» QUICK HITTERS

- Auburn hit .368 and scored 28 runs on 39 hits in the three-game series vs. Alabama. All three totals were the highest in a series this season.
- The Tigers have collected 10+ hits in three straight games and 9+ hits in seven straight. The team is hitting .328 in those last seven games.
- Ryan Bliss was named the SEC Freshman of the Week after going 6-for-12 with five runs and four RBI against Alabama. Bliss leads the team with a .333 average since the beginning of April.
- Will Holland has turned in three hits in back-to-back games for the first time this season and second time in his career. He is 6-for-8 with five runs and five RBI in the last two contests.
- Conor Davis is riding a nine-game hitting streak and is hitting .395 (15-for-38) during the span.
- Carson Skipper is set to make his eighth start of the season Tuesday, including his fifth at Plainsman Park. He is 2-0 with a 2.45 ERA in his previous four home starts.
- A win Tuesday would mark Auburn's 30th this season. The Tigers haven't won 30+ games in three straight seasons since 2003-05.
- Auburn is looking to sweep UAB in the season series in back-to-back years. A win Tuesday would mark the Tigers 22nd in the last 23 contests against the Blazers.

Butch Thompson enters his fourth season at the helm of the program in 2019. Thompson, who spent three seasons as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Auburn from 2006-08, returned to the Plains after seven seasons at Mississippi State as both associate head coach and pitching coach.

Butch Thompson was named Auburn's head baseball coach on October 22, 2015 and enters his fourth season with the Tigers in 2019.

Thompson, who spent three seasons as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Auburn from 2006-08, returned to The Plains after seven seasons at Mississippi State as both associate head coach and pitching coach.

Widely regarded as one of the premier pitching coaches in the country, he has seen 14 of his former pitchers make their Major League Baseball debuts, including eight since 2014. Thompson has also turned 29 pitchers who went undrafted out of high school into MLB draft picks.

Thompson had three pitchers drafted in the first 11 rounds in 2014 and five pitchers drafted, including three in the top 10 rounds, in 2013. He added a first-round selection in the 2016 draft, a third-round pick in Keegan Thompson in 2017 and the first No. 1 overall pick in program history in Casey Mize in 2018.

Along with his pitching pedigree, Thompson is also considered one of the top recruiters in the country. Since 2003, he has secured 12 recruiting classes that were ranked in the top 10 by either Baseball America or Perfect Game, including the No. 5 signing class in 2017 and a program record No. 4 class in 2018. His classes signed from 2006-08 at Auburn each ranked in the top 18 nationally, including the No. 5 class in 2008.

A native of Amory, Miss., Thompson has coached 26 Division I All-Americans and 38 all-conference performers. He has made 16 postseason appearances, including seven trips to the College World Series, and guided Birmingham-Southern to a NAIA National Championship in 2001 and was a national runner-up at Mississippi State in 2013.

Thompson was named the 2006 Fellowship of Christian Athletes SEC Coach of the Year while at Auburn and the 2014 Baseball America and American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA) National Assistant Coach of the Year while at Mississippi State.

Thompson has already made his mark in his first three seasons at Auburn as he became the fourth head coach in program history to notch his 100th win in his third season at the helm. Thompson has guided the Tigers to a 103-82 overall record and has taken the team to back-to-back NCAA regionals for the first time in 15 years. After tying the 2010 team for the most wins (43) in a season since 1999 and advancing to its first super regional since that same season, Auburn's 2018 team finished the year ranked No. 9 by USA TODAY, marking the program's highest ranking to end a season since 1998.

In seven seasons at MSU, Thompson made four NCAA regional trips, two Super Regionals, won the SEC Tournament and advanced to the College World Series finishing as NCAA runner-up in 2013. In three of the last four seasons, the Bulldogs' staff ERA finished no higher than 3.06. Thompson's 2013 pitching staff was one of two nationally to finish in the top 15 in ERA, strikeouts per nine innings and hits allowed per nine innings.

