Auburn puts a bow on the 2017 regular season with a trip to rival Alabama. No current player on the Auburn roster has ever played at Rhoads Stadium in a Tiger uniform.
- The Tigers lead the nation in double plays with 43 and average 0.84 per game. The next closest team Campbell with 30. Auburn has turned multiple double plays in nine games, including a season-high three in contests with Missouri and Alabama State.
- Auburn is the only team in the nation to rank in the top 20 in double plays, ERA and scoring. The Tigers are positioned in 17th with a 1.71 ERA and 19th in scoring at 5.84 runs per game.
- Kasey Cooper, the recent SEC Player of the Week, broke the SEC all-time RBI mark against MSU. She has 266 RBI, passing former Alabama player Charlotte Morgan (264), and currently ranks ninth in NCAA history. Her next target is Shelby Pendley of Arizona/Oklahoma at 269 RBI.
- Cooper also became the second player in SEC history to amass 250 hits and 250 RBI in a career. She joined the aforementioned Morgan as the only members in the 250 club.
- Carlee Wallace is the only catcher in the SEC to rank in the top 15 in the league in batting average (.356), slugging percentage (.664) and on-base percentage (.484).



GAMEDAY EXPERIENCE: JANE B. MOORE FIELD

» Jane B. Moore Field is in its 19th season hosting the Auburn softball program. On April, 26, 2003, the Auburn Softball Complex was renamed Jane B. Moore Field in 2002 in honor of Dr. Jane Moore who served more than 20 years as a member of Auburn's Committee on Intercollegiate Athletics. The complex holds dimensions of 201 feet at the corners and 220 feet in straight-away center field. Since head coach Clint Myers took over the program in 2014, 131,927 have seen a game at Auburn's on-campus venue. In the 16 previous seasons, the total attendance was 122,276.

CLINT MYERS » HEAD COACH

With the reputation of taking a program and turning it into a perennial power, head coach Clint Myers has taken Auburn softball to unprecedented heights in just three years.

Myers has guided the Tigers to back-to-back Women's College World Series appearances in the past two campaigns, when the previously best finish came with a showing at a regional final in 2006.

Since his appointment following the 2013 season, Auburn has broken 21 records, including 16 on offense, and led the nation in a plethora of categories.

Myers has coached nine All-Americans, with three coming in each of his seasons on The Plains. Before his arrival, the Tigers had five players who were tabbed All-Americans in the previous 17 campaigns.

In comparison with rivals in the conference, Myers has coached nine All-SEC performers, even setting a program record with four in 2015. Between 1997-2013, Auburn had never placed multiple players on the all-conference team lists. Since then, the Tigers have had three, four and two representatives in successive years under Myers.

As impressive as Myers' teams have been on the field, the program has taken a giant leap forward off of it.

Under Myers, Auburn has placed three on Academic All-America and Academic All-District lists, something that had never been done previously. In 2016, the Tigers had 24 honorees on the Academic All-SEC list. Kasey Cooper also became the first player in softball history to be named the SEC Scholar-Athlete of the Year and the NCAA Elite 90 winner.

A 1976 graduate of Arizona State, Myers was a member of the Sun Devil baseball team from 1970-73 and played on the College World Series runner-up squads in 1972 and 1973. He was later selected by the St. Louis Cardinals in the third round of the 1973 Major League Draft.

Myers and his wife, Katie, have two sons, Casey and Corey. They also have three grandchildren; grandsons, Cole and Christian, and granddaughter, Carlee.

INSIDE THE SERIES: ALABAMA

» The Tigers and Crimson Tide have faced each other 62 times with Alabama holding a 44-18 advantage. However, since head coach Clint Myers took over, Auburn has taken four of seven results, including the last three.

CAREER VERSUS THE CRIMSON TIDE

- » Four players have tallied multiple hits in their careers versus Alabama. Kasey Cooper leads the way with 11 base knocks and a .500 batting average. Carlee Wallace has two extra-base hits, while Jenna Abbott and Haley Fagan have each added a double.
- » In the circle, Jenna Abbott and Makayla Martin have seen action against the Crimson Tide. Martin touts a 1.91 ERA and has held the opposition to hit just .250. Abbott has notched a strikeout in 2/3 of an inning of work.

AN AUBURN SERIES WIN WOULD...

» A three-game series win by Auburn would give the Tigers their first in Tuscaloosa. Auburn has amassed six victories at Alabama all-time. If the Tigers emerge victorious Friday night, they would own a four-game winning streak for the third time in series history.




