NO. 2 AUBURN OPENS SEC COMPETITION HOSTING NO. 1 TEXAS A&M

The No. 2 Auburn equestrian team returns to the Auburn University Horse Center for a crucial meet early into the season, hosting No. 1 Texas A&M Saturday at 10 a.m. CT. Admission is free for Auburn's Southeastern Conference opener.

"This will be a really good test for us with Texas A&M coming off a good win at South Carolina," head coach Greg Williams said. "This weekend will show us how strong we are and what we need to continue to work on. We're a really good team and, if we can pull it all together at the same time, we're always tough to beat."

The top-ranked Aggies come to The Plains with a 2-0 record and are 1-0 in conference competition after defeating nationally-ranked South Carolina, 10-8, on the road, Sept. 30. TAMU opened the season with a 12-7 road victory at UT Martin (Sept. 23).

AUBURN LINEUP

Auburn's (2-1) roster for the weekend features a handful of experienced veterans in addition to a trio of newcomers.

The Tigers will boast three sophomores, one senior, and one freshman in the Equitation Over Fences lineup. Ashton Alexander, Caitlin Boyle, Ashley Foster, and Hayley Iannotti will each make their fourth start of the season in the event, while freshman Becky

Kozma will compete in her second meet of the year.

Starting for Auburn in Horsemanship is senior Hannah Stephens, junior Kelsey Jung, sophomores Lauren Diaz and Megan Rauh and freshman Kara Kaufmann. Jung and Kaufmann each have three wins in the event for the Tigers this season.

Alexander, Boyle, Foster, and Iannotti will all represent Auburn in Equitation on the Flat. The quartet will be joined by senior Tory Hoff.

The Reining corps will feature sophomores Ali Fratessa and Blair McFarlin. The pair have three wins a piece this year, while Fratessa boasts two MOP honors. Junior Alexa Rivard, sophomore Betsy Brown, and Kaufmann will also compete for Auburn.

TEXAS A&M SERIES HISTORY

Saturday's meet is the 17th meeting between the two teams since they first faced off during the 2003-04 season. The Tigers are 11-5 overall vs. the Aggies and hold a 7-0 mark in Auburn.

LAST MEETING - APRIL 16, 2016

The Tigers and the Aggies last squared off in the NCEA Championship Semifinal with Auburn coming away with a 10-6 victory.

The Hunt Seat corps finished 6-2 against TAMU. Caitlin Boyle and Elizabeth Benson went undefeated in both Flat and Fences, while Ashley Foster captured a point for Auburn in Flat and Hayley Iannotti won her match in Fences.

Auburn's Horsemanship crew finished 3-1 as then-seniors Hannah Loseke and Griffin Knight lead the way with 155 and 154 points, respectively, in their wins. Lauren Diaz also picked up an Auburn point in the event.

Blair McFarlin earned a 139-136.5 victory for the Tigers in Reining.

FIFTEENTH SEASON OF VARSITY EQUESTRIAN

The 2016-17 season marks the 15th year of varsity equestrian at Auburn. Head coach Greg Williams has guided the Tigers since the program was recognized by the Athletics Department and has amassed an impressive 120-49 overall record.

In 14 years, Auburn has earned four NCEA Championships (2006, 2011, 2013, 2016), one Southeastern Conference title (2016), three Southern Equestrian Conference crowns (2004, 2010,

2011) and three NCEA Hunt Seat championships (2008, 2011, 2013).

Individually, Auburn boasts 41 All-Americans and 34 All-SEC selections. The Southeastern Conference first began sponsoring equestrian in 2012-13.

UP NEXT

Auburn continues its homestand and hosts Alabama in an exhibition meet, Oct. 21, at 3 p.m. CT. The Tigers and the Tide will face off at the Auburn University Horse Center with only the Hunt Seat student-athletes competing.

HOLDING ON AT NO. 2

The Tigers stand at the No. 2 spot this week in the recent NCEA national poll.

Texas A&M is No. 1, while fellow SEC opponent Georgia is No. 3. Baylor and Fresno State round out the top 5. SMU, TCU, South Carolina, Oklahoma State, and New Mexico State are in spots 6-10.

