» After a successful 2-0 start to SEC play, No. 9 Auburn returns home to host Florida in a Saturday primetime showdown on ESPN2. The Tigers are coming off an 81-66 road victory at South Carolina, where they shot a season-best 51.8 percent from the field (29-of-56).

» The No. 1 (8.1) and No. 2 (5.8) teams in blocked shots will go head-to-head as well as two of the league's top big men in Auburn's Walker Kessler (7-foot-1) and Florida's (6-foot-11) Colin Castleton. Kessler became the first-ever player in program history to earn a nod as USBWA and ESPN National Player of the Week. He garnered SEC Player of the Week honors on Monday and ranks third nationally in blocks per game (4.4), while Castleton is 34th (2.4).

» The Tigers have won 10 in a row, along with Davidson, and own the fourth-longest active win streak in the country behind defending national champion Baylor (20), USC (13) and Colorado State (11).

» Freshman phenom and projected NBA Lottery pick Jabari Smith was recently named to the John R. Wooden Award Midseason Top 25 List. He is on a 11-game double-digit scoring streak and the top 3-point marksman on the team, shooting 43.2 percent from beyond the arc this year (32 made treys).

» Auburn is churning on all cylinders on offense and defense. The Tigers, currently 31st in the nation in scoring offense (80.3 ppg), topped the 80-point mark for the seventh time this season at South Carolina. Meanwhile, they have held three of their last five opponents to under 60 points.

» Aside from leading the nation in blocked shots, AU also ranks No. 20 in field-goal percentage defense (38.0%), No. 19 in scoring margin (+16.0) and No. 19 in steals per game (9.8).

- Has advanced to postseason play in 20 of 26 years as a head coach. In 2019-20, had a second-place finish in the SEC with a 25-6 record, including 12-6 in league play, that would be 21 of 25 years in the postseason not been canceled due to COVID

- Set single-season wins records at four different schools (29 at Southern Indiana in 1995; 26 at Wisconsin-Milwaukee in 2005; 31 at Tennessee in 2008; 30 at Auburn in 2019)

- Pearl has achieved a top-5 national ranking at Southern Indiana, Tennessee and Auburn. He has been in the top five in 10 seasons (1994-2001 at Southern Indiana, 2007-08 at Tennessee, 2019-20 at Auburn)

- Bruce Pearl's teams have led their conference in scoring 17 of the 26 years that he has been a head coach. His squads were the SEC's scoring champion in four of his six seasons at Tennessee, averaging 77.4 ppg while allowing 70.5 ppg

- One of 12 coaches to lead three different DI programs to the Sweet 16, joining Rick Barnes, Gene Bartow, John Calipari, Lon Kruger, Frank McGuire, Ralph Miller, Rick Pitino, Bill Self, Tubby Smith, Eddie Sutton and Bruce Weber. Including his stint at DII Southern Indiana, Pearl is one of only three coaches to take four programs (with three at the DI level) to the Sweet 16, joining Lon Kruger and Eddie Sutton

- With the win over Kentucky that sent Auburn to its first Final Four in program history, Pearl notched his 100th win as head coach of the Tigers. He is the first coach in Auburn history to have 100 wins in his first five seasons

- Bruce Pearl is the 11th coach in SEC history to win four conference crowns (overall or division) in a 10-year span. He is on the same list as Adolph Rupp (UK), Babe McCarthy (MSU), Billy Donovan (UF), Dale Brown (LSU), Joe Hall (UK), John Calipari (UK), Nolan Richardson (ARK), Rick Pitino (UK), Rick Stansbury (MSU) and Tubby Smith (UK)

- Auburn sold out of season tickets for the seventh consecutive year in 2021-22 (excluding COVID restricted seating season of 2020-21), all under Pearl, to continue the school record streak. Prior to Pearl, the only other time the Tigers sold out of season tickets came was 1999-2000

- In 26 full years as a head coach, Bruce Pearl's teams have finished either first or second in conference play 17 times

- At the Division I level, Pearl's teams have topped the 100-point mark 22 times, including a high of 124 in 2009 as well as 121 in the 2007 NCAA Tournament. In his second year as a coach at Southern Indiana the team averaged 101.7 ppg

- In the past five seasons, Auburn has the best non-conference record in the SEC during the regular season at 53-7 (.883), while scheduling regular NCAA Tournament teams in Arizona, Davidson, Dayton, Duke, Iowa State, Middle Tennessee, Murray State, Oklahoma, Texas Tech, UConn and Xavier

