On Auburn

They are getting better every week. Good offensive team, balanced—run-pass—hurt you both ways. Defensively, fast and very athletic and keep getting better. (It's a) big challenge. (They) are the best team we have faced this year.

Easier to play a team coming off a big win?

I don't know. I would have to know the team better and the staff better. I don't know either. So, it is hard to say. It looks to me like they are making steady improvement, every week all year on both sides of the ball.

So, when you usually see that on tape, that means one win or one loss usually isn't going to affect their progress very much.

Bye Week Effect on FAU

The extra week helps against Auburn. They give you a lot offensive-ly—a lot of formations and a lot of sets. They use their personnel in

many unique ways. To have the extra week probably helped us, in terms of our defensive staff getting ready.

Have you seen a similar offense to Auburn and what you will face?

Ours. I would say out of all the teams that we have faced, what (Wright, FAU's offensive coordinator) does offensively, I'm mean it is not exactly the same, but a lot of what we do mirrors a lot of what they do, especially in terms of the running game. What we had in the spring and in camp probably gives us something to draw on in terms of what we are going to see.

Bye Week. Did the player watch the game?

They (players) have been watching tape on them for a week, now. The focus for the staff is all on Auburn.

For the players we have introduced them to some concepts. Last night's (Sunday) practice was all Auburn.

Last week's practice was more funda-

mentals, playing fast, scrimmage type stuff. But, all the meetings and all film work has been on Auburn.

Health of the team with the bye week

I think we are healthier. I think we are fresher. I think we looked were pretty fast last night. They had a few days off. It helps, at this point of the year, to have a bye week. How easy or hard is it to keep your team on an even keel, facing Auburn with the program's recent success?
I will say this. Certainly, I was not surprised by the result of that game (Auburn last Saturday). Not one bit surprised. Having spent a week watching the previous games and looking at their improvement, I wasn't surprised. They are still the team I thought they were going into Saturday.

Last year versus Alabama and Georgia and this year?

No, we are at a different place right now. We are better. I think we were still trying to teach our players the basic fundamentals of our offense and defense a year ago at that time. That's why that was scary, playing the teams at that level. We are just more comfortable with who we are, I think. We will go in there and execute just fine... There wasn't fear. I say scary more for coaches. What am I going to call? What can I call against these teams? They give you a lot of different offense. A lot of formations and we really weren't sure the players were ready to handle that yet on that scale, especially on a stage like that. This year, minus the injuries, I feel pretty good about where we are and what we can match up with, get taught. I feel like we can actually, it is a difficult offense to face. It gives you a lot. It is almost like a Wing T/Wishbone style offense, in terms of giving you all the different sways and swipes, different fits and using the fullback and tight end creatively. But, I also feel like we can talk conceptually with our guys and draw on experience. We are going to do this like we did against this opponent and this like this like we did against this opponent and our guys will pick up on it. So, we are much better equipped to probably handle type of game, on both sides

of the ball than we were at that time.

Strength of Auburn and where the team is at?

I will say this, I think it is important that we go up there and play our best game. I think if we do that everything will be fine. I really do. I just think we need to go up there and play our best. Not worry about where Auburn is ranked or what the crowd is going to be like or any of that. We just need to go up there and play our game. Let it all hang out and we will be just fine.

Much more comfortable position than a year ago?

It is. I don't think I could have said that a year ago. To challenge, in a game like this, a year ago we would have had to play way over and above where we were, actually were. But, I have said that from the beginning, that is not who I want to be as a football program. I don't want to be that football team that has that one big upset and then goes in the tank for three weeks. I want to play our best game every week and let the chips fall where they may.

Carl Pelini was named head coach of Florida Atlantic University's football team on December 5, 2011. As the second head coach in the FAU program's 11-year existence, Pelini brought to its helm an intellectual thinker whose coaching experience ranges from serving as a top assistant at one of the most storied collegiate programs in the country, to rebuilding programs and teaching the game of football at the high school level.

In his first season, Pelini focused on shifting the culture of football on Florida Atlantic's campus. He began with individual accountability and all while making the change in both the offensive and defensive schemes. The results were evident at season's end with a national rank improvement of more than 20 spots in scoring defense, punt returns, turnover margin (+35) and sacks allowed. A direct reflection of the efforts made towards individual accountability was in the area of penalties. The Owls improved from a 2011 national rank of 117 (68.17) in fewest penalty yards per game to No. 64 (51.15). Pelini successfully mixed the returning players with newcomers that were instrumental in the shift. He and his staff's efforts to take advantage of the on-campus stadium also came to fruition each home Saturday with an average of 300+ unofficial visitors and the strongest recruiting class, both academically and athletically in the program's history.

