SAMFORD TO WRAP UP SEASON AT AUBURN SATURDAY

The Samford football team will travel to Auburn, Ala., to take on the 16th-ranked Auburn Tigers Saturday at 11 a.m. at Jordan-Hare Stadium. The game can be seen live on the SEC Network.

Samford enters the game with a record of 5-6 overall and 4-4 in Southern Conference play. The Bulldogs are coming off a 31-13 win at Western Carolina Saturday.

Auburn has a mark of 7-3 overall and 4-3 in the SEC. The Tigers are coming off a 21-14 loss to Georgia last Saturday.

THE SERIES

The Samford Bulldogs and Auburn Tigers will meet for the 29th time, with Auburn holding a 27-0-1 advantage in the all-time series.

The teams last met on Nov. 22, 2014, with Auburn earning a 31-7 win at Jordan-Hare Stadium. The one tie in the series came on Oct. 29, 1927, with the game ending in a 9-9 tie at Birmingham's Rickwood Field.

SAMFORD ON THE ROAD

Saturday's game will mark Samford's last of six true road games on the team's 2019 schedule. The Bulldogs are currently 2-3 in true road games so far this season. The Bulldogs also played one neutral-site game, falling to Youngstown State, 45-22 in a game played in Montgomery's Cramton Bowl.

Last season, Samford went 2-4 in road games.

SAMFORD AGAINST SOUTHEASTERN CONFERENCE TEAMS

Against the current members of the Southeastern Conference, Samford has an all-time record of 2-77-3, including an 0-27-1 record against Saturday's opponent, Auburn. This game will mark the seventh time in the last nine seasons Samford has faced an SEC opponent

Samford has played the following SEC schools: Alabama (0-20-1), Arkansas (0-1), Auburn (0-27-1), Florida (0-2), Georgia (0-2), Kentucky (0-1), LSU (0-1), Ole Miss (1-2), Mississippi State (1-17-1), Tennessee (0-2) and Vanderbilt (0-2).

THE LAST TIME OUT

Samford used big plays in all three phases to earn a 31-13 come-from-behind win at Western Carolina last Saturday.

Quarterback Liam Welch rushed 20 times for a career-high 105 yards and a touchdown. He also passed for 115 yards and a touchdown. Montrell Washington had one punt return that went for a 59-yard touchdown. Armond Lloyd and Jaleel Laguins had a fumble recovery each for the defense.

SAMFORD VERSUS IN-STATE TEAMS

Samford has an all-time record of 88-117-17 against college teams from the state of Alabama, including a record of 0-27-1 against Saturday's opponent, Auburn.

FRESHMEN STEPPING UP

So far this season, Samford has had several freshmen step up to make big plays.

Running back Jay Stanton leads the team in rushing with 671 yards on the season, and he rushed for a career-high 141 yards at Mercer. Wide receiver A.J. Toney ranks third on the team in receptions with 32 and fifth in receiving yards with 289. Michael Vice has five TD catches so far.

QUICK STRIKES

So far this season, Samford has continued the trend of quick scoring drives since Chris Hatcher became the program's head coach. So far this season, Samford has had 16 scoring drives of two minutes or less, and seven that took less than a minute. The times of those drives were: 0:30, 0:33, 0:39, 0:41, 0:41, 0:52, 0:57, 1:01, 1:01, 1:13, 1:22, 1:25, 1:44, 1:47, 1:48 and 1:52.

In four-plus seasons under Hatcher, Samford has had 110 scoring drives of two minutes or less and 50 that have lasted one minute or less.

THE LAST TIME VS. AUBURN

Samford and Auburn last met on Nov. 22, 2014, with Auburn taking a 31-7 victory.

For Samford in the loss, quarterback Michael Eubank passed for 125 yards and a touchdown. Karel Hamilton caught five passes for 67 yards, and Tony Philpot had one touchdown reception.

PUTTING UP POINTS

Samford has scored at least 20 points in 31 of its last 35 games. During that stretch, Samford has scored in the 40s three times, 50s twice, 60s three times and 70s once in a 73-22 win over VMI last season.

The Samford record for scoring in a game is 87 points in an 87-0 win over Birmingham-Southern on Nov. 23, 1907. Below is a list of the last time Samford has scored in different point ranges:

SAMFORD IN THE SOCON STATISTICAL RANKINGS

Through the first 11 games of the season, Samford leads the SoCon in several statistical categories.

As a team, the Bulldogs lead the league in scoring offense (35.2 ppg.), punt return average (19.4 ypr.), first downs (260) and fewest penalty yards per game (34.8).

