# UNIVERSITY OF NORTH ALABAMA 2021 Baseball Notes vs. Auburn

#### NORTH ALABAMA IN THIRD YEAR OF DIVISION I TRANSITION

- \* North Alabama is in its third year of a four-year transition to NCAA Division I.
- \* The Lions competed in NCAA Division II in 2018 before going 16-38 in their first season in Division I in 2019. It was just UNA's second losing season in baseball in the last 36 years.
- \* The Lions were 3-13 in the COVID-19 shortened 2020 season and are 7-39 in 2021 for a combined 26-90 record on the Division I level.

#### **JUST THIRD LOSING SEASON SINCE 1984**

- \* This game at Auburn is the final game of the 2021 season for the Lions.At 7-39, UNA will suffer just its third losing season in baseball in the last 38 years, since 1984.
- \* The Lions had a streak of 30 consecutive winning seasons from 1984-2013 before going 26-27 in 2014.
- \* UNA followed with four more winning seasons before going 16-38 in 2019 in its first season in Division I.

#### **DIVISION I ROAD WOES FOR THE LIONS**

- \* UNA has only played 40 of its 116 total games on the Division I level at home, and the Lions' record reflects that.
- \* North Alabama has an 15-25 record at Mike Lane Field in its Division I era, and a 11-65 record away from home during that same span.
- \* UNA is 2-24 on the road in 2021, with both of those wins coming at Lipscomb.

#### STREAKING BACKWARDS

\* UNA has lost its last 18 straight non-conference games, dating back to a 6-4 home win over Little Rock on March 5 of this season.

#### AUBURN IS FIFTH SEC OPPONENT FOR UNA THIS SEASON

- \* This meeting with Auburn will be the fifth game of the season for North Alabama against an SEC opponent.
- \* UNA lost 18-1 to then third ranked Mississippi State on the road on March 23 in Starkville.
- \* The Lions then fell 20-9 to third ranked Ole Miss on April 5 in Oxford.
- \*On April 20 at Alabama, the Lions led for the majority of the game before Alabama rallied in the bottom of the eighth inning to pull out an 8-6 win.
- \* A week ago at second ranked Vanderbilt, UNA led 1-0 early and eventually lost 3-2.

#### **UNA HISTORY VS. SOUTHEASTERN CONFERENCE SCHOOLS**

- \* North Alabama has a 6-43 all-time record against SEC schools in baseball.
- \* UNA is 1-7 against SEC teams as a Division I program.
- \* UNA has played five different SEC schools, having played 27 games against Alabama, 10 against Ole Miss, 10 against Mississippi State, one against Auburn and one against Vanderbilt.
- \* UNA is 2-25 vs. Alabama, 2-8 vs. Ole Miss, 2-8 vs. Mississippi State , 0-1 vs. Auburn and 0-1 vs. Vanderbilt.

#### **LIONS VS. TIGERS IN BASEBALL**

- \* This will be just the second all-time meeting between the Lions and Tigers in baseball. The only previous meeting was a an 8-7 Auburn win in 11 innings at Auburn in 2019.
- \* North Alabama held 5-0 and 7-6 leads but Auburn rallied for the win at Plainsman Park. UNA took a 7-6 lead in the top of the ninth inning but Auburn tied it in the bottom of the frame. The Lions could not push a run across in the 10th or 11th innings and Auburn finally claimed the win in the bottom of the 11th when Judd Ward singled, went to second on a wild pitch and scored on an Everett Lau RBI-single for the 8-7 win.
- \* North Alabama out-hit Auburn 12 to nine, led by Kevin Brenning who was four-for-six with two runs scored, four runs batted in and three doubles.



#### UNA'S THIRD SEASON OF DIVISION I BASEBALL

- \* This will be North Alabama's third season as an NCAA Division I baseball program and as a member of the ASUN Conference.
- \* The ASUN Conference has nine member schools in Alabama, Tennessee, Georgia, Florida, Kentucky and Virginia.