TIGERS SPLIT WEEKEND IN DELAWARE

Auburn traveled to Delaware last weekend for a pair of meets and came away with a 1-1 record. The Tigers opened with a 11-5 loss to then-No. 9 Fresno State Friday morning (Oct. 7). Auburn rebounded with a 12-4 victory over Delaware State the following day, Oct. 8.

Hayley Iannotti and Ashley Foster finished undefeated in Equitation Over Fences on the weekend. In Western, Ali Fratessa and Blair McFarlin also went undefeated, earning a pair of victories a piece in Reining.

Against the Hornets Saturday, Foster was named MOP in Equitation on the Flat with an 80-55 victory. Fratessa's 71 points in her win in Reining was the high score for the event, giving her MOP recognition. Caitlin Boyle picked up her first MOP nod of the season in Equitation Over Fences after defeating her opponent, 79-55.

AUBURN TOO MUCH FOR UT MARTIN

The No. 1 Auburn equestrian team officially kicked off the regular season with a 14-6 win at UT Martin last Thursday, Sept. 29.

A trio of Tigers earned Most Outstanding Player nods on the day. Becky Kozma and Megan Rauh each were awarded the first MOP honor of their careers, coming in Equitation Over Fences

and Horsemanship, respectively. Tory Hoft was honored for her performance in Equitation on the Flat.

The Tigers put together a dominating performance to start the meet, going into intermission with a 9-1 lead. The Horsemanship crew had great rides for Auburn and swept the Skyhawks, 5-0. Hannah Stephens opened the day with a 73-69.5 victory and was followed by Rauh's MOP performance, 75-71. Kelsey Jung and Kara Kaufmann edged both of their opponents as Jung took a 74.5-74 win and Kaufmann won her match, 72.5-72, while Lauren Diaz capped the event with a 72.5-63.5 victory.

Auburn went 4-1 in Equitation Over Fences to start things off in the Hunt Seat discipline. After UTM took the first point in the event, the Tigers rattled off four-straight victories starting with a 76-37 win from Caitlin Boyle. Ashley Foster's 86 points gave her the point for Auburn and Ashton Alexander topped her opponent, 83-80. Kozma's MOP ride came in a tight match as she won 92-91.

After the break, the Equitation on the Flat riders came away with a 3-2 mark against the Skyhawks. Caitlin Creel made her meet debut with an 81-75 victory and Foster picked up her second win of the day, 82-66. Hoft earned MOP honors in a 83-71 win. The Reining corps picked up a pair of victories from Betsy Brown and Alexa Rivard. Brown won 69.5-66.5, while Rivard took her match, 70-67.

LEADERSHIP

Strong leaders are necessary for any team to succeed and Auburn's seniors have been preparing to lead for three years with some of the best coming before them.

The Tigers boast six seniors this season -- Caroline Becker, Ashley Foster, Lena Hernig, Tory Hoft, Jacqueline Shilen, and Hannah Stephens.

Foster and Hoft return to the team following All-America performances on Flat in 2015-16. Foster was placed on the NCEA second team, while Hoft received honorable mention honors.

Stephens played a crucial role in Auburn's run to an SEC Championship, earning MOP honors in the title match vs. Georgia after scoring a 152 in Horsemanship.

But leadership is also coming from freshmen, sophomores and juniors alike.

Junior Alexa Rivard weighed in on what the driving force behind the team is this year from the perspective of one of only 11 upperclassmen.

"We definitely have a big target on our back," Rivard said. "I guess what we're focusing on is how we're riding individually as well as a whole team. We are working on staying focused individually but also staying focused together."

NEW FACES

With 12 freshmen and one junior transfer the team is primarily made up of underclassmen, and while a young team means less experience in collegiate riding it does not mean less determination.

The Western newbies include junior Kelsey Jung and freshmen Kara Kaufmann, Cydney Benes, Drew Rogers, Hannah Byrne, Haley Pembroke, Julia Kelly, and Sydney Hoffa. Five freshmen join an experienced Hunt Seat crew in Lillian Wagner, Anna Claire Smith, Bailey Brasington, Becky Kozma, and Summer Hill.

EXPERIENCED RETURNERS

The Tigers return six NCEA All-Americans from last year's championship squad. Sophomore Caitlin Boyle is coming off an outstanding freshman season where she was the SEC Freshman Rider of the Year in both Fences and Flat. She was placed on the NCEA All-Championship team in both events, while being named the championship's MOP in Fences.