Individually, Mitchell Fineran leads the league in scoring by kick (8.3 ppg.) and field goals per game (1.36). John Staton leads the league in both total tackles (112) and tackles per game (10.2).

SAMFORD HOME TO SOME OF COLLEGE FOOTBALL'S BEST

Throughout its history, Samford has been home to some of college football's greatest names.

Bobby Bowden, one of the game's greatest coaches, played at Samford from 1950 to 1952, and served as the Bulldogs' head coach from 1959 to 1962. He still holds the school record for highest winning percentage with a 31-6 record in his time at the school.

Jimbo Fisher, current head coach at Texas A&M, played quarterback at Samford in 1987, and was a member of the coaching staff from 1988 to 1992.

Terry Bowden, before becoming the head coach at Auburn, was Samford's head coach from 1987 to 1992. Bowden led Samford to the semifinals of the 1991 NCAA Division I-FCS Playoffs, and earned a playoff bid again in 1992, before being hired at Auburn.

Pat Sullivan, the 1971 Heisman Trophy winner as a quarterback at Auburn, was Samford's head coach from 2007 to 2014. Sullivan led Samford to its first Southern Conference championship in 2013 and is currently the program's all-time winningest coach.

EXPERIENCE RETURNS ON OFFENSIVE LINE

One of the strengths of the Samford offense has been the team's offensive line.

The Bulldogs returned four of the five starters in the group from last season. Entering Saturday's game, those four players, Nate Lee, Brendan Loftus, Nick Nixon and Mike Williams, have a combined 139 starts for the Bulldogs.

BULLDOGS IN THE NFL

Entering this week, six former Samford standouts are listed on NFL rosters. Veterans James Bradberry (CB-Carolina Panthers), Michael Pierce (DL-Baltimore Ravens), Jaquiski Tartt (S-San Francisco 49ers) and Nick Williams (DL-Chicago Bears); are joined by newcomers Ahmad Gooden (DL-Denver Broncos*) and Devlin Hodges (QB-Pittsburgh Steelers).

HATCHER PRODUCES THE BEST

Samford head coach Chris Hatcher has coached the national player of the year at two different levels on four different occasions. While he was the head coach at Valdosta State, his quarterback, Dusty Bonner won back-to-back Harlon Hill Trophies in 2000 and 2001, an award Hatcher himself won as the top D-II player in 1994. In 2007 at Georgia Southern he coached quarterback Jayson Foster to the Walter Payton Award as the top player in FCS football. Last season, Samford quarterback Devlin Hodges earned the Walter Payton Award as well.

BIG PLAY BULLDOGS

Through the first 11 games of the 2019 season, the Samford offense has produced 27 plays of 30 yards or more. Eight of those plays have gone for 50 yards or more, and the team has a long play of 82 yards.

During the entire 2018 season, the Samford offense produced 20 plays of over 30 yards. A total of 11 of those plays went for over 40 yards, seven of over 50 yards, three of over 60 yards and one of over 70 yards.

HATCHER'S OFFENSES PRODUCE

Through his first four-plus seasons, Samford head coach Chris Hatcher's offenses have averaged more points than under any other head coach in program history. Entering this week's game, Hatcher's teams have averaged 33.62 points per game, ahead of Bobby Bowden's 28.57 average. The average is also the highest in the SoCon during the last four-plus seasons. Below is a list of the top five head coaches in points per game in school history.

STATON AMONG NATIONAL LEADERS

Samford middle linebacker John Staton is among the leaders in all of FCS football in a couple of different categories. The junior ranks sixth in the nation in tackles per game (11.2) and 13th in total tackles (112).

PLAYING EXTRA FOOTBALL

So far this season, Samford has played in four overtime games for a total of 10 extra periods of football. The team had a double overtime loss at Tennessee Tech (58-59), a four-overtime win over The Citadel (61-55), an overtime loss at VMI (41-48) and a triple-overtime loss at Mercer (33-36).

SAMFORD IN NOVEMBER GAMES

Samford has an all-time record of 160-155-18 in games played in the month of November. This season, Samford will play four games in November, and the Bulldogs are currently 1-2 in those contests. Last season, Samford posted a record of 2-1 in the 11th month.

BARTON NAMED WINNER OF CHARLES WILLIAMS MEMORIAL JERSEY

Senior safety Nick Barton has been named the 15th recipient of the Charles Williams Memorial Jersey. The jersey, the No. 5, is given each year to a senior leader on the Samford team. The jersey honors former Samford player Charles Williams, who died in a car accident on May 23, 2003.

