TOUGH TEST AHEAD AS DAYTON HOSTS AUBURN

- The University of Dayton Flyers look to continue their success against SEC opponents hosting the Auburn Tigers on Wednesday, Nov. 29 at 7 p.m. ET.
- The game will be carried by CBS Sports Network and is available with live streaming audio and stats at DaytonFlyers.com.

SERIES STUFF

- Dayton leads the all-time series 4-0.
- The Flyers won the last meeting, 73-63 on Nov. 18, 2012 in the Charleston Classic.

POWER FIVE PROMINENCE

- The Flyers have won 15 of the last 18 contests against SEC opponents and six straight.
- Dayton is 32-14 in the last 10 years against programs from the ACC, Big 12, Big Ten, SEC and Pac 12 Conferences.

#TRENDING

- Dayton has won 16 straight at UD Arena.
- Dayton returns the 11th-fewest number of minutes played in Division I (2,020). Only Mississippi Valley State (386), Pitt (648), North Carolina Central (862), Kentucky (890), Austin Peay (1,392), Robert Morris (1,612), Iowa State (1,728), Memphis (1,825), James Madison (1,881) and Chattanooga (1,909) have fewer.
- Josh Cunningham leads the Atlantic 10 in rebounding (10.6 rpg) and has a double-double in two of his last three games.
- Cunningham has 18 offensive rebounds, nearly half of Dayton's offensive rebound total of 40.
- In the Charleston Classic, Darrell Davis averaged 24.0 points on 24 of 45 shooting from the field (.533) and 14 of 26 (.538) from 3-point range.
- Darrell Davis ranks fourth in the A-10 in scoring (20.0 ppg) and has scored in double figures in every games this season.
- Kostas Antetokounmpo has nine blocks and twice scored in double figures in the last four games. He is shooting 13 of 19 (.684) from the field in that span.
- In Dayton victories Xeyrius Williams is averaging 10.0 points with an assist-to-turnover ratio of 3.67. In the losses, Williams' averages drop to 7.0 points and 1.5 assist-to-turnover ratio.
- Jordan Davis averages 11.7 points while shooting 12 of 18 from the field (.667) and 8 of 13 from (.615) from beyond the arc in the last three contests.
- UD has progressively improved its 3-point field goal shooting in every game this season. The Flyers started off at 27 percent, but improved each game since.
- Dayton is one of 19 schools to have made the last four NCAA Tournaments.

- Dayton goes on the road to face the Mississippi State Bulldogs on Sunday, Dec. 3 at 8 p.m. ET.

CUNNINGHAM IN CONTROL

- Josh Cunningham has elevated his play into one of the top players in the Atlantic 10.
- He tallied game highs of 20 points and 16 rebounds against Akron.
- Added 13 points, seven rebounds and five assists versus Old Dominion.
- Enjoyed a huge game against Ohio with 18 points and 19 rebounds.
- Sank the game-winner in Dayton's home opener to cap a 22-point, seven-rebound night against Ball State.
- Named the Atlantic 10 Co-Player of the Week on Nov. 13.
- Cunningham serves as the team captain in 2017-18. This is his second consecutive season as a team captain.
- He returned to action against Rhode Island after missing 21 games with a torn ligament in his left ankle.
- A 6-foot-7, 225-pound forward from Chicago, he was a transfer to Dayton from Bradley.
- Cunningham was a Top-100 prospect (No. 98 on the ESPN Top 100) coming out of high school.
- He finished last year averaging 6.3 points, and 2.9 rebounds per game.

DARRELL DELIVERING

- Darrell Davis is enjoying a breakout senior season for the Flyers.
- Davis scored all 12 of his points in the second half against Akron.
- He led all scorers with 27 points against Old Dominion in the Charleston Classic.
- Davis led UD with 25 points thanks to 7 of 13 shooting from the field and hitting all eight free throw attempts.
- He scored a team-high 20 points vs. Hofstra.
- Davis played in his 100th game as a Flyer and finished with 16 points versus Ball State.
- He averaged 5.5 points, 1.9 rebounds and 1.2 assists as a junior.
- He finished 11th in the Atlantic 10 for 3-point field goal percentage (.385).

THE X-FACTOR

- Junior forward Xeyrius Williams enjoyed a breakout season improving his scoring average in 2016-17 by six points per game.
- Broke out against Ohio with 13 points, seven rebounds and six assists.
- He averaged 8.2 points, 4.8 rebounds and recorded a team-leading 36 blocks last season.
- Solid overall game against Ball State with eight points, six rebounds and five assists.
- Missed the Akron game with back spasms.

