### » QUICK HITTERS

- Auburn is 5-1 at home and is outscoring opponents 59-17 in six games at Plainsman Park.
- The Tigers turned in a season high in runs (16) and hits (17) Wednesday vs. UAB and have scored 29 runs on 29 hits in two games this week.
- The 16 runs on 17 hits were the most since setting program records in the categories against Alabama A&M a year ago.
- Auburn's pitching staff has allowed 22 runs in the first nine games, marking the fewest since also allowing 22 runs in the first nine games of the 2001 season.
- The Tigers are 74-23 (.763) against non-conference opponents in the regular season since the start of the 2018 season, including 39-12 (.765) on the weekend.
- Bryson Ware has driven in six runs on two occasions in the last six games. He is the first Auburn player to drive in six or more runs twice in a season since Tony Caldwell in 2011.
- The weekend marks the first time Auburn and Rhode Island have played.

**Butch Thompson enters his seventh season at the helm of the program in 2021, posting a record of 179-142 in his first six seasons. He led the program to the first College World Series appearance in 22 years in 2019 and took the Tigers to three straight regionals for the first time since 2001-03.**

Butch Thompson was named Auburn's head baseball coach on October 22, 2015 and enters his seventh season with the Tigers in 2021.

Thompson, who spent three seasons as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Auburn from 2006-08, returned to The Plains after seven seasons at Mississippi State as both associate head coach and pitching coach.

A native of Amory, Miss., Thompson has coached 31 Division I All-Americans and 40 all-conference performers. He has seen 18 of his former pitchers make their Major League Baseball debuts, including 12 since 2014. Thompson has also turned 33 pitchers who went undrafted out of high school into MLB draft picks.

Thompson had three pitchers drafted in the first 11 rounds in 2014 and five pitchers drafted, including three in the top 10 rounds, in 2013. He added a first-round selection in the 2016 draft, a third-round pick in Keegan Thompson in 2017 and the first No. 1 overall pick in program history in Casey Mize in 2018. With Tanner Burns also going as a supplemental first round pick in 2020, Auburn became one of four programs with a pair of pitchers drafted in the first round from 2018-20.

Along with his pitching pedigree, Thompson is also considered one of the top recruiters in the country. Since 2003, he has secured 14 recruiting classes that were ranked in the top 10 by either Baseball America or Perfect Game, including the No. 5 signing class in 2017 and a program record No. 4 class in 2018. His classes signed from 2006-08 at Auburn each ranked in the top 18 nationally, including the No. 5 class in 2008, which included All-American and SEC Player of the Year Hunter Morris.

In 29 years of coaching at the collegiate level, including 20 in the Southeastern Conference, Thompson has coached eight College World Series participants, including leading the Tigers to the program's first trip to the College World Series in 22 years in 2019. Thompson has also coached one national champion and a national runner-up, won nine conference championships and made 17 postseason appearances. He has also served as an assistant under three National Coach of the Year recipients.

Thompson was named the 2006 Fellowship of Christian Athletes SEC Coach of the Year while at Auburn and the 2014 Baseball America and American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA) National Assistant Coach of the Year while at Mississippi State.

Thompson has returned the Tigers to prominence in five seasons on The Plains as he has guided the team to a 179-142 overall record and took the team to three straight NCAA Tournament appearances for the first time since 2001-03, including back-to-back super regionals for the first time in program history. After advancing to the College World Series in 2019 and a winner-take-all game three in the Gainesville Super Regional in 2018, the Tigers finished those respective seasons ranked as high as No. 8 and No. 9. It marked the third time in program history the team has finished back-to-back seasons in the top 10.

Entering the 2019 postseason as the No. 2 seed in the Atlanta Regional, Auburn became the only program to sweep a regional on the road in each of the last two seasons before also becoming the first team to defeat North Carolina in a Chapel Hill Super Regional in 2019, punching its ticket to Omaha for the first time since 1997.

In seven seasons at MSU, Thompson made four NCAA regional trips, two Super Regionals, won the SEC Tournament and advanced to the College World Series finishing as NCAA runner-up in 2013. In three of his last four seasons in Starkville, the Bulldogs' staff ERA finished no higher than 3.06. Thompson's 2013 pitching staff was one of two nationally to finish in the top 15 in ERA, strikeouts per nine innings and hits allowed per nine innings.



In addition to his experience at Auburn and Mississippi State, Thompson also spent four seasons at Georgia from 2002-05, including a trip to the College World Series in 2004. While there, he guided the development of future Major Leaguers Josh Fields, Mitchell Boggs and Brooks Brown.

