THREE HITS

- The Auburn Horsemanship corps and the Flat riders have both experienced a wealth of success this season. Each group has combined for 23 wins on the year, respectively, for the Tigers.
- Senior Tory Hoft leads the team with six wins on Flat, while classmate Ashley Foster has six wins in Fences.
- Horsemanship riders Kara Kaufmann and Megan Rauh lead the group with five wins each. Kaufmann is undefeated in the event with a 5-0-1 overall mark.

NO. 3 AUBURN WELCOMES NO. 7 GEORGIA TO THE PLAINS

The No. 3 Auburn equestrian team officially kicks off the 2017 portion of the season Saturday, hosting SEC rival and No. 7 Georgia Saturday at the Auburn University Horse Center. Action is set to start at 1 p.m. CT.

"This has been a good rivalry for us and it's always a big meet," head coach Greg Williams said. "Georgia had a pair of really strong wins last week and they have a lot of momentum coming here this weekend. We've been really strong all year and I'm so excited to see this group put on some great performances this weekend. Coach Mary Meneely and Coach Jessica Braswell have done a great job and the team will be ready to reach the bar that they have set for themselves."

AUBURN LINEUP

Auburn (4-2, 2-1) will be represented by an experienced group of student-athletes Saturday vs. the Bulldogs

Hunt Seat opens the day in Equitation Over Fences and will be led by senior Ashley Foster, who is 6-1 in the event this season. She will be joined by sophomores Ashton Alexander, Caitlin Boyle, and Hayley Iannotti. Making her first Fences start of the season will be sophomore Alex Ladove.

Alexander, Boyle, Foster, and Iannotti will also represent Auburn in Equitation on the Flat. Senior Tory Hoft is set to compete in the event and enters the weekend with a 6-1 mark on Flat.

An experienced group will ride for the Tigers in Horsemanship as the crew has totaled 23 wins in the event this season. Freshman Kara Kaufmann is undefeated with a 5-0-1 record, while sophomore Megan Rauh holds a 5-1 overall mark. Senior Hannah Stephens, junior Kelsey Jung, and sophomore Lauren Diaz each have four wins on the year.

The Reining corps features an experienced crew with junior Alexa Rivard at the helm. Sophomores Betsy Brown, Ali Fratessa, and Blair McFarlin will also compete for the Tigers with Kaufmann joining the lineup.

FIFTEENTH SEASON OF VARSITY EQUESTRIAN

The 2016-17 season marks the 15th year of varsity equestrian at Auburn. Head coach Greg Williams has guided the Tigers since the program was recognized by the Athletics Department and has amassed an impressive 122-50 overall record.

In 14 years, Auburn has earned four NCEA Championships (2006, 2011, 2013, 2016), one Southeastern Conference title (2016), three Southern Equestrian Conference crowns (2004, 2010, 2011) and three NCEA Hunt Seat championships (2008, 2011, 2013).

Individually, Auburn boasts 41 All-Americans and 34 All-SEC selections. The Southeastern Conference first began sponsoring equestrian in 2012-13.

UP NEXT

The Tigers close out their regular season home schedule next weekend, hosting UT-Martin. Auburn and the Skyhawks are set to face off at 1 p.m CT, Feb. 18, at the AU Horse Center. The Tigers will honor their six seniors during the meet.

AUBURN MOVES UP TO THIRD

The Tigers open the spring season as the No. 3 team nationally, according to the most recent NCEA Coaches Poll.

Baylor jumped up to No. 1, while Texas A&M holds on at No. 2. Oklahoma State and Fresno State rounds out the top five. SMU, Georgia, South Carolina, New Mexico State, and TCU rank Nos. 6-10.

AUBURN-GEORGIA SERIES HISTORY

Georgia leads the all-time series with a 22-11 overall mark over the Tigers in dual competition. The Bulldogs hold a slight edge in meets competed on The Plains, 7-6.

The Tigers have won three of the last four meetings at home vs. the Bulldogs. Last season, Auburn defeated then-No. 1 Georgia (Nov. 13, 2015) to secure the nation's top spot in the polls and never looked back.

