The Eagles, who have been off since a 72-52 loss at Georgia State on Dec. 22, have lost three straight games with the others coming at Eastern Kentucky 63-59 and at South Alabama 70-57 ... Georgia Southern is 2-0 in the Southern Conference with wins over Chattanooga 84-76 and Appalachian State 73-62 ... the Eagles have also lost at South Florida 66-46, at Wake Forest 81-72 and at SMU 55-45 ... Eric Ferguson, who had 19 points and 12 rebounds in an 88-84 overtime loss to Auburn last year, leads four players who average in double figures with 14.4 ppg and a team-high 6.5 rpg ... Ben Drayton, who had 18 points on 4-o-f-9 three-pointers and nine assists vs. Auburn last year, averages 11.9 ppg ... Willie Powers chips in 11.1 ppg and shoots a team-best 42.4 percent from 3-point range while Jelani Hewitt

AUBURN-GEORGIA SOUTHERN SERIES

This is the sixth meeting between the Tigers and Eagles with Auburn winning all five of the previous games. The two teams met the past two seasons with Auburn pulling out an 88-84 overtime victory last year after having a 29-point lead and winning 95-75 in 2010.

The Tigers are 4-0 vs. the Eagles in Auburn and 1-0 in neutral sites, winning 77-45 in the Cardinal Varsity Club Classic in Muncie, Ind., on Dec. 2, 1994.

The first game in the series was an 80-64 Auburn victory on Dec. 21, 1964, in the Sports Arena in Auburn. Auburn defeated Georgia Southern 93-79 on Dec. 19, 2000, in Beard-Eaves-Memorial Coliseum.

TONY BARBEE vs. GEORGIA SOUTHERN

Auburn head coach Tony Barbee is 2-0 coaching against Georgia Southern winning last year in Auburn and while at UTEP when the Miners defeated the Eagles 96-79 on Nov. 18, 2008, in El Paso, Texas.

Third-year Georgia Southern coach Charlton Young is 0-2 vs. Auburn after losing to the Tigers the past two seasons.

Barbee is 1-0 coaching against Young.

CY RETURNS

Georgia Southern is coached by former Auburn assistant Charlton Young, who is in his third year as head coach of his alma mater. Young spent seven years at

Auburn from 1994-96 as an administrative assistant and 1996-97 and 2000-04 as an assistant.

3 GAMES IN 6 DAYS

Auburn returns from Hawaii by playing three games in six days beginning Friday vs. Georgia Southern. The Tigers play host to Bethune-Cookman on Jan. 2 and closes out non-conference play at Florida State on Jan. 4.

BEST START IN 12 YEARS

Auburn's 8-1 start was the best in 12 years going back to the 1999-2000 season when the Tigers began the season 16-1 and were ranked as high as No. 2 in the nation.

FRANKIE SULLIVAN GRADUATES

Junior Frankie Sullivan graduated from Auburn University with a degree in Sociology on Dec. 12. He is the first Tiger to graduate in three and a half years since Marquis Daniels, now of the NBA's Boston Celtics, earned his degree in 2003.

NOEL JOHNSON ELIGIBLE

Junior Noel Johnson, a 6-foot-6, 200-pound, guard who transferred from Clemson, was eligible to play for the first time as an Auburn Tiger vs. South Florida on Dec. 14 but was injured.

He has played in Auburn's last two games vs. Long Beach State and UTEP while averaging 1.0 point and 4.0 rebounds in 13.0 minutes.

A consensus top 56 prospect coming out of Fayette County High School in Fayetteville, Ga., in 2009, Johnson was rated as the nation's No. 30 prospect by ESPNU, No. 40 by HoopsReport.com, No. 48 by PrepStars, No. 53 by Rivals.com, No. 54 by Hoop Scoop and No. 56 by Scout.com.

