### » QUICK HITTERS

- Auburn has won eight-straight games, its longest winning streak since taking 11 in a row in 2009.
- The Tigers have opened the season with five straight series wins for first time since 2007.
- Auburn won its first road game of the season 7-4 at Georgia Tech on Tuesday after 22 at home.
- Auburn hitters have totaled 15 doubles over the last four games
- Will Holland was named SEC Freshman of the Week after batting .400 with 2 XHB, 4 RBI.
- Auburn has turned 13 double plays in the last nine games and leads the SEC with 23 on the year.
- The Tigers are the second toughest team to strikeout in the SEC with only 121 total.
- The Auburn bullpen holds a 1.35 ERA and .193 BAA in 33.1 IP over the last eight games.
- Jay Estes (.406, 7 RBI) & Conor Davis (.375, 6 RBI) are AU's top hitters over the last 10 gms (9-1).
- Auburn's 4-0 win over UAB last Tuesday gave the Tigers their NCAA-leading seventh shutout.
- Senior Blake Logan has been behind the plate for five of Auburn's seven shutouts.
- Auburn has out-scored its opponents 69-13 in the fourth and fifth innings combined this season, 25-2 in the fourth and 44-11 in the fifth. AU has scored 4+ in the 4th or 5th six times.

**Butch Thompson was named Auburn's head baseball coach by Auburn Director of Athletics Jay Jacobs on October 22, 2015. Thompson, who spent three seasons as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Auburn from 2006-08, returned to the Plains after seven seasons at Mississippi State as both associate head coach and pitching coach.**

Thompson was named the 2014 Baseball America and American Baseball Coaches Association National Assistant Coach of the Year while at Mississippi State.

Widely regarded as one of the premier pitching coaches in the country, he has had six of his former pitchers make Major League debuts since 2014 including Grant Dayton, Kendall Graveman, Jacob Lindgren, Chris Stratton, Jonathan Holder and Chad Girodo.

In 24 years of coaching at the collegiate level, including 14 in the Southeastern Conference, Thompson has coached seven College World Series participants, including one national champion and a national runner-up, won nine conference championships and made 14 postseason appearances. He has also served as an assistant under three National Coach of the Year recipients.

In seven seasons at MSU, Thompson made four NCAA regional trips, two Super Regionals, won the SEC Tournament and advanced to the College World Series finishing as NCAA runner-up in 2013. In three of the last four seasons, the Bulldogs' staff ERA finished no higher than 3.06. Thompson's 2013 pitching staff was one of two nationally to finish in the top 15 in ERA, strikeouts per nine innings and hits allowed per nine innings.

Thompson is considered one of the top recruiters in the country. Since 2003, he has secured nine recruiting classes that were ranked in the top 10 by either Baseball America or Perfect Game. His classes signed from 2006-08 at Auburn each ranked in the top 18 nationally including the No. 5 class nationally in 2008 which included All-American and SEC Player of the Year Hunter Morris.

Player development has been equally important for Thompson, who has turned 24 student-athletes who went undrafted out of high school into Major League Baseball draft picks.

A native of Amory, Miss., Thompson has coached 24 Division I All-Americans and 30 all-conference honors. Twelve pitchers tutored by Thompson have gone on to pitch in the big leagues.

Thompson had three pitchers drafted in the first 11 rounds of the 2014 MLB Draft, and in 2013 five of his pitchers were drafted including three in the top 10 rounds. He added a first round selection in the 2016 draft.

In addition to his experience at Auburn and Mississippi State, Thompson also spent five seasons at Georgia from 2002-05, including a trip to the College World Series in 2004. While there he guided the development of future Major Leaguers Josh Fields, Mitchell Boggs and Brooks Brown.

Thompson launched his coaching career as pitching coach and top assistant at Huntingdon College (Ala.) in 1993, before returning to his alma mater in Birmingham, where he helped lead the Panthers to back-to-back Southern States Conference championships and in 1995 coached BSC to its first NAIA World Series berth.

Thompson left BSC briefly to serve as head coach at Jefferson State Community College in Birmingham in 1997. While at JSCC, he was honored as the Regional Tournament Coach of the Year, the ABCA Alabama Junior College Coach of the Year and the Southeast Region Coach of the Year after guiding JSCC to a 39-21 mark, the AJCAA Region 22 State Championship and a third-place finish in the NJCAA Division II World Series.