Joining Boyle in Hunt Seat are seniors Ashley Foster and Tory Hoft and sophomores Hayley Iannotti and Ashton Alexander. Foster and Hoft were All-Americans in Flat, while Iannotti and Alexander were honored in Fences.

On the Western side, sophomores Lauren Diaz and Blair McFarlin and junior Alexa Rivard highlight the talented crew returning to The Plains this season. Rivard is a NCEA All-America honoree in Reining, earning All-SEC nods in the discipline as well. Diaz was named the conference's Horsemanship Freshman Rider of the Year, while McFarlin was placed on the NCEA All-Championship Team after going undefeated in Reining at the national meet.

Adding to the Western depth are sophomores Megan Rauh and Ali Fratessa. The pair were placed on the SEC All-Freshman team in Horsemanship and Reining, respectively.

EQUESTRIAN 101: SCORING AND RULES

GENERAL RULES

1. In equitation/horsemanship classes, only the rider is being judged therefore no penalty should be assessed because of the horse's conformation, color or movement.
2. Falling off a horse results in elimination.
3. Three refusals over jumps by a horse results in elimination.
4. Any rider not having her mount under sufficient control shall be removed from the ring by the show stewards and shall be disqualified or remounted at their discretion.
5. Riders must remain on the same mount throughout all phases of an equitation or horsemanship class unless the judge or coaches requests a re-ride.

COMPETITION RULES

Riders from opposing teams compete on the same horse. Each rider receives a score. The competitor with the highest score receives one point for their team.

Each rider from each team is given a 4 minute warm-up on the horse she drew in Equitation on the Flat and Equitation over Fences.

- Riders from Home team will warm up with each other. Riders from Visiting Team will warm-up with each other. Riders in Equitation over Fences are only allowed to jump 4 fences in their warm-up.

Each rider from each team is given a 4 minute warm-up on the horse she drew in Horsemanship.

- Riders from Home team and Visiting Team will warm-up together at the same time if the size of the ring allows for this.

Each rider from each team is given a 5 minute warm-up on the horse she drew in Reining.

- Riders from Home team will warm up with each other. Riders from Visiting Team will warm-up with each other.

HUNT SEAT RULES

General-- The rider should have a workmanlike appearance, seat and hands light and supple, conveying the impression of complete control.

Equitation on the Flat

Scoring: Scored out of 100. There are 9 movements as well as a collective mark. These are based out of 1-10 points for each movement and overall position. 1 meaning not executed and 10 meaning excellent.

Equitation over Fences

Scoring: Scored out of 100. Based on the rider's equitation, complete control of the horse, executing the jumps in correct form, and staying consistent.

WESTERN RULES

General-- The rider will be judged on seat, hands, and the ability to control and show the horse. Results as shown by the performance of the horse are not to be considered more important than the method used by the rider in obtaining them.

Reining

Scoring: Base score is a 70. There are 7-8 maneuvers depending on the pattern, as well as a collective mark. NRHA/AQHA patterns 1-10 must be used. In these patterns, there are spins, circles, lead changes, stops, rollbacks, and back. Within each maneuver one can score anywhere from a -1.5 to +1.5 points... -1.5 is extremely poor, +1.5 is excellent, and 0 points added to the maneuver means it was done correctly. There are also penalties such as kick outs, break of gait, missing leads, etc. that can be anywhere from -.5 to 5 penalty points.