Johnson played in seven games last season for Clemson while starting one and averaged 2.9 points and 1.6 rebounds in 13.1 minutes. He played the most minutes in Clemson's freshman class last season playing in all 32 games, averaging 4.8 points in 14.8 minutes per game. He shot 36.7 percent (29-of-79) from 3-point range and 73 percent from the foul line.

Johnson averaged 9.0 points in Clemson's postseason games against NC State and Missouri in the NCAA Tournament First Round. In the ACC Tournament first round game vs. NC State, he scored an ACC-high 12 points on 4-of-5 shooting

4 ADDITIONS

Auburn had four players dress out for the first time this season vs. North Florida on Dec. 17, including Clemson transfer Noel Johnson, freshman Cedrick McAfee, sophomore Josh Langford and senior Tony Neysmith.

Langford, who along with Neysmith were suspended for the first six games of the season, was the only Tiger who played. Langford scored a career-high tying 16 points vs. UTEP and is averaging 7.6 points and 2.2 rebounds while shooting 65.2 percent from the field.

Johnson, who was eligible for his first game vs. South Florida on Dec. 14, was injured and did not dress that game. He has played in Auburn's last two games.

McAfee, a highly-touted freshman from

Memphis, did not play vs. North Florida but played five minutes and had one rebound vs. Florida A&M and played vs. Long Beach State and UTEP.

Langford had been practicing with the team while Johnson and McAfee had not been able to because of injuries.

KENNY G CAREER-HI POINTS

Senior Kenny Gabriel scored a career-high 24 points, including 19 in the second half, vs. UTEP in the third place game of the Diamond Head Classic. Gabriel made 3-of-4 three-pointers and had eight rebounds.

He recorded Auburn's only double-double of the season with 15 points and a career-high tying 13 rebounds vs. North Florida. It was Gabriel's fourth double-double of his career after having three last season.

He is ranked third in the SEC with 2.5 blocks and fourth in the league with 8.1 rebounds per game.

FRANKIE NETS SEASON-HIGH POINTS

Frankie Sullivan tied a season-high with 22 points vs. Long Beach State in the Diamond Head Classic semifinals. He tied a career-high with six made 3-pointers on

nine attempts.

He ranks third in the SEC with 2.5 three-pointers made per game and is sixth in the league shooting 40.0 percent from behind the arc.

Sullivan went 10-of-20 from 3-point range in the three-game Diamond Head Classic.

FRANKIE IN TOP 10 MADE 3s

Auburn's Frankie Sullivan is 10th on Auburn's career top 10 list for 3-pointers made. He is 140-of-392 (.357) from behind the arc in his career. Here is the listing of made 3s:

LANGFORD NETS CAREER-HIGH

Sophomore Josh Langford, who has only played in Auburn's last five games, scored a career-high tying 16 points vs. UTEP. He has started the Tigers' last two games.

He is averaging 7.6 points and 2.2 rebounds while shooting 65.2 percent from the field and 77.8 percent at the foul line.

7 STRAIGHT HOME WINS

Auburn is on a seven-game homecourt winning streak, which is the longest streak in the two-year Auburn Arena history. It is also the Tigers' longest winning streak at home since winning seven straight games in the 2008-09 season.

The Tigers last won eight straight home games when winning nine straight

from the final home game of the 2004-05 season to the first eight games of the 2005-06 season.

IMPROVEMENT FROM LAST YEAR

Auburn, which is 8-3 this year, didn't win its eighth game last season until its 21st game at South Carolina on Jan. 29 while the Tigers' ninth win came in the 24th game vs. Miss. State on Feb. 12.

SCHOOL BLOCKS RECORD

Auburn set a school record with 17 blocks vs. Nicholls State on Nov. 25. It fell one short of the SEC record of 18 set by Arkansas vs. Missouri in 1996. The 17 by Auburn ties Kentucky vs. Morehead State in 1998 for the second most in SEC history.

Rob Chubb and Willy Kouassi had career-highs of five blocks each while Kenny Gabriel had a career-high four blocks. Varez Ward, Frankie Sullivan and Chris Denson had one each.

