• Clemson travels to Auburn, AL for its second straight road game against an SEC team. It marks Clemson's first game at Auburn since the 1935-36 season.

• The Tigers have won their first six home games, a first since the 2008-09 Clemson team won its first nine at Littlejohn.

• Clemson held Furman to 35 points Saturday, the ninth time the Tigers have allowed less than 40 in the 35-second shot clock era.

QUICK HITS

- Clemson and Auburn have met just once since the 1974-75 season, and that occurred in the 1993 postseason NIT when Cliff Ellis coached the ACC Tigers. Ironically, Ellis went on to coach at Auburn starting in the fall of 1994.
- Auburn's second-leading scorer, KT Harrell, played against Clemson in 2010-11 for Virginia. He posted four points in the Cavaliers' 49-47 win.
- Clemson is No. 1 in the nation in scoring defense and field goal percentage defense, fifth in three-point percentage defense and free throw accuracy, and eighth in blocks per game according to the NCAA's latest statistics.
- Thursday's game will be a homecoming of sorts for K.J. McDaniels, who is from Birmingham. He will have a large group of family on hand at Auburn.
- Jordan Roper posted double figures in Clemson's most recent game against Furman, his first such game since Temple on Nov. 21.
- Sidy Djitte has posted 10 rebounds in consecutive games for the Tigers. He is the first Tiger freshman to post double digit rebounds in two straight games since Chris Hobbs did it against The Citadel and Northwestern in 2000-01.

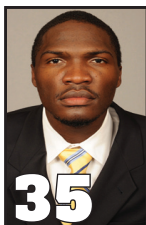

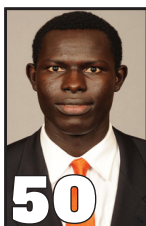

HEAD COACH BRAD BROWNELL

- Named the 21st men's basketball head coach in Clemson history on April 13, 2010.
- Is coaching his 12th season in Division I, having previously coached four years each at UNC Wilmington and Wright State.
- Set Clemson records for total wins (22) and ACC wins (9) by a first-year head coach in 2010-11.
- Led Clemson to first NCAA Tournament win in 14 years when the Tigers topped UAB in the first round in 2011.
- All 11 of his teams have ranked in the top 50 of the NCAA in scoring defense, including his first team at Clemson that led the ACC and was 24th nationally in scoring defense (61.4). Clemson's 2012-13 scoring defense (60.1) was the program's best since 1950.
- Has taken three different teams to NCAA Tournaments, one of only a few select coaches in the country to accomplish the feat.
- Took the UNC Wilmington program to a school-record 25 wins in his final season with the school, 2005-06.
- Named Colonial Athletic Association Coach of the Year in 2003 and 2006. He coached CAA Player of the Year Brett Blizzard in 2002-03, his first season as a Division I head coach.
- Took over Wright State in 2006-07 and guided the school to a record 23 wins in his first season and an NCAA Tournament bid.
- Named NABC District 10 Coach of the Year in 2007 and Horizon League Coach of the Year in 2008.
- Began his coaching career as a graduate assistant at Evansville in 1991-92, helping that program to an NCAA berth.
- Served as an assistant coach to Jerry Wainwright at UNC Wilmington from 1994-2002.
- Played Division III ball at DePauw University in Greencastle, IN.
- He and his wife, Paula, have two daughters, Abby (15) and Kate (13).

TIGER TRACKS

LAST TIME THEY MET

- Clemson defeated Auburn 84-72 in the first round of the 1993 postseason NIT at Littlejohn Coliseum.
- The ACC Tigers were led by Andre Bovain and the late Devin Gray, as the two combined to score 44 points.
- Clemson won despite committing 23 turnovers. The Tigers shot 52 percent from the field, including 45 percent (9-for-20) from long range.

CLEMSON TAKES TO THE PLAINS FOR ROAD TRIP

- The last time Clemson played at Auburn (Dec. 20, 1935), Franklin Delano Roosevelt was President of the United States.
- Clemson is 4-6 all-time in games at Auburn and 52-94 on the road versus teams currently in the Southeastern Conference.

TIGERS ALLOW JUST 35

- Clemson is coming off its second-best scoring defense performance of the 35-second shot clock era, which dates to the beginning of the 1993-94 season.
- The Tigers allowed only 35 points to Furman in their most recent game, a 36-point Clemson win.
- Clemson held Wofford to 28 points in 1995-96, Rick Barnes' second season with the Tigers.
- Two of Clemson's nine games in which it has held the opponent to less than 40 points have taken place this season, first against Delaware State on Nov. 13 and then against Furman on Dec. 14.

- Clemson leads the nation in both scoring defense (51.7) and field goal percentage defense (.337). Auburn will certainly challenge Clemson in both categories, as the SEC Tigers average 75.9 points per game overall and even more (79.8 ppg) at home.

DE-FENSE, DE-FENSE

- Clemson's 71-35 win over Furman was significant for a couple of defensive reasons.
- First, the 35 points were the fewest allowed by a Tiger team since Feb. 6, 1996 when Wofford scored 28 against Clemson.
- The 35 points were the fewest scored by Furman since the Paladins scored 32 at South Carolina in 1963.
- Clemson improved to 23-2 all-time under Head Coach Brad Brownell when limiting opponents to 50 points or less, 4-0 this season.

