Auburn comes into the game averaging 80.2 ppg, its highest scoring average after four games since 2004-05. SCOUTING TENNESSEE STATE

A member of the Ohio Valley Conference's East Division, Tennessee State heads into Saturday's match-up 0-6, having played just one home game, three away games and two neutral site games.

Tennessee State was picked to finish fifth in the six-team OVC East. TSU is trying to avoid its first 0-7 start since the 1999-00 season.

Tennessee State has been out-rebounded in every contest except one. Against Western Michigan, each team had 37 rebounds.

Senior guard Patrick Miller has scored 36 percent of the team's 370 points this seaosn.

DENSON THE DAMAGER

Senior guard **Chris Denson** has turned in four straight double-digit scoring games to start the season and seven-straight dating to last season. His 87 points scored are the most by an Auburn player to open the first three games of a season since Wesley Person scored 96 points and Aaron Swinson 95 to open the 1993-94 season. Person went on to average 22.2 ppg that year while Swinson averaged 20.7 ppg.

Denson has a career scoring average of 9.5 ppg on .468 percent shooting and has scored in double-digits in 37 of the 74 games he has played in.

HIGH-FLYING TIGERS

Auburn goes into Tuesday's contest averaging 82.0 ppg as a team, which is the highest the team has averaged four games into a season since it averaged 84.0 ppg to open the 2004-05 season.

HARD 2 GUARD(S)

Senior guard Chris Denson and junior guard

KT Harrell have led Auburn in scoring in each of the first four games, with Denson averaging 21.8 ppg and Harrell 18.3 ppg. The duo are the only set of SEC teammates to both be in the top six in the league in scoring, Harrell and Denson are averaging a combined 40.1 ppg while the next closest teammates are LSU's Johnny O'Bryant and Andre Stringer at a combined 36.6 ppg.

CLEANING THE GLASS

Auburn has out-rebounded its opponents in all four games this season and is a cumulative plus-30 on the boards, having grabbed 170 to its opponents 140. Auburn has held its opponents to just 50 offensive rebounds.

ADT, ALWAYS HOME

Senior center **Asauhn Dixon-Tatum** has led Auburn in rebounding three of the first four games, pulling down an average of 6.8 rpg, tied for 18th in the SEC. Of his 27 total rebounds, 17 have come on the offensive end of the floor. The 7-footer has also blocked 9 shots (2.3 bpg), which is third in the league.

POINTS IN THE PAINT

Auburn has won the points in the paint battle in each of its first four games and is a combined plus-50 6n points in the paint this season. Auburn scored 50 points in the paint against Northwestern State and had its biggest advantage in the paint against Jacksonville State (44-24).

AUBURN AT THE LINE

Auburn is hitting .683 percent of its free throws, seventh in the SEC, having taken 123, sixth-most in the league, and hitting 84.

Coach **Tony Barbee** wants his team to hit more free throws than the other team attempts, which Auburn accomplished in the opener against Nicholls (AU made 28, Nicholls shot 22) and in its last game against Murray State (AU made 23, Murray State attempted 21) and was one shy of meeting against Jacksonville State (AU made 23, JSU attempted 24). On the year, Auburn's opponents have attempted just 96 free throws.

ASSIST-TO-TURNOVER RATIO

Auburn enters the week second in the SEC in assist-to-turnover ratio at 1.3, dishing out 60 assists (15.0 apg) against 47 turnovers (11.8 per game). Senior guard **Chris Denson** leads the SEC at 4.3 (13 assists, 3 turnovers) while freshman point guard **Tahj Shamsid-Deen** is sixth at 2.3 (14 assists, 6 turnovers).

A PAYNE IN THE GLASS

Senior forward **Allen Payne** is currently seventh among active SEC players in career rebounds with 344 and career steals with 85. In 87 career games, he averages 4.0 rebounds per game and 1.0 steal per game while chipping in 6.1 points per game. During his three-plus years at Auburn, he has been the team's leading rebounder 15 times, it's leading scorer seven times and the assists leader five times. He has also collected 17 double-digit scoring games. He tied his career high in rebounds with 10 boards in the win over Murray State.

TOUGH DECEMBER SLATE AWAITS

The month of December figures to be a challenging one for Auburn with games at Iowa State (Dec. 2) as part of the Big XII/SEC Challenge, vs.





Fellow frosh **Dion Wade** is averaging 4.3 ppg in 11.8 mpg and **Benas Griciunas** is averaging 4.0 ppg and 2.8 rpg in 14.8 mpg. **Alex Thompson** saw his first action of the season against Jacksonville State and logged nine minutes, scoring a point.

GRIFFIN TO TAKE LEAVE FROM TEAM

Junoir forward **Chris Griffin** will take an indefinite leave from the Auburn basketball team to deal with a personal family issue, head coach **Tony Barbee** announced before the game against Jacksonville State.

"Chris is a very important part of this basketball team and I look forward to him rejoining the team when he and his family are ready," Barbee said.

QUOTING BARBEE...

On Tennessee State...