LAST MEETING - NOVEMBER 11, 2016

The then-No. 2 Auburn Tigers faced a tough Georgia team on the road and fell to the Bulldogs, 11-7, at the UGA Equestrian Complex.

The Horsemanship crew finished 3-1 over the Bulldogs, picking up career-high scores in every match. Lauren Diaz scored an impressive 79 in her win over Bailey Anderson to secure MOP honors, while Megan Rauh finished with a 77.5-77 victory in her match. Hannah Stephens earned 78 points, besting Anna Hutlas's 74. Kara Kaufmann remained undefeated in the event after tying Sammie Johnson, 76-76. Cydney Benes finished with a solid score of 76.5 in her loss.

Following intermission, Auburn topped Georgia with a 3-2 score in Equitation on the Flat. Tory Hoft a win with an 80-69 victory to start things off. Ashton Alexander earned MOP honors with an 84-80 win over Maddy Darst, while Caitlin Boyle won her match, 85-71.

Boyle picked up a point in Equitation Over Fences for the Tigers, defeating Liza Finsness, 84-81. In Reining, Blair McFarlin tied Kyndall Harper, 71.5-71.5.

PLAYER TO WATCH: MEGAN RAUH, WESTERN

» Sophomore Megan Rauh finished the fall strongly and is tied for first on the team with five wins in Horsemanship. She capped the first half of the season with three-straight wins - vs. #1 Texas A&M, at #4 Georgia, vs. #8 South Carolina.

AUBURN SIGNS 10 FOR 2017-18

The No. 2 Auburn equestrian team signed 10 riders to National Letters of Intent for the 2017-18 season, head coach Greg Williams announced.

"This is a dream class that we have worked on for a long time," head coach Greg Williams said. "I believe this to be one of the strongest groups to enter collegiate equestrian in one year."

Auburn will add Western riders Anna Enos (Rockwood, Penn.), Terri-June Granger (Dothan, Ala.), Deanna Green (Pilot Point, Texas), Savannah Ostner (Memphis, Tenn.), Taylor Searles (Scottsdale, Ariz.), and Nicole Ellis (Gainesville, Fla.).

Joining the Tigers in Hunt Seat are Carly Hoft (Raleigh, N.C.), Gia Rinaldi (Wayne, Ill.), Taylor St. Jacques (Glen Allen, Va.), and Ericka Koscinski (Center Moriches, N.Y.).

HUNT SEAT OVERPOWERS ALABAMA IN EXHIBITION

The No. 3 Auburn equestrian team kicked off the 2017 portion of the season with a 9-3 exhibition victory over Alabama. The Tigers and the Crimson Tide squared off in Tuscaloosa for the Hunt Seat-only competition, Jan. 20.

Auburn opened with a 4-2 win in Equitation Over Fences as Kennedy Knapic picked up the team's first point with a 79-72 victory. Becky Kozma earned MOP honors after her 81 points bested Lauren Neibauer's 75. Caitlin Creel scored 78 points in her win and Alex Ladove capped the event with an 80-77 victory over Madelyn Malone.

The Tigers went 5-1 in Equitation on the Flat, taking the first three matches. Ladove kicked things off with an 85-80 win for AU. Casey Schmitz put together an MOP ride in the event, scoring 88 points in her victory. It was the first MOP honor for the Ashburn, Va., product. Hayley Iannotti followed with an 87-80 win over Seide Cimbura. Creel earned her second win of the day (77-64) and Mackenzie Michaels closed out the day with an 82-81 victory.

RIVARD EARNS SEC RIDER OF THE MONTH

Junior Alexa Rivard of the No. 3 Auburn equestrian team was named the SEC Reining Rider of the Month for November.

The Suwanee, Ga., product picked up the second honor of her career following a pair of solid showings against league opponents.

road at Georgia, Nov. 11. She then helped Auburn earn a 13-5 win over South Carolina at home, Nov. 18, with a 67.5-66.5 victory over Maddie Thiel.

On the season, Rivard leads the team with four wins in the event. That includes two victories in SEC competition.

IANNOTTI NAMED SEC RIDER OF THE MONTH

Sophomore Hayley Iannotti was named the SEC Equitation on the Flat Rider of the Month for the month of October.