Head Coach Carl Pelini / 5-14 Overall

Pelini came to Boca Raton after serving four seasons as the University of Nebraska's defensive coordinator, a defense that was ranked as the best in the nation for a time during his tenure. In combined totals from 2009-11, Nebraska ranked second nationally in pass efficiency defense, fifth in passing yards allowed per game, seventh in scoring defense and No. 10 in total defense. Pelini's role in the Huskers' defensive dominance was recognized, as he was a nominee for the Frank Broyles Assistant Coach Award in both 2009 and 2010, and finished among the top-five each year.

During his last two years as defensive coordinator at Nebraska, Pelini's defense produced six All-Americans, two first-round NFL Draft picks and two conference defensive players of the year. In four seasons as Nebraska's defensive coordinator, four defensive players earned two-time first team all-conference honors - defensive tackles Ndamukong Suh (2008-09) and Jared Crick (2009-10); cornerback Prince Amukamara (2009-10); and linebacker Lavonte David (2010-11). Nebraska also had five first-team all-conference defensive backs in the past three seasons.

In 2011, the "Blackshirts" had to overcome the loss of three all-conference players, three 2011 NFL Draft picks and two coaches. Injuries bit the Huskers in 2011 when they lost the services of 2011 Big Ten Defensive

Back of the Year Alfonzo Dennard prior to the season opener and 2010 All-American Jared Crick for the season in October. Despite the challenges, Nebraska ranked among the nation's top-25 in pass defense and pass efficiency defense. Nebraska held six opponents to 14 points or less, including holding three opponents to their season-low point total and a fourth to their second-lowest output of the year.

Individually, linebacker Lavonte David was among four Blackshirts to contend for a major national award in 2011. David accumulated 122 tackles in 2011, and in two seasons under Pelini's direction, he set the school record for most tackles by a two-year player, while becoming the fifth player in Husker history to boast back-to-back 100-tackle seasons. The Big Ten Linebacker of the Year, David ranked fifth in Nebraska history with 274 career tackles, was a finalist for the Butkus Award, and a semifinalist for both the Chuck Bednarik Award and Lott Trophy.

The selection of both David and Dennard as Big Ten players of the year in their positions came on the heels of a Husker winning Big 12 Defensive Player of the Year in both 2009 (Ndamukong Suh) and 2010 (Prince Amukamara). In 2011, a total of seven Husker defenders earned first, second, or honorable-mention All-Big Ten honors.

The 2010 Blackshirts finished



No. 11 nationally in total defense and ranked in the top 10 in pass efficiency defense (third), passing yards allowed (fifth) and scoring (ninth). After leading the nation in scoring defense and pass efficiency defense in 2009, the 2010 unit achieved its lofty rankings despite the loss of three starters selected in the first four rounds of the 2010 NFL Draft.

Pelini produced a first-round draft pick for the second straight year when Amukamara was the 19th overall player selected in the 2011 NFL Draft. Amukamara was also the 2010 Big 12 Defensive Player of the Year, marking the second straight season a Husker took home the honor. David was named Big 12 Newcomer of the Year, while a league-high five Huskers were first-team All-Big 12 selections. Two more earned second-team accolades and two others were honorable-mention picks. Nationally, four Blackshirts were named first-or second-team All-Americans by at least one organization.

In 2009, the Huskers led the nation in scoring defense, pass efficiency defense and red zone defense, and was ranked in the top 10 nationally in sacks, rushing defense and total defense. Nebraska surrendered just 10.4 points per game, posted two shutouts and allowed only two opponents to reach 20 points. Nebraska held eight opponents to 10 or fewer points, including seven in single digits. Six of Nebraska's 14 opponents failed to score an offensive touchdown against the Blackshirts, while each of the team's opponents failed to reach their season average in points and only one reached its average in total offense.

Ndamukong Suh was the second overall pick in the 2010 NFL Draft after being named a Heisman Trophy finalist and the winner of the Associated Press National Player of the Year; Bronko Nagurski Trophy; Rotary Lombardi Award; Outland Trophy and the Chuck Bednarik Award. Suh was second on the Nebraska career chart

in tackles for loss, including a school-record tying seven TFL in the Big 12 Championship Game.

Defensive tackle Jared Crick set the school record with 5.0 sacks at Baylor University, while Matt O'Hanlon intercepted a school-record tying three passes against the University of Oklahoma.

In Pelini's first season in 2008, the Nebraska defense finished second in the Big 12 in total defense and ranked among the top 25 nationally in rushing defense. In the process, Nebraska allowed 127 fewer yards per game than in 2007.