In addition to his experience at Auburn and Mississippi State, Thompson also spent five seasons at Georgia from 2002-05, including a trip to the College World



Series in 2004. While there he guided the development of future Major Leaguers Josh Fields, Mitchell Boggs and Brooks Brown.

Thompson launched his coaching career as pitching coach and top assistant at Huntingdon College (Ala.) in 1993, before returning to his alma mater in Birmingham, where he helped lead the Panthers to back-to-back Southern States Conference championships and in 1995 coached BSC to its first NAIA World Series berth.

Thompson left BSC briefly to serve as head coach at Jefferson State Community College in Birmingham in 1997. While at JSCC, he was honored as the Regional Tournament Coach of the Year, the ABCA Alabama Junior College Coach of the Year and the Southeast Region Coach of the Year after guiding JSCC to a 39-21 mark, the AJCAA Region 22 State Championship and a third-place finish in the NJCAA Division II World Series.

He returned to Birmingham-Southern as top assistant the following season, beginning a four-year run during the most successful span in BSC baseball history. The Panthers won 196 games, four TranSouth Conference Championships and made three-consecutive appearances in the NAIA World Series. BSC's 2001 team posted a school-best 55-11 mark and captured the NAIA National Championship.

In 2002, Thompson joined the SEC baseball coaching fraternity as a pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at Georgia and has been a part of the league for the past 17 seasons.

Thompson currently serves as the large-school representative for the Alabama Baseball Coaches Association and is an All-American committee member representing the South region for the ABCA.

Thompson prepped at Amory (Miss.) High School and later starred as a pitcher at Itawamba (Miss.) Community College from 1989-90. On Oct. 25, 2014, Thompson was inducted into the ICC Athletic Hall of Fame.

SCOUTING THE BLAZERS

• UAB enters the week with a 22-26 overall record and are 8-16 in C-USA play.
 • The Blazers have won each of the last two conference series and five of the last seven games.
 • Offensively, UAB is hitting .279 as a team and are led by Paul Fullerton's .341 clip. Zack Davis has been the team's most consistent player and is hitting .337 with 14 doubles, six home runs and 39 RBI.
 • The Blazers rank sixth in the country with 118 stolen bases. Seventy-one of those stolen bases have come from two players in Jess Davis and Tyler Tolbert. Dava ranks second in the country with 42 stolen bases.

LEADING OFF

• Sophomore outfielder Judd Ward ranks second on the team with a .341 average in the last 10 games and leads the way with a .309 average in SEC play.
 • Ward has multiple hits in eight of the last 17 games, including a trio of three-hit efforts. He is hitting .362 (25-for-69) with 15 runs and seven doubles during the span.

HEATING UP

• Conor Davis is riding a nine-game hitting streak and is hitting .395 (15-for-38) during the span.
 • Will Holland is hitting .750 (6-for-8) with five runs and five RBI in the last two games.
 • Steven Williams is hitting .368 (7-for-19) in the last six games and hit his first home run since Mar. 24 Sunday.

BIG-HIT BLISS

• Ryan Bliss was named the SEC Freshman of the Week after going 6-for-12 with five runs and four RBI in the Alabama series, marking the first weekly honor from the conference of his career.
 • Bliss went 2-for-4 in all three games against the Crimson Tide and has multiple hits in four of the last five games.
 • He leads the team with a .333 average and ranks tied for second on the team with 14 runs and 15 RBI since the beginning of April.

CARPE DIEM

• Brody Moore made his first SEC start in the decisive game against Alabama Sunday and went 3-for-5 with two runs and a RBI.
 • He drove in the go-ahead run on a RBI single in the sixth inning to break a 3-3 tie against the Crimson Tide.
 • Moore, who tripled in his first career at-bat on Feb. 19, made his first career start vs. Jacksonville State on Apr. 9 and is 6-for-11 with five runs and three RBI since.
 • Moore is the son of Brandon Moore, who was a All-SEC shortstop for the Tigers (1991-94) and helped lead Auburn to the College World Series in 1994.

