NO. 21 AUBURN AT NCAA FAYETTEVILLE REGIONAL

The No. 21 Auburn gymnastics team is ready for NCAA postseason as the fourth-seeded squad continues the year at the 2017 NCAA Fayetteville Regional, April 1, in Fayetteville, Ark. Action begins at 4 p.m. CT in Barnhill Arena and the top two teams at the conclusion of the meet will advance to the NCAA Championship.

"We have a good bit of confidence on the team right now," head coach Jeff Graba said. "However, this is the postseason and at the regional meet, you need to perform in order to move on. If you don't, you go home. This young team needs to learn how to handle that so that we can have a great meet."

Auburn is joined by No. 1 seed and the fourth-ranked team overall Utah. Denver and California will be the Nos. 2 and 3 seeds, while host Arkansas and Central Michigan are also set to compete.

The top two teams from each of the six regionals will advance to the NCAA Championships, April 14-15, in St. Louis.

IN THE RANKINGS

Auburn stands at No. 21 in the weekly RoadToNationals.com rankings, having an RQS score of 196.265.

The Tigers are coming off a season-high score at the 2017 SEC Championship, finishing sixth overall with a 196.550. That score tied for the third-highest team total in program history at the conference meet.

Auburn is in the Top 25 in all four events leading up to this weekend's meet. The youthful squad continues to excel on bars and comes in 16th with a 49.185 RQS. The Tigers are also 19th on beam at 49.095. AU upped its RQS to 49.175 on floor and rank 23rd overall. The squad's 49.050 on vault is 21st in the country.

A trio of Tigers are among the Top 50 nationally. Sophomore Taylor Krippner ranks 39th nationally on beam with a 9.885 RQS. Classmate Emma Engler it tied for 44th on bars (9.875), while senior MJ Rott is tied for 40th on vault (9.855).

GAMEDAY EXPERIENCE: AUBURN ARENA

» The Auburn gymnastics program has enjoyed five sellouts (7,424) in the last three seasons at Auburn Arena. The Tigers have reached new heights already in 2017 as season ticket holder numbers have risen yet again.



2016 NCAA ANN ARBOR REGIONAL

Auburn advanced to the NCAA Championship for the second straight year after the Tigers finished tied for first with a 196.525 in the NCAA Ann Arbor Regional in the Crisler Center on the campus of the University of Michigan.

Auburn and Stanford finished tied for first with a 196.525 and the Tigers will advance as a top seed after the tie break. The regional win is the first in program history.

Highlighting the night was the team's performance in the fifth rotation on floor. Following its second bye, Auburn put together a 49.400 and were led by Kait Kluz, Lexus Demers and Caitlin Atkinson. The trio finished tied for first overall as each earned a 9.9. MJ Rott and Abby Milliet chipped in a pair of 9.85s for the Tiaers.

After a first round bye to start the night, Auburn opened with a 49.125 on bars. A trio of Tigers in Kluz, Milliet and Taylor Krippner led the way with a 9.85 each. Atkinson added a 9.8, while Samantha Cerio led off the rotation with a 9.775.

The Tigers headed to beam next and totaled a 48.850. Demers finished tied for third overall in the meet with a 9.875 to lead the Oranae and Blue. Atkinson added a 9.8 and Milliet followed with a 9.750. Cerio finished her night with a 9.725 on the apparatus and Kullen Hlawek made her regional debut with a 9.7.

Auburn closed out the meet on vault with a 49.150 and were led by Rott's 9.9. Her score gave her first in the event. Atkinson and Demers chipped in a pair of 9.85s, while Krippner earned a 9.8. Sarah Garcia and Kluz each totaled a 9.750 for the Tigers.

Atkinson finished the all-around in fifth with a 39.350.

AUBURN LINEUP

Auburn will feature 18 routines from sophomores and freshmen Saturday, while the other six will come from the team's four seniors. In addition, 14 routines will come from student-athletes who have never competed in the postseason. Freshman Katie Becker will once again compete in all four rotations for the Tigers as the Boone, N.C., product is set to make her fifth start in the all-around for Auburn. Becker has competed in all events at Alabama (Feb. 17), at Missouri (March 3), vs. Pittsburgh (March 10), and at the SEC Championship (March 18). She finished with a season-best 38.950 in Tuscaloosa, while taking the all-around title vs. the Panthers with a 38.925.

