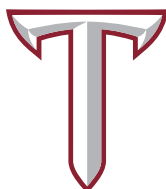

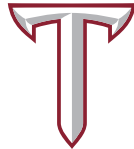

## BY THE NUMBERS

71

The Trojans held the dangerous Samford attack that was averaging nearly 90 point a game to just 71 on Wednesday. The Bulldogs managed just 5 3-pointers.

24

Senior Nick Stampley had himself a night Wednesday against Samford. The Broward County native, scored 17 points, grabbed 12 rebounds and recorded five blocks. Stampley is the first Trojan to record a double-double with five blocks since Tom Jervis had 14-12-6 in 2007.

36

The Trojans hit 36-of-44 free throw attempts on Wednesday. Troy hit at least 30 free throws in a game for the first time since 2013 (Nichols, Nov. 19). The 36 made free throws are the most in Troy's D-I history.

13

Senior Khalil Waters continues to nail his free throw attempts. After entering with a consecutive made FT streak of 29, Waters hit his first nine attempts before finally missing. The senior made his next four, as his FT pct for the year sits at 92.3 percent.

13

Troy has held its three opponents (North Ala, Central Baptist, Samford) to just 13 made 3-pointers. Troy held the dangerous Samford attack to just 5-of-23 (21.7%) overall and to just 1-12 (8.3%) in the second half.

10

Junior Zay Williams continues to blossom down low for the Trojans. The forward scored 20 points and grabbed 13 total rebounds. Zay had 12 and 10 in the second half alone, and recorded his second game with 13 rebounds (his career high).

**AUBURN, Ala.** – The Troy Trojans withstood a furious second half comeback and earned their first-ever win over Auburn 81-77 on Friday night at Beard-Eaves-Memorial Coliseum.

Troy (5-3) had been 0-10 entering the game against the Tigers (4-4), with the most recent loss coming in 2006.

With 3:34 left and the Trojans on top by four, Tay Waller hit a three from the top of the key. After a couple of misses by both teams, Brendon Knox scored two inside putting Auburn in the lead for the first time since it led 41-40 less than two minutes into the second half.

Michael Vogler answered for Troy with an acrobatic lay-in and after an Auburn miss, Brandon Hazzard got a run-out lay-up for a 77-74 lead with a minute to go. Two free throws by Hazzard and 1-of-2 from the stripe by Vernon Taylor sandwiched an errant Auburn trey.

Hazzard finished the game with 28 points, his highest total against a Division I opponent this season. He also hit a season-best seven 3-pointers. Frankie Sullivan hit a deep three to cut the Troy lead to three points with four seconds left, but after a foul Trayce Macon split a pair at the line to make it a two-possession game. With just three seconds left Auburn was unable to get off a final attempt.

Hazzard connected on his first two 3-point attempts of the game to give Troy an early 11-5 lead. Auburn took back the lead with a 7-0 run that was finally halted by another Hazzard trey at the 13:40 mark of the first half.

The Trojans struggled with turnovers throughout the first half. As a group, the squad committed 15 turnovers in the first half and a season-high 23 for the game. Richard Delk personally committed five before the intermission.

Delk redeemed himself scoring 12 points and grabbing 10 rebounds for his second double-double as a Trojan. Vogler added 14 points and tied a season-high with nine assists. Antywan Jones chipped in with 11 points on three treys.

Both squads traded baskets to close out the opening period and a trey by Vogler with four seconds left before the half gave the Trojans a 40-38. Troy led both of its SEC opponents this season by two points at halftime.

Auburn tied the game at 43-43 with 17:33 left, but Vogler nailed his second trey to put the Trojans back on top. Lucas Hargrove hit back-to-back treys for the Tigers, but the Trojans bounced right back with a 10-0 run capped by another Hazzard triple to take a 53-46 lead with 15:43 remaining.

Troy shot a blistering 53.7 percent (29-for-54) from the field and 52 percent (13-for-25) from beyond the arc, both season highs. The Tigers' shooting from deep heated up in the second after connecting on just 3-of-16 attempts in the first half. Auburn hit 5-of-15 after the break.

Auburn went on a 6-0 run to draw within two points, but Hazzard got three the hard way to push the lead back out to five points, 66-61. An 8-3 run by the Tigers cut Troy's lead down to 71-69 with less than five minutes to go.

Troy out-rebounded Auburn 39-36, improving to 5-1 this year when it wins the battle on the glass.

The victory is just Troy's third-ever over an SEC program and the second for Maestri. Troy last earned a win over an SEC team in 2002 defeating Arkansas 74-66 in Fayetteville.



**TEAM NOTES**

**BREAKFAST WITH THE TROJANS**

Troy's matchup Saturday at Auburn has been moved to an 11 a.m. start time to accommodate the SEC Network. The game was originally scheduled for 1 p.m. on the SEC Network. The matchup is Troy's second nationally-televised contest of the season.

**A WHOLE LOT OF FREE THROWS**

Troy converted on 36 of its 44 free throw attempts on Wednesday night. The 36 made free throws are the most in Troy's D-I history. The Troy program record for free throws made in a game was 41 against Auburn-Montgomery back in 1992.

