#### Series History || Auburn Leads 4-0 || Last Meeting: AU 77, SLU 65 (12/31/08 in Auburn, Ala.)

» Tipoff on The Plains is here as Auburn (0-1) faces Southeastern Louisiana (1-0) in its home opener on Friday at Neville Arena.

» The Tigers look to bounce back after opening the 118th season of basketball with a hardfought 88-82 loss versus No. 17-ranked Baylor on Nov. 7 in Sioux Falls, S.D.

» This is head coach Bruce Pearl's first game against Southeastern Louisiana in his 29-year coaching career. Auburn is 9-0 in home openers under Pearl.

» The Tigers have won 45-consecutive non-conference home games at Neville Arena including a 7-0 mark with wins over George Mason, USF, Winthrop, Texas Southern, Saint Louis, Colgate and Georgia State in 2022-23.

» Auburn has sold out season tickets every year in the Bruce Pearl Era (10-straight seasons).

» In its last outing, Auburn's defense turned 15 Baylor turnovers into 16 points.

» Preseason All-SEC First Team selection Johni Broome is the team's top returning scorer (14.2 ppg), rebounder (8.4 rpg) and shot blocker (2.4 bpg). He is one of the top returning players in the country and in the SEC. This summer, Broome was invited to the NBA Elite Camp in Chicago and later elevated himself into the NBA Draft Combine.

#### SOUTHEASTERN LOUISIANA AT-A-GLANCE

» Southeastern Louisiana is one of two non-conference opponents on the Tigers' schedule picked to win its league next to UNC Asheville (defending Big South Conference champions).

» The Lions opened the season with a 90-71 victory over NCAA Division II Delta State on Nov. 6. Junior guard Roger McFarlane, a preseason All-Southland Conference First Team selection, led the way with 14 points.

» The Auburn game starts off a string of five-straight road games for Southeastern.

# WILLIAMS ON CUSP OF MILESTONE

» After graduating with a bachelor's degree in kinesiology in May, Jaylin Williams chose to come back for his fifth and final year on The Plains. Last season, he was the team's third-leading scorer (11.2 ppg) and third-leading rebounder (4.7 rpg) in 2022-23.

» Williams is on the cusp of becoming the winningest player in program history with 87 career victories – tied with former Tigers Allen Flanigan (2019–23), Anfernee McLemore (2016–20) and Scott Pohlman (1997–2001). He is also 113 points away from recording his 1,000th career point.

» Entering the season with 107 career games played, he needs to appear in 20 games this season to crack Auburn's career games played list and is now 26 games behind Frankie Sullivan's record of 134 games played from 2009-13.

## **INSIDE THE SERIES**

» Auburn leads 4-0 in the all-time series with Southeastern Louisiana – all four victories coming in Beard-Eaves Memorial Coliseum. Both teams last met on New Year's Eve in 2008 with the Tigers prevailing, 77-65.

» The first game in the series came during the 1998-99 season opener as the Tigers won 114-60 on their way to winning the program's second-ever SEC regular-season title. Auburn also defeated the Lions, 77-47, on Dec. 2, 2002, and 66-51 on Dec. 14, 2005.

## **PRESEASON RANKINGS**

» Entering the 2023-24 season, Auburn has received preseason billing at No. 15 in the Ken Pomeroy Ratings, No. 15 by Evan Miya and No. 24 by The Athletic. The Tigers are receiving votes in both national polls. KenPom also has AU ranked No. 16 in offensive efficiency and No. 15 in defensive efficiency.

# **FRESHMAN PHENOM**

» Freshman guard Aden Holloway led Auburn with 19 points and six assists in 26 minutes of play versus No. 17-ranked Baylor in his collegiate debut on Nov. 7. He made a team-high four 3-pointers on eight attempts against the Bears as he was one point shy of becoming the fourth freshman in program history to score 20 points in a debut. His total of 19 points is tied for fifth among all Division I freshmen in a season opener this season.

## **PLAYER TO WATCH: DENVER JONES**

» Junior guard Denver Jones scored 13 points on 3-of-5 shooting from 3-point range against No. 17-ranked Baylor in his Auburn debut. He scored 953 points and made 108 3-pointers on 35.9 percent shooting from long range in two seasons prior at FIU. He is 34 points away from recording his 1,000th career point with 966 points to date.

## NOT A NEW KID ON THE BLOCK

» Senior center Dylan Cardwell tied a career high with a game-high five blocks against Baylor on Nov. 7. The mark is tied for the third-most in a game nationally this season. Cardwell previously set his career high against South Florida and George Mason in 2022. Auburn blocked 10 shots versus the Bears, which is currently tied for first as a single-game high among NCAA Division I leaders.

# **TRAVELING TIGERS**

» Friday's game against Southeastern Louisiana is one of only three home games for Auburn in its first nine games of the season. Following this stretch, the Tigers play their final four non-conference games at home, before opening SEC play at Arkansas on Jan. 6, 2024.

