» QUICK HITTERS

- Auburn is coming off a four-game series sweep against Illinois-Chicago in which the team scored 44 runs on 50 hits and outscored the Flames by 37.
- The Tigers 44 runs and 50 hits were the most in a series since 2018.
- Rankin Woley led the league with eight hits and four doubles last weekend.
- Judd Ward hit for the cycle in game one of Saturday's doubleheader, becoming the first Auburn player to accomplish the feat since Clete Thomas in 2005.
- Thirty-one players saw action opening weekend, including 14 newcomers.
- Freshman right-hander Trace Bright is set to make his Auburn debut Wednesday. Bright was rated by Perfect Game as the No. 1 RHP and No. 5 player in Alabama last year.
- Auburn starting pitchers went 4-0 with a 1.89 ERA over the weekend. The quartet also struck out 29 batters and issued nine walks in 19.0 innings.
- The pitching staff has allowed runs in just one of the last 21 innings.
- Wednesday's contest marks the second all-time meeting between Auburn and Oakland.

Butch Thompson enters his fifth season at the helm of the program in 2020, posting a record of 141-110 in his first four seasons. He led the program to the first College World Series appearance in 22 years in 2019 and has taken the Tigers to three straight regionals for the first time since 2001-03.

Butch Thompson was named Auburn's head baseball coach on October 22, 2015 and enters his fifth season with the Tigers in 2020.

Thompson, who spent three seasons as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Auburn from 2006-08, returned to The Plains after seven seasons at Mississippi State as both associate head coach and pitching coach.

A native of Amory, Miss., Thompson has coached 27 Division I All-Americans and 39 all-conference performers. He has seen 14 of his former pitchers make their Major League Baseball debuts, including eight since 2014. Thompson has also turned 31 pitchers who went undrafted out of high school into MLB draft picks.

Thompson had three pitchers drafted in the first 11 rounds in 2014 and five pitchers drafted, including three in the top 10 rounds, in 2013. He added a first-round selection in the 2016 draft, a third-round pick in Keegan Thompson in 2017 and the first No. 1 overall pick in program history in Casey Mize in 2018.

Along with his pitching pedigree, Thompson is also considered one of the top recruiters in the country. Since 2003, he has secured 13 recruiting classes that were ranked in the top 10 by either Baseball America or Perfect Game, including the No. 5 signing class in 2017 and a program record No. 4 class in 2018. His classes signed from 2006-08 at Auburn each ranked in the top 18 nationally, including the No. 5 class in 2008, which included All-American and SEC Player of the Year Hunter Morris.

In 27 years of coaching at the collegiate level, including 18 in the Southeastern Conference, Thompson has coached eight College World Series participants, including leading the Tigers to the program's first trip to the College World Series in 22 years in 2019. Thompson has also coached one national champion and a national runner-up, won nine conference championships and made 17 postseason appearances. He has also served as an assistant under three National Coach of the Year recipients.

Thompson was named the 2006 Fellowship of Christian Athletes SEC Coach of the Year while at Auburn and the 2014 Baseball America and American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA) National Assistant Coach of the Year while at Mississippi State.

Thompson has returned the Tigers to prominence in four seasons on The Plains as he has guided the team to a 141-110 overall record and three straight NCAA Tournament appearances for the first time since 2001-03, including back-to-back super regionals for the first time in program history. After advancing to the College World Series a season ago and a winner-take-all game three in the Gainesville Super Regional in 2018, the Tigers have finished each of the last two seasons ranked as high as No. 8 and No. 9, respectively. It marks the third time in program history the team has finished back-to-back seasons in the top 10.

Entering the postseason as the No. 2 seed in the Atlanta Regional, Auburn became the only program to swept a regional on the road in each of the last two seasons before also becoming the first team to defeat North Carolina in a Chapel Hill Super Regional, punching its ticket to Omaha for the first time since 1997.

In seven seasons at MSU, Thompson made four NCAA regional trips, two Super Regionals, won the SEC Tournament and advanced to the College World Series finishing as NCAA runner-up in 2013. In three of his last four seasons in Starkville, the Bulldogs' staff ERA finished no higher than 3.06. Thompson's 2013 pitching staff was one of two nationally to finish in the top 15 in ERA, strikeouts per nine



innings and hits allowed per nine innings.