- His teams have been just as successful off the court as Auburn has had 32 graduates in six years – the most in the SEC. In 2018, Auburn received an Academic Progress Rate Public Recognition Award marking the first time the Tigers have been honored since the award began tracking data in 2004. The NCAA annually honors teams earning multiyear Academic Progress Rates in the top 10 percent of all squads in each sport

- Auburn recently secured its fourth perfect APR score of 1,000 in mid-May, something that has never been accomplished in program history

- In the past five years, Auburn men's basketball has averaged an APR of 995 (out of 1,000). In the previous four seasons before Pearl and his staff arrived, Auburn's APR average score was 940

- Pearl started AUTLIVE at Auburn in 2015-16 to benefit cancer patients in the fight to beat cancer. AUTLIVE raises the awareness of cancer prevention and detection while t-shirt sales and donations raise money to benefit cancer patients. He initiated the OUTLIVE program in 2009 at Tennessee in recognition of former Vol Chris Lofton, who beat testicular cancer through early diagnosis and treatment and went on to play the entire 2007-08 season while recovering from his battle with the disease

- On Dec. 19, 2019, Children's Harbor in Birmingham, Ala. dedicated their on-site basketball court in honor of the charitable work done by Coach Pearl and the Pearl family over the last six years.

- Bruce Pearl has raised over \$1.2 million in only six golf tournaments at Auburn. Pearl and his wife, Brandy, have remarkably raised \$770,000 in the last three years benefitting Children's Harbor in Birmingham through the Bruce Pearl Fore the Children Golf Classic. The mission of Children's Harbor is to help children with serious illness and their families

- The Bruce Pearl Family Foundation in conjunction with L5 Foundation, an organization dedicated to addressing the essential and basic needs of cancer patients, donated \$20,000 to five charities in a ceremony in Knoxville in August 2015

- The Pearl family announced on Feb. 27, 2007, a \$100,000 donation to endow a scholarship in the name of former Tennessee player Dane Bradshaw. The Dane Bradshaw Athletic Scholarship Endowment is awarded to the male or female student-athlete at UT who best epitomizes the characteristics of the 2006-07 senior captain

A LOOK AT THE GATORS

» Florida has one of the oldest and most-experienced teams in the country with eight transfers including seven NCAA Division I and one JUCO.
 » The Gators, who reached the NCAA Second Round a year ago (lost to Oral Roberts), are also known for their defense and currently rank No. 25 in steals per game (9.5).
 » Like Auburn, their second-leading scorer is coming off the bench and a transfer – Phlandrous Fleming Jr. is averaging 10.9 points per game. He previously played at Charleston Southern.

INSIDE THE SERIES

» Auburn leads 89-82 in the all-time series with Florida.
 » However, the Gators have won the last two meetings in the series pulling off a rare 74-57 win at Auburn Arena on Feb. 23, 2020. They are 4-2 lifetime when playing in the Tigers' home venue.

WELCOME TO THE JUNGLE

» For the eighth-straight home game this season and 48th time in Auburn Arena (2010-Present) history, Saturday's game is sold out (9,121 capacity). A ticket to an Auburn Men's Basketball game is the toughest in town. Stubhub is Auburn Athletics' official secondary ticket market for fans looking to attend the game.
 » Auburn is a perfect 7-0 on its home court this season. The Tigers are one of 100 NCAA Division I schools, who remain undefeated at home. They will play three of their next five games in the friendly confines of Auburn Arena.

39 IN A ROW

» Auburn has won 39 consecutive non-conference games at Auburn Arena. It's last non-conference home loss was Jan. 20, 2016 vs. Oklahoma State (63-74). Bruce Pearl is 49-3 at Auburn in non-conference home games.

AUBURN'S CONSISTENT RISE TO THE TOP 10

» Auburn has been ranked in the Top 10 in four of the last five years under Head Coach Bruce Pearl. The Tigers were previously ranked in the Top 10 seven times during the 1958-59 (2nd), 1960-61 (9th), 1962-63 (9th), 1985-86 (10th), 1986-87 (5th), 1998-99 (2nd) and 1999-00 (2nd) campaigns.

» AU made a season-high tying 14 blocked shots versus LSU behind a career best 11 from Kessler. It tied as the most in the Bruce Pearl Era next to 14 at Georgia and versus Missouri during the 2020-21 season and against Yale this season.
 » It was three off from the school single-game record (17 vs. Nicholls State in 2011 – SEC record is 18).
 » One of the top shot blockers in the country, Walker Kessler has now tallied 61 stops this season. The school single-season record is 126 (48% of that record through 14 games).

