Men

• Auburn heads to the 2011 NCAA South Regional hosted by the University of Alabama on Saturday. The race will be run on 6k (women) and 10k (men) courses at the Harry Pritchett Cross Country Course in Tuscaloosa, Ala.

• Last season, Auburn's top two individual runners, Ben Cheruiyot and Holly Knight, placed in the top 7 and advanced.

AUBURN IN THE POLLS

• The Auburn men dropped five spots in the most recent USTFCCCA, down to 12th in the South Region. The Tigers are one of seven SEC programs ranked in the South region's top 15.

DUO SHINES AT SEC MEET

• Auburn freshman Kane Grimster and sophomore Elizabeth Briasco each posted a top 20 finish at the SEC Meet on October 31. Grimster placed 14th and was one of just three freshmen in the top 15 on the men's side. He was named to the All-SEC Freshman team as well as a second team All-SEC performer for his efforts.

• Briasco made a late push in the final mile to claim 19th place in 21:25.14 - a 90 second improvement over her performance in the 2010 SEC Championship as a freshman.

1-2 AT FSU, GRIMSTER FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

• Auburn freshmen Kane Grimster (1st) and Niklas Buhner (2nd) took the top two spots at the 2011 Seminole Invite. The duo helped lead the Tigers to their third team win of the season in three races. For his effort, Grimster joined Buhner as an Auburn runner being honored as SEC Freshman of the Week.

• On the women's side, Alyssa Fisher was the highest finisher among attached runners in second place. Followed by Briasco in third, the pair led the women to a third place finish.

TIGERS DOMINATE HOME MEET

• The Auburn men made it two-for-two this season with the team title in the lone home meet of the season on Sept. 9. The men bested the field by 29 points with freshman Niklas Buhner winning the 6k race in 18:54.4 - nearly 30 seconds ahead of the second place finisher.

• The race was the first of the season for Buhner who was held out of the Troy race for more training. Fellow freshman Kane Grimster, also running in his first meet of the season, crossed the finish line fifth in 19:23.2.

• On the women's side, sophomore Elizabeth Briasco posted her second-straight solid finish with a second place showing. She was joined in the top four by junior Alissa Fisher (4th place - 14:53.4). The women's team finished third overall.

• For their efforts in the Auburn Invite, Briasco was named SEC Women's Runner of the Week and Buhner was named SEC Men's Freshman Runner of the Week.





Grimster placed 14th at the 2011 SEC Championship and was one of just three freshmen in the top 15 on the men's side. He was named to the All-SEC Freshman team, as well as a second team All-SEC performer for his efforts.







Third Season

2011 AUBURN CROSS COUNTRY





Mark Carroll

Head Coach Mark Carroll enters the 2011 campaign, his third with Auburn, ready to take the Tigers' program to the next level in the world of collegiate cross country.

2010 featured three of Carroll's runners earning first team All-SEC honors after solid performances at the conference championships – highlighted by second place finishes from Ben Cheruiyot and Holly Knight.

Additionally, both Cheruiyot and Knight advanced to the 2010 NCAA Championships.

In his first season with Tigers in 2009, Carroll tutored Felix Kiboiywo and Cheruioyt to All-American accolades as the men's team placed 25th at the NCAA Cross Country Championships. The Auburn men also brought home two third-place finishes from the NCAA South Regional and SEC Championships, and Kiboiywo took medalist honors for the third time of his career at the NCAA South Regional.

With Carroll at the helm, the Auburn women finished in the Top 10 at five of their six meets for the 2009 season. Carroll led the Lady Tigers to a sixth-place finish at the NCAA South Regional and a seventh-place finish at the SEC Championships.

Prior to joining the Auburn staff, Carroll was the US Athlete Manager for Athletics Ireland, where he guided Gareth Turnbull, Mark Christie and Liam Reale to becoming one of the top Irish running trios in the nation while also training several other Irish runners stateside.

Before coaching Carroll was a world-class distance runner specializing in the 3,000 and 5,000-meters. As a 19-year old, the Cork, Ireland native, earned the first major title of his career, capturing the 1991 European Junior Title in the 5K in Thessalonika, Greece.

In 1998 he won bronze at the European Track & Field Championships held in Budapest. In 2000, he won the European Indoor 3K title. In that same year, Carroll posted the top mile time of his career (3:50.3) in Oslo, Norway.

Carroll is a four-time IAAF World Track and Field member, and holds the Irish-national record in the 3K (7:30.36), which he set in 1996, as well as the 5K (13:03.93) set in 1998. He also held the national record of 27:46.42 in the 10K that was set in 2000, a record that has since been broken.

He has participated in several marathons in the later stages of his career, highlighted by a sixth-place finish in the 2002 New York Marathon. His time of 2:10.54 sits only 61 seconds off of the Irish national record of 2:09.17.

Carroll was a member of the 2000 and 2004 Ireland Olympic Team. He competed in the 5K both years, and in 2000 just missed qualifying for the finals by one place.

During his collegiate days at Providence College, Carroll earned six All-American honors as well as seven Big East titles (cross country; 1,000 meters; 1,500 meters; 3,000 meters (twice); distance medley relay and 4 x 800 meters). His crowning achievement as a Friar came when he won an NCAA Indoor Championship title in the 5,000-meters.

Carroll holds a USTFCCCA level two coaching certificate that he acquired in 2008.

He married the former Amy Rudolph in October of 2005. Rudolph, an accomplished runner in her own right, is a two-time Olympian, as well as a U.S. Indoor Champion in the 3,000-meter run.

2010 SEASON IN REVIEW

High hopes for 2010 after a solid 2009 season gave way to frustration, but despite an under-achieving Fall output by both the men's and women's teams there were solid performances by a pair of individuals. Senior Ben Cheruiyot and departed former runner Holly Knight posted top 10 finishes at the NCAA South Regional in Tuscaloosa and earned berths in the NCAA Championships.

Both Cheruiyot (24:01.36) and Knight (20:49.39) placed second in their respective races at the conference finale hosted by South Carolina. That would be just one of the solid showings by the pair over the course of the 2010 campaign. Knight was joined by fellow senior Stephanie Barnes (21:15.86) in the top 10 at SEC's. The Clevedon, England-native posted a seventh-place finish.

For their efforts, the trio each earned All-SEC recognition.

The season started with a strong showing from both sides at the Troy Invitational in early September with the men finishing first and the women taking second place. Auburn's Barnes and Stephanie Briasco placed one and two to clinch the win.

Knight picked up her first race win of the season in Tuscaloosa the following week, while Cheruiyot finished third as both teams finished fourth in the Crimson Classic. The Tigers closed out September with another pair of fourth-place finishes, highlighted by a pair of race wins from Knight and Cheruiyot.

The pair of wins at the Brooks Memphis Twilight Cross Country Classic earned the duo SEC Cross Country Athletes of the Week.

The final regular season race of 2010 featured the tandem both setting season highs - including a personal best by Cheruiyot. The Kenyan crossed the finish line with a mark of 29:21.06, while his female teammate, Knight, came across in 16:50.25 for a third place finish.
