STARTING XI

- » Auburn enters the SEC Tournament for the 26th time in program history, including the 21st straight season, which is tied for the longest active streak in the league.
- » The Tigers are 14-22-5 all-time at the SEC Tournament, including 12-17-4 under head coach Karen Hoppa and 10-15-4 since the tournament moved to Orange Beach in 2003.
- » Auburn and South Carolina met on one other occasion in the SEC Tournament with the Tigers advancing on penalty kicks, 5-3, in 2015.
- » With a win, Auburn would advance to its first SEC Tournament semifinal since 2016.
- » A win would also mark the Tigers first result against South Carolina since 2015.
- » Fifth-year defender Alyssa Malonson was named the SEC Defender of the Year and First Team All-SEC, becoming Auburn's fourth Player of the Year in program history and its first since Julie King was also named the Defender of the Year in 2011.
- » Sophomore Anna Haddock joined Malonson as a First Team All-SEC honoree and was the only sophomore to earn the distinction, while redshirt sophomore Marissa Arias tied for the league lead in conference goals and earned second-team accolades.
- » It marks the first time since 2017 Auburn has had multiple First Team All-SEC performers.
- » Haddock and Arias along with Sydney Richards have accounted for 22 of the team's 34 goals this season (65 percent), including 14 of the last 16.
- » Auburn's defense turned in five shutouts in SEC play, good for the most in the league. The Tigers turned in three straight shutouts from Oct. 1-17.





» Auburn Soccer Complex is in its 28th season as home of Auburn women's soccer. The Tigers have played there in all but one season (1993), when they played at Wilbur "Bodie" Hinton Field. Since moving to the facility, Auburn boasts a record of 179-67-21 (.710). The Auburn Soccer Complex seats 1,500. Located across the street from the Auburn Athletic Complex, the soccer stadium's natural turf playing surface is 120 yards long, by 78 yards wide.

STRONG STRETCH

- » Since falling to Arkansas in last year's SEC Tournament, Auburn is 17-6-2 (.720).
- » The Tigers have outscored opponents 50-19 during the stretch and have surrendered multiple goals on just four occasions while scoring multiple goals 14 times.

SUPER SOPHOMORES

- » Auburn has started at least six true or redshirt sophmores in every game this season, and at least one member of the group has scored in all but three contests.
- » The group has accounted for 21 goals (62%), 24 assists (62%) and 66 points (62%).

LEADING THE CHARGE

- » After leading all freshmen nationally with 10 assists a season ago, Haddock leads the team and ranks top 10 in the SEC in goals (nine), assists (seven) and points (25).
- » Haddock, who was the only sophomore named First Team All-SEC would enter the top 10 in single-season in goals and points with her next score.

ARIAS ON THE ATTACK

- » Redshirt-sophomore Marissa Arias was named Second Team All-SEC after ranking second on the team with seven goals and 16 points and tying for the SEC lead with five goals in league play.
- » All seven of Arias' goals and 15 of her 16 points came in a span of nine games from Sept. 9-Oct. 17.

D-TEAM

- » The Tigers defensive unit matched the program record for fewest goals allowed in a season in 2020-21 (15).
- » Dating back to the start of last spring, Auburn has allowed 19 goals in 25 contests good for a 0.74 goals against average.
- » The Tigers have turned in 12 shutouts during the span, including a league best five in SEC play, and have allowed multiple goals just five times, all against ranked opponents.

IRON WOMAN

- » Alyssa Malonson returned for her final season in an Auburn uniform after being selected by the N.C. Courage with the 20th pick of the 2021 NWSL Draft and became the fourth player in program history to earn conference Player of the Year honors, including the first since Julie King in 2011.
- » Malonson has started every game (94) since stepping foot on campus and is now the program record holder for games played, games started and consecutive games started.
- » With four assists this season, the fifthyear defender also ranks tied for eighth in program history with 23 career assists.

TALE OF TWO HALVES

- Just 12 of Auburn's 34 goals this season have come in the first half, including four of 15 goals in league play.
- » The Tigers are 11-2-1 when leading or tied at half and 0-3-0 when trailing at half.

PLAYER TO WATCH: ALYSSA MALONSON

>> Fifth-year defender Alyssa Malonson was named the SEC Defender of the Year and First Team All-SEC Sunday, becoming Auburn's fourth Player of the Year honoree in program history and the first since 2011. Malonson has started 94 straight games in her Auburn career and is the program record holder in games played, games started and consecutive games started.
