LEADING OFF

The No. 12 Texas A&M Aggies and No. 19 Auburn Tigers face off in a key SEC series as the league ledger hits the midway point.

After four weeks of conference action, the Aggies (7-4-1 SEC) and Tigers (7-5) are two of seven teams within two games of first-place Georgia (9-3) in the standings.

Texas A&M and Auburn are both licking the wounds from dropping SEC series last weekend, along with losing in midweek action. The Maroon & White lost two of three at LSU and dropped a midweek game against Texas State (5-3). Auburn lost two of three in a home series against Arkansas and lost an 11-6 decision to Jacksonville State Tuesday.

The Aggies rank in the top 20 in the nation in numerous pitching categories, including **Strikeouts Per Nine Innings** (2nd - 11.3), **K-to-BB Ratio** (3rd - 3.85), **WHIP** (8th - 1.14), **ERA** (9th - 2.90), **Walks Allowed Per Nine Innings** (11th - 2.92), **Hits Allowed Per Nine Innings** (15th - 7.30) and **Shutouts** (16th - 4).

Individually, **ASA LACY** ranks fourth in the nation in strikeouts (79) and strikeouts per nine innings (14.61) and 10th in hits allowed per nine innings (4.25) and 16th in ERA (1.29) and 29th in WHIP (0.88). **JOHN DOXAKIS** ranks 7th in the nation in K-to-BB ratio (11.40) and 12th in walks allowed per nine innings (0.93). **KASEY KALICH** ranks 8th in the nation in saves with eight.

In the weekend series at LSU, **BRADEN SHEWMAKE** moved into ninth place on the Aggies' career RBI list. With 146 career ribbies, he needs one to tie Chuck Knoblauch for eighth place. Shewmake also moved into a tie for 10th place on Texas A&M's career triples list with 10.

SUSTAINED EXCELLENCE

The Texas A&M Aggies are one of only four schools to appear in each of the last 12 NCAA Division I Baseball Championships. The Maroon and White's 12-season NCAA postseason string is the second longest in the SEC trailing only Vanderbilt (13 years). It's also the longest active string among Texas schools.

TEXAS A&M/AUBURN SERIES NOTABLES

The Maroon & White and Auburn have met 19 times previously, with the Aggies holding the all-time series advantage, 11-8. The series did not start until Texas A&M joined the SEC in 2013.

The last meeting came in game three of the 2018 SEC Tournament. **JOHN DOXAKIS** dominated the Tigers, throwing a no-hitter into the eighth inning, in the 4-2 win. Doxakis earned the win, throwing 7.1 innings, allowing one run on two hits and two hit batters, while fanning 10. Nolan Hoffman closed out the game, and earned his 14th save of the season, which tied him for the Texas A&M single-season save record. At the plate, **ZACH DELOACH** had a perfect day, going 3-for-3 with a sac fly, one run and two RBI. George Janca went 2-for-3 with two runs, while **BRADEN SHEWMAKE** added a two-run double.

TOUGH TESTS SPANGLE THE 2019 SCHEDULE

The Aggies will face 12 different opponents who made the 2018 NCAA Championship for a total of 28 games, including Arkansas (3), Auburn (3), Gonzaga (3), LSU (3), Mississippi State (3), Ole Miss (3), South Carolina (3), Vanderbilt (3), Baylor, Dallas Baptist, Houston and Texas. Thirty-six of Texas A&M's games will be against teams that finished in the top 100 of the final RPI rankings in 2018, including 13 games against teams which finished in the RPI top 25. The Aggies play seven games against College World Series squads from 2018, including three against runner-up Arkansas.

POST-SEASON STREAK CONTINUES HEADING INTO 2019

Prior to the arrival of head coach **ROB CHILDRESS**, Texas A&M had never appeared in the NCAA Tournament more than four consecutive years. Last year's regional bid extended the Aggies' current string to 12 consecutive years, something that had never happened before in the program's 116-year history.