He returned to Birmingham-Southern as top assistant the following season, beginning a four-year run during the most successful span in BSC baseball history. The Panthers won 196 games and four TranSouth Conference championships and made three-consecutive appearances in the NAIA World Series. BSC's 2001 team posted a school-best 55-11 mark and captured the NAIA National Championship.

In 2002, Thompson joined the SEC baseball coaching fraternity, beginning a four-year term as pitching coach and recruiting coordinator in Athens. Georgia's 2003 recruiting class was ranked 10th nationally, while capturing the SEC title in 2004 en route to advancing to the NCAA College World Series.

Thompson, honored as the 2006 Fellowship of Christian Athletes SEC Coach of the Year, has shared his expertise as a featured speaker at numerous baseball coaching clinics throughout the United States.

He earned a bachelor's degree in history at BSC in 1992 and completed a master's degree in sports administration at UAB in 1996. He is married to the former Robin Ashe of Birmingham, Ala., and they are the parents of three daughters --- Anna, Olivia and Madelyn Gail.

**UP NEXT**

- Auburn squares off with rival Alabama in the 2017 Capital City Classic at Montgomery's Riverwalk Stadium. The Tigers are 7-1 all-time in the event including a 10-1 victory in 2016.
- Alabama is 11-10 on the year and travels to No. 7 South Carolina this weekend after being swept by Mizzou to open SEC play.
- Chandler Avant is leading the Crimson Tide at the plate with a .349 average and six RBI. Cobie Vance is hitting .346 and has drive in 17. On the mound, Alabama holds a 3.35 staff ERA.

**SCOUTING THE OPPOSITION**

- Georgia and head coach Scott Stricklin are 9-13 on the season including 0-3 in SEC play after being swept at LSU last week. The Bulldogs picked up a 9-6 win over Kennesaw State on Tuesday.
- UGA is hitting .269 as a team led by slugging catcher Michael Curry with five homers and 25 RBI with a .298 average. Junior outfielder Keegan McGovern leads the team with a .348 average. Freshman shortstop Cam Shepherd is hitting .308 with one homer and 10 RBI.
- Georgia has struggled on the mound with a 5.56 staff ERA - which ranks last in the SEC. The brign spot on the weekend has been Sunday starter RHP Chase Adkins with a 3-1 record and 2.97 ERA. UGA has walked 98, which is second most in the SEC.
- The defense hasn't helped Georgia much either with a SEC-leading 41 errors (.951 fielding percentage).
- In a rivalry that dates back to 1896, Auburn has won the last two series including a sweep at Plainsman Park in 2015 and four of the last five series. The Tigers have won 10 of the last 15 games.
- The Tigers have six players from Georgia on their roster including five from metro Atlanta.

**PAIR OF ACES**

- Auburn right-handers Keegan Thompson and Casey Mize have established themselves as one of the top 1-2 punches not only in the SEC, but in the country.
- The pair owns a combined record of 7-0 and an ERA of 0.56. The duo has allowed only 40 hits in 64.1 innings pitched.
- The Tigers are the only team in the country with two pitchers ranked in the top 13 in ERA where Mize (0.30) is 8th and Thompson (0.78) is 13th.
- Mize ranks eighth nationally and second in the SEC in K per 9 innings with 13.96. His strikeout-to-walk ratio is 22nd in NCAA/2nd in SEC at 9.20.
- Thompson is third in SEC with 4.67 hits/nine innings. The duo has walked only 12 combined this season.

**DOUBLE PLAY DANDIES**

- Auburn leads the SEC with 23 double plays recorded in its first 23 games this season. The total ranks 13th nationally.
- The Tigers have turned 13 double plays in the last nine games which is more than four teams in the SEC have all season.
- Auburn produced four double plays against Presbyterian on March 10 which was the most for the program since 2014.
- From 2013-15, Butch Thompson guided Mississippi State to an NCAA best 201 double plays. Auburn recorded 46 double plays during Thompson's first season in 2016.

**HOLLAND EARNS SEC FRESHMAN HONOR**

- Freshman infielder Will Holland was named SEC Freshman of the Week on March 20 after batting .400 (6-for-15) with three runs, one triple, one homer and four RBI during Auburn's 5-0 week and three-game sweep of Florida.
- Holland homered, tripled and scored three times with four RBI on the week and was perfect in the field with 13 assists and part of six double plays.
- He hit a key 2-run homer in the Friday win over Florida and his bunt in ninth inning Sunday set the stage for walk-off win.
- With four RBI on Friday, he became the first Auburn freshman with 4+ RBI in a game since Blake Logan in 2014 and the first rookie with 4+ in a SEC game since Brian Fletcher in 2008.