The Tigers followed that up with 10 blocks against Arkansas-Pine Bluff.

Kenny Gabriel scored a career-high 24 points, 19 in the second half, and Varez Ward added 18 but it wasn't enough as UTEP defeated Auburn 83-76 in the Hawaiian Airlines Diamond Head Classic third place game. Josh Langford added a career-high 16 for the Tigers. UTEP shot a torrid 65 percent from the field in the second half, including 71.4 percent (5-of-7) from 3-point range. John Bohannon had 20 points and nine rebounds to lead five Miners in double figures. Michael Perez added 18 points on 4-of-6 three-pointers while Jacques Streeter added 12 and Gabriel McCulley and Cedrick Lane had 10 each. UTEP had an 8-2 run to push its lead out to 68-61 with 4:09 left on a John Bohannon conventional 3-point play. The Miners extended it to as much as 11 points at 82-71 with 21 seconds left before holding off the Tigers for the win. Auburn (8-3) bridged both halves with a 13-5 run to take its first lead since the midway point of first half at 44-42 on a Gabriel dunk with 15:18 remaining. Gabriel scored nine of the Tigers' first 12 points of the second half. UTEP had an 8-0 run to regain the lead at 54-50 with 8:31 to play. Auburn trailed 22-19 with 8:47, but UTEP scored seven straight points to take a 31-23 lead with five minutes left in the half. Langford's 11 first half points and Ward's 10 kept the Tigers in it. UTEP (6-6) led 37-31 at the half. The game had nine lead changes and six ties while UTEP shot 53.1 percent from the field for the game, including a torrid 65 percent in the second half. The Miners shot 69 percent from 3-point range on 9-of-13 treys, including 5-of-7 in the second half.

coming in the first half. In overtime, Sullivan had a steal and sank a jumper to put the Tigers ahead 85-82 with 46 seconds remaining. Auburn, which was 8-of-11 from the foul line in the extra period, sealed the game when Ross made a pair of foul shots with 5.7 seconds remaining for the final four point margin. After Georgia Southern scored the first basket of the game, Auburn never trailed again as the Tigers scored 15 straight points in the first four minutes. The Tigers played nearly a flawless first half as they continued to increase their lead to 30-8 with 10:49 left and then to as much as 47-18 with 3:26 remaining before holding a 52-25 halftime edge. In the torrid first half, Auburn shot 54.5 percent from the field and made 7-of-14 from 3-point range while holding Georgia Southern to only 26.1 percent shooting and 2-of-11 from behind the arc. The second half was totally the opposite. Georgia Southern, which shot 68 percent from the field and an incredible 9-of-13 (.692) from 3-point range in the second period, was down 25 points with 14:36 to play before finishing regulation on a 42-17 run. Ben Drayton sank a 3-pointer with 5.5 seconds to go to send it into overtime tied at 76. Georgia Southern, coached by former Auburn assistant coach Charlton Young, was led by freshman Eric Ferguson's 19 points and 12 rebounds. Ben Drayton and Zuri James scored 18 points apiece for the Eagles.

SEASON NOTES

FRANKIE

Junior Frankie Sullivan received a medical hardship waiver after only playing in six games last season and has two years of eligibility remaining. He averaged 8.2 points and 3.0 assists in 24.7 minutes in the final six non-conference games, starting the final four.

The Uniontown, Ala., native had left knee surgery on July 27, 2010 and missed Auburn's opening eight games and the final 17 games.

Sullivan averaged 12.7 points, 3.7 rebounds, 2.0 assists and 1.9 steals for Auburn as a sophomore in 2009-10 while starting all but one of the 31 games. He shot 43.1 percent from the field and 37.1 percent from 3-point range.

BIG OFFSEASON FOR CHUBB

Junior Rob Chubb, who averaged 7.6

points and 3.8 rebounds in 20.2 minutes per game in his first significant collegiate playing time last year as a sophomore, added 20 pounds to his 6-foot-10 frame during the offseason.