#### **UNA HEAD COACH MIKE KEEHN**

- \* Mike Keehn has an overall 334-288-1 in his 13th season as head baseball coach at North Alabama.
- \* Keehn is in his 33rd season on the UNA coaching staff overall, having previously served 20 years as an assistant coach with the Lions under Mike Lane.
- \* Keehn's 33 combined seasons at UNA makes him the longest tenured baseball coach in school history. Mike Lane was at UNA for 25 years, all as head coach, and George Weeks was UNA's head baseball coach for 23 seasons.
- \* Keehn is also the longest tenured coach in any sport ever at UNA.
- \* Keehn's 334 career wins make him the secopnd winningest coach in UNA history, behind Lane.
- \* Keehn is a 1985 graduate of the University of Nebraska-Kearney. Previous UNA head coach Mike Lane was a 1974 Nebraska-Kearney graduate, meaning the Lions have had a head coach from UNK for the last 38 straight seasons.

#### **LIONS VS. RANKED SEC TEAMS**

- \* North Alabama has two all-time wins over nationally ranked SEC teams
- April 19, 1990 over 10th ranked Mississippi State, 10-3 (while UNA was Division II)
- April 2, 2019 over 18th ranked Ole Miss, 10-6
- \* The Lions lost to third ranked Mississippi State this season, 18-1 in Starkville, and at third ranked Ole Miss, 20-6 on April 5.
- \* UNA has four wins vs. SEC schools in its last 15 games against the league (4-11).

#### **BREAKING BAD**

- \* With the 8-5 win on April 23 against Bellarmine, UNA snapped three losing streaks. Prior to the win, the Lions had lost 13 straight games overall, seven straight home games and six straight ASUN games.
- \* With a 6-3 win at Lipscomb on April 30, the Lions snapped a 25-game road losing streak that dated back to 2020, as well as a 13-game losing skid in ASUN Conference games.

#### **WALKS AND STRIKEOUTS HAVE BEEN A PROBLEM**

- \* UNA batters have struck out 449 times this season in 45 games for an average of just under 10 strikeouts per game. The Lions have struckout more times than any other team in the ASUN.
- \* UNA pitchers have walked 232 batters this season and hit another 41 batters for 273 free base runners this season. The Lions have given more free passes than any team in the ASUN.

#### **DOUBLE-DIGIT SCORING**

\* North Alabama pitching has given up 10 or more runs in 12 of the team's last 22 games. Prior to that, UNA had only allowed 10 or more runs in four of its first 24 games.

#### NO POST-SEASON FOR THE LIONS

\* North Alabama finished fifth in the ASUN North Division and will not advance to the ASUN post-season tournament.

#### MY HOME IS IN ALABAMA

\* The 39 players on the UNA squad come from 11 different states, with one player from Canada. There are 16 players from the state of Alabama and 23 players from outside the state. There are five from Tennessee, five from Florida, four from Georgia, two from Mississippi and one each from Texas, Ohio, Connecticut, Illinois, Minnesota and Wisconsin.

#### **UNA BASEBALL SUPERLATIVES**

- \* The UNA baseball program has had just two losing season in the last 36 years.
- \* While in the NCAA Division II, the Lions won 10 Gulf South Conference Divisional crowns, five GSC Tournament Championships and played in 12 NCAA Division II Regional Tournaments.
- \* UNA won the 1999 South Central Regional and advanced to the Division II World Series
- \* Among the UNA baseball alums who have played in the Major Leagues are Josh Willingham, who played in the 2014 World Series with the Kansas City Royals and hit 195 vareer home runs in an 11-year MLB career, and reliever Sergio Romo, who pitched for the San Francisco Giants in the 2010, 2012 and 2014 World Series.

#### TWO FORMER LIONS COMPETED IN 2014 WORLD SERIES

\* Two former University of North Alabama baseball players found themselves on opposite sides of the 2014 World Series as Josh Willingham (1998-00) and the Kansas City Royals faced Sergio Romo (2004) and the San Francisco Giants.

#### WILLINGHAM HIT TWO GRAND SLAMS IN A SINGLE MAJOR LEAGUE GAME

- \* Former UNA Lion Josh Willingham is one of just 13 players in the history of Major League Baseball to hit two grand slams in a single game.
- \*On July 27, 2009, while playing for the Washington Nationals, Willingham hit two grand slams against the Milwaukee Brewers in a 14-6 win by the Nationals. He also tied a franchise record with eight runs batted in.
- \* The bat that he used to hit the two grand slams is on display in the Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown, N.Y.

