#### >> QUICK HITTERS

- Auburn enters the final weekend of non-conference play as the national leader in runs scored
   (121) and ranks in the top 10 in the NCAA in eight offensive categories.
- In 30 games since the start of last season, the team has recorded the most hits (353) and has scored the second most runs (279) in Division I.
- Auburn has hit 17 home runs through 12 games and is one of three teams to have seven players with multiple home runs this season joined by LSU and Old Dominion.
- The Tigers' weekend rotation of Cody Greenhill, Mason Barnett and Trace Bright marks the team's fourth different weekend rotation through four weeks this season.
- The trio is 4-0 with a 1.50 ERA, 30 strikeouts and 14 walks in 36.0 innings this season.
- Auburn has also utilized 10 different lineups both positionally and with the batting order through 12 games this season.
- This weekend marks the first meeting between Auburn and Little Rock.

## **BUTCH THOMPSON**

## **HEAD COACH**

Butch Thompson enters his sixth season at the helm of the program in 2020, posting a record of 154-115 in his first five seasons. He led the program to the first College World Series appearance in 22 years in 2019 and has taken the Tigers to three straight regionals for the first time since 2001-03.

Butch Thompson was named Auburn's head baseball coach on October 22, 2015 and enters his sixth season with the Tigers in 2021.

Thompson, who spent three seasons as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Auburn from 2006-08, returned to The Plains after seven seasons at Mississippi State as both associate head coach and pitching coach.

A native of Amory, Miss., Thompson has coached 30 Division I All-Americans and 39 all-conference performers. He has seen 16 of his former pitchers make their Major League Baseball debuts, including 10 since 2014. Thompson has also turned 32 pitchers who went undrafted out of high school into MLB draft picks.

Thompson had three pitchers drafted in the first 11 rounds in 2014 and five pitchers drafted, including three in the top 10 rounds, in 2013. He added a first-round selection in the 2016 draft, a third-round pick in Keegan Thompson in 2017 and the first No. 1 overall pick in program history in Casey Mize in 2018. With Tanner Burns also going as a supplemental first round pick in 2020, Auburn became one of four programs with a pair of pitchers drafted in the first round in the last three years.

Along with his pitching pedigree, Thompson is also considered one of the top recruiters in the country. Since 2003, he has secured 13 recruiting classes that were ranked in the top 10 by either Baseball America or Perfect Game, including the No. 5 signing class in 2017 and a program record No. 4 class in 2018. His classes signed from 2006-08 at Auburn each ranked in the top 18 nationally, including the No. 5 class in 2008, which included All-American and SEC Player of the Year Hunter Morris.


In 28 years of coaching at the collegiate level, including 19 in the Southeastern Conference, Thompson has coached eight College World Series participants, including leading the Tigers to the program's first trip to the College World Series in 22 years in 2019. Thompson has also coached one national champion and a national runner-up, won nine conference championships and made 17 postseason appearances. He has also served as an assistant under three National Coach of the Year recipients.

Thompson was named the 2006 Fellowship of Christian Athletes SEC Coach of the Year while at Auburn and the 2014 Baseball America and American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA) National Assistant Coach of the Year while at Mississippi State.

Thompson has returned the Tigers to prominence in five seasons on The Plains as he has guided the team to a 154-115 overall record and three straight NCAA Tournament appearances for the first time since 2001-03, including back-to-back super regionals for the first time in program history. After advancing to the College World Series in 2019 and a winner-take-all game three in the Gainesville Super Regional in 2018, the Tigers have finished each of the last two full seasons ranked as high as No. 8 and No. 9, respectively. It marked the third time in program history the team has finished back-to-back seasons in the top 10.

Entering the 2019 postseason as the No. 2 seed in the Atlanta Regional, Auburn became the only program to sweep a regional on the road in each of the last two potseasons before also becoming the first team to defeat North Carolina in a Chapel Hill Super Regional in 2019, punching its ticket to Omaha for the first time since 1997.

In seven seasons at MSU, Thompson made four NCAA regional trips, two Super Regionals, won the SEC Tournament and advanced to the College World Series finishing as NCAA runner-up in 2013. In three of his last four seasons in Starkville, the Bulldogs' staff ERA finished no higher than 3.06. Thompson's 2013 pitching staff was one of two nationally to finish in the top 15 in ERA, strikeouts per nine



innings and hits allowed per nine innings.

In addition to his experience at Auburn and Mississippi State, Thompson also spent four seasons at Georgia from 2002-05, including a trip to the College World Series in 2004. While there, he guided the development of future Major Leaguers Josh Fields, Mitchell Boggs and Brooks Brown.

Thompson launched his coaching career as pitching coach and top assistant at Huntingdon College (Ala.) in 1993, before returning to his alma mater in Birmingham, where he helped lead the Panthers to back-to-back Southern States Conference Championships and in 1995 coached BSC to its first NAIA World Series berth.

Thompson left BSC briefly to serve as head coach at Jefferson State Community College in Birmingham in 1997. While at JSCC, he was honored as the Regional Tournament Coach of the Year, the ABCA Alabama Junior College Coach of the Year and the Southeast Region Coach of the Year after guiding JSCC to a 39-21 mark, the AJCAA Region 22 State Championship and a thirdplace finish in the NJCAA Division II World Series.