"They have played a challenging schedule. It has gotten them ready for their opportunity to come here to Auburn. (Patrick Miller) is one of the best point guards in the country, he can score it at will. They have a couple of big guys, (M.J. Rhett) is a double-double machine. They have capable bodies. If we come in here thinking we are going to sleepwalk through we are going to be in for a long night because they have been competitive in just about every single game and they have a guy that can go beat you by himself in Miller. Teams like that are always dangerous."

On guys settling into roles...

"I think guys are getting comfortable in their roles and as we always talk about, make sure whatever your role is, do it better than anyone else can do it. We are getting close to that. Asauhn (Dixon-Tatum) is one of those guys that had a breakout game in the last game in his role but I think myself and all of his teammates are still expecting more because he's capable of more."

On senior Allen Payne being aggressive...

"He knows what his role is for this team, but at the same time he is an effective offensive player. For us to have the type of team offensively that I think we can be we need to have four, five, six guys in double figures. He is one of the guys I am looking at and he needs to be aggressive in his spots."

DENSON GOES BIG AGAINST DEMONS

Senior guard **Chris Denson** had a career night against Northwestern State, going 12-for-18 from the floor en route to a career-high 29 points. The two-guard also matched his career highs in both rebounds (9) and assits (5).

GET THAT SHOT OUTTA HERE!

Asauhn Dixon-Tatum blocked a career-high-tying four shots in the season-opening win over Nicholls and he now has 9 on the season and 53 for his career, which is currently eighth among current SEC players. The senior center is averaging 1.47 blocks per game in his two-year Auburn career. To break into the Auburn career top-10 for blocks, he would need to record 35 more blocks this season.

DUNK YOU VERY MUCH

Senior center **Asauhn Dixon-Tatum** has 13 made field goals this season, dunking home six of them. He unofficially had 16 dunks all of last season.

THE TAHJ MAHAL

Freshman point guard **Tahj Shamsid-Deen** became the first Auburn freshman to start a season-opener since Earnest Ross in 2009-10 and the first Auburn freshman to start the season-opener at the point since Quantez Robertson in 2005-06. Shamsid-Deen responded by scoring five points and dishing out a team-best four assists.

POINT, POINT, PASS!

Auburn's point guard duo of **Tahj Sham-sid-Deen** and **Malcolm Canada** are combining for 12.0 ppg and 5.3 apg. Canada is also chipping in 2.8 rebounds per game, with all 11 of his rebounds coming on the defensive boards.

AUBURN IN THE AUBURN ARENA

Auburn opens the season by playing five consecutive home games in the Auburn Arena. Auburn is 33-25 (.569) all-time in games played at the Arena, including a 24-9 (.727) record in non-conference games.

Auburn boasts two 7-footers on its roster in centers **Asauhn Dixon-Tatum** and freshmen **Benas Griciunas.** Add in freshman center **Matthew Atewe**, who is 6-9, and Auburn can put up one of the biggest front courts in the SEC. Kentucky also has two 7-footers while Alabama and LSU each has one.

Auburn's roster has an average height of 77.71 inches (6-5 3/4).

BLUE DOWNS ORANGE IN SCRIMMAGE

The Blue Team, led by Chris Denson (18) and Asauhn Dixon-Tatum (18 points, 10 rebounds), came back from a 4-point halftime deficit to defeat the Orange Team, 59-50, in a scrimmage on Saturday afternoon, Oct. 26. Denson scored 15 points in the second half, hitting all five of his field goals. Chris Griffin scored 19 for the Orange Team, hitting five 3-pointers along the way.

Auburn used a 15-0 run early in the second half to put the game decidedly out of reach. Leading 58-38 with 17:05 left, Shamsid-Deen hit a 3-pointer to start the run before Harrell went off for nine points, punctuating the run with a dunk off of a steal to make it 73-38 with 12:24 left.

Sean Morgan led Paine with 16 points while Darius Smith scored 14 and Kenny Fluellen 13.

Guards KT Harrell and Chris Denson combined for 41 points as the Auburn men's basketball team opened the 2013-14 season with a 76-54 win over Nicholls on Friday night at the Auburn Arena.

Harrell, a transfer from Virginia who sat out last season, scored 21 points on 7-for-13 shooting, hitting a pair of 3-pointers and five free throws. The junior from Montgomery had 15 points at the half and scored Auburn's first five points of the game, hitting a 3-pointer just 15 seconds into the contest and then a layup just 40 seconds later.

Denson, a senior from Columbus, Ga., did most of his damage from the free throw line. He hit a career-high 11 free throws on 14 attempts while shooting 4-for-8 from the floor to finish with 20 points.

Auburn (1-0) led by eight at the half, 37-29, but used a 14-2 run midway through the second half to put the game away. Denson would score a total of 8 points during the run, hitting a 3-pointer and three free throws to go along with his layup.

Tahj Shamsid-Deen, who became Auburn's first freshman to start a season-opener at the point since Quantez Robertson in 2005-06, finished with 5 points and 4 assists.

Center Asauhn Dixon-Tatum finished with 8 points, 8 rebounds and 4 blocks.

Auburn finished the game with a 39-34 edge on the boards and held Nicholls (0-1) to just 33.9 percent shooting from the floor, including 25 percent (6-for-24) from 3-point range.