Childress has led the Aggies to the postseason each of the last 12 seasons, topping the previous-high water mark of four-straight trips, a feat that had happened only twice before at Texas A&M. Former head coach Tom Chandler led his squad to the NCAA Regionals each season from 1975 to 1978 and 11 years later the Aggies enjoyed a similar four-year run from 1986-89 under the direction of head coach Mark Johnson.

TOP 20 PITCHING

The Aggies rank in the top 20 in the nation in numerous pitching categories, including **Strikeouts Per Nine Innings** (2nd - 11.3), **K-to-BB Ratio** (3rd - 3.85), **WHIP** (8th - 1.14), **ERA** (9th - 2.90), **Walks Allowed Per Nine Innings** (11th - 2.92), **Hits Allowed Per Nine Innings** (15th - 7.30) and **Shutouts** (16th - 4).

FIRST SEC TEAM TO 2,700 WINS

The Aggies own the most wins of any SEC program with 2,700 victories, which ranks 11th nationally. Texas A&M enters play with a 2,720-1,514-43 mark. On February 20, 2019, the Aggies became the first SEC team to reach the 2,700-win mark with a 9-1 win against Prairie View A&M. Texas A&M's all-time winning percentage of .641 also leads the SEC and ranks 15th among NCAA Division I schools.

FOLLOWING THE ACTION

STIRRING THE DRINK

BRYCE BLAUM has blossomed as the Aggies' leadoff hitter. The Houston native and Ole Miss transfer is batting .295 (39-for-132) with a .409 on-base percentage in the top spot in the lineup. He leads the team with 38 runs, four home runs and 11 stolen bases. Blaum has led off three games with home runs in 2019. He has added four doubles, two triples and 14 RBI.

When leading off an inning, Blaum has reached base in 32 of 65 opportunities (.492).

KLOSING TIME

Just past the midway point of the regular-season, closer **KASEY KALICH** is on pace to threaten the Aggies' single-season saves record. The A&M mark of 14 was set by Jason Jester in 2013 and matched by Nolan Hoffman last season.

Kalich is 8-for-9 in save opportunities. He enters the week with a 1-0 record, 2.11 ERA, 1.03 WHIP and 33 strikeouts in 21.1 innings over 17 appearances.

SHRINERS CLASSIC CHAMPS

For the second time in the last three trips, the Aggies claimed the title at the Shriners Hospitals for Children College Classic. The Maroon & White earned victory against two Top 25 teams, including No. 18 Baylor (5-2) and No. 17 TCU (1-0). They capped off the 3-0 performance with a 3-2 victory over Houston.

Texas A&M's pitching staff allowed just three earned runs on the weekend, holding opponents to a .126 batting average. The Aggies registered a 4.00 K-to-BB ratio, 0.74 WHIP and 12.00 strikeouts per nine innings. **JOHN DOXAKIS** equaled a career high with 12 strikeouts in the opener against Baylor, holding the Bears to one run on four hits. On Saturday, **ASA LACY**, **BRYCE MILLER**, **JOSEPH MENEFFEE** and **KASEY KALICH** held TCU to one hit. On Sunday, **JONATHAN CHILDRESS** worked 3.0 hitless innings before the bullpen had to take over. **CHANDLER JOZWIAK**, Miller, Menefee and **CHRISTIAN ROA** combined to allow one earned run over 6.0 innings.

BRYCE BLAUM had a pair of home runs and **ZACH DELOACH** batted .375 (3-for-8) on the offensive end.

Four Aggies earned All-Tournament Team recognition at the Classic, including Doxakis, Foster, Lacy and Shewmake.

PRESEASON HONORS FOR DOXAKIS AND SHEWMAKE

JOHN DOXAKIS and **BRADEN SHEWMAKE** were named to the Preseason All-SEC team as voted on by the conference's coaches.