Previous winners of the jersey were Ossie Buchannon (2005), T.C. Myers (2006), Jay McCurdy (2007), Rodney Shepherd (2008), Jon Weber (2009), Bryce Smith (2010), Sean Thompson (2011), Ryan Dudchock (2012), Justin Shade (2013), Brinson Porter (2014), Carson Barnett (2015), Devon Schmitt (2016), Shaheed Salmon (2017) and Tyler Queen (2018).

PRESEASON SOCON HONORS

Samford placed four players on the Southern Conference's coaches' pre-season All-SoCon teams. Offensive lineman Nick Nixon and place-kicker Mitchell Fineran were Samford's first-team honorees. Defensive linemen Justin Foster and Nelson Jordan were both named to the second team.

SOCON PRESEASON PREDICTIONS

The SoCon released its preseason polls for both the coaches and media in July, and Samford was picked to finish sixth in both polls.

In the Coaches Poll, Wofford was picked to win the league with 63 total points and seven first-place votes. Furman was picked second with 55 points and one first-place vote, while ETSU was picked third with 44 points and one first-place nod. ETSU was followed by Chattanooga (40 pts.), Mercer (34), Samford (33), The Citadel (22), Western Carolina (21) and VMI (12).

The media also picked Wofford to win the league with 253 points and 21 first-place votes. The Terriers were followed by Furman (229 pts, 6 first-place votes), ETSU (187 pts, 2 first-place votes), Mercer (146), Chattanooga (134), Samford (125), The Citadel (111), Western Carolina (88) and VMI (32).

MONTGOMERY, Ala. – The Samford football team dropped a 45-22 decision to Youngstown State in the Guardian Credit Union FCS Kickoff at Cramton Bowl.

Samford committed four costly turnovers (1 fumble and 3 interceptions), with Youngstown State picking up 14 points off those miscues.

For Samford in the game, starting quarterback Liam Welch completed 13-of-22 passes for 142 yards and a touchdown. Backup quarterback Chris Oladokun came in during the fourth quarter and completed 7-of-10 passes for 125 yards and a touchdown. Oladokun also rushed five times for 14 yards and a score.

DeMarcus Ware led the running game, gaining 61 yards on 12 carries. Robert Adams, a Montgomery native, had four receptions for 74 yards and a touchdown. Montrell Washington caught two passes for 80 yards, including a 64-yard touchdown.

The Samford defense was led by John Staton with 12 total tackles, including seven solo stops. Jaleel Laguins totaled 10 tackles, including nine solo. Freshman Trimarcus Cheeks had the team's lone sack of the day.

Samford jumped on top first, scoring a touchdown on the Bulldogs' second drive of the game. Welch hit Adams for a 55-yard touchdown over the middle to give Samford a 7-0 lead with 9:09 to go in the first quarter.

YSU knotted the score when Nathan Mays connected with Samuel St. Surin for a 16-yard score to make the score 7-7 with 2:12 left in the opening period. On the second play of Samford's ensuing drive, YSU's Cash Mitchell recovered a Welch fumble and returned it 25 yards for a touchdown for a 14-7 Penguin lead with 1:29 left in the first quarter.

Colten McFadden added to the Penguins' lead with a 43-yard field goal to push YSU's lead to 17-7 with 10:57 left in the second quarter. Mays threw a four-yard touchdown pass to Josh Burgett with 36 seconds left before halftime to give Youngstown State a 24-7 lead at the break.

After a scoreless third quarter, YSU's Braxton Chapman scored a one-yard run with 14:29 to go in the fourth quarter to make the score 31-7. Samford's Oladokun then hit Washington for a 64-yard touchdown pass, and the two-point conversion was good to cut the lead to 31-15 with 13:37 left in the game.

YSU's Chapman scored on a one-yard run with 5:16 left to push the lead to 38-15. Oladokun scored on a 10-yard run with 3:17 to go to cut the lead to 38-22. YSU added one final touchdown on a three-yard run by Christian Turner to make the final score 45-22.

2019 SAMFORD FOOTBALL

CHRIS HATCHER HEAD COACH



Chris Hatcher was named Samford's 36th head football coach on Dec. 11, 2014. Now in the midst of his fifth season at Samford, Hatcher boasts a career record of 153-82 in 19-plus years as a college head coach, having previously coached at Murray State, Georgia Southern and Valdosta State.

Hatcher's 2018 team posted the program's eighth-straight winning season, the longest streak in program history. Also during the season, quarterback Devlin Hodges became the FCS' all-time leader in career passing yards. Hodges also earned the highest individual honor at the FCS level, winning the Walter Payton Award. Additionally, he was named the Southern Conference's Offensive Player of the Year for a third-straight season.