#### LIONS HAVE NOT BEEN NO-HIT SINCE 1975 - A STREAK OF 2,261 STRAIGHT GAMES

- \* Although UNA has limited hits in several games this season, the Lions have not been no-hit in a collegiate baseball game since Roger Mayo of Jacksonville State threw a no-hitter against UNA in 1975.
- \* That means the Lions have at least one hit in their last 2,261 consecutive games.

#### **UNA IN ASUN CONFERENCE SERIES**

- \* North Alabama has played 15 all-time ASUN Conference baseball series and UNA has a 13-31 overall record in ASUN play.
- \* The Lions are 9-14 at home in ASUN play and 4-17 on the road.
- \* UNA has won four series, split one and lost the other 10.
- \* UNA has been swept in seven of the 15 ASUN series.

#### FIRST DI AND ASUN SWEEPS FOR LIONS

- \* UNA's three-game sweep of a series against Lipscomb on March 26-28 marked the Lions' first sweep of a three-game series on the Division I level, as well as the first sweep of an ASUN Conference series.
- \* The Lions won two ASUN series in 2019, both 2-1, against Jacksonville and NJIT. There were no conference series in the COVID-19 shortened season in 2020.

#### **ASUN SERIES SWEEP VS. LIPSCOMB**

- \* North Alabama thought it had finally turned the corner after a dismal 1-17 start when the Lions swept a three-game series from Lipscomb, Entering that weekend, the Lions were hitting just .166 as a team and had been outscored 150-37 and out-hit 179-90.
- \* In its ASUN Conference series against Lipscomb, the Lions got their first three-game series sweep on the Division I level, as well as their first ASUN Conference sweep downing the Bisons 12-2, 7-6 and 6-5 in 15 innings. In those three games, UNA scored 25 runs on 34 hits and hit .281 as a team.

#### **HOME SUCCESS**

- \* Five of UNA's seven wins this season have come at home where the Lions are 5-13 this season.
- \* UNA is 4-8 at home this season in ASUN Conference play.
- \* North Alabama has a 15-24 record at Mike Lane Field in its Division I era.
- \* UNA has a 770-267-5 record at home at Mike Lane Field since 1984.
- \* The Lions were 571-156-4 at home under Mike Lane and are 199-111-1 at home under Mike Keehn.

#### **GOING THE DISTANCE**

\* North Alabama played the second longest game in school history and the longest game ever at home on March 28 of this season against Lipscomb. The Lions 6-5 win over Lipscomb took 15 innings and five hours and five minutes to complete. Lipscomb held 4-0 and 5-1 leads in the game before UNA rallied. The Lions forced extra innings with a two-run RBI-single in the bottom of the ninth by Kylan Barnett. Neither team scored a run through the first five extra innings. In fact, UNA's bullpen held Lipscomb hitless and scoreless from the eighth inning on (eight otal innings). In the bottom of the 15th, Dominick McIntyre drew a walk and later scored on a two-out, RBI-single by Reid Homan to win the game.

#### **HITTER'S NOTES**

#### **Drew Hudson**

- \* Hudson has hit in the leadoff spot in 34 games this season.
- \* He has a current three-game hitting streak.
- \* Hudson had a nine-game hitting streak ended at Alabama State when he went 0-for-4.

#### **Devne Daniel**

- \* Daniel has aneight-game hitting streak end last Tuesday at Vanderbilt.
- \* Daniel leads the team with 14 multi-hit games.
- \* Daniel hit .438 in four games two weeks ago (7-for-16) with seven runs scored and three runs batted in. He had a .563 slugging percentage and a .571 on base percentage.
- \* Daniel leads the Lions with 44 starts this year and 45 games played in overall.

#### **Kylan Barnett**

- \* Barnett had a streak of having reached base safely in the 14 straight games end in game two vs. Kennesaw State when he was 0-for-
- \* Barnett hit .421 two weeks ago (8-for-19) with four runs scored and nine runs driven in. He slugged .737 with a .476 on base percentage.
- \* Barnett went 4-for-4 in UNA's last game against Davidson.
- \* Barnett's two-run single with one out in the bottom of the ninth inning tied the game 5-5 with Lipscomb on March 28 and the Lions went on to win 6-5 in 15 innings.
- \* Barnett hit a home run to lead off the seventh inning at Alabama State, breaking up a no-hitter and a shut-out at that point.