TIGERS CONVERTING AT LINE

- One of Clemson's biggest improvements this season has historically been an area of trouble: free throw shooting. The Tigers are fifth nationally with a .783 free throw accuracy, second-best among ACC teams.
- Clemson has shot 70 percent or

better from the free throw line just five times in the last 35 seasons. One of those seasons, however, was 2010-11, Brad Brownell's first at Clemson.

- The 1981-82 team holds the school record with a .734 figure.

TIGERS BEAT TWO 2013 NCAA TOURNEY PROGRAMS

- Clemson's wins over Temple and Davidson were important because of the fact that both programs were in the NCAA Tournament last March.

- The two programs that the Tigers knocked off in the first two rounds of the Charleston Classic had combined for 50 wins during the 2012-13 season.
- Prior to the Charleston Classic, the last time Clemson beat two NCAA Tournament teams from the previous year back-to-back was 2009-10, when the Tigers beat Boston College on Jan. 9 and North Carolina on Jan. 13.

SIX 20-POINT GAMES

- Junior forward K.J. McDaniels scored 20 or more points in six of Clemson's first nine games this season. It is the most productive stretch of 20-point games by a Tiger since Ed Scott had six in a seven-game stretch in 2002-03.
- McDaniels did not have a single

20-point game in his career prior to the 2013-14 season.

McDANIELS SCORES 27 POINTS IN ROAD GAME

- K.J. McDaniels tied an individual high under current Head Coach Brad Brownell with 27 points in Clemson's most recent road game at Arkansas.
- Devin Booker set the road game mark last season when he made 13 field goals on his way to a 27-point outing at NC State.
- In 35 road games under Brownell, five players have combined for six 20-point games. Tanner Smith is the only player under Brownell with multiple games of 20 or more points on the road.

NNOKO WITH PAIR OF DOUBLE-DOUBLES THIS SEASON

- One of the keys to the season for Clemson is in the post, where center Landry Nnoko is attempting to make up for some of the productivity lost due to the graduation of All-ACC player Devin Booker.
- Nnoko has come on strong of late, with two double-doubles and three double digit rebound games over the last seven. He totaled 10 points and a career-high 15 rebounds in the comeback win over Temple on Nov. 21.
- Against SC State, Nnoko scored nine of his career-high 13 points in the second half to help put the Bulldogs away. He added 13 boards and another career-high with four blocked shots.

HALL'S STEADY HAND LEADING TIGERS THIS SEASON

- Rod Hall ranks among the ACC's top players in assist-to-turnover ratio this season, with 40 assists and only 11 turnovers in a team-high 298 minutes of action.
- Hall's most surprising contribution has come offensively, where he already has six double figure scoring games so far this season. Entering 2013-14, he had only four in his career spanning 62 games.
- He is the same lockdown defender Tiger fans have seen in the past. In the championship game of the Charleston Classic, Hall helped limit star UMass point guard Chaz Williams to 1-for-12 shooting. Last time out versus Furman, he helped limit Stephen Croone to nine points and nine turnovers. Croone averaged 20.4 points per game entering the contest.

ROPER FIFTH IN SCHOOL HISTORY IN 3-POINT %

- Sophomore guard Jordan Roper may be third on this year's team in three-point accuracy behind Adonis Filer and Devin Coleman, but he is fifth in school history on a career basis from behind the arc.
- Roper has made 52 of 125 career attempts from three, a .416 figure better than the likes of marksmen Chris Whitney (.413), Terrence Oglesby (.395), K.C. Rivers (.378) and Terrell McIntyre (.372).
- He has made at least one three-pointer in eight of nine appearances. The only game he failed to make a three was against UMass, when he played just five minutes after suffering a concussion.

MOVIN' ON UP

- With 30 blocked shots already this season, K.J. McDaniels finds himself 10th in the Clemson record books with 108 career blocks.
- He passed Raymond Sykes for sole possession of 10th with two blocks at Arkansas, and needs just six to pass Glen McCants for ninth place.

- Djitte is the first Tiger freshman since Chris Hobbs in 2000-01 to post double digit rebound totals in consecutive games.
- His seven offensive rebounds against Furman were the most by a Tiger freshman since K.J. McDaniels also had seven at Florida State in 2010-11.

COLEMAN CLEMSON'S VERSION OF THE 'MICROWAVE'

- No player on Clemson's roster can heat up from the field quicker than Devin Coleman.
- He first backed up that fact with 10 points in eight minutes during a frantic rally that fell short in the second half against UMass on Nov. 24.
- Coleman has scored double figures in four games this season, including last time out. He is second on the team with a .450 shooting percentage behind the arc.
- Since he began his career just 0-for-11 from three, Coleman has made 13 of his last 34 attempts dating to his freshman season (38.2 percent).

MCDANIELS GOES FOR 20, 8 & 7...TWICE

- How difficult is it to produce at least 20 points, eight rebounds and seven blocks in the same game? A quick scan of Clemson's archives shows that it has only been accomplished a total of 12 times by four different players.
- One of those players is K.J. McDaniels, and he has achieved the statistical feat twice in seven games so far this season.
- Moreover, he did it in back-to-back games for only the second time in school history. Tree Rollins, a 7-footer, was the first to do it in 1974-75. McDaniels is 6-foot-6.

SMITH OUT INDEFINITELY

- Reserve post player Josh Smith has missed the last two games for Clemson, at Arkansas and home against Furman.
- He will not dress at Auburn due to a stress reaction in his back. Head Coach Brad Brownell said he will be out indefinitely with the injury and did not put a timetable on his return.