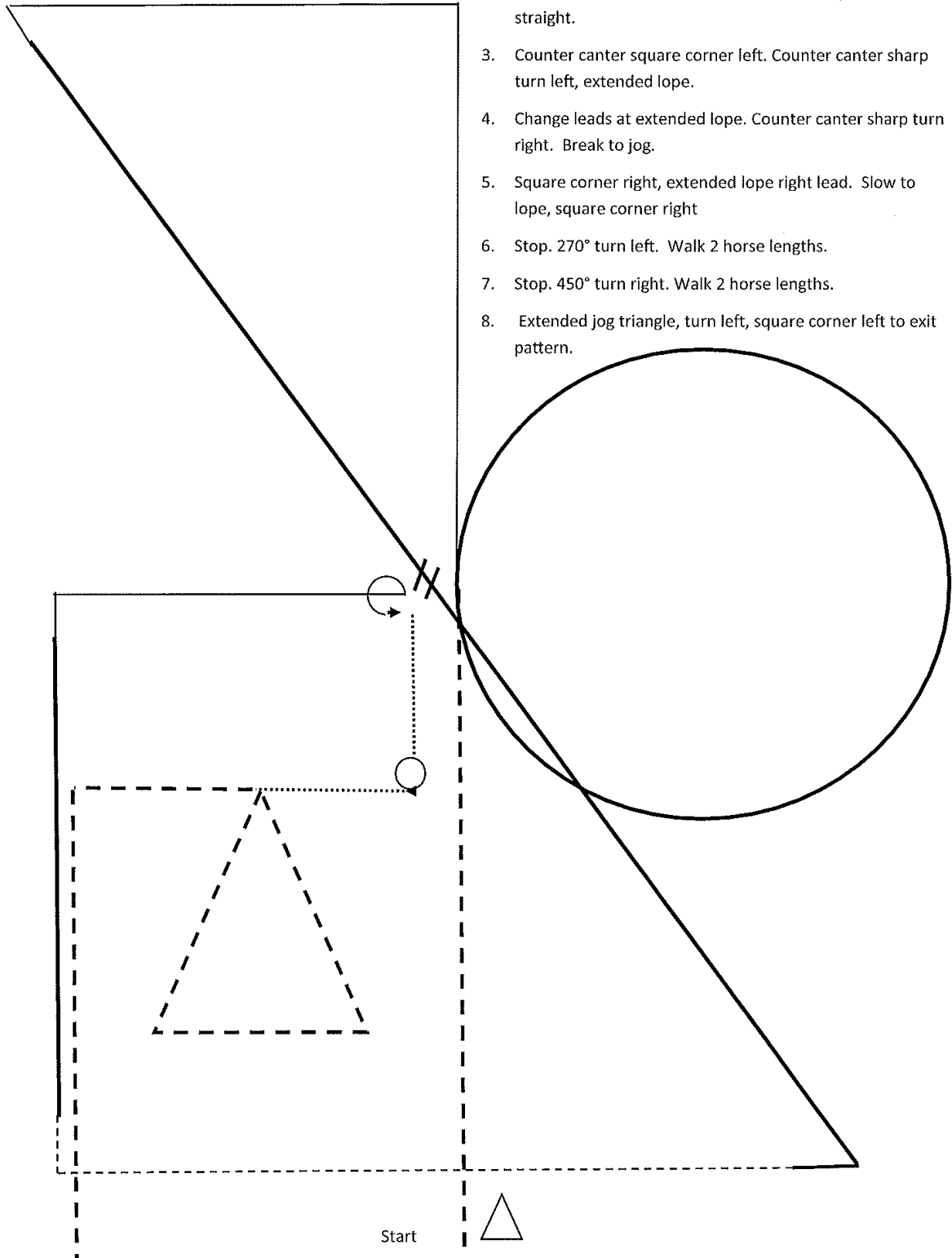
Horsemanship

Scoring: Base score is a 70. There are 7-9 maneuvers depending on the pattern, as well as a collective mark. Within each maneuver one can score anywhere from a -1.5 to +1.5 points... -1.5 is extremely poor, +1.5 is excellent, and 0 points added to the maneuver means it was done correctly. There are also penalties such as kick outs, break of gait, missing leads, etc. that can be 1,3 or 5 penalty points depending on severity.

