Opening statement...

“First off, like to say, congratulations to the Oregon Ducks. After you play a team, you get a really good judge of how good they are. That’s a very good football team that we beat. I think they will win a lot of games. I really want to thank our fans. I know a lot of them had plane issues and everything, and it was ugly at times and they hung in there with us. And they were a big factor. Really appreciate our fans. If you look at the game, we got off to a tough start. You got to give them credit. I think they had really good schemes early, made some big plays, offensively, defensively and special teams. At halftime we came in, we made some adjustments. We really just talked about we need to win the line of scrimmage. Our defense did a super job holding them just a few yards rushing in the second half. I felt like we were able to lean on them some in the second half, running the football.

“Bottom line is we didn't play our best. They're a really good team. We got a lot of things that we can work on, that we can improve. You know, you look at really the key plays of the game, I think in the fourth quarter when they had fourth and about a foot and our defense stopped them. And then, of course, the fourth down and 3 where we were running a little naked seal and Bo [Nix] got outside, and he found a way to get the first down just by a little bit. I thought that was big. Then, of course, we hit Seth [Williams] there. We got in field goal range and we could kind of catch our breath. We didn't have a timeout, so there was a little bit of stress that went with that. We just really wanted to give Seth one chance, you know, to have a 50/50 ball. And Bo underthrew it just a little bit and Seth tipped it to himself and made a big-time play. It was a really good win. Our locker room is really excited. I’m real proud of those guys. We found a way to win, especially when we didn't play our best. But you've got to give Oregon a lot of credit for that.”

On Bo Nix...

“He has some savviness to him, there's no doubt. Of course, when the game is on the line, you got to make plays and that's the one thing he showed. In all fairness, it was his first start. He went against one of the better teams in the country. In this kind of environment, he did some really good things. But when the game is on the line, he found a way to win the game. And I think that was real special for his first start.”

On the defense after the first quarter...

“We made some adjustments. They were hitting us with some little outside zones and they creased us a couple of times. Their quarterback is a really good player. They had a really good scheme and at halftime our defense made adjustments. The big thing was stopping the run. I think they only had a handful of yards in the second half, and that was really a good thing for us. Of course, we were able to get the ball a few more times on offense, too, in the second half.”

On the shift in the second half...

"We talked about we need to win the line of scrimmage. We need to try to turn this game into a line of scrimmage game. And I think in the second half we were able to do that. That helped us win the game. And that was real important up front. And I thought our offensive line did a good job, too. They were presenting a lot of different looks, showing some things they hadn't showed. They were playing Okie, and they were moving a lot, and they were mixing things up. Hats off to their coaches. I think they had a really good plan."

On the offensive line...

"We've got a senior offensive line. They told me at halftime, 'Coach, let's run the football. Let's try to run over them. We're ready.' Literally that was our mind set. We felt like we needed to. We had a couple of turnovers. That turnover in the red zone – we got down to the 3-yard line, I called a bad play on first down and we ended up having to kick a field goal. Really proud of our offensive line and really Boobie (JaTarvious) Whitlow. He ran hard inside. He had a really good night running the football against a good defense."

On what he said to Bo Nix before the game...

"I told him before the game, 'Hey, man, there's going to be mistakes out there. You just keep plugging, man, don't flinch. Just keep battling.' And that's what he did. He didn't get down. He's a real positive guy. And he's positive with his teammates. He was positive with me. And I think that's a really good sign."

On the decision to take a shot at a touchdown at the end of the game...

"I felt like we were in field goal range. But at the same time, I just felt like we had a good chance 50/50 ball. And we talked about that in the game scenarios, 'Hey, if he's open, give him a chance where he can catch it. If not, throw it out of the end zone.' It took the stress of having the field goal team go out there. And I kind of liked it (laughter)."

On where this game ranks for him...

"I tell you what, our players were about as excited as I have seen them in a long time. Our fans were just off the charts. Like I said, it was ugly at times. Our fans just hung in there and just really showed that Auburn spirit and that Auburn toughness. Our guys found a way to win. And it was just a great atmosphere. It was a big time win for us to get us off to a 1-0 start against one of the top teams in the country. I think that will give us momentum now. At the same time, the good thing is we won. There were a lot of things we've got to correct. I think everybody saw that. In all three phases, we've got to clean some things up and we'll do that. But it really is good to be 1-0 against that team."

Bo Nix, QB, Fr.

On if the game was his first "Patrick Nix to Frank Sanders" moment...

"Well, everybody keeps comparing different passes to it. But I think that was my first 'Bo to Seth' moment, and that was just the first moment that we were able to come through. And we were able to do something for our team that we had struggled to do all day. Me and Seth [Williams] hadn't completed many passes. That might have been the second on that drive. But like I said, it was just a huge moment for Auburn, and I was grateful and glad to be a part of it. It was a huge win."

On his mindset in the final drive...

"I knew that we had to get in field goal range. I knew we had to get to the 35-yard line. But, the offense, we were moving at that point. We struggled in the first half. The second half we started to run the ball really well. Finally, it came down to a two-minute drill. And we had to throw the ball just a little bit. There for a second, it looked like we were running out of time. We just stayed calm and we protected well, and we made a huge fourth-down conversion there at the point and completed that out route to Seth. We just finished it off."