THE CROSBY SHOW

- John Crosby has provided a solid veteran presence at the point guard spot this year.
- He dished out five assists against Akron.
- Crosby registered 13 points, six rebounds and four assists versus Ball State.
- A 6-foot-2 guard from Baltimore, Md., previously came off the bench in his first 64 games at Dayton.
- This past season he averaged 2.8 points, 1.9 rebounds and made 11 of 23 three-point attempts (.478).

TREY OF LIGHT

- Sophomore Trey Landers played in nine games for the Flyers last year, averaging 3.0 points and 1.4 rebounds.
- Finished with eight points and seven rebounds versus Ball State.
- Injured his ankle against Ohio and did not play against Old Dominion and Akron.

GREEK FREAK 2.0

- Redshirt freshman Kostas Antetokounmpo sat out the 2016-17 season after being ruled as a partial qualifier by the NCAA.
- He was a consensus top 100 high school prospect (89 according to Rivals, 98 by Scout).
- With Josh Cunningham in foul trouble vs. Hofstra, he stepped up to the tune of 10 points, 10 rebounds, four blocks, two assists and a steal in 26 minutes of action.
- Antetokounmpo tallied 12 points on 5 of 6 shooting from the field against Akron.

SMOOTH SVOBODA

- Freshman Matej Svooboda played four seasons as an amateur on the CEZ Basketball Nymburk team.
- CEZ Basketball Nymburk won Czech Republic Championship. 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017.
- Played for Czech Republic National Team U16-20 from 2011-2016 at European Championships.
- Was the second-leading scorer in the 2016 FIBA U-20 European Championships in Helsinki, Finland. He averaged 19.0 points a game in the seven-game tournament.
- Made his Flyer debut versus Hofstra with two points and two assists in 12 minutes.
- Broke out with nine points versus Akron.

AIR JORDAN

- Freshman Jordan Davis came to Dayton as after becoming the all-time leading scorer at Dutch Fork High School with 1,659 points.
- Averaged 22.3 points, 6.6 rebounds, 2.5 assists and 1.7 steals for his career.
- Three-time all-region, two-time All-South Carolina Player of the Year.
- Tallied 10 points and three steals in the Ohio win.
- Scored 11 points on 4 of 4 shooting from the field against Old Dominion.
- Davis scored 12 of his 14 points in the second half versus Akron.

DELIVERING IN THE CRUTCHER

- Freshman guard Jalen Crutcher was one of the top guards coming out of Memphis, Tenn.
- Member of the Memphis Commercial Appeal's Class AAA All-Metro team, he played in the 2017 Basketball Coaches of Tennessee/Tennessee Athletic Coaches Association all-star game.
- Had six points and five rebounds versus Ball State in his Dayton debut.
- Added eight assists with zero turnovers against Akron.

JORDAN PIERCE

- Freshman Jordan Pierce averaged 12.1 points and 9.5 rebounds as a senior, leading Union Catholic to a 17-11 record.
- In his first varsity season, averaged 7.8 points, 5.9 rebounds and 1.1 blocks per game in 24 games as a junior.

RYAN MIKESELL TO MEDICALLY REDSHIRT IN 2017-18

- Forward Ryan Mikesell will redshirt the 2017-18 season as he rehabs from surgeries to correct impingement injuries to both of his hips.
- As a sophomore, Mikesell was one of only four Flyers to see action in all 32 games. He started 24 and averaged 5.7 points, 3.9 rebounds and 20.8 minutes a game.

OBADIAH TOPPIN WILL SIT OUT THE 2017-18 SEASON

- Freshman Obadiah Toppin will not this season after an NCAA ruling that he does not meet initial eligibility standards.
- Toppin will retain four seasons of eligibility, beginning with next season.
- While at Mt. Zion Prep in Baltimore this past year, Toppin averaged 17 points, eight rebounds and four assists.

THE TRANSFORMED UD ARENA

- The University of Dayton is embarking on a \$72 million renovation of its arena. The transformation of University of Dayton Arena will occur in three phases - from 2017 to 2019.
- The Arena is an iconic community resource with an economic impact of upwards of \$10 million annually.
- UD Arena has been the site of 117 NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Tournament games, 34 more than any other tournament host.