Thompson launched his coaching career as pitching coach and top assistant at Huntingdon College (Ala.) in 1993, before returning to his alma mater in Birmingham, where he helped lead the Panthers to back-to-back Southern States Conference Championships and in 1995 coached BSC to its first NAIA World Series berth.

Thompson left BSC briefly to serve as head coach at Jefferson State Community College in Birmingham in 1997. While at JSCC, he was honored as the Regional Tournament Coach of the Year, the ABCA Alabama Junior College Coach of the Year and the Southeast Region Coach of the Year after guiding JSCC to a 39-21 mark, the AJCAA Region 22 State Championship and a third-place finish in the NJCAA Division II World Series.

He returned to Birmingham-Southern as top assistant the following season, beginning a four-year run during the most successful span in BSC baseball history. The Panthers won 196 games and four TranSouth Conference Championships and made three-consecutive appearances in the NAIA World Series. BSC's 2001 team posted a school-best 55-11 mark and captured the NAIA National Championship.

In 2002, Thompson joined the SEC baseball coaching fraternity as a pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at Georgia and has been a part of the league for the past 17 seasons.

Thompson currently serves as the large-school representative for the Alabama Baseball Coaches Association and is an All-American committee member representing the South region for the ABCA.

Thompson prepped at Amory (Miss.) High School and later starred as a pitcher at Itawamba (Miss.) Community College from 1989-90. He is a member of both the ICC Athletic Hall of Fame (Class of 2014) and MACCC Hall of Fame (Class of 2021).

Thompson earned a Bachelor's Degree in History at BSC in 1992 and completed a Master's Degree in Sports Administration at UAB in 1996. He is married to the former Robin Ashe of Birmingham, Ala., and they are the parents of three daughters --- Anna, Olivia and Madelyn Gail.

- Rhode Island enters the weekend with a 0-6 overall record after road series at Williams & Mary and South Alabama to begin the season.
- Offensively, Javier Vargas leads the way with a .316 average while Eric Genther is the Rams top run producer with a home run and five RBI.
- On the mound, five pitchers who have made an appearance have yet to allow an earned run.

**ROSTER AT A GLANCE**

- Auburn's 2022 roster consists of 21 returners and 19 newcomers, including seven freshmen and 12 transfers (six four-year, six JUCO).

**LEGACY LEADERS**

- Seniors Garrett Farquhar, Kason Howell, Brody Moore and Carson Skipper have been voted by their coaches and teammates as the Legacy Group for the 2022 season.

**PITCHING ON POINT**

- The Auburn pitching staff has allowed 22 runs (20 earned) through the first nine games of the season.
- The 22 runs through nine games are the fewest since also allowing 22 runs through nine games in 2001.
- The four earned runs allowed in the State Farm Showdown to begin the season were the fewest in three games against Power 5 competition since 2019 (UT).

**STRIKING 'EM OUT**

- Auburn struck out a season high 19 batters in the series opener against Yale.
- The 19 strikeouts were the most in a game since striking out 20 in a 15-inning contest against Arkansas in 2019 and tied for the most in a nine-inning game in the Stat Crew era (since at least 1994).
- The Tigers have struck out 10 or more batters in three straight and four of the last five games.

**SOLID STARTS**

- Auburn starting pitchers are 4-0 with a 1.26 ERA and 40 strikeouts to go along with 14 walks in 35.2 innings.
- Jordan Armstrong and Trace Bright started and finished the Yale series with a combined 17 strikeouts and three walks in 11.1 scoreless innings.
- Bright turned in the first quality start of the season in game two of last Saturday's doubleheader.
- Mason Barnett allowed one run on two hits with no walks and eight strikeouts in his first start of the season Wednesday against UAB.

**THE ARMSTRONGS**

- John and Jordan Armstrong (unrelated) have yet to allow a run in a combined seven appearances and 13.0 innings to begin their Auburn careers.
- Jordan made his first career start in the series opener against Yale last Friday and pitched 5.1 scoreless innings with a career best 11 strikeouts and no walks.

**SONNY STARTS SLUGGING**

- Senior transfer Sonny DiChiara leads the SEC and NCAA in doubles (7) and ranks in the top five in the league in average (.500), slugging (1.179), on-base percentage (.634), runs (14), home runs (4) and total bases (33) through two weeks.
- Eleven of DiChiara's first 14 hits are for extra bases and he has an extra-base hit in seven of nine games this season, including multiple extra-base hits on four occasions.
- DiChiara has reached multiple times in all nine games. He reached safely in 11 of 12 plate appearances from Feb. 20-25 with the lone time he was put out coming on a sac fly.
- The senior slugger homered in each of his first three and four of his first five home games at Plainsman Park.