The Wellington, Fla., product went 2-0-0 in the month of October for the Tigers. Her first ride of the season in Flat came against No. 1 Texas A&M, Oct. 15, and she picked up an 89-58 win to help Auburn top the Aggies in a tiebreak. Her 89 points was a team-high score for the day and her margin of victory of 31 points was the largest by any student-athlete during the meet.

In Auburn's exhibition win over Alabama, Oct. 21, Iannotti earned an 84-82 victory, helping the Tigers sweep the Tide in the event.

AUBURN WINS TIEBREAK OVER NO. 1 TEXAS A&M

For the third time in four years, it all came down to the tiebreak score between Auburn and Texas A&M. And for the third time, the Tigers pulled out the victory, capturing a 1594-1501.5 (9-9) victory.

Horsemanship put together a solid showing against the Aggies, going 4-1 on the day. Hannah Stephens was the high scorer, having 75.5 points in her MOP victory. Lauren Diaz followed with a 74-71.5 win, while freshman Kara Kaufmann remained undefeated on the year with a 72.5-70.5. Sophomore Megan Rauh picked up Auburn's fourth point in the event, 73-63.5.

A pair of Tigers in Ashley Foster and Caitlin Boyle put two points on the board for Auburn in Equitation Over Fences. Foster's 85-83 win gave her MOP honors and kept her undefeated in the discipline. Boyle won 84-75, and Auburn went into intermission with a 6-4 lead.

It was a tight contest in Equitation on the Flat as Auburn came away with a 2-1 win in the event. Tory Hoft earned her third win of the year, 82-78. Hayley Iannotti was the high scorer in the event, having 89 points in her win. Boyle and Foster came away with a pair of ties in their matches.

With Reining remaining, Auburn held a slim 8-5 advantage. The

Aggies took four points in tightly contested matches, while Alexa Rivard gave Auburn its ninth point of the day with a 68.5-59 victory.

AUBURN TOO MUCH FOR UT MARTIN

The No. 1 Auburn equestrian team officially kicked off the regular season with a 14-6 win at UT Martin last Thursday, Sept. 29.

A trio of Tigers earned Most Outstanding Player nods on the day. Becky Kozma and Megan Rauh each were awarded the first MOP honor of their careers, coming in Equitation Over Fences and Horsemanship, respectively. Tory Hoft was honored for her performance in Equitation on the Flat.

The Tigers put together a dominating performance to start the meet, going into intermission with a 9-1 lead. The Horsemanship crew had great rides for Auburn and swept the Skyhawks, 5-0. Hannah Stephens opened the day with a 73-69.5 victory and was followed by Rauh's MOP performance, 75-71. Kelsey Jung and Kara Kaufmann edged both of their opponents as Jung took a 74.5-74 win and Kaufmann won her match, 72.5-72, while Lauren Diaz capped the event with a 72.5-63.5 victory.

Auburn went 4-1 in Equitation Over Fences to start things off in the Hunt Seat discipline. After UTM took the first point in the event, the Tigers rattled off four-straight victories starting with a 76-37 win from Caitlin Boyle. Ashley Foster's 86 points gave her the point for Auburn and Ashton Alexander topped her opponent, 83-80. Kozma's MOP ride came in a tight match as she won 92-91.

After the break, the Equitation on the Flat riders came away with a 3-2 mark against the Skyhawks. Caitlin Creel made her meet debut with an 81-75 victory and Foster picked up her second win of the day, 82-66. Hoft earned MOP honors in a 83-71 win. The Reining corps picked up a pair of victories from Betsy Brown and Alexa Rivard. Brown won 69.5-66.5, while Rivard took her match, 70-67.

EQUESTRIAN 101: SCORING AND RULES

GENERAL RULES

1. In equitation/horsemanship classes, only the rider is being judged therefore no penalty should be assessed because of the horse's conformation, color or movement.
2. Falling off a horse results in elimination.
3. Three refusals over jumps by a horse results in elimination.
4. Any rider not having her mount under sufficient control shall be removed from the ring by the show stewards and shall be disqualified or remounted at their discretion.
5. Riders must remain on the same mount throughout all phases of an equitation or horsemanship class unless the judge or coaches requests a re-ride.