**FLORIDA SWEEP NOTABLES**

- Auburn's three-game sweep of then No. 5 Florida checked several boxes for the Tigers. Not only was it the first sweep of the Gators since 1987 and just the second ever in the long history of both programs, it was Auburn's first series win over a top 5 team since taking down LSU in 2015.

- It was Auburn's first sweep in a SEC opening series since 2010 and first sweep of a top 6 team since taking all three games with No. 6 Tennessee at Plainsman Park in 2001.
- Auburn has started 3-0 in SEC play five times (1980, 1986, 1995, 2010), but has never started 4-0.

**SHUTOUT SUCCESS IN 17**

- Auburn posted its NCAA-best seventh shutout in 18 games with a 4-0 win over UAB on March 14. The Tigers have recorded nearly twice the amount of strikeouts in 2017 than the four from 2016.
- The seven shutouts are the most since Auburn had eight in 2015, 1989 & 1976. The Tigers had nine shutouts in 1988.
- Senior catcher Blake Logan has been behind the plate for five of the seven shutouts. Senior Damon Haecker has caught the other two. Logan has caught all or part of 16 shutouts in his college career.
- As part of the seven shutouts, the Auburn staff has held opponents scoreless in back-to-back games three times.
- The Tigers have held an opponent with out an earned run twice in a series three times through four weeks in 2017.
- Auburn recorded five shutouts in its first nine games, surpassing the team's 2016 total and the most in the first nine games since 1976.
- The Auburn pitching staff posted consecutive shutouts to open a season for the first time since 1928.

**SCORELESS STREAK CEMENTS RECORD BOOK SPOT**

- Keegan Thompson established his spot in the Auburn record books once again in his start vs. Presbyterian. The junior tossed two scoreless to start the game and 3.1 without an allowing an earned run. Those efforts extended his streaks to 23.2 clean to open a season and 24.1 before allowing an earned run.
- Thompson cruised through seven scoreless innings vs. Lipscomb extending his scoreless innings streak to open the season out to 21.0 - the best by a Tiger since 2007 and the longest with no runs allowed since 1976.

**KT DOMINATION LEADS TO SEC HONOR**

- Keegan Thompson impressed for the third straight start with his 7-inning, 1-hit shutout of Lipscomb. Thompson struck out five and retired 12 straight before exiting following the seventh with 90 pitches thrown.
- For his success, Thompson was honored as the SEC Pitcher of the Week for the second time in his career.

**EARLY PITCHING SUPERLATIVES**

- The trio of weekend starters: Keegan Thompson, Casey Mize and Davis Daniel had a combined 1.12 ERA, 4-0 record with 34 strikeouts and only three walks through two weekends.
- AU pitchers allowed only 18 BB in the first 8 games, the 2nd fewest in the SEC.
- Tiger pitchers Casey Mize and Cole Lipscomb combined for 16 strikeouts in the Saturday win over Holy Cross - the most for Auburn since the trio of Cole Nelson, Bradley Hendrix and Garrett Bush combined for 16 strikeouts against Florida Atlantic in 2010.

**RECORD COMEBACK IN MIDWEEK OPENER**

- Auburn got behind early on 2/22 vs. Florida A&M trailing 7-0 after four innings, but the Tigers didn't lost heart. Auburn rallied to win 12-8 posting the biggest come-from-behind win for the program since tackling Jacksonville State 12-8 after falling behind 8-0 on 5/7/2013.
- It was the largest deficit overcome by the Tigers at Plainsman Park since they out-slugged Mississippi State 16-14 after trailing 9-0 on May 8, 2010.

**ON THE HOME FRONT**

- Auburn opened the 2017 season with 22 games at home, the most for the Tigers in program history. Auburn plays 36 total games at home in 2017.
- Twenty-two games at home breaks the previous mark of 15 straight to open a season from 2003 (12-3) and 2004 (14-1).
- Auburn finished the season-opening homestand 17-5. The Tigers won their first road game of the season 7-4 at Georgia Tech on March 21.

**DEGREE IN HAND**

- Four members of the Auburn roster already hold their college degrees. Outfielders Bo Decker and Sam Gillikin and pitchers Cole Lipscomb and Kevin Davis have all earned their degrees. Decker, Lipscomb and Davis are each currently pursuing a second undergraduate degree and Gillikin is working towards an MBA in the Harbert College of Business.