#### **Peyton Thomas**

- \* Thomas had a seven-game hitting streak end last Tuesday at Vanderbilt.
- \* Thomas hit .417 two weeks ago (5-for-12) and also walked three times for a .500 on base percentage.
- \* Thomas had reached base safely in the last 11 straight games prior to the middle game of the Bellarmine home series. He has since reached base in five of the six games after that streak ended.
- \* Thomas homered twice in the ASUN series with Lipscomb, hitting a three-run shot in game two and a solo shot in game three. He also homered in yesterday's game, as all three of his home runs have come in ASUN play.
- \* Thomas scored UNA's first run of the Division I era at Jacksonville State on February 15, 2019.
- \* Thomas hit UNA's first pinch-hit home run of the Division I era on April 23, 2019 in the eighth inning at Memphis.

#### **Reid Homan**

- \* Homan reached base safely in 19 straight games and had a 13-game hitting streak both end in middle game of the Lipscomb road series when he went 0-for-4. Both were the longest streaks of the season by a Lion and also set Division I era records at UNA.
- \* His father Matt played baseball at Alabama and his grandfather Dennis Homan was an All-American wide receiver at Alabama in the 1960's.
- \* Went 2-for-4 at Alabama his season with a run scored and a run driven in.
- \* Homan had UNA's first hit and first RBI on the Division I level with a single at Jacksonville State on February 15, 2019.
- \* Homan is second on the UNA team with 13 multi-hit games.
- \* Homan was 9-for-15 in four games two weeks ago for a .600 batting average with two runs scored, five RBI, a double and four stolen bases. He slumped to just .235 in four games this past week 4-for-17).
- \* Homan has played in 133 career games at UNA with 130 starts.
- \* Homan delivered a two-run single in the bottom of the eighth inning against Bellarmine on April 23 to give the Lions a 6-5 lead as they went on to an 8-5 win
- \* Homan delivered a two-out single in the bottom of the 15th inning at home against Lipscomb on March 28 to drive in Dominick Mc-Intyre and give the Lions a 6-5 win over Lipscomb in the longest UNA home game ever.

#### **Dominick McIntyre**

- \* Went 2-for-3 with an RBI, a double, a walk and a stolen base in UNA's last game at Vanderbilt.
- \* Drew a walk in the bottom of the 15th inning and later scored the winning run in UNA's 6-5 win over Lipscomb on March 28 in the longest home game in the Lions' baseball history.
- \* In the three-game ASUN series with Lipscomb, McIntyre was 6-for-11 with two doubles, six runs scored, drew four walks and stole two bases in three attempts.

#### Luke Harper

- \* Harper was recovering from an injury early in the season and has only played in 18 games but he is UNA's leading hitter at .298.
- \* Went 2-for-4 at Alabama with three runs driven in and followed with a hit and three more RBI on April 23 against Bellarmine, giving him six RBI in two games.
- \* Harper hit .417 two weeks ago (5-for-12) with two runs scored and two RBI. That included going 3-for-4 in game two at Lipscomb with a run scored and two runs batted in in a 5-3 win. He also walked twice for a .500 on base percentage.

#### **Austin Thrasher**

- \* Thrasher was walked, hit-by-pitch, scored two runs and had two stolen bases in UNA's last game at Vanderbilt.
- \* Thrasher reached base in eight straight games earlier this season.
- \* Thrasher had a team-high five runs batted in in the Lions' 12-2 win over Lipscomb on March 26.

#### **Kevin Brenning**

- \* On UNA's previous game at Auburn, Kevin Brenning was four-for-six with two runs scored, four runs batted in and three doubles.
- \* Brenning had a game-winning home run in UNA's 6-4 victory over Little Rock on March 5. He hit a two-run shot in the bottom of the eighth to break a 4-4 tie.
- \* Brenning held UNA's Division I record for reaching base in 18 consecutive games in 2019 before it was broken last week by Reid Homan at 19.