COMPETITION RULES

Riders from opposing teams compete on the same horse. Each rider receives a score. The competitor with the highest score receives one point for their team.

Each rider from each team is given a 4 minute warm-up on the horse she drew in Equitation on the Flat and Equitation over Fences.

- Riders from Home team will warm up with each other. Riders from Visiting Team will warm-up with each other. Riders in Equitation over Fences are only allowed to jump 4 fences in their warm-up.

Each rider from each team is given a 4 minute warm-up on the horse she drew in Horsemanship.

- Riders from Home team and Visiting Team will warm-up together at the same time if the size of the ring allows for this.

Each rider from each team is given a 5 minute warm-up on the horse she drew in Reining.

- Riders from Home team will warm up with each other. Riders from Visiting Team will warm-up with each other.

HUNT SEAT RULES

General-- The rider should have a workmanlike appearance, seat and hands light and supple, conveying the impression of complete control.

Equitation on the Flat

Scoring: Scored out of 100. There are 9 movements as well as a collective mark. These are based out of 1-10 points for each movement and overall position. 1 meaning not executed and 10 meaning excellent.

Equitation over Fences

Scoring: Scored out of 100. Based on the rider's equitation, complete control of the horse, executing the jumps in correct form, and staying consistent.

WESTERN RULES

General-- The rider will be judged on seat, hands, and the ability to control and show the horse. Results as shown by the performance of the horse are not to be considered more important than the method used by the rider in obtaining them.