OFFENSIVE EXPLOSION

- Auburn's 17 runs in the series finale against Alabama were the most in a game this season, and the team's 19 hits were its second most.
- The Tigers hit .368 and scored 28 runs on 39 hits in the three-game series, marking the highest totals in all three categories in a series this season.
- The team put an exclamation point on the weekend by scoring nine runs on eight hits in the eighth inning Sunday. Both totals were the most in an inning this season.

HOME SWEET HOME

- Auburn is 20-7 at home this season and went on a 14-game home winning streak earlier this season, which was tied for the third longest in program history.
- Auburn went 29-6 in games played at Plainsman Park last season, marking the most home wins in a season since 1997 (30) and the second-most home wins all-time.
- The Tigers are 49-13 at home since the start of the 2018 season and 72-26 at home since 2017.
- The team has won 15 of the last 17 home series dating back to the regular season finale in 2017.

TAKING DOWN THE TIDE

- Auburn beat Alabama, 17-7, in the decisive series finale Sunday, marking the team's second straight series win against the Crimson Tide. It's the first time Auburn has beat Alabama in back-to-back series since 2003-04.
- Auburn's 17-run outburst in the series finale was the third time the team has scored 17 or more runs against Alabama in the last seven games. Prior to the last seven games against the Crimson Tide, Auburn had not scored 17 runs in any of the previous 107 games in the series.
- The Tigers have outscored the Alabama 72-25 in the last two series, and Auburn is hitting .374 in those six games.

LATE-INNING LEAD

- Auburn's loss in the middle game vs. Alabama marked the team's first when leading after eight innings this season.
- Auburn is 25-1 when leading after seven and 29-1 when leading after eight this season.
- The Tigers are 110-9 when ahead after seven and 128-7 when ahead after eight under head coach Butch Thompson.
- Conversely, Auburn is 1-13 when trailing after seven and 0-16 when trailing after eight this season. The Tigers are 8-75 and 2-81, respectively, under Coach Thompson.

RUN AT YOUR OWN RISK

- Judd Ward leads the SEC with six outfield assists this season, which is more than eight SEC teams have recorded.
- Four of Ward's six outfield assists have cut down a run at the plate, with all four coming in the seventh inning or later.

CONOR IN THE CLUTCH

- Conor Davis' walk-off hit in the series finale vs. Ole Miss marked the second of Davis' career. He also hit a walk-off three-run home run in the bottom of the ninth inning of a series-clinching win vs. South Carolina in 2017.
- Davis has four go-ahead hits this season. Along with the walk-off single, he hit a grand slam to break a 4-4 tie at UAB, a RBI double to break a 3-3 tie vs. Arkansas and a two-RBI single to break a 1-1 tie at Jacksonville State.

CANADIAN CRUSHER

- Edouard Julien leads the team with 44 RBI and is the first Auburn player since 2010-11 with 40 or more RBI in back-to-back seasons.
- Julien broke Frank Thomas' freshman RBI record and led the SEC and all freshmen nationally with 69 RBI a season ago.
- He drove in 101 runs in his first 94 games at Auburn, becoming the fifth fastest Auburn player to reach 100 RBI:

 2. Gabe Gross - 86 games
 3. Frank Thomas - 89 games
 4. Todd Faulkner - 90 games
 5. Edouard Julien - 94 games

JACK IS BACK

- Sophomore lefty Jack Owen improved to 4-0 this season after throwing 5.0 innings and allowing one run in the series opener vs. Alabama last Friday.
- Owen is 1-0 with a 1.86 ERA in three appearances since returning to the pitching staff after missing four weeks with shoulder tendinitis.
- The California native was named the SEC Pitcher of the Week after turning in a complete-game shutout vs. UTSA on Mar. 9.
- Owen didn't allow a run in 20.2 innings prior to his start vs. Tennessee and set the program record with 28.2 innings without allowing an earned run dating back to last season.

