- » No. 7/7 Auburn hits the road for the first time in two weeks as it travels to South Carolina for a crucial three-game SEC series.
- » As a team, Auburn has reached base at a .432 clip with the leadoff hitter, including 118 times the opening batter has reached base in 273 tries. The Tigers are also batting .613 this season with runners on third base and less than two outs, gathering 76 hits over the 44 games thus far.
- » The Tigers lead the nation in double plays with 35 and average 0.81 per game. The next closest teams are Campbell and UT Arlington, who each have 27 in 2017.
- » Auburn leads the SEC in walks (219) and double plays (35) and ranks in the top three in triples (13), wins (37), runners picked off (2), and walks allowed (76).
- » Kasey Cooper became the second player in SEC history to amass 250 hits and 250 RBI in a career. She joined Alabama's Charlotte Morgan as the only members in the 250 club.
- » Cooper was also named a finalist for the Senior CLASS Award. She is one of just 10 finalists and is the first player in program history up for the award.



#### **GAMEDAY EXPERIENCE: JANE B. MOORE FIELD**

» Jane B. Moore Field is in its 19th season hosting the Auburn softball program. On April, 26, 2003, the Auburn Softball Complex was renamed Jane B. Moore Field in 2002 in honor of Dr. Jane Moore who served more than 20 years as a member of Auburn's Committee on Intercollegiate Athletics. The complex holds dimensions of 201 feet at the corners and 220 feet in straight-away center field. Since head coach Clint Myers took over the program in 2014, 131,927 have seen a game at Auburn's on-campus venue. In the 16 previous seasons, the total attendance was 122,276.

#### **CLINT MYERS » HEAD COACH**

With the reputation of taking a program and turning it into a perennial power, head coach Clint Myers has taken Auburn softball to unprecedented heights in just three years.

Myers has guided the Tigers to back-to-back Women's College World Series appearances in the past two campaigns, when the previously best finish came with a showing at a regional final in 2006.

Since his appointment following the 2013 season, Auburn has broken 21 records, including 16 on offense, and led the nation in a plethora of categories.

Myers has coached nine All-Americans, with three coming in each of his seasons on The Plains. Before his arrival, the Tigers had five players who were tabbed All-Americans in the previous 17 campaigns.

In comparison with rivals in the conference, Myers has coached nine All-SEC performers, even setting a program record with four in 2015. Between 1997-2013, Auburn had never placed multiple players on the all-conference team lists. Since then, the Tigers have had three, four and two representatives in successive years under Myers.

As impressive as Myers' teams have been on the field, the program has taken a giant leap forward off of it.

Under Myers, Auburn has placed three on Academic All-America and Academic All-District lists, something that had never been done previously. In 2016, the Tigers had 24 honorees on the Academic All-SEC list. Kasey Cooper also became the first player in softball history to be named the SEC Scholar-Athlete of the Year and the NCAA Elite 90 winner.

A 1976 graduate of Arizona State, Myers was a member of the Sun Devil baseball team from 1970-73 and played on the College World Series runner-up squads in 1972 and 1973. He was later selected by the St. Louis Cardinals in the third round of the 1973 Major League Draft.

Myers and his wife, Katie, have two sons, Casey and Corey. They also have three grandchildren; grandsons, Cole and Christian, and granddaughter, Carlee.

#### **INSIDE THE SERIES: SOUTH CAROLINA**

» The Tigers and Gamecocks have dueled 56 times in series history, with Auburn holding a 31-25 advantage. The series was dominated by South Carolina early on as the Gamecocks won 15 of the first 17 matchups. Since that point, however, the Tigers have battled back and boast a 29-10 mark in the series since 2003, including 15 of the last 19.

#### **CAREER VERSUS THE GAMECOCKS**

» The current Auburn roster has fared well against South Carolina. Carlee Wallace boasts a career average of .444 versus South Carolina, while Victoria Draper has hit .333. There's also been a power surge as Kasey Cooper has two home runs and seven RBI against the Gamecocks, while Madi Gipson has three doubles and six RBI. Whitney Jordan also touts a roundtripper and two RBI. In the circle, Kaylee Carlson is 2-0 with a 0.84 ERA and six strikeouts in games against the league foe.

#### AN AUBURN SERIES WIN WOULD...

» A series win by Auburn would give the Tigers their 10th series victory against South Carolina all-time and fourth in Columbia. It would also send Auburn to its fifth SEC series win of 2017.




