- » After a 99-68 rout of Nebraska on Saturday in a Holiday Hoopsgiving game held in Atlanta, the Tigers got the attention of the voters and moved up five spots to No. 13 in this week's Associated Press Top 25 Poll their highest national ranking this season.
- » North Alabama comes to town for a non-conference, in-state tilt on Tuesday night at Auburn Arena. Fans are encouraged to bring a new, unwrapped toy for Auburn Basketball's Toy Drive. All donations will be benefit Toys for Tots.
- » The Tigers and Lions are both currently on a five-game win streak. AU boasts the 10th-best scoring offense in the nation averaging 84.2 points per game, while UNA is one of the top scoring defenses holding opponents to 57.8 points per game (14th).
- » Head Coach Bruce Pearl continues to serve a two-game suspension recently handed down by the NCAA. His son, Steven, will serve as Acting Head Coach against North Alabama. The younger Pearl, who played for his father at Tennessee from 2007-11, is in his eighth year with the program and fourth as an assistant.
- » Steven Pearl currently does a lot of work with the program's defense and works primarily with the fourmen including Jabari Smith, Walker Kessler and Jaylin Williams. The first and last time he served as a Head Coach, was coaching a sixth grade youth team in Knoxville, Tenn., while working in medical sales.
- » Auburn is one of only 29 schools in NCAA Division I with one or fewer losses on the season. The Tigers currently rank No. 4 in blocked shots per game (7.1) and No. 8 in steals per game (10.8). They made a season-high 16 steals and 26 assists versus Nebraska. AU also shot a season-best 51.3% from the field.

#### **BRUCE PEARL**

Head Coach 8th year at Auburn • 145-93 27th year overall • 607-238



- 7 National Coach of the Year Awards, 2006 Basketball Times, CBSsportsline, Sporting News National Coach of the Year
- 2006 & 2008 AP SEC Coach of the Year, 2008 SEC Co-Coach of the Year
- 2008 Rupp Cup Co-winner
- Has advanced to postseason play in 20 of 26 years as a head coach. In 2019-20, had a second-place finish in the SEC with a 25-6 record, including 12-6 in league play, that would be 21 of 25 years in the postseason not been canceled due to COVID
- Set single-season wins records at four different schools (29 at Southern Indiana in 1995; 26 at Wisconsin-Milwaukee in 2005; 31 at Tennessee in 2008; 30 at Auburn in 2019)
- Pearl has achieved a top-5 national ranking at Southern Indiana, Tennessee and Auburn. He has been in the top five in 10 seasons (1994-2001 at Southern Indiana, 2007-08 at Tennessee, 2019-20 at Auburn)
- Bruce Pearl's teams have led their conference in scoring 17 of the 26 years that he has been a head coach. His squads were the SEC's scoring champion in four of his six seasons at Tennessee, averaging 77.4 ppg while allowing 70.5 ppg
- One of 12 coaches to lead three different DI programs to the Sweet 16, joining Rick Barnes, Gene Bartow, John Calipari, Lon Kruger, Frank McGuire, Ralph Miller, Rick Pitino, Bill Self, Tubby Smith, Eddie Sutton and Bruce Weber. Including his stint at DII Southern Indiana, Pearl is one of only three coaches to take four programs (with three at the DI level) to the Sweet 16, joining Lon Kruger and Eddie Sutton
- With the win over Kentucky that sent Auburn to its first Final Four in program history, Pearl notched his 100th win as head coach of the Tigers. He is the first coach in Auburn history to have 100 wins in his first five seasons
- Bruce Pearl is the 11th coach in SEC history to win four conference crowns (overall or division) in a 10-year span. He is on the same list as Adolph Rupp (UK), Babe McCarthy (MSU), Billy Donovan (UF), Dale Brown (LSU), Joe Hall (UK), John Calipari (UK), Nolan Richardson (ARK), Rick Pitino (UK), Rick Stansbury (MSU) and Tubby Smith (UK)
- Auburn sold out of season tickets for the seventh consecutive year in 2021-22 (excluding COVID restricted seating season of 2020-21), all under Pearl, to continue the school record streak. Prior to Pearl, the only other time the Tigers sold out of season tickets came was 1999-2000
- $\bullet$  In 26 full years as a head coach, Bruce Pearl's teams have finished either first or second in conference play 17 times
- $\bullet$  At the Division I level, Pearl's teams have topped the 100-point mark 22 times, including a high of 124 in 2009 as well as 121 in the 2007 NCAA Tournament. In his second year as a coach at Southern Indiana the team averaged 101.7 ppg
- In the past five seasons, Auburn has the best non-conference record in the SEC during the regular season at 53-7 (.883), while scheduling regular NCAA Tournament teams in Arizona, Davidson, Dayton, Duke, Iowa State, Middle Tennessee, Murray State, Oklahoma, Texas Tech, UConn and Xavier
- His teams have been just as successful off the court as Auburn has had 32 graduates in six years the most in the SEC. In 2018, Auburn received an Academic Progress Rate Public Recognition Award marking the first time the Tigers have been honored since the award began tracking data in 2004. The NCAA annually honors teams earning multiyear Academic Progress Rates in the top 10 percent of all squads in each sport