# **ELITE IN THE SEC**

» Auburn ranks second in the SEC with 143 victories (two wins behind Tennessee) and a .711 winning percentage over the last six seasons. The Tigers have also won the second-most SEC Championship titles (3) and second-most NCAA Tournament games (7) in that span behind Alabama's four titles and Arkansas' eight NCAA Tournament victories.

# PEARL ON THE VERGE OF MOVING UP CAREER WINS LIST

» Bruce Pearl enters his 10th season as Auburn's head coach with a 173-112 record on The Plains. With his next victory, he will pass Sonny Smith, who led Auburn to a 173-154 mark in 11 seasons from 1978-89, for third all-time in program history. Joel Eaves leads the way with 213 wins from 1949-63 and Cliff Ellis, who led the Tigers to 186 victories from 1994-2004, is second.

# **RETURNING PRODUCTION**

» Auburn returns 58.1 percent of its minutes, 60.2 percent of its scoring and 61.3 percent of its rebounding from last season. The Tigers return five of their Top 7 scorers – three of the five players, who averaged 20 minutes per game, and three of five players, who recorded at least 100 rebounds last season.

# JOHNSON ENDS LAST SEASON ON HOT STREAK

» Last season, K.D. Johnson shot 16-of-29 (55.2%) from 3-point range over the last nine games shooting 25.3 percent (20-of-79) from long range in the first 24 games. Johnson averaged 10.6 points over the last nine contests of the season.

## **AUBURN vs. THE TOP 25**

Auburn is 77-224 against AP Top 25 teams all-time including 18-28 under Bruce Pearl. The Tigers set a program record with six wins against ranked opponents during the 2018-19 season including five straight from the SEC Championship through their run to the Final Four. Additionally, Auburn is 103-32 as a ranked team in the Pearl Era.

# WELCOME TO AUBURN'S BLOCK PARTY

» Auburn is the only team that has finished in the Top 25 in the country in blocked shots per game in each of the previous seven seasons. No other team has finished in the Top 25 in blocks per game in more than five seasons over that stretch. The Tigers have blocked 1,300 shots since the start of the 2016-17 season.



# HEAD COACH BRUCE PEARL



Auburn Head Coach Bruce Pearl is in his 10th season on The Plains.

He has guided the Tigers to 173 wins in nine seasons, the program's first-ever No. 1 ranking in both national polls and a memorable run to the NCAA Final Four in 2019.

The three-time SEC Coach of the Year's accomplishments also include two Southeastern Conference regular-

season championships, one SEC Tournament championship and four NCAA Tournament berths with the Tigers.

Pearl currently ranks No. 13 among active NCAA Division I coaches in career wins (635) and No. 8 all-time among winningest SEC coaches with 318 career victories at Auburn and Tennessee combined.

During the 2022-23 season, the Tigers continued to make history finishing the season with a 21-13 overall record – the 11thmost wins in program history. Auburn has now turned in 20-win seasons in five of the last six years and is the second-winningest program in the SEC in that span.

Auburn was ranked a program-best 32-consecutive weeks in The Associated Press Top 25 Poll and as high as No. 11 in the country during the season. It was one of 10 schools to be ranked in the AP Top 25 throughout the 2022 calendar year.

For the third-consecutive school year, the Tigers achieved a team GPA of 3.0 or higher and received the NABC Academic Excellence Award under Pearl.

Six Tigers have been drafted into the NBA and developed by Pearl and his coaching staff including All-Americans Jabari Smith (No. 3 overall in 2022) and Walker Kessler selected (No. 22 overall in 2022). Both are currently playing in the league along with Chuma Okeke (No. 16 overall in 2019), Isaac Okoro (No. 5 overall in 2020), JT Thor (No. 37 overall in 2021) and Sharife Cooper (No. 48 overall in 2021).

Pearl's teams have been just as successful off the court as Auburn has had 37 graduates since 2014 - the most in the SEC.

In 28 seasons as a head coach, he has guided his teams to the NCAA Tournament 21 times and a 635-256 (.713) winning record.

Pearl is the only head coach (football or men's basketball) in SEC history to lead two programs to a No. 1 national ranking (Auburn in 2022 and UT in 2008). Additionally, he is just one of three head coaches to take four programs (three at the Division I level) to the Sweet 16, joining Lon Kruger and Eddie Sutton.

Through the Bruce Pearl Family Foundation, he and his wife, Brandy, remain committed to giving back to those in Alabama, providing support to children and families facing challenging and life-altering illnesses through Children's Harbor.

In 2015-16, Pearl started AUTLIVE at Auburn to benefit patients in the state of Alabama in the fight against cancer. AUTLIVE also raises the awareness of cancer prevention and detection.

A native of Boston, Mass., Pearl graduated cum laude from Boston College in 1982 with a bachelor's degree in business administration. He is the proud father of four children, Jacqui, Steven, Leah and Michael, and enjoys spending time with his grandchildren.