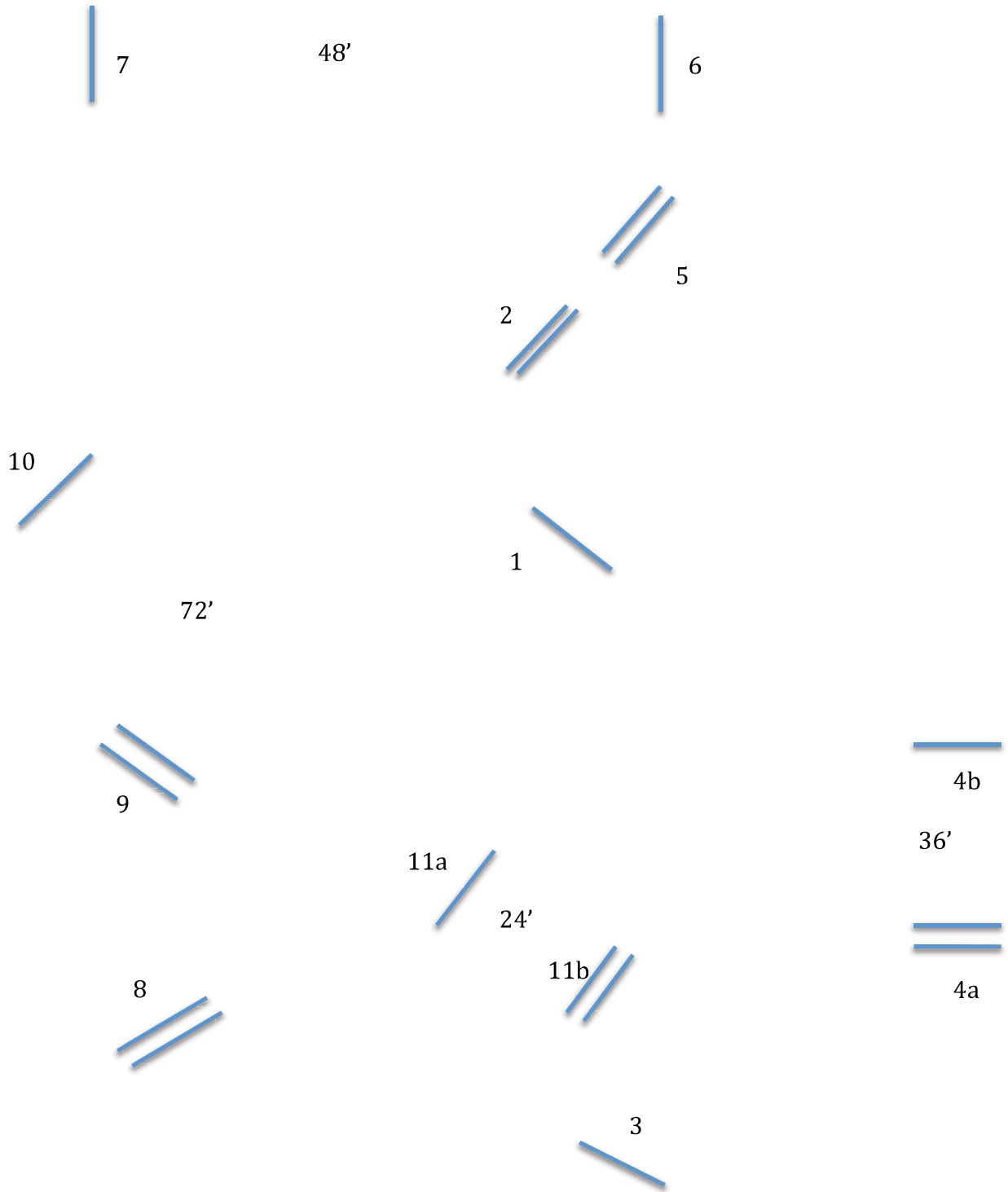
Reining

Scoring: Base score is a 70. There are 7-8 maneuvers depending on the pattern, as well as a collective mark. NRHA/AQHA patterns 1-10 must be used. In these patterns, there are spins, circles, lead changes, stops, rollbacks, and back. Within each maneuver one can score anywhere from a -1.5 to +1.5 points... -1.5 is extremely poor, +1.5 is excellent, and 0 points added to the maneuver means it was done correctly. There are also penalties such as kick outs, break of gait, missing leads, etc. that can be anywhere from -.5 to 5 penalty points.

Horsemanship

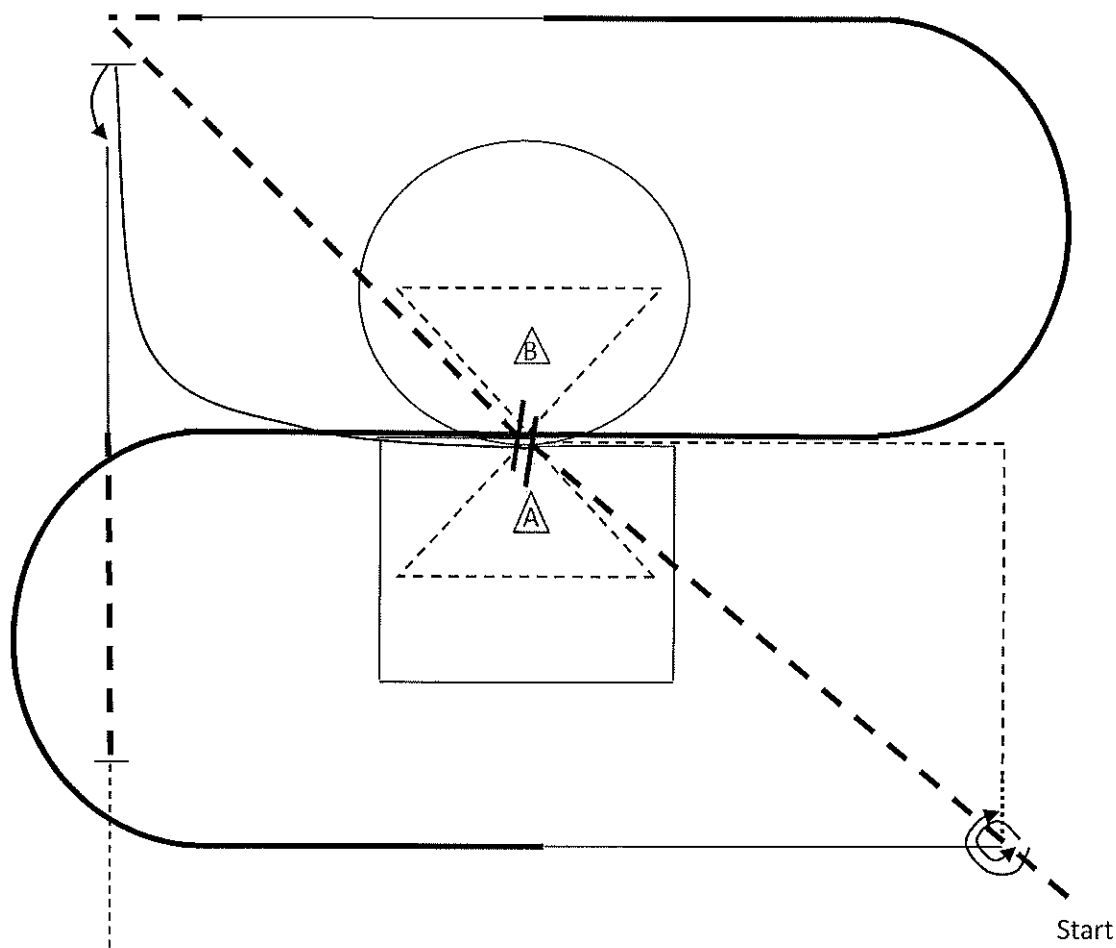
Scoring: Base score is a 70. There are 7-9 maneuvers depending on the pattern, as well as a collective mark. Within each maneuver one can score anywhere from a -1.5 to +1.5 points... -1.5 is extremely poor, +1.5 is excellent, and 0 points added to the maneuver means it was done correctly. There are also penalties such as kick outs, break of gait, missing leads, etc. that can be 1,3 or 5 penalty points depending on severity.

