OPENING TIP

- UAB and Auburn meet on the hardwood for the 20th time in history on Saturday and UAB leads 10-9 all-time.
- UAB is 84-23 all-time against schools from the state of Alabama and has won 78.3 percent of those games.
- Nate Darling is shooting 66.7 percent from three-point range over his last three games.
- UAB forward William Lee is only 26 blocks shy of becoming the school's all-time leader.
- Chris Cokley ranks fourth in Conference USA in scoring (17.1 ppg) and first in rebounding (10.1 rpg).
- UAB ranks first in Conference USA and seventh in the NCAA with a .804 free throw percentage.
- UAB ranks first in Conference USA and fifth in the NCAA with a +12.1 rebounding margin.
- Chris Cokley has double-doubles in five of UAB's first nine games and is 10th in the NCAA in double-doubles.
- UAB has the best winning percentage (.589) of any school in the state of Alabama during the last six seasons.
- UAB forward William Lee ranks eighth all-time in Conference USA history with 241 career blocked shots.
- UAB forward William Lee has 241 career blocks and has the third-most of any current player in the NCAA.

Robert Ehsan begins his second season as head coach of the UAB men's basketball program and his fifth season on the staff after serving as associate head coach under former Blazer head coach Jerod Haase.

Ehsan guided UAB to 17 wins in his first season as head coach and directed the Blazers to their fourth consecutive winning season. Under Ehsan, UAB continued to serve as one of the top defensive teams in the country, ending the year first in Conference USA and 25th in the NCAA with 4.9 blocked shots per game.

Junior forward William Lee became the first player in school history to win the Conference USA Defensive Player of the Year award in consecutive seasons, finishing the year first in the league and 20th in the country with 2.4 blocks per game. Lee was also selected to the All-Conference USA Second Team, marking the third straight year in which he was named all-conference.

Lee is also only the fourth player in league history to be named Conference USA Defensive Player of the Year twice. In addition, Lee earned a spot on the All-Conference USA Second Team.

As an assistant coach, Ehsan played a key role in the resurgence of UAB basketball, as he helped the Blazers capture the 2015 Conference USA Tournament championship and an automatic berth to the NCAA Tournament. UAB would go on to make shockwaves in the second round of the 2015 NCAA Tournament, as the 14th-seeded Blazers knocked off No. 3 seed Iowa State, 60-59, to advance to the NCAA Round of 32.

Ehsan and UAB enjoyed more success the following season when the Blazers won the 2016 Conference USA Championship with a 16-2 record inside the league. Additionally, UAB set school records for overall wins (26), Conference USA wins, road wins (10) and consecutive wins (14).

Individually, Robert Brown, Chris Cokley, Lee and Nick Norton were named all-conference, while Lee was tabbed the C-USA Defensive Player of the Year and Dirk Williams the Sixth Man of the Year.

A second consecutive trip to the postseason capped the year when the Blazers earned a berth in the NIT for the 12th time in school history.

Prior to his time at UAB, Ehsan spent a season as an assistant coach at Virginia Tech University under Seth Greenberg and six seasons under Gary Williams at the University of Maryland, where he was heavily involved with many aspects of the program, including coaching, player development, recruiting, academics, scouting, scheduling and fundraising.

At Maryland, Ehsan was instrumental in securing two Top 25 recruiting classes, and developed players like Jordan Williams, All-ACC, and ACC Player of the Year Greivis Vasquez. He was also involved in the recruitment of Brown, who was originally recruited by Ehsan at Virginia Tech before transferring to rejoin him at UAB, as well as UAB standout Lee and others.

Ehsan played four seasons at UC Davis and started his last two seasons for the Aggies, serving as team captain in his senior year. Ehsan finished 23rd in the nation in free-throw percentage as a junior for UC Davis, which was in a transition period while moving from NCAA Division II to Division I. At UC Davis, Ehsan received the Gordon S. Baranco Award, symbolizing exceptional leadership, unselfishness, work ethic and commitment to the team.

Ehsan earned a bachelor's degree in economics at UC Davis and completed a Master of Business Administration degree at Maryland. Ehsan is a native of Sacramento, Calif., and is married to the former Lindsey Rattray. They have one daughter, Katelyn, and a son, Davis.