- Tanner Burns, who missed his first start in an Auburn uniform last weekend after making 28 straight starts to begin his career, was named to the Golden Spikes Award Midseason Watch List, marking the fourth straight season an Auburn player has earned the recognition - Anfernee Grier (2016), Keegan Thompson (2017), and Casey Mize (2017-18)
- He was also named to the Hall of Fame Foundation National Pitcher of the Year Award midseason watch list and a midseason All-American by D1 Baseball and Perfect Game.

HOMETOWN HERO

- Auburn High School product Brooks Fuller has made five straight SEC starts dating back to Saturday at South Carolina and ranks second on the team with a 3.77 ERA in conference play.
- Fuller handed Texas A&M its first shutout loss of the season with 6.0 scoreless innings on Apr. 13 and struck out a season-high six batters vs. Ole Miss the following weekend.

FINDING HIS ROLE

- Freshman lefty Garrett Wade has turned in a 3.24 ERA in seven relief appearances and hasn't allowed more than one run in any of his last four relief efforts, all which have come in conference play.

FITTS RIGHT IN

- Richard Fitts is 3-0 with a 2.82 ERA in 10 relief appearances this season, including 2-0 with a 0.00 ERA in his last three relief appearances.

FIRST IMPRESSIONS

- Devin Warner made his first career start at Jacksonville State last Tuesday and went 3-for-4 with a run scored and three RBI.

BULL MENTALITY

- Cody Greenhill leads the team and ranks fifth in the SEC with nine saves, which are the most by an Auburn player since 2013.
- Five of Greenhill's nine saves have come on the road, including four in SEC road games, and he ranks second in the conference with seven saves in league games.

SHUTTING 'EM OUT

- Auburn ranks second in the country with seven shutouts this season.
- The Tigers seven shutouts are already two more than last season and are tied for the fifth most in a single-season in program history. The single-season record is nine in 1988.
- The Tigers didn't allow a run in 33.1 innings from Mar. 6-9, marking a program record in the category.

PUTTING 'EM IN MOTION

- Auburn has stolen 56-of-67 bases this season, which is already six more than the team's total in 66 games last year.
- The Tigers stole 26 straight bases from Feb. 19-Mar. 17, marking the longest streak of successful stolen bases since stealing 32 straight bases in 2002.
- The team's six stolen bases in the series finale vs. Tennessee were the most in a game since 2016, and the 11 stolen bases in the series were the most in a series in the Stat Crew era (1993). They were also the most in a three-game span since 2012.

- With eight games left in the regular season, including five games at Plainsman Park, Auburn is positioned to make its third straight NCAA Tournament appearance for the first time since 2001-03.
- The Tigers enter the week ranked No. 15 in the RPI with the No. 2 strength of schedule.
- Auburn was an out away from advancing to a super regional in 2017 and a run away from making it back to Omaha for the first time since 1994 a season ago.

PACKED HOUSE

- Auburn sold a record number of season tickets in 2019 (2,163), which surpassed its previous record of 1,991 tickets sold a season ago.
- The Tigers have welcomed 89,714 fans through the gates of Plainsman Park this season, which ranks 15th in the country.
- The team's average attendance of 3,323 is good for 16th in the nation.

BIG LEAGUE TIGERS

- In 2018, former Auburn pitcher Trey Wingenter became the 51st player in Auburn history to appear in the Major Leagues. He made his MLB debut for the San Diego Padres on Aug. 7, 2018.
- Wingenter is one of three former Tigers to open the 2019 season on a big league roster, joining Josh Donaldson (Braves) and Garrett Cooper (Marlins). Grant Dayton is also on the Braves' 40-man roster but is currently inactive.

TIGERS IN THE DRAFT

- Auburn had seven players selected in the 2018 MLB Draft, including the program's first No. 1 overall draft pick in Casey Mize.
- The seven players drafted were the most in a season since 2010 (11) and tied for the second most in program history.
- The Tigers have had multiple players drafted every year since 2006 and at least one player selected for 44 straight years, which is tied for the longest streak in the SEC.
