» QUICK HITTERS

- Auburn welcomes Presbyterian to the Plains for the second series since 2014 (AU won 2-of-3).
- Keegan Thompson was named SEC Pitcher of the Week on Monday for the 2nd time in his career.
- Thompson is making his 2nd career start vs. PC; he pitched a 1-hit CG 3-0 W with 5 K on 3/1/14
- Jonah Todd has reached base in all 14 games in 2017 with a hit in 13 games and a RBI in 10 games.
- Daniel Robert has reached base in 29 straight games in which he has a PA since March 13, 2016.
- Josh Anthony is batting .421 (8-for-19) in last five games with three doubles and four RBI.
- Auburn has out-scored its opponents 41-10 in the fourth and fifth innings combined this season, 18-1 in the fourth and 23-9 in the fifth. AU has scored 4+ in the 4th or 5th four times.
- Auburn starters Keegan Thompson and Casey Mize own a combined 0.24 ERA with 39 K & 6 BB.
- Auburn's 8-0 win over Lipscomb gave the Tigers five shutouts in its first 11 games for first time since 1976. Auburn leads the nation with five shutouts after posting only four in all of 2016.
- The Tigers have been the toughest team to strikeout in the SEC so far in 2017 with only 59 total.

Butch Thompson was named Auburn's head baseball coach by Auburn Director of Athletics Jay Jacobs on October 22, 2015. Thompson, who spent three seasons as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Auburn from 2006-08, returned to the Plains after seven seasons at Mississippi State as both associate head coach and pitching coach.

Thompson was named the 2014 Baseball America and American Baseball Coaches Association National Assistant Coach of the Year while at Mississippi State.

Widely regarded as one of the premier pitching coaches in the country, he has had six of his former pitchers make Major League debuts since 2014 including Grant Dayton, Kendall Graveman, Jacob Lindgren, Chris Stratton, Jonathan Holder and Chad Girodo.

In 24 years of coaching at the collegiate level, including 14 in the Southeastern Conference, Thompson has coached seven College World Series participants, including one national champion and a national runner-up, won nine conference championships and made 14 postseason appearances. He has also served as an assistant under three National Coach of the Year recipients.

In seven seasons at MSU, Thompson made four NCAA regional trips, two Super Regionals, won the SEC Tournament and advanced to the College World Series finishing as NCAA runner-up in 2013. In three of the last four seasons, the Bulldogs' staff ERA finished no higher than 3.06. Thompson's 2013 pitching staff was one of two nationally to finish in the top 15 in ERA, strikeouts per nine innings and hits allowed per nine innings.

Thompson is considered one of the top recruiters in the country. Since 2003, he has secured nine recruiting classes that were ranked in the top 10 by either Baseball America or Perfect Game. His classes signed from 2006-08 at Auburn each ranked in the top 18 nationally including the No. 5 class nationally in 2008 which included All-American and SEC Player of the Year Hunter Morris.

Player development has been equally important for Thompson, who has turned 24 student-athletes who went undrafted out of high school into Major League Baseball draft picks.

A native of Amory, Miss., Thompson has coached 24 Division I All-Americans and 30 all-conference honors. Twelve pitchers tutored by Thompson have gone on to pitch in the big leagues.

Thompson had three pitchers drafted in the first 11 rounds of the 2014 MLB Draft, and in 2013 five of his pitchers were drafted including three in the top 10 rounds. He added a first round selection in the 2016 draft.

In addition to his experience at Auburn and Mississippi State, Thompson also spent five seasons at Georgia from 2002-05, including a trip to the College World Series in 2004. While there he guided the development of future Major Leaguers Josh Fields, Mitchell Boggs and Brooks Brown.

Thompson launched his coaching career as pitching coach and top assistant at Huntingdon College (Ala.) in 1993, before returning to his alma mater in Birmingham, where he helped lead the Panthers to back-to-back Southern States Conference championships and in 1995 coached BSC to its first NAIA World Series



berth.

Thompson left BSC briefly to serve as head coach at Jefferson State Community College in Birmingham in 1997. While at JSCC, he was honored as the Regional Tournament Coach of the Year, the ABCA Alabama Junior College Coach of the Year and the Southeast Region Coach of the Year after guiding JSCC to a 39-21 mark, the AJCAA Region 22 State Championship and a third-place finish in the NJCAA Division II World Series.

He returned to Birmingham-Southern as top assistant the following season, beginning a four-year run during the most successful span in BSC baseball history. The Panthers won 196 games and four TranSouth Conference championships and made three-consecutive appearances in the NAIA World Series. BSC's 2001 team posted a school-best 55-11 mark and captured the NAIA National Championship.

In 2002, Thompson joined the SEC baseball coaching fraternity, beginning a four-year term as pitching coach and recruiting coordinator in Athens. Georgia's 2003 recruiting class was ranked 10th nationally, while capturing the SEC title in 2004 en route to advancing to the NCAA College World Series.

Thompson, honored as the 2006 Fellowship of Christian Athletes SEC Coach of the Year, has shared his expertise as a featured speaker at numerous baseball coaching clinics throughout the United States.

Thompson prepped at Amory (Miss.) High School and later starred as a pitcher at Itawamba (Miss.) Community College from 1989-90. On Oct. 25, 2014, Thompson was inducted into the ICC Athletic Hall of Fame.

He earned a bachelor's degree in history at BSC in 1992 and completed a master's degree in sports administration at UAB in 1996. He is married to the former Robin Ashe of Birmingham, Ala., and they are the parents of three daughters --- Anna, Olivia and Madelyn Gail.

