## QUICK HITS

- Auburn looks to remain undefeated at Jane B. Moore Field as the Tigers continue their homestand with the Auburn Invitational. The Tigers welcome Troy, Southern Miss and Southeastern Louisiana for the three-gay tournament.
- Justus Perry is just 18 putouts shy of becoming just the sixth Tiger in program history to record 1,000 career putouts. She is also just four hits shy from her 100th career base knock.
- Tossing her second no-hitter in three weeks, SEC Freshman of the Week Maddie Penta is the first Auburn pitcher to toss multiple no-hitters in the same season since Marcy Harper (2) in 2014.
- Auburn and Florida are the only SEC schools to have two players ranked in the top eight in earned run average. The Tiger freshman duo of Shelby Lowe (0.36) and Maddie Penta (0.85) rank fourth and eighth, respectively.
- The Tiger pitching staff allowed just one run over the Tiger Invite to bring the team ERA 1.21, which ranks 14th in the country.

## BY THE NUMBERS

**17** Maddie Penta struck out 16 consecutive batters en route to her second no-hitter of the season. She closed the game with 17 strikeouts, the second most in a single game in Auburn history.

**15.2** Shelby Lowe has not allowed a run to score in 15.2 consecutive innings pitched. She ranks fourth in the SEC with a 0.36 ERA.

**0** Makenna Dowell has recorded no strikeouts in 31 at-bats this season to rank as one of the toughest batters in the country to strike out.

Coach Dean, assistant coaches and select student-athletes are available for interviews by contacting Taylor Shirey in the communications office. All interviews during the week will be conducted via phone or through ZOOM. Weekly media availabilities will be conducted approximately 30 minutes prior to Tuesday practices throughout the season unless otherwise specified. ZOOM information will be emailed to the media on Mondays. Specific interview request should be made at least 24 hours in advance to ensure availability. **Due to COVID protocols, all practices during the 2021 season are CLOSED.**

Postgame interviews with Coach Dean and requested players will be conducted via ZOOM following a brief cooling-off period. ZOOM links will be emailed out to media on game days.

**CREDENTIALS**

Media members wishing to cover Auburn softball should contact Taylor Shirey at least 48 hours prior to each home contest. Due to COVID-19, seating at Jane B. Moore Field is extremely limited. There will be an estimated 1-2 seats available for reporters (including visiting media) for home contests. In addition, there will be a very limited number of photo/video credentials.

All credentials will be issued on a game-by-game basis. No passes will be issued in advance. Credentials will be available for pick up on game days at Media Will Call located at the main entrance of Jane B. Moore Field. You will receive email confirmation following the 48 hour deadline of which game(s) you have been approved to cover. Due to limitations on spacing, media seating will be outdoors this season. Please dress accordingly. With the limited space, media member may only be selected to attend one game per weekend series

based on demand to ensure an opportunity for all members of the media to cover a contest in person.

All persons at Jane B. Moore Field are required to wear face coverings and observe social distancing.

No media will have access to field level at any time.

- » It's been over 15 years since the two teams have faced on the diamond, Auburn last faced Southern Louisiana on Feb. 14, 2003 in Monroe, La., winning the game 3-2.

### BACK WHERE WE BELONG: AUBURN RETURNS TO NATIONAL RANKINGS

- » With the program's best start since 2018, Auburn returned to the national spotlight this week with its first Top 25 rankings of the 2021 season.
- » Auburn checked in at No. 24 in the USA Today/NFCA Coaches Poll. It is the first time Auburn has been ranked by the publication since its 2020 preseason poll.
- » Auburn also earned a Top 25 in the ESPN.com/USA Softball Collegiate Top 25 as the Tigers were ranked tied with UCF at No. 23. It is the first time that Auburn has been ranked by the publication since 2019.

### ANOTHER ONE: PENTA EARNS SECOND SEC FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK HONOR

- » Tossing her second no-hitter in three weeks, freshman pitcher Maddie Penta was named the Southeastern Conference Freshman of the Week for the second time this season.
- » Penta is the first Auburn Tiger to win multiple SEC Freshman of the Week honors in the same season since Kasey Cooper in 2014. She is the first Auburn pitcher to win the award multiple times in a season since Anna Thompson in 2007.
- » The Chesapeake City, Md., native tossed two complete-game shutouts for Auburn over the Tiger Invite. Penta allowed just four hits and four walks over her 14.0 innings of work, while striking out 27 batters.