Also in 2018, Hodges set school records for single-season completions (388), attempts (550), passing yards (4,283). Hodges was named the SoCon's Offensive Player of the Year and a third team All-American at the conclusion of the season.

In 2017, Hatcher led the team to an 8-4 record and a spot in the NCAA Division I-FCS Playoffs for a second-straight season for the first time since 1992.

As a unit, the 2016 Samford offense ranked third among all FCS schools in passing offense, averaging 349.4 passing yards per game. The offense also ranked sixth in the nation in red zone offense (90.2%), 11th in team passing efficiency (155.24), 12th in scoring offense (35.1 ppg.) and 14th in total offense (446.2 ypg.).

In his first season at Samford in 2015, Hatcher put his stamp on the Bulldog program. Samford finished the season third in the nation in passing offense (332.9 ypg.), seventh in the nation in total offense (479.7 ypg.) and seventh in fourth down conversions (66.7%). Hatcher's special teams also stood out, ranking fifth nationally in kickoff return average (24.34 ypr.).

Hatcher led the Bulldogs to a 6-5 record that first season, ending the season with a pair of impressive Southern Conference road wins at Wofford and Mercer. The 2015 team also produced a pair of All-Americans in cornerback James Bradberry and place-kicker Anthony Pistelli.

Hatcher came to Samford after serving as the head coach at Murray State University from 2010 to 2014. In five seasons as the head coach of the Racers, Hatcher's teams employed the high-powered "Hatch Attack" offense to top the Division I-FCS football charts. In 2014, the Racers ranked second in the nation in passing offense, averaging 327.2 yards per game. The team also ranked 15th in total offense at 468.3 yards per contest.

MSU used a balanced attack in 2013. The Racers rushed the ball 424 times, while throwing it 458, in averaging 398.6 yards of offense. The offense was spearheaded by All-America wide receiver Walter Powell, who hauled in 66 passes for 837 yards and 13 touchdowns in just 10 games.

The 2012 Murray State offense led the Ohio Valley Conference for the third-straight season. MSU averaged a school-record 484.4 yards of offense per game, while also setting a new single-season record by averaging 348.9 yards through the air.

The 2011 season saw the Racers go 7-4 and post back-to-back winning seasons for the first time since the 1999-2000 seasons. MSU closed the season winning five of its final six games, including going on the road and knocking off nationally-ranked Tennessee Tech.

The Racer offense was among the most prolific in the nation as MSU ranked third in scoring offense, fourth in total offense and seventh in passing offense. The 5,070 yards of total offense marked just the fifth time in school history MSU amassed over 5,000 yards, while the 460.9 yards per game were the third-most all time. The Racers also rushed for 152.27 yards per game.

The defense was not to be outdone as the Racers recorded their first shutout in seven years with a 39-0 victory over Mississippi Valley State. It also marked the first shutout on the road since 1986, and the first non-conference road shutout since the 1979 season.

In 2010, the Racer offense led the OVC in passing offense, total offense and scoring offense, while ranking fourth nationally in passing offense, fifth in total offense and fifth in scoring offense.

Hatcher is no stranger to the Southern Conference, as he served as the head coach at Georgia Southern from 2007 to 2009.

In his first season with the Eagles in 2007, Hatcher led GSU to the second-best regular season turnaround in program history, a plus-4 improvement from 2006. The Eagles ranked among the national leaders in various categories on offense, defense and special teams.

He also coached five All-America players, including quarterback Jayson Foster, the second Walter Payton Award winner at GSU.

The Eagles returned to the national rankings after a 14-week hiatus as the Hatcher era got off to a 4-1 start. GSU climbed as high as No. 11, after the Eagles recorded three-straight victories at No. 5 Appalachian State, ending the Mountaineers 30-game home winning streak, at home against No. 25 The Citadel and at No. 10 Wofford.

The prolific offense ranked first in rushing, eighth in total offense, eighth in scoring offense and 23rd in sacks allowed. The defense was 14th in turnover margin and 17th in fumbles recovered, while the special teams ranked 25th in net punting.

The 2008 season saw Hatcher guide the Eagles to the program's 25th winning season in 27 years.

In late October, the Eagles set an NCAA record for the largest fourth-quarter comeback as GSU erased a 31-3 deficit for

a thrilling 38-31 overtime victory at Western Carolina. The OT contest was just the first of an NCAA record four overtime games played by the Eagles in 2008.