UAB CONTINUES ROAD TRIP SATURDAY AT AUBURN

The UAB men's basketball team takes on its second straight opponent from the state of Alabama Saturday at 3:30 p.m. when the Blazers travel to Auburn for a matchup on the SEC Network. UAB has won three consecutive games after posting a 90-78 win at Troy on Tuesday. Junior Lewis Sullivan scored 19 points and grabbed five rebounds to lead five Blazers in double figures. The win improved UAB to 10-0 all-time against Troy.

UAB AND AUBURN

UAB and Auburn will meet on the hardwood for the 20th time in school history when the two teams battle on Saturday. The Blazers hold a 10-9 lead in the all-time series that dates back to the 1982-83 season. In the most recent meeting, Auburn posted a 74-70 victory last season in Birmingham behind 21 points and five rebounds from Jared Harper. Overall, Auburn has won the last four games between the two schools, but the last three matchups have been decided by a total of 11 points and an average of 3.7 points per game. UAB will be looking for its first win in Auburn since 1995.

UAB AND THE SEC

UAB is 31-37 all-time record against schools currently in the Southeastern Conference. The Blazers' last win against the league came when UAB defeated Arkansas 70-65 in overtime at Bud Walton Arena in 2010. Overall, UAB's 10 wins over Auburn are the most against any school in the league. Additionally, UAB has defeated all 14 schools in the SEC at least once.

SWEET HOME ALABAMA

UAB will face its second of three schools from the state of Alabama when the Blazers battle Auburn on Saturday from Auburn Arena. UAB enters play against the Tigers sporting an all-time record of 84-23 and a .785 winning percentage against schools from the state of Alabama. The Blazers will also face Alabama A&M (Dec. 16) later this season in the BHM JAM at Legacy Arena in Birmingham.

HOLDING THE LEAD

UAB won its third consecutive game on Tuesday when the Blazers defeated Troy 90-78 on the road. The Blazers have built leads early in each of their last three games and have held those leads for the majority of the game. In fact, UAB enters play Saturday at Auburn having trailed for only 15:18 during their current three-game winning streak. The Blazers never trailed against both Mississippi College (Nov. 26) and Memphis (Nov. 30).

FINDING HIS STROKE

UAB sophomore guard Nate Darling went 3-for-4 from three-point range Tuesday in a 90-78 victory over Troy and finished with 14 points and four assists. Darling enters play Saturday at Auburn shooting 66.7 percent (8-for-12) from three-point range over his last three games. Darling opening the season 4-for-26 from down town and shot just 15.4 percent over the first six games of the year. Overall, Darling is shooting 31.6 percent from beyond the arc.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE TROUBLE

UAB senior forward Chris Cokley secured his second straight double-double on Tuesday when he scored 14 points and grabbed 10 rebounds in a victory over Troy. In the previous game against Memphis, Cokley had 18 points and 10 rebounds. He enters play Saturday at Auburn looking to become the first Blazer since Rod Rucker in 2013 to have a double-double in three consecutive games.

MAKE ONE, WIN ONE

UAB sophomore guard Nate Darling hit three 3-pointers Tuesday in a road victory over Troy. The Blazers have enjoyed a great deal of success when Darling makes at least one three-pointer in a game. In fact, UAB is 13-4 in games when Darling hits at least one trey. Additionally, the Blazers are a perfect 7-0 in games when Darling makes two or more three-pointers.

BLAZERS PARTNER WITH MIKE SLIVE FOUNDATION

The UAB men's basketball team and head coach Robert Ehsan have partnered with the Mike Slive Foundation for Prostate Cancer Research in the fight to block cancer. Coach Ehsan and the entire men's basketball staff along with all 13 players will make a donation for every block recorded during the 2017-18 Conference USA season. The Blazers have blocked an average of 182.3 shots over the last three seasons and each of those seasons have resulted in an amount that ranked among the top five in school history.

HAVING THEIR NUMBER

UAB senior forward Chris Cokley has enjoyed a great deal of success in two career games against Auburn. Cokley enters play Saturday averaging 16.5 points and 9.5 rebounds per game against the Tigers. Cokley scored a then career-high 25 points to go along with 12 rebounds in 2015 in the last meeting at Auburn Arena. Last season, Cokley finished with eight points and seven rebounds.

REBOUND KINGS

Saturday's game between Auburn and UAB features two of the top rebounding teams in the NCAA. The Tigers stand 13th in the nation with 43.0 rebounds per game while the Blazers rank 30th in the country with 41.3 rebounds per game. In addition, UAB ranks fifth in the NCAA with a + 12.1 rebounding margin and Auburn is seventh with a +11.8 rebounding margin.