### OH NO-NO, SHE DIDN'T

- » With just three weeks of collegiate play under her belt, Maddie Penta has tossed two no-hitter with another lights outs performance - this time against IUPUI.
- » Penta struck out 16 consecutive batters over the first six innings. She carried a perfect game bid into the top of the seventh before issuing a walk. She closed the game with her 17th strikeout to secure her second no-hitter of the season.
- » The right-hander's 17 strikeouts tied for the second most in a single game in Auburn history. She was one shy from the program's record single-game record of 18.
- » She is the first Auburn pitcher to toss multiple no-hitters in the same season since Marcy Harper (2) in 2014.

careers. Perry is just 18 putout shy of her 1,000th of her career. She currently stands in sixth in program history with 982. She would be just the sixth Tiger to eclipse 1,000 career putouts joining, Kendall Veach, Tatiana Fernandez, Mary Petrie, Jade Rhodes and Elizabeth Eisterhold.

» Perry is tied for fourth in program history with Sara Dean (2002-2005) with a .989 fielding percentage.

### THIS SEASON IS BROUGHT TO YOU BY THE LETTER "K"

» Led by a dynamic freshman duo, Auburn's pitching staff has put the nation on notice that it is one of the best in the country.

» Auburn ranks fourth in the Southeastern Conference and 14th in the nation with a 1.21 team earned run average. The Tigers rank second in the SEC behind just Alabama in total strikeouts. Auburn has 108 strikeouts through the first three weeks of the season. Alabama stands at 116.

» Auburn's pitchers flexed their muscle over the Tiger Invite as all five members of the staff tossed multiple innings over Auburn's 5-0 weekend. The staff allowed just one run over 35 innings as Auburn held a 0.20 over the tournament.

» The dynamic duo of Maddie Penta and Shelby Lowe has carried the bulk of the work in the circle, combining for seven of Auburn's 11 wins. The pair have two of the eight lowest earned run averages in the SEC as Lowe (0.36) ranks fourth and Penta (0.85) ranks eighth.

» The duo also rank in the top 10 in the league in strikeouts with Penta's 49 good for fourth and Lowe's 30 standing at ninth most in the SEC.

### KEEPING IT "100": MICKEY DEAN EARNS HIS 100TH VICTORY ON THE PLAINS

» Fourth-year head coach Mickey Dean guided the Tigers to their first win over a ranked opponent in 2021 with a 5-4 victory against No. 19 South Carolina to open the Osprey/Dolphin Invitational on Feb. 21, 2021. The victory was a major one as it marked the 100th win for Dean during his tenure at Auburn.

» Coach Dean is inching towards another major

milestone as he stands just 24 wins away from his 600th career coaching victory. He enters the weekend with a 576-222 (.722) overall career record.

» During his short time at Auburn, Mickey Dean has already gathered a long list of coaching feats, all while he continues to overhaul the program's culture and return Auburn softball to the top of the SEC.

» The national spotlight will be on the Tigers once again this season as Auburn is set to appear on national television nine times in 2021, following ESPN's announcement for the spring softball slate.

» Auburn will have four home games broadcasted nationally, including the Sunday series finale against in-state rival Alabama during Auburn's SEC opening weekend. Five of Auburn's road contests will also be aired on the ESPN Family of Networks.

» The Tigers will be featured on the SEC Network six times and will end the regular-season broadcast schedule with their May 7 road test at LSU airing on ESPNU.

» Included in the major television package, the majority of Auburn's home games as well as every SEC road contest will be available to stream on the SEC Network+.

### NO-NO SEMO

» In her first collegiate start, Maddie Penta made a little history, tossing the 26th no-hitter in program history. It was the first no-hitter for the Tigers since Makayla Martin vs. Maryland on Feb. 18, 2018.

» Penta allowed just four base runners, all via walks, over her five innings of work. She struck out seven to secure an 8-0 season-opening victory.

» She is just the third Auburn freshman to toss a solo no-hitter and the last since Marcy Harper vs. Savannah State on March 14, 2013.

» She is the first freshman in program history to toss a no-hitter in a season opener.

### PENTA-THLETE: MADDIE EARNS SEC FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

» After a phenomenal collegiate debut in the circle in Auburn softball's sweep of Southeastern Missouri, freshman pitcher Maddie Penta was named the Southeastern Conference Co-Freshman of the Week on Monday, sharing the award with Georgia's Sydney Chambley.

» Picking up two wins and a shutout over opening weekend, Penta posted a 0.00 earned run average as she allowed just one unearned run in 12 innings of work. She held opponents to a .051 batting average and struck out a team-high 13.

» She is the first freshman to win the honor since her teammate Carlee McCondichie was named Co-Freshman of the Week on March 2, 2020. This is the third SEC Freshman of the Week honor during the Mickey Dean era.