On if the comeback win was a dream come true...

"Absolutely. I would have never thought the game would have ended like that, to be honest, especially the first one. We would not have been in the situation had not the defense played out of their minds in the second half. After the first quarter, they gave up seven points and that's a huge defensive stand for any team. So we just really had all the momentum in the second half. They had a huge fourth down stop and we started moving the ball. We got the ball back with two minutes. Finally, it was our turn to make a play and thankfully we did it."

On his nerves before the game...

"It's a tough situation. It's a tough environment. That stadium is huge. Obviously, it's the biggest I have ever played in. And your first game with a new team, you are playing against a great team. You are playing against a great quarterback. So I was just excited. I was excited to play. I was ready to play. I started off a little slow. But my teammates had my back like they told me they would. And sure enough, we finished it out."

On what he saw on the fourth down play...

"I saw a whole bunch of white jerseys (laughter). And everybody I felt like was covered. And it just hit me that I guess I better run for it. I don't know, I just got it. So I was thankful. And everything passed off and I just ran and got it."

On the struggles in the first half...

"I think it was a combination of things. We were moving the ball successfully. We just kept getting in our own way. We had some penalties. I turned the ball over. Certain plays weren't working like we had hoped. We just kept the pedal to the metal, and we just kept doing on what we do. At the end of the day we ran the ball and we ran the ball pretty successfully. Once we found out, Coach Malzahn just decided we're going to run the ball. And we did that in the second half. We went down the field and scored. And then we kind of got our mojo back, and we started real competing. We started really were playing. We got excited on the sideline and the momentum started going towards us. And I think that helped the defense a lot. They really took a stand."

On what he said to the offense before the final drive...

"Right. So the second half, we came in here, we knew we had to make some adjustments. And never did we doubt each other. Never did we start pointing fingers. That's when it kind of hit me that we have a really good chance of coming back because it's not anybody's fault. We have a great mindset. We were down. We knew what we had to do. We had to go out there and do it. We had a great leadership up front. Five seniors and they really put it together, and they just started blocking people and really getting after it. And so we just started running the ball. And everything worked in our favor there in the second half. But when they looked at me and they knew they needed a spark, I looked at them and knew I needed a spark. We went together and we moved the ball down the field and we scored a touchdown."

On the defense in the second half vs. the first half...

"All credit to Oregon, they jumped out on us early and put in a lot of things. We knew they weren't going to come out with the eye candy, but knowing and stopping it are two different things. We just were able to get it settled down in the second quarter and just kind of continued on from there and played Auburn defense. We've got to go back to the drawing board and get back to work though."

On the nerves in the final moments for the offense...

"If it's easy, it ain't for Auburn. That will always be the case."

On the fumble return...

"I saw it and I scooped and tried to score with it. But when I got down to the two- or three-yard line, I thought, 'There ain't nobody behind me.' So that's why I slowed down. I just know I saw somebody to the right of me, and I'm like, 'I'm in now' and he just came from behind me. I get in at halftime and everybody was blowing my phone up telling me, 'You ran out of gas!' Then the team gave me a hard time about it, but everybody was happy for me."

On what Auburn did better in the second half on defense...

"We kind of just shut it down and played Auburn football. That's what it all came down to."

On the offense pulling out the win...

"I love Bo [Nix]. I told him that before the game. He's meant to be here. I had no doubt in him."

On the Cam Newton-like touchdown...

"[Coach Malzahn] always says when we watch film, 'I'm breaking this play out of the archives.' I think he's referring to Cam because Cam ran the play. I like the play, obviously."

On what the win means...

"It's big for our university and it's big for our program. It's big to me. It means a lot to help this team in any way that I can. To contribute and when my opportunity comes, I'm here."

On the last drive...

"We did a good job of staying calm in that situation we were in. That was his (Bo Nix) first time being in that type of situation and he did a really good job."

On staying positive despite first-half struggles...

"We knew that we were going to come back. We never stopped believing and we had it in our minds that we were going to come back."

On when he felt like his old self again...

"I think it was the play at the two-yard line. I made somebody miss and I felt like I was back to myself, taking all the hits again. Nothing is hurting right now, so that's when I felt like myself again."

JaTarvious Whitlow, RB, So.

On his thoughts when Bo Nix kept the ball on fourth down...

"When I saw him run and saw him scrambling, I thought he was going to throw the ball to me, so I'm like 'right here.' And then I saw him stick those feet into the ground and cut up and I was like, 'you better get it. [laughs] You better get it man!"

On what it says about a freshman QB to make that play...

"That tells me a lot. Coming into the game, I was like, 'I hope Bo [Nix] doesn't let this big game atmosphere get to him.' And when he came in and did that in a big game like this, it tells a lot. He really loves the game. He really loves Auburn. Most quarterbacks go in there and freeze up. Not him. He put his head down and got the extra three yards we needed to get on the big fourth down to win the game."

Oregon Head Coach Mario Cristobal

Opening Statement...