Sophomore guard Wendell Green Jr. has had the hot hand in each of the last six contests for Auburn shooting 40 percent or better from the field in all but one of those games. Through the Tigers' first two SEC games, he is averaging a team-leading 18.6 points and 4.0 assists per game. Green Jr. poured in a team-and season-high 22 points at South Carolina to mark his 11th career 20-point outing.

» With an 10-player rotation, the Auburn bench has outscored its opponents' bench, 416-255, this season including 40-11 at South Carolina on Jan. 4 to ring in the New Year.
 » The Tiger reserves have accounted for 37 percent of the team's scoring output behind sixth man Wendell Green Jr. (12.7 ppg), Jaylin Williams (6.9 ppg), Chris Moore (3.1 ppg), Lior Berman (3.1 ppg) and Dylan Cardwell (2.6 ppg).

CLEANING THE GLASS

» Auburn grabbed a season-high 50 rebounds including 16 on the offensive end against North Alabama on Dec. 14. It was the second-most offensive boards in a single game this season behind 17 at USF on Nov. 19.
 » The Tigers are averaging 12.07 offensive rebounds per game which ranks in the Top 65 in NCAA Division I. Walker Kessler (30) and Dylan Cardwell (23) lead the team in that category.

AUBURN AS A RANKED TEAM

» Auburn enters 2021-22 ranked No. 22 in the preseason Associated Press Top 25 poll, marking the seventh time in school history it has appeared in the preseason poll. It is the third time in the Pearl Era, all in the last four years, that the Tigers have been ranked to begin the season.

» Under Bruce Pearl, the Tigers are 71-21 when ranked, including a 13-1 mark in 2021-22.

AUBURN VS. TOP-25 OPPONENTS

» Auburn is 73-218 against teams from the AP Top 25 all-time. Three years ago, the Tigers set a program record by defeating six top-25 teams, including five in a row from the SEC Tournament title to a trip to the Final Four.

BEST 5 YEAR RUN IN SCHOOL HISTORY

» Auburn won 112 games between 2016-17 and 2020-21, which is the best five-year win total in school history. The Tigers entered the 2021-22 season with 94 wins over the last four years, needing 19 wins this season to set the new mark.

FLANIGAN RETURNS TO LINEUP

» Auburn junior guard Allen Flanigan, the SEC's fourth leading returning scorer, had a successful procedure in early September to repair his right Achilles after suffering a non-basketball related trauma. He made a return to the lineup versus Murray State on Dec. 22 and started against No. 16 LSU on Dec. 29.

» He and his father, Wes, an alum and assistant coach for the Tigers, are one of 24 known father-son coach-player combos currently in NCAA Division I. The list also includes Dan and Andrew Hurley (UConn), Mike and Antoine Davis (Detroit Mercy), Penny and Jayden Hardaway (Memphis), Juwan and Jace Howard (Michigan), Tom and Steven Izzo (Michigan State) and Frank and Brandon Martin (South Carolina) to name a few notable father-sons.

PRESEASON HONORS AND WATCH LIST

» A pair of Tigers appear on some of the nation's top watch lists. Freshman Jabari Smith is a member of the John Wooden Preseason Top 50 Watch List which identifies 50 players for national player of the year and all-America honors. Smith also is on the Karl Malone Award Watch List which is presented each year to the country's top power forward. Sophomore center Walker Kessler is on the Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Award Watch List, given annually to the nation's top center.

» Allen Flanigan was named to the Coaches' Preseason All-SEC first team while Jabari Smith was named to the second team. Smith, the highest rated player ever signed at Auburn, was the only freshman to be voted on either team.

NABC TABS TIGERS FOR ACADEMICS

» The 2020-21 Auburn men's basketball team was named a recipient of the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) Team Academic Excellence Award. The award, created by the NABC Committee on Academics, recognizes outstanding academic achievement by a team with a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 or better. The Tigers earned the award for the first time since its inception in 2013 and were one of only two Southeastern Conference teams to garner recognition, in addition to Tennessee.

SEC IN STRETCH

» Babatunde "Stretch" Akingbola represented Auburn at this year's Southeastern Conference Basketball Leadership Council that was held in September. The council consisted of one male representative and one female representative from each of the SEC's 14 institutions. The goal of the leadership council is for student-athletes to serve as a conduit of communication from their teams to the conference office on issues related to student-athlete experience, student-athlete wellness, and to provide feedback on proposed rules governing the SEC and NCAA.