He returned to Birmingham-Southern as top assistant the following season, beginning a four-year run during the most successful span in BSC baseball history. The Panthers won 196 games and four TranSouth Conference Championships and made three-consecutive appearances in the NAIA World Series. BSC's 2001 team posted a school-best 55-11 mark and captured the NAIA National Championship.

In 2002, Thompson joined the SEC baseball coaching fraternity as a pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at Georgia and has been a part of the league for the past 17 seasons.

Thompson currently serves as the large-school representative for the Alabama Baseball Coaches Association and is an All-American committee member representing the South region for the ABCA.

Thompson prepped at Amory (Miss.) High School and later starred as a pitcher at Itawamba (Miss.) Community College from 1989-90. On Oct. 25, 2014, Thompson was inducted into the ICC Athletic Hall of Fame.



- Shortstop Ryan Bliss has started and played in all but two games since stepping foot on campus in 2019.
- Bliss has multiple hits in 31 of 66 games since April 1, 2019 and is hitting .333 (88-for-264) during the span.

#### **RANKIN IS ROLLIN'**

- Rankin Woley is riding a five-game hitting streak and has multiple hits in three of the last four contests.
- Woley is 8-for-14 with nine runs and three doubles during the span.
- The graduate third baseman is hitting .380 (41-for-108) with 24 runs, 13 doubles, four home runs and 28 RBI in 28 games since the start of last season.

#### **SWING IT. STEVEN**

- Senior outfielder Steven Williams ranks second among active SEC players in hits (151), home runs (25) and RBI (111).
- Williams would enter the top 10 in program history with 10 or more home runs this season.

#### **IS T-MILL FOR REAL?**

- Tyler Miller reached base in nine straight plate appearances from 2/27-3/5, going 8-for-8 with four runs, a double, triple, homer and four RBI during the stretch.
- Miller is tied for the SEC lead with 18 RBI and ranks fourth in the league with a .419 average.
- Entering week four, he is one of four players in the country to rank in the top 20 in the NCAA in both categories.

#### **GETTING IT STARTED**

- Prior to Ryan Bliss missing two games against Alabama A&M, Judd Ward and Bliss had hit first and second in the Auburn lineup in 47 straight games dating back to 2019.
- During the 47-game span, the duo hit .318 (124-for-390) with 87 runs, 23 doubles, three triples, 11 home runs and 68 RBI.

#### **PROVEN VETERANS**

- Seniors Cody Greenhill and Jack Owen are two of eight SEC pitchers with a career sub-4.00 ERA and 100+ IP.
- Greenhill has posted a 2.63 ERA in 133.2 IP while Owen has turned in a 3.76 clip in 124.1 IP.

#### A NEW ROLE

- Senior right-hander Cody Greenhill made his first career start and earned the win in the season opener vs. Presbyterian.
- Greenhill previously made 53 career relief appearances since 2018 and ranks sixth in program history in saves (19).

#### **RECORD-SETTING PERFORMANCE**

- Auburn set the program record with 33 runs in a win against Alabama A&M on Feb. 24, eclipsing the previous mark of 32 runs against Troy on Mar. 2, 1994.
- The Tigers also tied the program record with 27 hits in the contest, matching the previous record set in the same game against the Trojans.
- The team scored 14 runs in the fourth inning, coming up two runs shy of the program record.
- Twelve players recorded a hit in the game and 10 had two or more, including all nine in the starting lineup.
- Nine players drove in two or more runs, including four players with four or more RBI, led by Brody Moore's seven.
- The Tigers totaled 11 doubles in the game and three players had a pair of two-baggers. It marked the first time since 2010 the team hit 10 or more doubles in a game.
- Bryson Ware set the single-game program record by scoring six runs in the contest.

#### **WEALTH OF EXPERIENCE**

- The Tigers return 12 position players, including seven players who started 10 or more games, and 10 pitchers from last year's team.
- The returning position players accounted for 76 percent of the runs, 77 percent of the RBI and 79 percent of the Tigers' hits in 2020.
- Despite losing two weekend starters in Tanner Burns and Bailey Horn, the returning pitchers accounted for 62 percent of the strikeouts, 66 percent of the innings pitched and 71 percent of the team's appearances in 2020.

#### ON THE ROAD AGAIN

• Auburn's trip to Round Rock, Texas, for the Round Rock Classic from Feb. 26-28 marked the team's first road trip since the program's appearances in the 2019 CWS.

## **TOUGH TESTS AHEAD**

- Four of Auburn's last seven games have come against ranked opponents (#25 Oklahoma, #18 Boston College).
- The Tigers are scheduled to play eight other opponents ranked in the top 25 of one of the six major polls, including four of the top five and five of the top seven in D1 Baseball's latest top 25.

## ALL-SEC

- Ryan Bliss and Rankin Woley held down the left side of the infield on the Preseason All-SEC Team selected by the leagues head coaches earlier this month.
- The tandem are the first shortstop and third baseman teammates to both be named First Team Preseason All-SEC since Dalton Guthrie and Jonathan India of Florida in 2017.



- The 2020 MLB Draft marked the 46th consecutive year Auburn had at least one player selected, tied for the longest active streak in the SEC.
- With Tanner Burns and Bailey Horn going in the first and fifth rounds, it marked the third time in program history two pitchers were drafted in the first five rounds, including the first time since 1997.
- It was also the fifth straight draft with a top-five-round pick, marking the second time in program history to accomplish the feat (1997-2001), and the fourth straight draft with a top-seven-round pitcher for the first time in program history.