Hatcher's team provided impressive numbers in all three phases. The offense ranked 20th nationally in passing and scoring, while the defense ranked 26th in sacks and 22nd in tackles-for-loss. The special teams units finished 14th in punt returns and 36th in kickoff returns.

All of this was done as Hatcher and his staff were forced to play close to 30 freshmen on a consistent basis throughout the season. In all, five Eagles received All-SoCon honors and seven freshmen representing offense, defense and special teams were named to the inaugural SoCon All-Freshman Team.

Prior to his time at GSU, Hatcher molded Valdosta State into one of the most dominant teams in Division II.

The winningest coach in Blazers' history, Hatcher was 76-12 at his alma mater. In his first year back at VSU, Hatcher took a 4-7 squad the previous year and produced a 10-2 overall record (8-1 in GSC action) and a berth in the Division II playoffs. He coached quarterback Dusty Bonner, who was a two-time winner of the Harlon Hill Trophy as the NCAA Division II Player of the Year, an award Hatcher won himself in 1994.

His 2001 and 2002 teams posted back-to-back undefeated records during the regular season, part of a Gulf South Conference record 35 straight victories during the regular season.

During the 2004 championship season, the Blazers lost their season-opener before rattling off 13 consecutive victories, capped by a 36-31 victory over Pittsburg State in the title game. Hatcher was named National Coach of the Year by the American Football Coaches Association and was the offensive coordinator for the East squad at the Hula Bowl.

In 2005, Valdosta opened the season ranked No. 1 for four-straight weeks and saw the season culminate with a sixth-straight NCAA postseason appearance. Despite an 8-2 record in 2006, the 10th-ranked Blazers did not receive an invitation to the playoffs, marking the first time that occurred in the Hatcher era.

The 2006 team finished sixth nationally in passing offense (283 yards per game), 12th in scoring offense (34.9 ppg.) and 19th in total offense (389.9 ypg.). In addition to the offensive success, the 2006 defense ranked 27th nationally in scoring defense (15.7 ppg.) while the special teams ranked third in punt returns (17.3 ypr.) and blocked seven kicks.

The Macon, Ga., native spent one year as quarterbacks/tight ends coach at the University of Central Florida where he worked with future NFL quarterback Daunte Culpepper. He then spent three years working with the quarterbacks at the University of Kentucky where he worked under former VSU head coach Hal Mumme. During his time with the Wildcats, he coached the No. 1 NFL draft pick, All-America quarterback Tim Couch.

While at UK, Hatcher and the Wildcats played in the 1999 Outback Bowl, the program's first New Year's Day Bowl in 47 years, then followed that the following year with a berth in the '99 Music City Bowl. It marked the first time the Wildcats had consecutive bowl appearances in 15 years.

Hatcher carried his success on the playing field to help him develop into one of the nation's winningest coaches. A two-time All-American quarterback at VSU (1993 and 1994), Hatcher threw for 11,363 yards and 121 touchdowns during his stellar career. During his senior year in 1994, he led the Blazers to their first postseason berth, advancing to the quarterfinals, and when it was all said and done set 29 VSU passing and total offense records.

Among the national records he once set were a 68.5 career completion percentage and a streak of 20-straight completions in a game against New Haven. Hatcher held 14 Valdosta State, 13 Gulf South Conference and 17 Division II national records. He also started 41 consecutive games, posting a 29-10-2 record.

Not only did Hatcher excel on the field, he was just as successful in the classroom. Twice he received the Gulf South Conference's Commissioner's Trophy which is awarded to the league's Most Outstanding Student-Athlete. He finished his senior year by winning several national honors including: the NCAA Top Eight Award, the CoSIDA Academic All-America National Player of the Year and a postgraduate scholarship from the National Football Foundation and College Football Hall of Fame.

At the time when Hatcher won the Harlon Hill Trophy, he won by the second-largest voting margin in the then-19-year history of the award. Hatcher was also voted to the GSC Football team of the 1990s.

The honors continued to add up even after his playing days. Hatcher was named to the Valdosta State University Athletic Hall of Fame in 2001, in his first year of eligibility. He was also elected into the Macon Sports Hall of Fame the same year.

In 2005, Hatcher was inducted into the Division II Hall of Fame. Hatcher was also inducted into the inaugural class of the GSC Hall of Fame in 2014.

Hatcher graduated from Valdosta State in 1995 with a bachelor's degree in health and physical education.

He and his wife, Lori, also a graduate of VSU, are the parents of a son, Ty, and daughter, Talley. Ty is entering his second season as a quarterback on the Samford team.