HORSEMANSHIP PATTERN

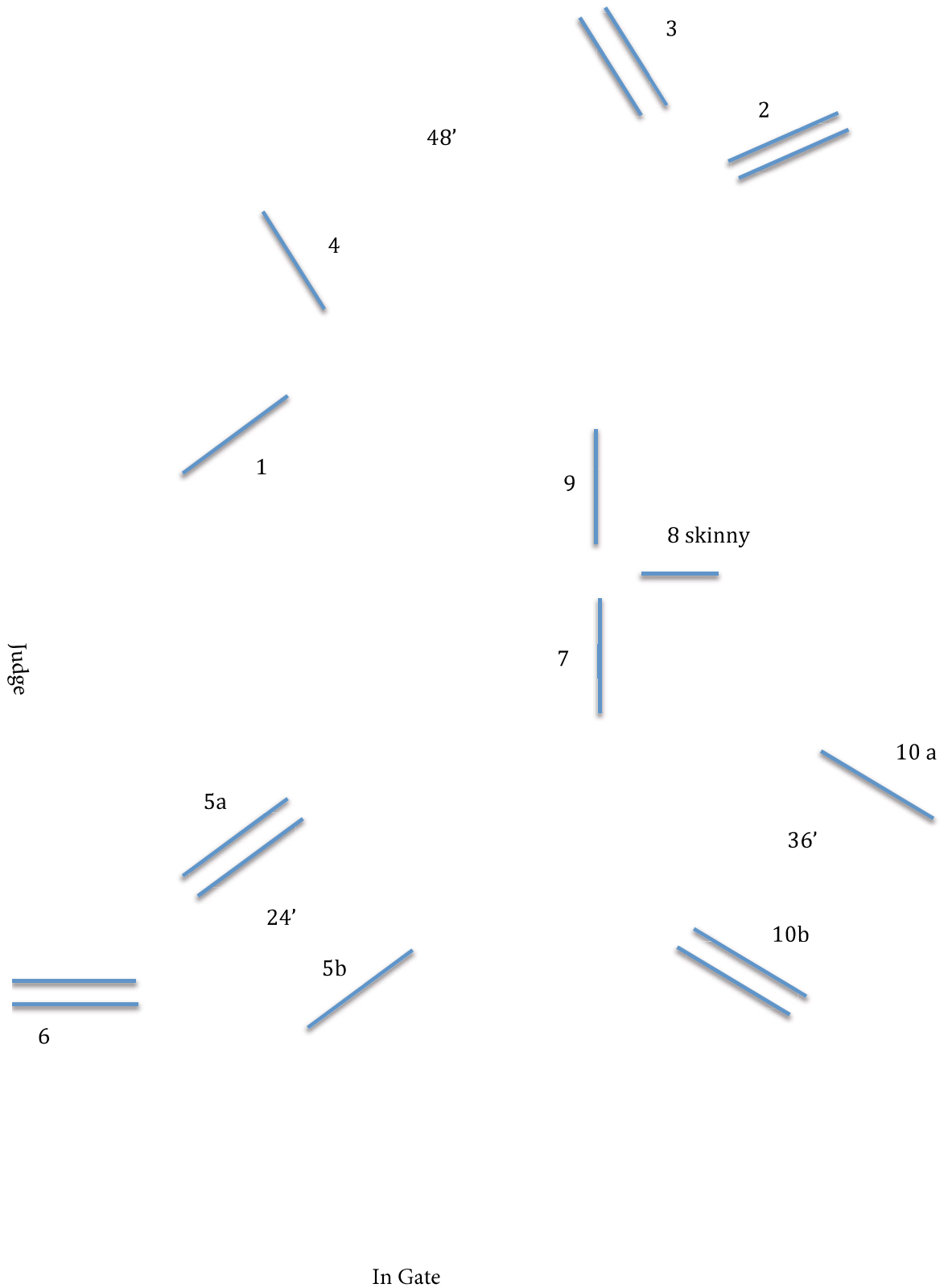
Pattern #35

1. Enter at extended trot. At center lope right lead.
2. Extended lope circle to the right. Slow to lope. Continue straight.
3. Counter canter square corner left. Counter canter sharp turn left, extended lope.
4. Change leads at extended lope. Counter canter sharp turn right. Break to jog.
5. Square corner right, extended lope right lead. Slow to lope, square corner right
6. Stop. 270° turn left. Walk 2 horse lengths.
7. Stop. 450° turn right. Walk 2 horse lengths.
8. Extended jog triangle, turn left, square corner left to exit pattern.