- UAB holds an 8-5 record before a three-game weekend set with ULM. Brewer Hicklen is the top hitter with a .286 BA, three triples and five RBI. The Blazers have a staff ERA of 2.35, which is 12th nationally.
- The Gamecocks are 7-4 on the year entering a weekend series at Austin Peay. Taylor Hawthorne has been hot at the plate in the early going with a .378 AVG, 1 HR & 11 RBI.

- For his success, Thompson was honored as the SEC Pitcher of the Week for the second time in his career.

SCORELESS STREAK ENTERS RECORD BOOK

- Keegan Thompson cruised through seven scoreless innings vs. Lipscomb extending his scoreless innings streak to open the season out to 21.0 - the best by a Tiger since 2007 and the longest with no runs allowed since 1976.

EARLY PITCHING SUPERLATIVES

- Auburn recorded a NCAA best five shutouts in its first nine games, surpassing the team's 2016 total.
- The trio of weekend starters: Keegan Thompson, Casey Mize and Davis Daniel had a combined 1.12 ERA, 4-0 record with 34 strikeouts and only three walks through two weekends.
- Auburn pitchers allowed only 18 walks in the first eight games, the second lowest total in the SEC.
- Tiger pitchers Casey Mize and Cole Lipscomb combined for 16 strikeouts in the Saturday win over Holy Cross - the most for Auburn since the trio of Cole Nelson, Bradley

Hendrix and Garrett Bush combined for 16 strikeouts against Florida Atlantic in 2010.

RECORD COMEBACK IN MIDWEEK OPENER

- Auburn got behind early on 2/22 vs. Florida A&M trailing 7-0 after four innings, but the Tigers didn't lost heart. Auburn rallied to win 12-8 posting the biggest come-from-behind win for the program since tackling Jacksonville State 12-8 after falling behind 8-0 on 5/7/2013.
- It was the largest deficit overcome by the Tigers at Plainsman Park since they out-slugged Mississippi State 16-14 after trailing 9-0 on May 8, 2010.

ON THE HOME FRONT

- Auburn opens the 2017 season with 22 games at home, the most for the Tigers in program history. Auburn plays 36 total games at home in 2017.
- Twenty-two games at home breaks the previous mark of 15 straight to open a season from 2003 (12-3) and 2004 (14-1).

OPENING WEEKEND NOTABLES

- Senior Daniel Robert was a key cog at the plate and on the mound in the series with GW. Robert batted a team-high .500 (8-for-16) with one RBI and three runs scored. Robert also pitched Auburn out of a jam on Sunday with 1.2 scoreless and a couple of strikeouts.
- The Auburn pitching staff posted consecutive shutouts to open a season for the first time since 1928. The Tigers issued only five walks in 27 innings with a 2.50 ERA.
- Damon Haecker made his first career start behind the plate in the season opener. It was Haecker's fourth consecutive Opening Day start and at his third different position (2B, 2014-15 and 3B, 2016). Haecker is the first Tiger since Justin Hargett (2008-2011) to start four consecutive opening day games.

NEWCOMERS SHINE ON OPENING WEEKEND

- A trio of newcomers shined at the plate on opening weekend as IF Dylan Ingram (.444, 5

RBI), OF Jonah Todd (.417, 5 R, 2 RBI) and IF Jay Estes (.353) all had strong offensive debuts.

- IF Josh Anthony had a RBI in his first Auburn plate appearance and IF Luke Jarvis drove in four on the weekend.

ERA LEADERS RETURN

- Auburn owns a statistical irregularity in that it returns three different pitchers that have led the team in ERA over the last three seasons. Sophomore Casey Mize led the team with a 3.52 ERA in 2016, redshirt senior Cole Lipscomb posted a team-best 2.53 mark in 2015 and redshirt junior Keegan Thompson burst on the scene with a program-leading 2.01 as a freshman in 2014. Thompson won 12 games over his first two seasons with a 2.49 ERA before missing the 2016 season due to injury.

DEGREE IN HAND

- Four members of the Auburn roster already hold their college degrees. Outfielders Bo Decker and Sam Gillikin and pitchers Cole Lipscomb and Kevin Davis have all earned their degrees. Decker, Lipscomb and Davis are each currently pursuing a second undergraduate degree and Gillikin is working towards an MBA in the Harbert College of Business.

OUCH WATCH

- Senior utility man Damon Haecker has been hit by a pitch 30 times in his career – a new Auburn record. The Altamonte Springs, Fla. native ranks 16th among active NCAA players and second in the SEC.

BIG LEAGUE TIGERS

- In 2016, former Auburn left-hander Grant Dayton became the 49th player in Auburn history to appear in the Major Leagues. He made his debut for the Los Angeles Dodgers on July 22. Dayton joined Toronto's Josh Donaldson and Chicago's David Ross as former Tigers in the big leagues last season.
- Auburn had six players drafted in 2016 led by outfielder Anfernee Grier at No. 39 overall by

the Arizona Diamondbacks. The Tigers have had multiple players drafted every year since 2006 and at least one player selected for 42 straight years, the second longest streak in the SEC.

PLAINS MAN PARK UPDATES FOR 2017

- Auburn's Samford Stadium-Hitchcock Field at Plainsman Park undertook several renovations prior to the 2017 season. Most notably was the addition of a new 24x62'4 foot video board replacing the previous board in left field. In addition, a second scoreboard was added outside the visiting to aide in fan experience for fans in left field.
- More than 3,800 chairback seats in the ballpark were replaced with plans to replace all chairbacks prior to 2018.
- Auburn also added state-of-the-art sound and lighting systems. The MUSCO LED lighting system is used in the top facilities in the world.
- Lastly, Auburn partnered with TrackMan to implement a data analytic system that brings the Tigers to the forefront nationally in next-level player development. TrackMan incorporates video and uses 3D Doppler radar to measure extension, spin rate, speed, exit velocity and more.