GREAT GRADUATES

- The NCAA Graduation Success Rate (GSR) report on Division I student-athletes released Nov. 8 places the University of Dayton among the top schools in graduating its student-athletes. Dayton posted a 94 GSR this year, which is the highest among all 13 Ohio NCAA Division I universities and tied for 36th in the nation.

- The tournament field, which was announced today, also includes Butler, Florida, Middle Tennessee State, Oklahoma, Stanford, Virginia and Wisconsin.
- The tournament is a three-games-in-three-days event held over the Thanksgiving holiday at the Atlantis Resort.

BASKETBALL BRILLIANCE

- Dayton is one of 19 schools to have made the last four NCAA Tournaments.
- Joining Dayton are Kansas (28 straight appearances), Duke (22), Michigan State (20), Gonzaga (19), Wisconsin (19), North Carolina (7), Cincinnati (7), VCU (7), Arizona (6), Iowa State (6), Wichita State (6), Oregon (5), Villanova (5), Dayton (4), Virginia (4), Baylor (4), Providence (4), Xavier (4) and Kentucky (4).

PICKED 5TH IN A-10

- The two-time regular-season champion University of Dayton Flyers have been selected to finish fifth in the Atlantic 10 this season, according to a poll of the conference's head men's basketball coaches and selected media.
- Dayton was 24-8 overall, and Atlantic 10 Conference regular season champions with a 15-3 league record last season.

CATCH 22

- Dayton moved up to 22nd nationally in average attendance in 2016-17 in the annual men's basketball attendance report.
- UD's average crowd of 13,018 fans a game was the best in school history, topping the 12,982 in the Arena's first season in 1969-70.
- Dayton improved 76 fans a game from a year ago, and moved up three ranking spots.
- The 22nd ranking is UD's best since being 18th with an average of 12,570.

THE MADNESS STARTS IN DAYTON

- "March Madness" will begin again in Dayton as UD Arena serves as the host site for the 2018 NCAA First Four.
- UD Arena is the all-time leader with 117 NCAA Tournament games hosted.
- That is 34 more than the original home of the NCAA Tournament, Kansas City's Municipal Auditorium.
- Since the NCAA Tournament expanded to 64 teams in 1985, Dayton has hosted the event 21 times.
- The University of Dayton is riding a 17-year streak, including four years (2001, 2006, 2009, 2013) in which it hosted the tournament's opening round game(s) and the next two rounds.

TERRIFIC TRANSFERS

- Dayton has been led in scoring by a transfer the last six years.
- Kevin Dillard led the Flyers in scoring in 2011-12 and 2012-13, Jordan Sibert followed in 2013-13 and 2014-15, while Charles Cooke topped the scoring in 2015-16 and 2016-17.

BROKEN RECORD

- Dayton broke the single-season average attendance record this year with 13,018 fans per game.
- The previous record was 12,982 fans per game, which was set the first year UD Arena opened in 1969-70.
- Dayton finished in the Top 30 in men's basketball attendance for the 19th straight season.
- This is the 19th consecutive year with an average attendance of 12,000 or more fans.
- Since UD Arena opened in 1969, Dayton has been in the NCAA's Top 35 in attendance every season.

100-PLUS SELLOUTS AT UD ARENA

- UD Arena has 117 sellouts in its 48-year history, including the last two exhibition games.
- Dayton sold out the home opener against Ball State.
- The record for sellouts is eight in the Arena's first season (1969-70).

280 AND COUNTING

- Dayton's game versus George Mason on Feb. 25, 2015 marked the 250th consecutive UD regular season home game with an attendance of at least 11,000 fans.
- The Flyers now have 286 straight.

THE 99 PERCENT

- In the last 17 years, 99% of UD's home games have drawn at least 10,000 (524 of 527), including the last 323 regular season games.

DAYTON'S NBA LINEAGE CONTINUES

- Flyer alum Charles Cooke (New Orleans Pelicans), is representing Dayton during the 2017-18 NBA season with a two-way contract.
- He is one of the 20 former Flyers who have played in the NBA.

DID YOU KNOW?

- UD won more games than any other school in both the 1950s and 60s. UD won 435 games between 1950 and 1969 and ranks among the top teams in Division I history.
- The Flyers' .763 (228-71) winning percentage in the 1950s ranks fifth in the decade. Their .729 (207-77) winning percentage ranks eighth in the 1960s.

DAYTON INKS TOP 100 TALENT DWAYNE COHILL

On Nov. 8, 2017, University of Dayton men's basketball coach Anthony Grant announced that Dwayne Cohill signed a National Letter of Intent to join the Flyers.