In addition to his experience at Auburn and Mississippi State, Thompson also spent four seasons at Georgia from 2002-05, including a trip to the College World Series in 2004. While there, he guided the development of future Major Leaguers Josh Fields, Mitchell Boggs and Brooks Brown.

Thompson launched his coaching career as pitching coach and top assistant at Huntingdon College (Ala.) in 1993, before returning to his alma mater in Birmingham, where he helped lead the Panthers to back-to-back Southern States Conference Championships and in 1995 coached BSC to its first NAIA World Series berth.

Thompson left BSC briefly to serve as head coach at Jefferson State Community College in Birmingham in 1997. While at JSCC, he was honored as the Regional Tournament Coach of the Year, the ABCA Alabama Junior College Coach of the Year and the Southeast Region Coach of the Year after guiding JSCC to a 39-21 mark, the AJCAA Region 22 State Championship and a third-place finish in the NJCAA Division II World Series.

He returned to Birmingham-Southern as top assistant the following season, beginning a four-year run during the most successful span in BSC baseball history. The Panthers won 196 games and four TranSouth Conference Championships and made three-consecutive appearances in the NAIA World Series. BSC's 2001 team posted a school-best 55-11 mark and captured the NAIA National Championship.

In 2002, Thompson joined the SEC baseball coaching fraternity as a pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at Georgia and has been a part of the league for the past 17 seasons.

Thompson currently serves as the large-school representative for the Alabama Baseball Coaches Association and is an All-American committee member representing the South region for the ABCA.

Thompson prepped at Amory (Miss.) High School and later starred as a pitcher at Itawamba (Miss.) Community College from 1989-90. On Oct. 25, 2014, Thompson was inducted into the ICC Athletic Hall of Fame.

He earned a Bachelor's Degree in History at BSC in 1992 and completed a Master's Degree in Sports Administration at UAB in 1996. He is married to the former Robin Ashe of Birmingham, Ala., and they are the parents of three daughters, Anna, Olivia and Madelyn.

SCOUTING THE GOLDEN GRIZZLIES

- Oakland enters the first midweek of the season with a 2-0 overall record after defeating Akron in a pair of contests last weekend.
- Offensively, the Golden Grizzlies are hitting .221 as a team and are led by Cam Post's .667 clip. Mario Camilletti was named the Nike Horizon League Batter of the Week after collecting a triple, double and pair of singles on the Golden Bears opening weekend. Four different Oakland hitters drove in a run during the two games.
- On the mound, Oakland turned in a 1.35 staff ERA and struck out 25 batters. Rutan will make his first career start for the Golden Grizzlies, having pitched 39 innings of relief in his first two seasons.

PACKED PLAINSMAN PARK

- Auburn welcomed 13,747 fans through the gates of Plainsman Park during opening weekend, including 3,753 fans on Opening Night. The crowd was the third-largest recorded for a season opener in program history.
- The 2020 season marks the first time in program history that reserved season tickets have been sold out. The team has increased season ticket sales in each of head coach Butch Thompson's five seasons - 1,638 (2016), 1,645 (2017), 1,991 (2018), 2,163 (2019) and 2,297 (2020).

WELCOME HOME, HUDDY

- Former Auburn great and 17-year MLB veteran Tim Hudson returns to the Auburn baseball program as the volunteer assistant and pitching coach in 2020.
- Hudson posted a 222-133 record with a 3.49 ERA in his MLB career and is the winningest MLB pitcher in SEC history. Eligible for the Hall of Fame ballot next year, Hudson was a four-time All-Star and 2014 World Series champion with the San Francisco Giants. He is a member of the Atlanta Braves Hall of Fame and Alabama Sports Hall of Fame.

HISTORIC RUN

- Auburn's appearance in the 2019 College World Series was the team's fifth all-time and the first since 1997.
- The Tigers have been to three straight regionals for the first time since 2001-03 and two straight super regionals for the first time in program history.
- The team has won 118 games in the last three seasons, marking the most wins in a three-year span since winning 124 games from 1999-2001.