Auburn kicks things off on a bye before heading to bars where

the squad has enjoyed success in the event this season. Making her 54th start in the event will be redshirt senior Kelsey Kopec. Becker will kick things off in the leadoff spot for the Tigers with Kopec following. Sophomore Taylor Krippner and Samantha Cerio and freshman Gracie Day will go in spots 3-5, while sophomore Emma Engler is set to anchor for the fourth-straight meet.

The squad moves on to beam and the team's youth shines through as three spots are held by sophomores (Cerio, Engler, Krippner). Becker and redshirt freshman Emma Slappey are also set to compete. Senior Kullen Hlawek will lead things off for the Tigers.

Auburn goes on one more bye before floor follows and brings the most experience for Auburn as seniors Lucia Scaglione and MJ Rott joins Hlawek in the lineup. A trio of freshmen in Becker, Slappey, and Day will also compete for points for Auburn.

The Tigers close out the regional meet on vault in the final rotation of the day and Rott will guide the youthful lineup as she is set to compete in her 53rd career meet in this event. Sophomores Engler, A'Miracal Phillips, and Krippner join Rott, while Becker and Day are also set to go in the rotation.

LAST TIME OUT - SEASON-HIGH SCORE AT SECS

Auburn put together its best performance of the season, finishing sixth at the 2017 SEC Championship with a season-best score of 196.550 in the Veterans Memorial Arena in Jacksonville, Fla.

The team total tied the program's third-best score in SEC Championship history. In addition, six Tigers earned All-SEC honors, marking the most conference honors for Auburn in a single season.

Auburn, competing in the afternoon session, opened the day on beam and put together a solid 49.050 to get things started. Emma Slappev set a career-best score in the event, leading the Tigers with a 9.875. Taylor Krippner anchored AU with a 9.85, while Kullen Hlawek led things off with a solid score of 9.8. Katie Becker added a 9.775 and Emma Engler chipped in a 9.75.

The Tigers moved on to floor for rotation two and added a 49.125 to their score. MJ Rott earned All-SEC honors as she led all afternoon session competitors with a 9.875. Hlawek and Slappey also picked up All-SEC nods as the pair scored a pair of 9.85s. Gracie Day finished her energetic routine with a 9.825, while Lucia Scaglione was given a 9.725.

The squad tied a season-best on vault, coming away with a 49.150. A trio of Tigers in Rott, Day, and A'Miracal Phillips led the squad with 9.85 apiece. That score tied a career best for both Phillips and Day. Krippner and Engler added a pair of 9.8s and that score tied Engler's season high.

Auburn ended the day on bars, putting up one of its best scores of the season with a 49.225. Engler and Samantha Cerio picked up All-SEC honors as the duo each tied career bests with 9.9s. Day followed with a 9.875, while Krippner secured a solid score of 9.8. Kelsey Kopec added a 9.75 for the Tigers.

ALL-SEC SELECTIONGS

Six student-athletes on the No. 21 Auburn gymnastics team earned All-SEC recognition, the league announced Thursday. That set a new program-best total for the Tigers and was the most by any SEC school this year.

To earn All-SEC recognition, gymnasts must finish in the top two spots (including ties) per event in each SEC championship session.

A trio of Tigers garnered All-SEC nods on floor. Senior MJ Rott led all afternoon session competitors in the event with a 9.875, while classmate Kullen Hlawek and redshirt freshman Emma Slappey came in second with a pair of 9.85s. The conference recognition is the second of Rott's career, while Hlawek and Slappey pick up the first of theirs.

Three more first-time, All-SEC honors came on bars as sophomores Emma Engler and Samantha Cerio finished first in the afternoon with a pair of 9.9s. That total tied a career best for each. Freshman Gracie Day was close behind at 9.875 to pick up All-SEC recognition.