The duo were both named to the All-SEC Second Team. The pair have each hauled in Preseason All-America recognition with Doxakis earning a spot on the D1Baseball.com All-America Second Team and Shewmake named to the Rawlings/Perfect Game All-America Third Team.

In 2018, Doxakis posted an 8-5 record with a 2.70 ERA, .212 opponent batting average while striking out 92 in his 93.1 innings of work.

The Houston native shined in the postseason, notching a 2-0 record, 0.68 ERA and 22 strikeouts over 13.1 innings in his two starts. At the SEC Tournament, Doxakis outpitched Auburn's Casey Mize, the No. 1 overall pick in the 2018 MLB Draft, by yielding just one run on two hits while striking out 10 in 7.1 innings. In regional play, he worked 6.0 innings against Indiana, allowing one unearned run on one hit and two walks while striking out 12.

Last season, Shewmake earned All-SEC First Team recognition as a shortstop. He played in 61 games, notching a .327 batting average with 43 runs, eight doubles, four triples, five home runs, 45 RBI and 12 stolen bases.

As a freshman, Shewmake filled up his trophy case playing second base. In addition to earning the Aggies' first SEC Freshman of the Year honor, he was named All-America First Team by Baseball America, Collegiate Baseball and the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association and All-America Second Team by the American Baseball Coaches Association and D1Baseball.com. Collegiate Baseball named him National Freshman of the Year and the NCBWA christened Shewmake the District VII Player of the Year.

He was the only Aggie to start all 64 games in 2017. As a rookie, he batted .328 with 90 hits, 47 runs, 18 doubles, two triples, 11 home runs, 69 RBI and 11 stolen bases. Shewmake logged a .529 slugging percentage. His 34 RBI in SEC play ranked third in the league. He hit .307 with 15 runs, five doubles and seven home runs in conference action.

STACKING UP WINS

The Aggies are one of just five teams to log 40 or more wins in every season since 2015. The other four squads are Dallas Baptist, Florida, Florida State and Louisville.

Texas A&M pitchers are holding opponents to a .225 batting average with runners in scoring position. **BRYCE MILLER** is limiting opponents to 2-for-22 (.091) with two walks and 11 strikeouts in 25 RISP situations. **ASA LACY** is 4-for-26 with 15 strikeouts and four walks in 20 RISP situations. **BRANDON BIRDSSELL** is 0-for-6 (.000) with three strikeouts in RISP situations.

With runners in scoring position and two outs, the opponent average drops to .196 (28-for-143).

WEEKEND WARRIORS

The Aggies' weekend rotation has been one of the nation's best through the first eight weekends. **JOHN DOXAKIS**, **ASA LACY**, **JONATHAN CHILDRRESS**, **CHANDLER JOZWIAK**, **JOSEPH MENEFEE** and **CHRISTIAN ROA** have combined for a 1.98 ERA, .194 opponent batting average, 0.96 WHIP and 5,14 K-to-BB ratio in their weekend starts. Despite a grand slam that sank Texas A&M against Texas State, the Aggies have done relatively well in traffic on the mound, holding opponents to three hits (.161 - 5-for-31) and a .188 on-base percentage (5-for-31) while striking out 12 in 32 plate appearances with bases loaded. The numbers are a smidge skewed as Aggie pitchers have thrown two wild pitches with the bases load.

Ks FOR DAYS

The Texas A&M pitching staff is on pace to set a school record for strikeouts in 2019. With 397 strikeouts through 35 games, the Maroon & White are on pace to hang 635 Ks through the 56-game regular-season schedule. The school record for strikeouts in a season is 612 set by the 2010 squad, the only season the Aggies have ever reached the 600-K mark. With a sufficient run at the SEC Tournament and NCAA Championship, the Aggies could flirt with becoming just the second SEC team to post 700 strikeouts in a season, potentially joining Vanderbilt's 2015 squad that recorded 703 strikeouts.