### HOT START TO 2021

» With its undefeated weekend at the Tiger Invite, Auburn is off to its best start to a season with its 10-1 record since Mickey Dean's first year on The Plains back in 2018.

» That season, Auburn won 15 consecutive contests to begin the year.

- » Alyssa Rivera was off to one the best starts of her career before the 2020 season came to a halt. She returns for one more year with some unfinished business: rewriting the Auburn record book.
- » Rivera is one of just nine student-athletes in program history to record at least 100 runs scored, 150 hits and 110 RBI over their careers.
- » Rivera currently ranks third in career stolen base percentage (.864), fourth in stolen bases (38) and tied for 10th in home runs (28). She is knocking on the door in several additional offensive categories.
- » Rivera enters the fourth weekend of the season ranked among the top 50 active NCAA student-athletes in career games played (202) and total bases (296).

» The 11,000-square-foot facility features six batting tunnels, a netting system, team meeting space, pitching machines, LED lighting and clay pitching circle, allowing student-athletes the ability to practice year round regardless of weather.

» Gregg Heim graduated from Auburn University in 1965 in business administration. He served in the Army Reserve and enjoyed a distinguished insurance career for Liberty National. » The Tigers currently rank sixth in the country in accumulated attendance with 1,480 fans over the two home weekends. Auburn has reached its 2021 max capacity of 370 in all of its home contests this season, the average is good for fifth in the country.

## HEAD COACH MICKEY DEAN

Mickey Dean enters his fourth season as the head coach of the Auburn softball program. In 13 years at the collegiate level, Dean has coached nine NCAA Tournament teams, including one super regional participant, and won nine conference championships.

A native of Elkton, Va., Dean has guided 78 all-conference players, 43 all-region honorees and eight All-Americans, including 2017 National Player of the Year, Megan Good. He has also been touted as the conference coach of the year eight times.

During his time on The Plains, Dean has guided the Tigers to a 96-49 overall record and two NCAA Regional appearances. Dean's resume at Auburn also includes three NFCA All-Region selections and two All-SEC selections. He also guided slugger Kendall Veach to All-America honors from Softball America in 2019.

Dean's third season at Auburn was shortened due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Before the 2020 season was halted, Dean helped the Tigers to 16 wins, highlighted by victories over No. 25 Northwestern and No. 16 Minnesota. The Tigers made program history on March 2, 2020, when Alyssa Rivera (Player), Samantha Yarbrough (Pitcher) and Carlee McCondie (Freshman) swept the SEC's weekly awards. It marked the first time Auburn has swept all three SEC awards.

Auburn closed the 2019 season with a 39-21 overall record, earning its sixth straight NCAA Tournament bid. The Tigers closed the conference slate with a 10-14 mark and earned a spot in the 2019 SEC Softball Tournament semifinals. Dean guided Kendall Veach to All-SEC and NFCA All-Region team honors. The program made history as the senior class was drafted in the 2019 National Pro Fastpitch Draft.

Dean led Auburn to a 15-0 start to open the 2018 season, which tied the best start in program history and were the most wins in SEC history among first-year head coaches. He earned his 500th career win during the Wilson/DeMarini Classic when Auburn earned a shutout win over Western Illinois on Mar. 4. He led the Tigers to their 800th win in program history with a 2-1 victory over Kennesaw State on April 4.

Dean came to Auburn after five seasons as the head coach at James Madison. During his five-year stint at James Madison, Dean compiled a record of 237-56 (.809).

He amassed five 40-win seasons, including the final two campaigns with 52 and 50 victories, respectively. The Dukes broke 104 program records, including over 40 pitching records while boasting one of the nation's top staffs under Dean's guidance.

Prior to his reign in Harrisonburg, Va., Dean spent six seasons as the head coach at Radford where he took the Highlanders to their first-ever NCAA Tournament appearances in 2009 and 2010.

Before taking the position at Radford, Dean served as an assistant coach at Akron (2001-02), Indiana (2002-04) and Longwood (2005-06).

In addition to his collegiate coaching experience, Dean has also worked on the professional and international level.

He was the pitching coach for the Venezuelan National Team (2002-08) and the head coach for the Chicago Bandits (2004-10) that finished as the National Pro Fastpitch regular season champions five times and won the title in 2008.

Dean was named NPF Manager of the Year three times and coached world-renowned pitcher Jennie Finch, who was the NPF's Co-Pitcher of the Year in 2005 and has a gold and silver medal from her two Team USA Olympic appearances.

A 1987 graduate of Elon University, Dean was a pitcher on the baseball team where he was a four-year letterwinner.

Dean and his wife, Liz, have one son, Isaac, and one daughter, Caroline.