In addition, Slappey and Day were placed on the SEC All-Freshman team for their performances on floor and bars, respectively.

SUCCESSFUL SWINGING ON BARS

Auburn has had success on the uneven bars this year, ranking in the Top 20 in the event nationally with a 49.185.

Auburn's season-best score came vs. the Razorbacks in February as the team finished with a 49.375. The Tigers capped the regular season vs. Pittsburgh with another solid score, earning a 49.225 as a group. The squad earned that same score at SECs.

GYMNAST TO WATCH: EMMA SLAPPEY

» Redshirt freshman Emma Slappey put together solid performances on beam and floor for Auburn at the SEC Championship. She was placed on the All-SEC and SEC All-Freshman team for her performance on floor where she earned a 9.85 in the afternoon session. She also led AU on beam with a career-high 9.875.



Sophomore Emma Engler has been very steady in the event for Auburn and is ranked tied for 44th nationally at 9.875. That RQS is also tied for 10th in the central region. Sophomore Samantha Cerio has also been very steady in the event for AU and it tied for 17th in the central region at 9.865. Freshman Gracie Day stands tied for 19th regionally at 9.86.

CONTINUED GROWTH ON FLOOR

Auburn has seen its floor scores continue to rise behind the solid contributions of three of its seniors - Kullen Hlawek, MJ Rott, and Lucia Scaglione

The team has set new season-highs on floor in the last two regulard season meets, scoring a 49.250 at Missouri (March 3) before capping the season with a 49.325 vs. Pitt (March 10).

Scaglione has scored a career best 9.875 on floor on two occasions and has an RQS of 9.85. Hlawek's scores have continued to rise as she earned back-to-back 9.9s to conclude the regular season. Rott captured the event title vs. the Panthers, tying a career best with a 9.95. Rott and Hlawek are tied for 18th and 20th, respectively, in the central region.

STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE

In a poll on RoadtoNationals.com, Auburn's 2017 schedule ranks the second toughest schedule in the nation.

Ten of Auburn's 11 regular season meets are against teams ranked in top 25. Those include match ups with five teams who competed in last year's Super Six - Oklahoma (Feb. 10), LSU (Feb. 24), Alabama (Jan. 29, Feb. 17), Florida (Jan. 27), Georgia (Jan. 13).

<u>UP NEXT</u>

Auburn hopes to secure one of two spots that will advance out of the regional to the NCAA Championship. The two-day meet is slated for April 14-15 and will be held in Chaifetz Arena in St. Louis.

Three-time SEC Coach of the Year Jeff Graba enters his seventh season at the helm of the Auburn gymnastics program in 2017 and has guided the Tigers record heights during his time on The Plains.

For his efforts over the past six seasons, the Minnesota native was named SEC Coach of the Year in 2014 and 2015 and SEC co-Coach of the Year in 2012.

Most recently, Graba and the 2016 team added to the list of firsts for the program under his guidance. The Tigers snapped the 117-meet losing skid to Alabama in February of that season, defeating the Crimson Tide at home (197.275-197.250). Auburn also defeated Georgia in Athens for the first time in program history, setting a new program-high road score on the way (197.325).

In addition, the Tigers earned the program's first No. 1 NCAA regional seed and captured the NCAA Ann Arbor Regional title with a 196.525.

Auburn enjoyed a breakout season in 2015 as Graba led the Tigers to the NCAA Championship Super Six for the first time in 22 years. That season, Auburn broke or tied 52 program records that season.

Auburn's sixth place finish at the Super Six was the Tigers' second best in history and highest since 1993 with a NCAA nationals record score of 197.075. The Tigers also had a program record Super Six score of 195.625.

Auburn reached the 2015 NCAA Championship for the first time since 2003 and for only the fourth time overall as the Tigers tied a schoolbest with a runner-up finish at the NCAA Regional with a regional record score of 196,900.

Graba was named Auburn head coach on August 16, 2010. He came to The Plains after spending five years as an assistant coach at Utah. While with the Utes, he was named the 2009 West Region Assistant Coach of the Year while coaching bars, collaborating on floor routines and serving as the recruiting coordinator.