STAYING IN THE GAME

UAB senior forward Chris Cokley enters play Saturday at Auburn second on the team with an average of 27.9 minutes per game. Last season, Cokley only averaged 21.7 minutes per game due in large part to foul trouble. This season, Cokley has only committed 12 fouls and averages just 1.3 fouls per game. In addition, Cokley has only reached three fouls in a game once this season (Richmond). Last season, Cokley had 12 fouls by the fourth game of the season and had two games with at least three fouls.

FREE IS GOOD

UAB went 13-for-18 from the free throw line and shot 72.2 percent Tuesday against Troy. The Blazers enter Saturday at Auburn with five games over 80.0 percent from the charity stripe thus far this season and lead Conference USA and rank seventh in the NCAA by shooting 80.4 percent from the free throw line overall. Junior Jalen Perry paces the team at 91.3 percent from the stripe having made 21 of his 23 attempts.

CRASHING THE GLASS

UAB grabbed 40 rebounds Tuesday against Troy and finished with 20 more boards than the Trojans. The Blazers have now recorded more rebounds than all nine of their opponents and enter Saturday against Auburn ranked first in Conference USA and fifth in the NCAA with a +12.1 rebounding margin.

MOVING ON UP

UAB senior forward William Lee blocked one shot Nov. 30 against Memphis and continues to showcase his ability as one of the top shot blockers in Conference USA history. In fact, Lee ranks eighth all-time in Conference USA history with 241 career rejections. Lee needs four more blocks to tie Bamba Fall of SMU to move into seventh place. Fall played for the Mustangs from 2006-09. Jerome Jordan of Tulsa has the most all-time blocks in C-USA history with 333. Jordan played for the Golden Hurricanes from 2007-10.

LET'S GET TO TEN

UAB has proven especially good during the Robert Ehsan era when leading by 10 points at any point during a game. In fact, the Blazers are already 6-0 this season when building a 10-point lead and 19-1 all-time under Ehsan. Last season UAB had a 13-1 record in games in which it led by at least 10 points.

CLIMBING THE CHARTS

UAB senior forward William Lee grabbed seven rebounds Tuesday against Troy to up his career total to 672 to move into fifth place all-time at UAB. Lee is now 74 rebounds shy of moving into fourth place all time at UAB. Teammate Chris Cokley tallied 10 boards against the Trojans and ranks sixth all-time at UAB with 671.

LENDING A HELPING HAND

UAB junior guard Nick Norton delivered five assists Nov. 30 in an 71-56 victory over Memphis. Norton has proven to be one of the top distributors in the NCAA during his career in Birmingham and now has 36 games with at least five assists. The Blazers have enjoyed a great deal of success when Norton collects at least five helpers, as UAB owns a 25-11 record when he reaches that mark.

MAN AMONG BOYS

UAB senior forward Chris Cokley has been nothing short of dominant this season and enters Saturday against Auburn averaging a double-double with 17.7 points and 10.1 rebounds per game. Cokley ranks fourth in Conference USA in scoring and first in rebounding while standing 20th in the NCAA in rebounding. Cokley already has three games of at least 24 points. In addition, Cokley ranks 10th in the NCAA with five double-doubles so far this season.

THIS IS OUR STATE

In addition, the Blazers account for 45.2 percent of its scoring from inside the paint. Senior forward Chris Cokley leads the charge for UAB with 17.7 points per game.

REBOUNDING SUCCESS

UAB senior William Lee grabbed seven rebounds Tuesday in an 90-78 victory over Troy. UAB has enjoyed a great deal of success when Lee pulls down seven or more rebounds during his career. In fact, UAB is 39-8 when Lee finishes with seven or more rebounds. Overall, Lee ranks third on the team with 5.7 rebounds per game.

NUMBER THREE

UAB senior forward William Lee enters Saturday against Auburn with 241 career blocked shots and owns the third-most career rejections of any active player in the NCAA. Minnesota senior Reggie Lynch (348) and senior Tai Odiase (273) of Illinois-Chicago are the only two active players in the country with more career blocked shots than Lee.

HALFTIME HIGH

UAB led Troy 41-40 at halftime on Tuesday and is now 6-0 this season when leading at halftime. The Blazers are now 82-14 when leading at halftime since the start of the 2012-13 season.