**RAMBUSCH RAKES**

- Junior college transfer Blake Rambusch, who ranked 11th in the NJCAA with a .444 average a season ago, has collected three hits on three occasions in his first nine games.
- The redshirt junior has reached base in 66 of the last 67 games dating back to the final 13 games of his freshman season at Grayson College in 2019.
- Rambusch hit his first Auburn home run in the series finale against Yale, a go-ahead solo homer in the 8th inning.

**HOWELL'S HEATING UP**

- After going hitless in the first three games of the season, senior outfielder Kason Howell is hitting a team best .478 in the last six games.
- Howell has matched a career best with three hits in three of the last five games and is 10-for-19 with six runs and seven RBI in the span.
- He hit a walk-off homer to clinch the series against Yale last weekend. The walk-off homer was the first of Howell's career and the first by an Auburn player since Steven Williams in the 2019 Atlanta Regional.

**WARE-ING 'EM OUT**

- Junior outfielder Bryson Ware hit his first career grand slam in the first inning of last Wednesday's 13-1 win against Troy.
- Ware ultimately drove in a career high six runs in the contest and matched the RBI total in Wednesday's 16-1 win against UAB, going 3-for-4 with two doubles and a triple.
- Ware is the first Auburn player with six or more RBI in two games in a season since 2011.

**SPEED KILLS**

- Redshirt junior outfielder Josh Hall executed a straight steal of home in last Sunday's win vs. Kansas State.
- It marked the first time an Auburn player stole home since Justin Hargett pulled it off against Davidson on Mar. 3, 2010.

**LIKE FATHER, LIKE SON**

- Senior infielder Brody Moore is the son of former Auburn and All-SEC shortstop Brandon Moore (1991-94).
- After wearing No. 19 and playing second base/utility in his first three seasons on the Plains, Brody has a new number and position in 2022 - No. 4 and shortstop - just like his dad.
- Brody is 3-for-7 and has scored five runs in the last two games.
- Brandon hit .332 in four years and 242 games in an Auburn uniform. Brody is a .300 career hitter in parts of three seasons and 87 games.

**BURKY AND SKIP IN THE BULLPEN**

- Junior Blake Burkhalter and senior Carson Skipper were two of nine SEC relievers named to the NCBWA Stopper of the Year Watch List.
- Auburn is one of two SEC programs with multiple honorees.
- It marks the fifth straight season an Auburn pitcher has been recognized on the list, including the second straight for Skipper.
- The duo has allowed one run one three hits in a combined five appearances and 9.1 innings.
- Burkhalter earned a two-inning save in his season debut vs. Texas Tech and the win last Saturday vs. Yale.

**ONE-RUN AFFAIRS**

- After going 6-11 one-run games last year, Auburn is 2-1 in one-run games this season.
- A year ago, thirteen of Auburn's 30 SEC games, including seven of its first 10, were decided by one run and seven more were decided by two runs.
- The Tigers went 4-9 in one-run games and 6-14 in games decided by two runs or less in league play.

**BIG SHOES TO FILL**

- Auburn is forced to replace its top three hitters and five everyday starters from a year ago in shortstop Ryan Bliss, third baseman Rankin Woley, first baseman Tyler Miller and outfielders Steven Williams and Judd Ward.
- The quintet combined to hit .296 with 192 runs, 50 doubles, 58 home runs and 191 RBI.

**TWENTY-SIX YEARS IN THE MAKING**

- Volunteer assistant and pitching coach Tim Hudson, who began his time on the Plains as a player in the fall of 1995, recently earned his degree in interdisciplinary studies with emphases on health promotion and philanthropy studies on Dec. 11, 2021.

**MLB SUCCESS ON STAFF**

- Auburn's coaching staff has 54 years of experience in professional baseball, including 32 years in the MLB between pitching coach Tim Hudson (17 years), hitting coach Gabe Gross (seven years), strength coach Chris Joyner (eight years).
- Other members of the coaching and support staff with professional experience include assistant coach Karl Nonemaker, director of player development Aaron Everett and athletic trainer Anthony Sandersen.

**AUBURN IN THE MLB DRAFT**

- The 2021 MLB Draft marked the 47th consecutive year Auburn had at least one player selected, tied for the longest active streak in the SEC.
- Ryan Bliss was drafted by the Arizona Diamondbacks in the second round with the 42nd overall pick in last year's draft, becoming the fifth-highest position player and ninth-highest draft pick overall in Auburn history.
- It marked the sixth straight season Auburn had a top-five-round pick, marking the first time in program history to accomplish the feat.