"We're certainly grateful for the opportunity to be on such a big stage on this national spotlight and proud of the effort, the toughness, the resiliency of our guys. Certainly like to have a few things back. And a tough one, a real tough one. Real tough moments in that locker room right now. But, at the same time, a tremendous amount of guys that are encouraged about the potential of our football team, the caliber of team that we can be. And, you know, we landed. It's time to get on to business and get ready for next week."

On the situations with two called timeouts, Justin Herbert injury and fourth down play...

"The wrong personnel was in. And when we got the personnel straightened out, they weren't quite sure as to who was going to do what. But we don't blame them. We take it as a coaching staff. That's on us. We had a few guys that obviously were down for the game, and then a couple guys that had cramped up during the game. So we were trying to make the pieces work for a certain play. And I'd rather be safe than sorry in that situation and use the timeout and give us a chance to run it. But it didn't work out."

On the defensive effort...

"I thought they did a great job all night. I think we had our chance in the red zone, as they did as well. You know, we had a chance to score a touchdown. But, you know, if a guy drops a ball, I say we have to coach it better. If we miss a field goal, I say we have to coach the field goal kicker better. So you're never going to see me up here pointing fingers. We didn't capitalize in the red zone. We stopped them in the red zone as well. But, overall, I thought the defense played with a lot of energy and made a lot of great plays."

On if the team lost it's running mentality...

"I thought we were moving along pretty well in the first half. A lot of those plays are RPOs. So if they're designed runs with tags on them, so if they are playing a certain coverage or if we are outnumbered, the ball is going to come out. But it wasn't a matter of the run not being called. It was the defensive look dictated the ball being spit out there. So it ends up being more plays in the pass call than the run call."

On not draining the clock on offense...

"Well, we tried to get the play in at about 17, being that we'd snapped the ball around 5, 6. But we also felt that we were going to have to score, and we felt like we had to get in a rhythm. We didn't feel that it would be a matter of taking the air out of the clock, or the air out of the ball, I should say. We felt we were going to have to take a risk."

On the fumble in the red zone...

"Miscue right there. The mesh between the quarterback and the running back got too tight. They bumped into each other, and the ball came out."

On taking deep shots...

"We tried to take some more. We got in six- and seven-man protection. We tried to take some shots that were covered. Justin [Hebert] took off with a couple, also got sacked on a couple. Checked the ball down once as well. So we were trying to take some deep shots. They were playing a lot of man coverage, and you have to when they do so, right? Because you're outnumbered, which is also part of the reason where the passing numbers get a little bit skewed with the run numbers, because, in the RPO game, sometimes those balls have to be spit out there."

On the national perception and not letting the loss turn into more...

"A couple of things. I think our guys all recognize our goals are still in front of us. Number two, I think we all recognize Nevada is a really good football team. And the third thing is our guys - we have a really good group of leaders, and our program is built from the inside out. We don't hocus pocus it. We don't build it on a poor foundation. We build it on the right stuff. So when situations like this hit, that you're prepared to bounce back and move forward."

Troy Dye, LB, Sr.

On what to do after a loss like this one...

"You just have to get back. You have to rely on your leaders. Work on your craft. You have to get back to what you work on. You have to do what you do. You watched this game. You saw what happened. We just have to get better."

On the performance of the defense...

"We played our (expletive) off and played balls to the wall. We did what we needed to do for 60 minutes. Like I said earlier in the week, if we did that, hopefully we came out with a W. We had that output but it didn't work out that way. We have to play harder next time and turn those turnovers into touchdowns."

On not letting the loss turn into another one...

"You definitely can't let a loss like this beat you twice. You just have to bounce back. Hopefully, we can bounce back this week and get better. They (Nevada) is a tough team. We have to bounce back. They are riding really high. We have to put this behind us. They don't care about how we feel. They don't care about our loss. They are going to want to play as hard as they can, and we have to do that as well."

On the missed opportunities...

"We had a lot of opportunities to execute and we didn't do what we wanted to do, and we kind of shot ourselves in the foot a couple times. But I thought the defense played really well, and I know what type of team we have going forward."

On the difference from first quarter to the rest of the game...

"We just didn't execute. I think first quarter we came out fired up and excited but unfortunately, we didn't play as well in those last three quarters."

On the fumble in the red zone...

"I dropped it, and someone picked it up and we tried our best to get back and our defense ended up making a stop in the red zone."

On the difference fromt the first quarter to the rest of the game...

“I think it comes back to those details that, you know, if there’s one thing in the play that’s a miscue, then the play is not going to be effective. So again, correcting those little mistakes and making sure we’re on point for next week.”

On the feeling in the locker room...

“We know that this doesn’t define our season but even though it’s the first game, and it’s kind of a gut check, we know what kind of team we can be and we saw the flashes in the game. So, it’s all about just coming together and staying together and making sure that we’re on point.”

On the 9-month build-up to the game being over...

“I think obviously we’re disappointed with the outcome, but I know we’re going to come back even stronger next week and for the rest of the season. I know that’s the kind of team we are and so I’m excited to see where we can continue to build and develop.”