- Auburn recently secured its fourth perfect APR score of 1,000 in mid-May, something that has never been accomplished in program history
- $\bullet$  In the past five years, Auburn men's basketball has averaged an APR of 995 (out of 1,000). In the previous four seasons before Pearl and his staff arrived, Auburn's APR average score was 940
- Pearl started AUTLIVE at Auburn in 2015-16 to benefit cancer patients in the fight to beat cancer. AUTLIVE raises the awareness of cancer prevention and detection while t-shirt sales and donations raise money to benefit cancer patients. He initiated the OUTLIVE program in 2009 at Tennessee in recognition of former Vol Chris Lofton, who beat testicular cancer through early diagnosis and treatment and went on to play the entire 2007-08 season while recovering from his battle with the disease
- On Dec. 19, 2019, Children's Harbor in Birmingham, Ala. dedicated their on-site basketball court in honor of the charitible work done by Coach Pearl and the Pearl family over the last six years.
- Bruce Pearl has raised over \$1.2 million in only six golf tournaments at Auburn. Pearl and his wife, Brandy, have remarkably raised \$770,000 in the last three years benefitting Children's Harbor in Birmingham through the Bruce Pearl Fore the Children Golf Classic. The mission of Children's Harbor is to help children with serious illness and their families
- $\bullet$  The Bruce Pearl Family Foundation in conjunction with L5 Foundation, an organization dedicated to addressing the essential and basic needs of cancer patients, donated \$20,000 to five charities in a ceremony in Knoxville in August 2015
- The Pearl family announced on Feb. 27, 2007, a \$100,000 donation to endow a scholarship in the name of former Tennessee player Dane Bradshaw. The Dane Bradshaw Athletic Scholarship Endowment is awarded to the male or female student-athlete at UT who best epitomizes the characteristics of the 2006-07 senior captain

#### **BLOCK PARTY**

- » AU made a season-high 14 blocked shots versus Yale behind a career best three from Cardwell and four from Kessler. It tied as the most in the Bruce Pearl Era next to 14 at Georgia and versus Missouri during the 2020-21 season. » It was three off from the school single-game
- » It was three off from the school single-game record (17 vs. Nicholls State in 2011 SEC record is 18).
- » One of the top shot blockers in the country, Walker Kessler has now tallied 30 stops this season. The school single-season record is 126 (23% of that record through just nine games).

#### FROM THREE

» Auburn has made 10-or-more 3-pointers in six of its nine games this season including the last four. The Tigers drained 14 treys against Nebraska - a season best in the category.

#### 37 IN A ROW

» Auburn has won 37 consecutive non-conference games at Auburn Arena. It's last non-conference home loss was Jan. 20, 2016 vs. Oklahoma State (63-74). Bruce Pearl is 47-3 at Auburn in non-conference home games.