A 6-foot-2, 175 pound guard from Holy Name High School in Parma Heights, Ohio, Cohill is a consensus Four-Star and Top 100 prospect.

He led Holy Name to a 23-4 record in 2016-17 and its second regional appearance in three years. A versatile guard, he averaged 22.9 points, 6.9 rebounds, 3.3 assists and 2.5 steals per game as a junior and shot 35 percent from three-point range.

He chose the Flyers over schools from the Big Ten, the Big XII and the ACC.

DON DONOHER TO RECEIVE USBWA'S DEAN SMITH AWARD

- National College Basketball Hall of Famer Don Donoher has been named the winner of the 2017 Dean Smith Award given annually by the U.S. Basketball Writers Association.
- Donoher will be presented the award on Dec. 13.
- He is the third individual to receive the honor. Former Georgetown coach John Thompson was the first recipient, followed by Michigan State coach Tom Izzo.
- Donoher retired in 1989 after 25 years as Dayton's head coach with 437 career victories, the most in UD history.

BUCKY BOCKHORN - THE IRON MAN

- Bucky Bockhorn has been doing color for UD games on radio longer than any other team's analyst in the country (46 years).
- Wyoming's Kevin McKinney is next (38 years, and he only does home games) and Wichita State's Dave Dahl is third (37, and he also only does home games).
- As a team, Bucky and play-by-play man Larry Hansgen are third behind Pitt's Bill Hillgove and Dick Groat (39 years) and Wichita State's Mike Kennedy and Dave Dahl.
- Larry and Bucky have been together for 35 years.

The University of Dayton announced Anthony Grant as the 20th head coach in Flyer Basketball history on March 30, 2017.

"I am honored and humbled to be the head coach at the University of Dayton," Grant said. "It's a great responsibility to take over at an institution that is so well-respected. Anyone you talk to in college basketball would say our program is a successful one, but the potential is here for so much more."

Grant was most recently on the coaching staff of the NBA's Oklahoma City Thunder, working with athletes such as Kevin Durant and Russell Westbrook. He spent the last two seasons on Billy Donovan's staff after nine seasons as head coach at Alabama and VCU and 13 seasons as a Division I assistant coach.

In nine seasons as a head coach, Grant took his teams to three NCAA tournament appearances and six postseason tournament berths. He has a career record of 193-110 (.637).

Grant is also a 1987 graduate of the University of Dayton, where he was a four-year basketball letterwinner and three-year starter. He played in 105 games at Dayton, averaging 11.6 points and 6.7 rebounds per game over his career. He was the Flyers' co-captain and the White-Allen Most Valuable Player as a senior. His teams played in two NCAA tournaments and one NIT.

"I join Neil and the entire Flyer Nation in offering a warm welcome to Coach Grant, his wife Christina and their family," UD President Eric F. Spina said. "In our time together, Anthony clearly demonstrated his ability, his desire to be here and is a clear fit with the University's values and priorities, which include integrity, the development of character, and winning."

In six years at Alabama, Grant amassed a record of 117-85 (.579) while guiding the Crimson Tide to the 2012 NCAA Tournament, their first tournament berth since 2006. He also took Alabama to the NIT on three occasions.

Prior to Alabama, the Miami, Fla. native spent three seasons as the head coach of VCU where he led the Rams to a 76-25 (.752) record and three consecutive Colonial Athletic Association Championships. VCU went to the NCAA tournament twice under Grant and was 45-9 (.833) in CAA games.

Prior to becoming a head coach, Grant spent 13 years as a respected Division I assistant coach. The last 10 years were at the University of Florida (1996-2006) where he served under Donovan. Grant helped lead the Gators to their first national title in 2006, and Florida won the national title again in 2007 with players he recruited and developed.

The 20th coach in Dayton's history, Grant is just the seventh Flyer coach in the last 70 years. In the modern era of UD basketball, Grant is just the second Dayton grad to coach the Flyers. The first was his coach, College Basketball Hall of Famer Don Donoher (1964-89).

He and his wife Christina have four children.

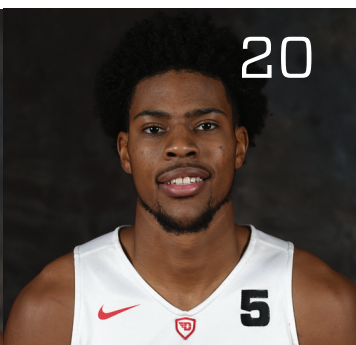