Chubb now weighs 242 pounds.

THEY HAD GAME

Auburn's coaching staff ranks second nationally among Div. I coaching staffs in points scored.

Auburn's coaching staff (Div. I players only) scored 4,373 points total in their collegiate careers. Tony Barbee scored 1,643 points at UMass, Milt Wagner finished fourth on Louisville's all-time scoring chart with 1,836 points and Tony Madlock had 894 points.

AUBURN ARENA QUICK SKETCH

Entering its second season, the official groundbreaking of the new \$86 million Auburn basketball arena and practice facility was on Aug. 29, 2008.

The Auburn Arena, with a capacity of 9,121, includes over 29,000 square feet of student-athlete space, a two-court practice facility, coaches offices, the Auburn University Athletic Ticket Office, an AU Team Store, the relocated Lovelace Museum and two food courts along with many other amenities.

360 Architecture of Kansas City, Mo., worked with Davis Architects of Birmingham on the design of the arena. The firm of Robins & Morton of Birmingham served as construction manager. The 243,792 square foot facility features chair back seats along with bleacher seating for students. The building also provides improved facilities for the student-athletes, including men's and women's locker room suites with sports medicine facilities, lounges and team meeting rooms. Along with a strength and conditioning center, a two-court practice facility enables the

team another practice areas.

The arena has 12 luxury suites on the arena level that not only open inside the facility, but also opens on the outside of the arena for multiple entertaining opportunities throughout the year. Loge box seating also is available as well as on-site food preparation.

The seating configuration offers better sight lines and moves fans closer to the court. The furthest seat is just 43 feet in elevation from courtside, compared to 60 feet in elevation at Beard-Eaves, with two-thirds of the seats in Auburn Arena being less than 27 feet in elevation from courtside.

The scoreboard features a high-definition video board with full message/information center technology. For the student fan amenities, there is a private entrance, a private court-side commons and food court and court-side seating that permits standing with unobstructed views.

The new facility serves as more than a sports complex. With over 12,000 square feet of banquet/entertainment space, its design affords ready adaptation into a site for concerts, other cultural events, convocations and other community gatherings. On-campus student housing is adjacent to the new arena creating a unique "student village" experience.

2011 FALL SIGNEES

- **Jordan Price, 6-5, 218, G**
Decatur, Ga. (Southwest DeKalb HS)

Jordan Price, ranked 71st nationally by Rivals.com, averaged 19 points, 6.5 rebounds and nearly four assists per game as a junior at Southwest DeKalb High under coach Dwayne McKinney. As a sophomore, he played at Chattanooga McCallie where he was named Tennessee's Mr. Basketball.

He attended the NBA Camp in Virginia for college prospects this past summer and was one of the outstanding scorers. He was named to the 2009 ESPN Rise underclassmen All-American team. He won middle school championships and tournament MVPs leading his eighth grade team to a 21-0 record.

Price chose Auburn over Memphis, Georgia, Georgia Tech, Ole Miss, Michigan and Miami (Fla.).

"Jordan Price is a talented combo guard at his size at 6-foot-5, 218 pounds," said Auburn head coach Tony Barbee. "He can play the one. He can play the two. He can really score. He can run a

team. He has a lot of talent."

• **Shaquille Johnson, 6-5, SF Alpharetta, Ga. (Milton HS)**

Shaq Johnson, ranked 92nd nationally by ESPN.com, averaged 9.0 points and 7.0 rebounds as a junior at Milton High last year for coach David Boyd. The team had eight seniors last season, including four that signed Div. I scholarships.

Johnson won the Under Armour Dunk Contest at Venice Beach, Calif., this past August that was televised by ESPN. The dunk contest featured Derrick Williams, the No. 2 pick of the 2011 NBA Draft. Johnson won the event with a windmill dunk, a high-flying dunk that cleared a 6-foot-9 player and a circus dunk by going through his legs and jamming left-handed.