ONE OF ONLY TWO

UAB senior forward William Lee begins play Saturday against Auburn looking to join elite company. Lee opens the game with 1,146 career points, 672 career rebounds and 241 career blocks. He is attempting to become only the second player in Conference USA history to have 1500 career points, 800 career rebounds and 300 career blocks. Jerome Jordan, who played at Tulsa from 2007-10, is the only player in Conference USA history to accomplish that feat.

HOLDING THEM DOWN

UAB limited its fourth team of the season to 70 points or less by holding Memphis to 56 points on Nov. 30. The Blazers have now won 35 of their last 41 games in which it held an opponent to 70 points or less. In addition, the Blazers are 72-15 since the start of the 2012-13 season when allowing 70 points or less.

DROPPING DIMES

UAB junior guard Nick Norton tallied three assists Tuesday against Troy and enters play Saturday at Auburn with 337 career assists. Norton ranks 10th all-time at UAB and needs just 28 more helpers to move into ninth place.

Lee now has 15 career double-doubles and has helped UAB to a very successful record over those 14 games. In fact, UAB is 14-1 when Lee records a double-double.

FOUR OR MORE

UAB senior forward William Lee swatted five shots Nov. 26 in a 90-53 victory over Mississippi College. Lee enters play Saturday against Auburn with 21 career games with four or more blocked shots. The Blazers are 20-1 and have won 19 straight games when Lee has at least four blocks.

WE KNOW HOW TO DISH

UAB tallied 20 assists Nov. 17 against LeMoyne-Owen College to mark the 19th time the Blazers have recorded at least 20 helpers in a game since start of the 2014-15 season. UAB is a perfect 19-0 in those games and enters play Saturday against Auburn third in Conference USA with 16.6 assists per game.

WELCOME TO THE FAMILY

UAB head coach Robert Ehsan and the Blazers signed three in their 2017-18 signing class. Scheduled to join the Blazers next season in Birmingham will be Jude Akabukeze of North Marion High School in Farmington, W.Va., Ryan Boyce of East High School in Memphis, Tenn., and Tamell Pearson of Morgan Park High School in Chicago, Ill.

ALL-CONFERENCE DUO

UAB seniors William Lee and Chris Cokley were both named to the Preseason All-Conference USA Team, making UAB one of only two schools in the league with more than one selection. Lee was first on the team last season in scoring (13.2 ppg), rebounding (6.7 rpg) and blocked shots (2.4 bpg), while Cokley was second in scoring (12.1 ppg) and rebounding (6.0 rpg) and first in field goal percentage.

LEE NAMED TO MALONE WATCH LIST

The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame announced that UAB senior William Lee is one of 20 student-athletes selected to the 2018 Karl Malone Award Watch List. Named after Hall of Famer and two-time NBA Most Valuable Player Karl Malone, the annual honor is in its fourth year and recognizes the top power forwards in Division I men's college basketball. A national committee comprised of top college basketball personnel determined the watch list of 20 candidates.

REPEAT OFFENDER

UAB senior forward William Lee was selected as the Conference USA Defensive Player of the Year for the second consecutive season when he won the award last March. Lee ended the season with 80 blocked shots and ranked 20th in the NCAA with 2.4 per game. Lee is the first player in Conference USA to repeat as the winner since Joey Dorsey of Memphis accomplished the feat in 2007 and 2008. Lee is looking to become only the second player in league history to win the award in three consecutive seasons. Kenyon Martin won the award from 1998-2000 when he played for the University of Cincinnati.

WORLD CHAMPION

UAB sophomore guard Nate Darling made history over the summer when he won a Gold Medal with Team Canada at the 2017 FIBA U19 World Cup in Cairo, Egypt. Darling and the Canadians upset the USA in the semifinals before knocking off Italy the following day in the finals. It was the first Gold Medal for Team Canada in the event in its history. Darling averaged 7.6 points, 2.3 rebounds and 2.0 assists per game over the course of the tournament.

DIAPER DANDY

Robert Ehsan begins his second season as head coach of UAB as the 10th-youngest head coach in the NCAA at 35 years old. Maurice Joseph of George Washington stands as the youngest coach in the NCAA at 32 years old. Ironically, Ehsan and Joseph met last season when UAB faced George Washington in the consolation game of the CBE Hall of Fame Classic.

PRESEASON PREDICTIONS

The UAB men's basketball team was predicted to finish second in the Conference USA Preseason Poll as voted on by the league's head coaches. UAB received four first-place votes and is predicted to finish behind only reigning Conference USA champion Middle Tennessee. Louisiana Tech received the final two first-place votes and was predicted to finish third.