EQUITATION OVER FENCES PATTERN



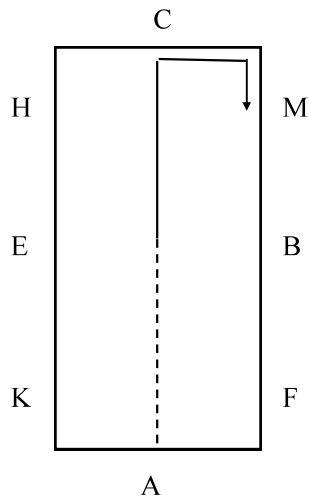

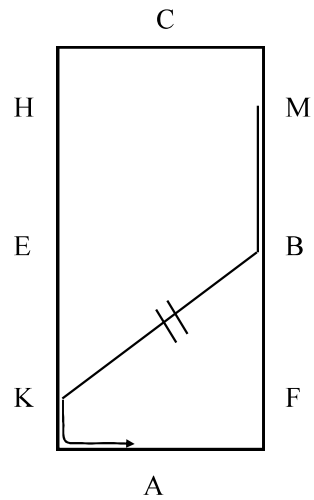


1. Extended trot on the diagonal line. Slow to the jog and jog triangles around the cones starting with cone B. Extended trot on the diagonal line and a tight right corner.

8. Break to extended trot. Stop, hesitate and pick up stirrups. Exit at a jog.

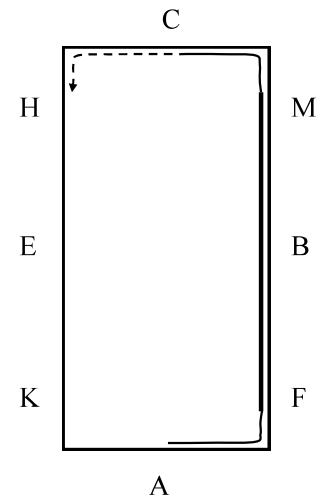

- 1.** Beginning on the right lead, complete three circles to the right: the first circle small and slow; the next two circles large and fast. Change leads at the center of the arena.
 - 2.** Complete three circles to the left: the first circle small and slow; the next two circles large and fast. Change leads at the center of the arena.
 - 3.** Continue around previous circle to the right. At the top of the circle, run down the middle to the far end of the arena past the end marker and do a right rollback - no hesitation.
 - 4.** Run up the middle to the opposite end of the arena past the end marker and do a left rollback - no hesitation.
 - 5.** Run past the center marker and do a sliding stop. Back up to the center of the arena or at least 10 feet (3 meters). Hesitate.
 - 6.** Complete four spins to the right.
 - 7.** Complete four spins to the left. Hesitate to demonstrate the completion of the pattern.
- Rider may drop bridle to the designated judge.