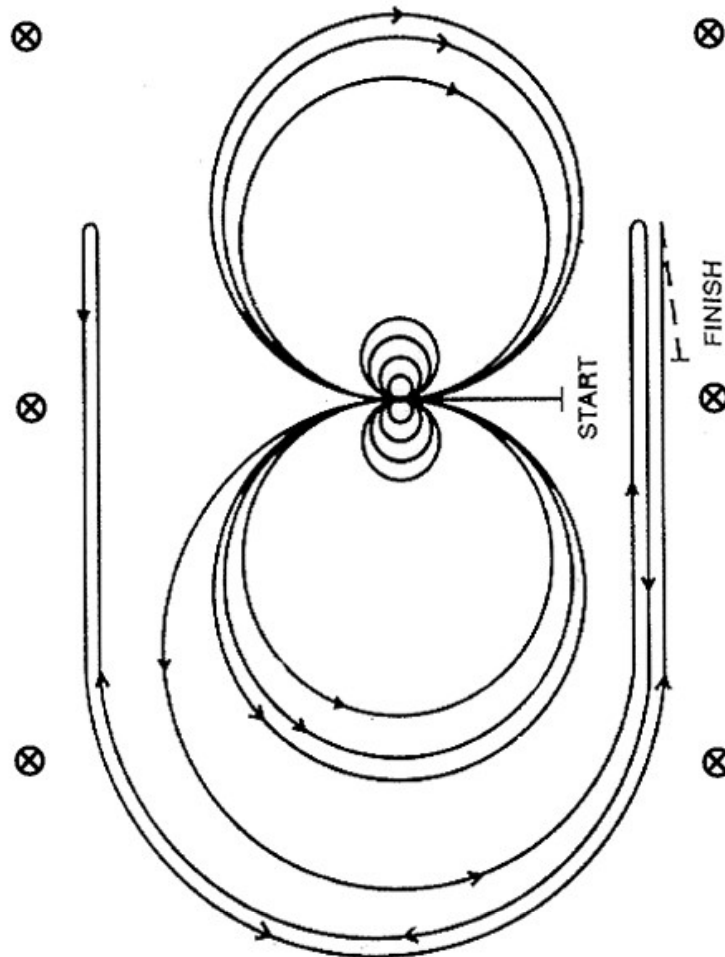

REINING PATTERN

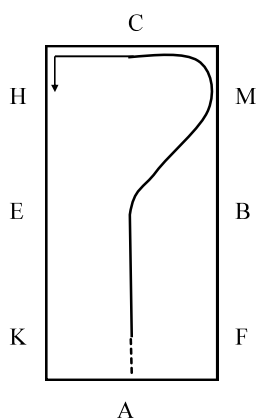


Horse must walk or stop prior to starting pattern.

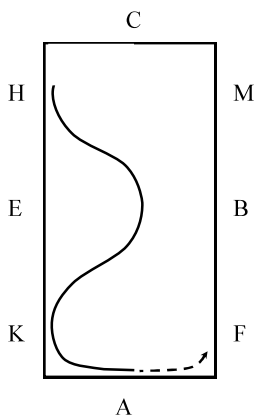
Beginning at the center of the arena facing the left wall or fence.

- 1.** Complete four spins to the right.
- 2.** Complete four spins to the left. Hesitate.
- 3.** Beginning on the left lead, complete three circles to the left: the first two circles large and fast; the third circle small and slow. Change leads at the center of the arena.
- 4.** Complete three circles to the right: the first two circles large and fast; the third circle small and slow. Change leads at the center of the arena.
- 5.** Begin a large fast circle to the left but do not close this circle. Run up the right side of the arena past the center marker and do a right rollback at least 20 feet (6 meters) from the wall or fence - no hesitation.
- 6.** Continue back around previous circle but do not close this circle. Run up the left side of the arena past the center marker and do a left rollback at least 20 feet (6 meters) from the wall or fence - no hesitation.
- 7.** Continue back around previous circle but do not close this circle. Run up the right side of the arena past the center marker and do a sliding stop at least 20 feet (6 meters) from the wall or fence. Back up at least 10 feet (3 meters). Hesitate to demonstrate the completion of the pattern. Rider may drop bridle to the designated judge.

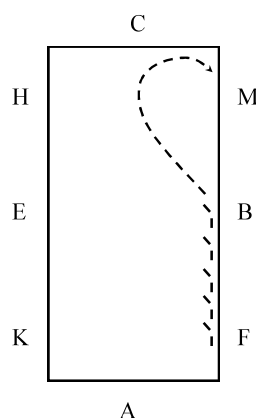