SCORING IN BUNCHES

- Auburn has scored a combined 854 runs and has hit 123 home runs in the last two seasons. Both numbers are the most since 2009-10 when the Tigers scored a combined 975 runs and hit 234 home runs.
- The Tigers picked up where they left off opening weekend, scoring 44 runs on 50 hits against Illinois-Chicago. The 44 runs scored are the most through four games to start a season since 2000 (51) while the 50 hits are the most since 2007 (52).

STRONG STARTS

- Auburn started the 2018 season 15-0, marking the second-best start in program history, and was 20-2 to start the 2019 season, which was tied for the best 22-game start in history.
- Auburn is 43-10 (.811) against non-conference opponents in the regular season dating back to 2018, including 25-3 (.893) on the weekend.

PRESEASON RECOGNITION

- Coming off an All-American campaign in 2019, junior right-hander Tanner Burns has been named preseason All-SEC, a preseason All-American by Baseball America, Collegiate Baseball, D1 Baseball and Perfect Game, and a member of the Golden Spikes Award watch list for the second straight season.
- Burns went 4-4 with a 2.82 ERA in 2019 and joined Casey Mize as just the second pitcher since 2000 to strike out 100 or more batters in a season.

GAP-TO-GAP

- Auburn ranks second in the country with 17 doubles this season (second to Troy - 21).
- The 17 doubles are the most through four games in the Stat Crew era (since 1993) and the most in any four-game stretch since also hitting 17 doubles from Mar. 3-9, 2018.

BULL

- Junior reliever Cody Greenhill recorded his 18th career save in Friday's season opener, ranking sixth in program history in the category.
- He struck out a career high six batters in 4.0 innings of scoreless work.
- Greenhill ranked tied for second in the league with 12 saves in 2019, including seven in SEC play.
- He joined Burns as a preseason All-American, earning the recognition from NCBWA. He was also named preseason All-SEC and to the NCBWA Stopper of the Year Award watch list for the second straight season.

ALL-SEC TIGER TRIO

- Senior infielder Rankin Woley joined Burns and Greenhill as a preseason All-SEC honoree, marking the first time Auburn had multiple members recognized by the league's head coaches in the preseason.
- The Tigers were one of four teams - joining Arkansas, Mississippi State and Vanderbilt - with three or more preseason all-conference honorees.

GARNERING ATTENTION

- Auburn was picked by the league's head coaches to finish tied for third in the SEC West.
- The team picked up two first-place votes in the division and one vote as the overall conference champion.
- The third place finish is the highest Auburn has been picked in the sixth addition of the preseason coaches poll.

WEALTH OF EXPERIENCE

- Auburn returns seven everyday starters and 10 pitchers, including eight who threw 35 or more innings, from last year's College World Series team.

HOME SWEET HOME

- Auburn opens the 2020 season with 23 consecutive games at Plainsman Park and has 37 home games on the schedule.
- The Tigers are 55-16 (.775) at home since the start of the 2018 season.

TIGERS IN THE DRAFT

- Auburn had five players selected in the 2019 MLB Draft, imarking the 14th straight season the team has had multiple players drafted
- The Tigers have also had at least one player selected for 45 straight years, which is tied for the longest streak in the SEC.

BIG LEAGUE TIGERS

- In 2018, former Auburn pitcher Trey Wingenter became the 51st player in Auburn history to appear in the Major Leagues. He made his MLB debut for the San Diego Padres on Aug. 7, 2018.
- Wingenter was one of three former Tigers to spend the entirety of the 2019 season on a big league roster, joining Josh Donaldson (Braves) and Garrett Cooper (Marlins). Grant Dayton also appeared for the Braves last season.
- Coming off a 2018 season in which he spent some time on the DL, Donaldson bounced back with the Braves and hit 37 home runs with 94 RBI en route to being named the NL Comeback Player of the Year.

TAKE 'EM TO SCHOOL

- Auburn has 12 players on its team that chose to attend Auburn rather than sign a professional contract, including four players who were selected in the 2019 draft in June.

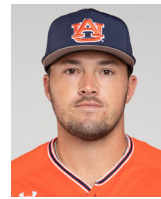

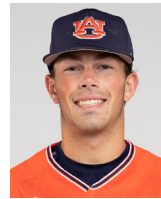