#### PRESEASON HONORS AND WATCH LIST

- » A pair of Tigers appear on some of the nation's top watch lists. Freshman Jabari Smith is a menber of the John Wooden Preseason Top 50 Watch List which identifies 50 players for national player of the year and all-America honors. Smith also is on the Karl Malone Award Watch List which is presented each year to the country's top power forward. Sophomore center Walker Kessler is on the Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Award Watch List, given annually to the nation's top center.
- » Allen Flanigan was named to the Coaches' Preseason All-SEC first team while Jabari Smith was named to the second team. Smith, the highest rated player ever signed at Auburn, was the only freshman to be voted on either team.

#### ON TO THE LEAGUE

» Auburn lost four of its top six scorers from last season including a pair of NBA Draft picks in guard Sharife Cooper (20.2 ppg, 8.0 apg) and forward JT Thor (9.4 ppg, 5.0 rpg). Thor was a first round pick of the Charlotte Hornets, while Cooper was a second rounder to the Atlanta Hawks.

#### TRACKING THE TIGERS

- » Auburn has the best overall record in the SEC since 2017 (102-39).
- » From 2017-20, Auburn was one of four major programs to win at least 25 programs each year joining Duke, Kansas and Kentucky.
- » Made its first NCAA Final Four appearance in 2019.
- » Auburn has graduated 32 players in the last five years, the most of any SEC program.
- » Auburn's 4 NBA Draft picks in last three years is tied for seventh most nationally and third in the Southeastern Conference.
- » The four draft picks in last three years are the most for Auburn in the modern draft era (Chuma Okeke, Isaac Okoro, JT Thor, Sharife Cooper).
- » Auburn one of two programs in the country to beat Kentucky in each of the last four years.
- » Bruce Pearl won his 600th career game in his last regular season game of the 2020-21 season.
- » Bruce Pearl is second among active SEC coaches in winning percentage as a head coach (.718).

#### PLAYER TO WATCH: WENDELL GREEN JR.

Sophomore guard Wendell Green Jr. came off the bench and registered a season-high tying 19 points shooting 4-for-6 from the long range in a 99-68 victory over Nebraska on Dec. 11 in a Holiday Hoopsgiving game in Atlanta. His impressive stat line also including six rebounds and six assists against the Cornhuskers. It marked Green Jr.'s fifth game in double digits this season and third game with six-or-more assists in the team's last four contests. He currently leads the Tigers in assists per game (4.6), which ranks sixth best in the SEC.



#### **FLANIGAN OUT**

- » Auburn junior guard Allen Flanigan had a successful procedure in early September to repair his right Achilles after suffering a non-basketball related trauma, but has been in practice the last three weeks doing light workouts.
- » Flanigan's surgery was performed at the Andrews Sports Medicine & Orthopedic Center at St. Vincent's Hospital in Birmingham. The SEC's fourth leading returning scorer, Flanigan is expected to return to the team mid-to-late December.
- » As a sophomore in 2020-21, Flanigan averaged 14.3 points, 5.5 rebounds and 2.9 assists while starting in all 27 games. The most improved scorer in the SEC last season, Flanigan was one of three players in the league to average 14.0 points, 5.0 rebounds and 2.5 assists per game.

#### SEC IN STRETCH

» Babatunde "Stretch" Akingbola represented Auburn at this year's Southeastern Conference Basketball Leadership Council that was held in September. The council consisted of one male representative and one female representative from each of the SEC's 14 institutions. The goal of the leadership council is for student-athletes to serve as a conduit of communication from their teams to the conference office on issues related to student-athlete experience, student-athlete wellness, and to provide feedback on proposed rules governing the SEC and NCAA.

» The 2020-21 Auburn men's basketball team was named a recipient of the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) Team Academic Excellence Award. The award, created by the NABC Committee on Academics, recognizes outstanding academic achievement by a team with a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 or better. The Tigers earned the award for the first time since its inception in 2013 and were one of only two Southeastern Conference teams to garner recognition, in addition to Tennessee.

» Under Bruce Pearl, the Tigers are 64-21 when ranked, including a 6-1 mark in 2021-22.