**ALL BARK NO BITE**

In just the programs third matchup in the last 17 years, the Trojans defeated Samford Wednesday night for the first time since 2003. In the wire-to-wire victory, the Trojans held the dangerous Samford attack to a season-low 71 points and five total 3-pointers made. Coming into the contest, the Bulldogs had scored at least 75 points in every game this season.

**BLOCK PARTIES ARE COVID SAFE!**

The Trojans have recorded 13 total blocks the last two games. After recording seven against Central Baptist on Sunday, the Trojans turned in six blocks Wednesday night against Samford. Senior Nick Stampley had five of the Trojans six, including his second half block that appeared on the SportsCenter Twitter account.

**ROARING WATERS**

Senior Khalyl Waters continues to impress this season. The combo guard is averaging 10.0 points this season and is shooting an impressive 36-of-39 (92.3%) percent from the line. Waters has recorded at least 20 points in two of his last three games. Waters scored a career-best 21 against Samford on Wednesday.

**SAY ZAY!**

Junior Zay Williams continues to be a force for the Trojans inside. Williams is averaging 13.3 points and 8.4 rebounds a game this season. The forward has scored at least 10 points in five of Troy's seven games, and has scored 63 points in his last four games. Troy is 3-12 the last two seasons when Zay doesn't play (10-14 when he does).

**LEAVING HIS STAMP**

Senior Nick Stampley recorded the best game of his Troy career Thursday against Samford. The forward scored 17 points, grabbed 12 rebounds, had five blocks and even appeared on SportsCenter! The forward is the first Trojan to record a double-double with five blocks since Tom Jervis had 14 points, 12 rebounds and six blocks. Stampley is also the first Trojan to record a five block performance since Tim Owens recorded six against Middle Tennessee back in 2012.

**HIT THE GLASS**

The Trojans had two players record double-digit rebounds- Z. Williams and Stampley in two of the last three games. Last Sunday Williams recorded 13 rebounds while Stampley had 10. On Wednesday, Williams again had 13 rebounds while Stampley had 12. Sunday's instance was the first time Troy had two double-digit rebounders since Jordan Varnado (11) and Alex Hicks (14) each had at least 10 rebounds back on Jan. 26, 2019 against Louisiana.

**DEFENSE HAS LED TO WINS**

The Trojans were 7-1 last season when they held teams to 65 points or fewer. Troy's lone loss when holding a team below that mark was at Texas A&M (56-52, loss). The Trojans were also 8-1 last season when holding an opponent to less than 40 percent shooting. Wednesday's win over Samford is the first time that Troy won when a team shot better than 40 percent from the field and scored more than 65 (1-3). So far this season Troy is 3-0 when holding a team below 65 points and 3-0 when holding teams below 40 percent shooting.

**REP THE 'T'**

Head coach Scott Cross preaches the mantra that the toughest team always wins. So far this season Troy has taken 19 total charges in seven games. The Trojans have taken at least two charges in every game except the UNCW game where they failed to take one. Troy took 80 charges in 31 games a season ago. Nick Stampley took 32 of those 80 (40 percent).

**Y-2K**

The Trojans have played 1,990 basketball games in school history heading into the 2020-21 season. Troy's 10th game of the year will be its 2,000th all-time game.

**TOP OF THE CLASS**

Troy's 2020 recruiting class that head coach Scott Cross and staff just signed is regarded as one of the best classes in the Sun Belt Conference and is the best class in school history. The 11-man class features eight scholarship players including the first four-star recruit in program history (Burnett), a pair of ASWA Super Five selections (Woods, Miles) and a pair of JUCO teammates (Punter and Pantophlet). Woods, Miles and Burnett all teamed up for Team Alabama in the Alabama Mississippi all-star game. The class is Cross' first recruiting class at Troy.

**BAMA BOYS**

The 2020-21 Troy roster will feature seven in-state products including five new faces (Burnett, Miles, Fletcher, O'Brien, Woods). The five join returners Desmond Williams and Zay Williams.

**CROSS FINALIZES HIS STAFF**

Head coach Scott Cross welcomes two new members of the coaching staff to Troy and promoted one member of the 2019-20 staff. No stranger to the Sun Belt Conference, Cross welcomed assistant coach Byron Jones to the Troy basketball family. A veteran of over two decades, Jones joins the Trojans after three seasons at Air Force. In addition to his time in Colorado, Jones also spent eight years at Fresno State, two years at Winston-Salem State, five years at UNCW, and six years at Denver. While at Denver he helped lead the Pioneers transition into D-I and the Sun Belt Conference. In addition to Jones' hiring, Cross promoted former video coordinator Trent Patterson to Director of Basketball Operations and added Director of Player Personnel Brandon Gilbert. A double Troy graduate, Patterson has worked his way up from being an undergrad manager to the Director of Operations in just four seasons. Gilbert joins the Trojans after a decorated high school coaching career in the Dallas area.

**OPENED WITH A BANG**

Troy opened the Scott Cross era with the second-largest Trojan Arena crowd in program history. The announced attendance of 5,010 was the most since the Trojans drew 5,120 against Mississippi State in the Trojan Arena opener.