Pelini joined the Nebraska staff after three seasons on Frank Solich's coaching staff at Ohio University. He played a vital role in helping the Bobcats turn around their football program, including a nine-win season and bowl game in 2006. Those marks were firsts for the university since the 1968 campaign. The Bobcat defense continued the turnaround the following season, ranking in the top 30 nationally in scoring and total defense in 2007.

Pelini spent 2004 as the defensive coordinator and secondary coach at Minnesota State Mankato, under head coach Jeff Jamrog, a former Husker player and assistant coach. Pelini helped the Mavericks to a 6-5 record after a win less season the previous year. Prior to this, Pelini spent the 2003 season as Nebraska's defensive

graduate assistant, where he worked with the defensive line and helped Nebraska to rank No. 2 nationally in scoring defense and takeaways and 11th in total defense.

As the head coach at Austintown Fitch High School in Austintown, Ohio from 2000 to 2002, Pelini rebuilt a program that had not had a winning season for eight years before his arrival. His coaching efforts culminated with a 6-4 record in 2002.

Pelini previously was the head coach and athletic director at Winnetonka High School in Kansas City, Missouri, from 1996 to 2000, and also served as the defensive coordinator at Blue Valley High School in Overland Park, Kan.

Pelini played two seasons at Columbia University in New York, before transferring to Youngstown State University in Youngstown, Ohio, where he earned his bachelor's degree in English literature in 1989. He was a defensive graduate assistant on Bill Snyder's staff at Kansas State University throughout the 1989 and 1990 seasons, and then served as a restricted earnings coach in 1991. He also received a master's degree in journalism from KSU in 1991 and a master's degree in education from Ohio State University in 1993.

The 6 Major Rule Changes for the 2013 Season

1. Targeting Fouls: Automatic Ejection, Part I:

Players will automatically be disqualified from the game for targeting fouls, including (Rule 9-1-3) targeting and initiating contact with the crown of the helmet, and (Rule 9-1-4) targeting and initiating contact to the head or neck area of a defenseless opponent with the helmet, forearm, elbow or shoulder. The foul itself has not changed. These plays have been illegal for a number of years, but the penalty has been stiffened to include automatic ejection plus the 15-yard penalty.

2. Targeting Fouls: Automatic Ejection, Part II:

A player is at great risk of being ejected from the game for a launch (leaving his feet to attack an opponent by an upward and forward thrust of the body to make contact in the head or neck area); a crouch (followed by an upward and forward thrust to attack with contact at the head or neck area); leading (with helmet, forearm, fist, hand or elbow to attack with contact at the head or neck area); or lowering (the head before attacking by initiating contact with the crown of the helmet).

3. Offensive Blocking Below the Waist Rule:

The rule establishes a zone for the offense that extends seven yards from the snapper toward each sideline and goes five yards into the defensive secondary and in the other direction all the way back to the offensive team's end line. Within this zone, an offensive back who is stationary inside the tackle box and an offensive lineman inside the seven-yard zone may legally block below the waist until the ball has left the zone. Everyone else on the offensive team may legally block below the waist only if the block is clearly to the front of the opponent. This only-from-the-front rule also holds true for everyone on the offensive team once the ball has left the zone. In addition, no one on the offense is allowed to block below the waist if the block is directed toward his own end line.

4. Expansion of the 10-Second Runoff Rule:

In 2013, if a player is injured within the last minute of a half, and this is the only reason for stopping the clock, the opponent may choose to have 10 seconds subtracted from the game clock. The injured player's team can preserve the 10 seconds by using a timeout.

5. Player May Remain in the Game Via a Timeout After Helmet Comes Off:

The rule requiring a player to leave the game for one down if his helmet comes off has been modified to allow a player to remain in the game if his team is granted a charged timeout to adjust the player's helmet.

6. Minimum Time to Spike the Ball for Another Play Set at 3 Seconds:

Teams will need a minimum of three seconds from the referee's signal to "spike" the ball to allow for another play at the end of a half. Teams must still execute the spike, but they will have a reasonable opportunity for another play. If the clock shows one or two seconds, they will only have enough time to run a play without first spiking the ball.

FOOTBALL NAMES 2013 CAPTAINS

Florida Atlantic University's Head Football Coach Carl Pelini announced the 2013 captains, voted upon by the team, as senior center Mustafa Johnson, senior running back Jonathan Wallace, senior defensive lineman Andrew Stryffeler and junior linebacker Andre Kirk.

Johnson became a vocal leader in 2012 as a junior college transfer. He earned a starting spot for the 2012 season opener. Following the conclusion of the season he began working with underclassman and newcomers to fill the gaps left by four senior starting offensive linemen. That leadership has continued throughout the spring, summer and pre-season camp.