Johnson selected Auburn over Florida, Georgia, Georgia Tech, Clemson and Miami (Fla.).

"Shaq Johnson is a ridiculous athlete who is still growing in his understanding of the game but has a chance to be a fantastic player because he has really worked on his game to not only be a good athlete, but to be able to shoot the ball out on the perimeter," said Barbee. "He plays for a fantastic coach at Milton High. I am excited about Shaq."

• **Jordon Granger, 6-9, 215, PF Florissant, Mo. (McClure North)**

Jordon Granger (pronounced Jor - Don), led McClure North High to the Missouri Class 5 State Championship last year while averaging 14.8 points, 8.8 rebounds and 3.8 blocks as the Stars had a 29-5 record under coach Randy Reed. In one week last season, he had a pair of triple-doubles in three wins with 14 points, 14 rebounds and 14 blocks vs. Normandy and 21 points, 10 rebounds and 6 blocks vs. Roosevelt and 16 points, 16 rebounds and 10 blocks vs. Jackson.

Granger chose Auburn over Missouri, Arkansas, Illinois, Saint Louis U. and Detroit.

"Jordon Granger, out of St. Louis, is a 6-foot-9, 215-pound power forward who is the kind of power forward that I like that is not just locked to the block," said Barbee. "He is a guy who can play in the post and rebound the ball but can also stretch the floor with his ability to handle it and his ability to shoot the three. He is a fantastic addition to the program."

• **Asaahn Dixon-Tatum, 7-0, 230, C Anderson, Ind. (Chattahoochee Tech)**

Asaahn Dixon-Tatum (pronounced A - sahn) is attending Chattahoochee Tech in Marietta, Ga., this year while averaging 11 points, 13 rebounds and 6 blocks per game. He recorded his third triple-double of the season in the first 10 games vs. East Georgia College on Dec. 5. He averaged 4.6 points, 4.0 rebounds and a conference-leading 2.2 blocks per game as a redshirt freshman at Div. II Grand Valley State in Michigan last year. His 59 blocks were the fourth highest in school history, and he shot 57.1 percent from the field. He had a season-high 7 blocks in only 18 minutes vs. Lake Superior State, and scored in double-figures three times, including a season-best 11 points at Northern Michigan.

Dixon-Tatum chose Auburn over Memphis, Ole Miss, UAB and Evansville. He averaged 11 points, 13 rebounds and 6 blocks in Chattahoochee Tech's first three games on this season.

"Asaahn Dixon-Tatum, a junior college center, is unique in that he is not your typical junior college player," said Barbee. "He is a late bloomer who graduated high school at 6-foot-9, 190 pounds. Now after going to a Div. II school for two years, he is 7-foot, 230 pounds with a 7-foot-4 wingspan and a 36-inch vertical jump. He is extremely athletic for someone who is 7-foot. He has a unique ability to block shots and rebound the ball because of how high he plays above the rim, and he is a developing offensive talent."

AUBURN TRIPLE-DOUBLES?

Never in the 106 seasons and 2,320 games of Auburn Basketball (1237-1082-1) (.533) has a Tiger recorded a coveted triple-double.

OVERTIME RECORD

Auburn has a 45-47 (.489) record in overtime games in its history. The Tigers, who were 1-2 in overtime games last season, have not played extra time this year.

WHAT'S NEXT?

Auburn plays host to Bethune-Cookman on Jan. 2 at 7 pm Central in Auburn Arena. The Wildcats, who are 4-10 on the season and 1-0 in the MEAC, haven't played since a 67-59 loss to Tennessee Tech on Dec. 23. Their MEAC win came in a 74-59 victory over Florida A&M on Dec. 3. The Wildcats have also lost to Stanford, Saint Mary's, Baylor and Jack-

sonville 65-55. Anthony Breeze averages team-highs of 12.4 ppg and 7.2 rpg while Garrius Holloman adds 10.1 ppg and 6.3 rpg.