Wallace led the Owls in rushing a year ago with 673 yards, an average of 3.8 yards per carry, in 11 games played and found the end zone six times. He split time with two backs and may be in a similar situation in 2013.

Stryffeler saw action in six 2012 games and recorded eight tackles and one quarterback hurry. The Sanford, NC native has seen action in 18 games during his career and has been among the team's two-deep since coming to Boca Raton. His hard work lead by example will be a key to the FAU defense.

Kirk, the youngest of the four captains, was fourth in total tackles a year ago and returns as the team's second leading tackler. He is a true junior that will be a part of an experienced defense and one that enters the season deep at the linebacker

position.

Pelini stated that the captains will be a part of each coin toss and will be joined by seniors so that every senior will have the opportunity to represent the Owls for the official coin toss at least once during the season.

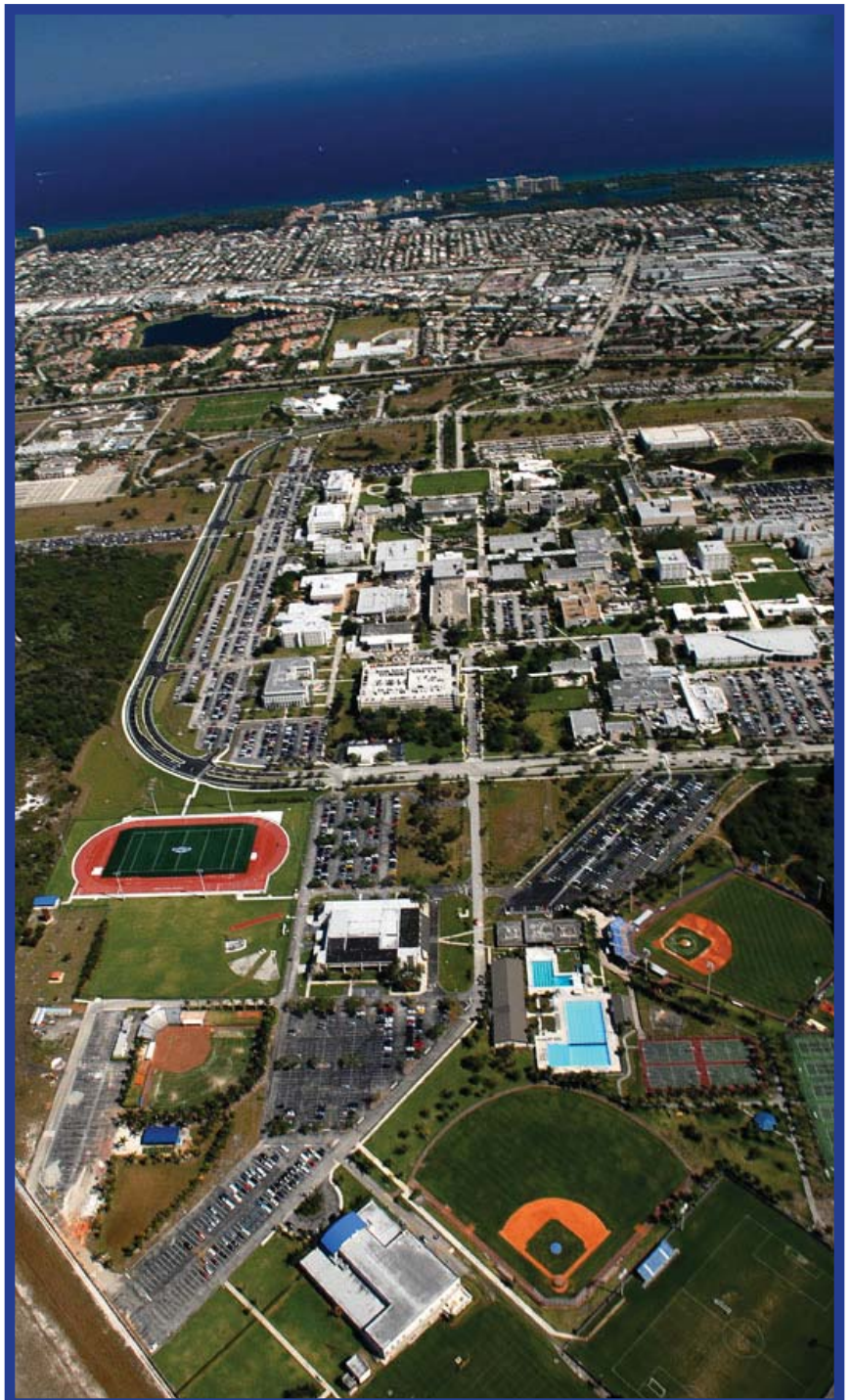
