- Coming off the program's second 40-win season of the Mickey Dean era, Auburn softball returns to the diamond with every starter from the 2022 season, including Preseason All-SEC honorees Maddie Penta and Bri Ellis.
- Auburn holds a 21-4-1 all-time record in season openers and has won eight of its last nine. Auburn is competing at the NFCA Leadoff Classic for the second time in the last four seasons. Auburn went 3-2 in the tournament in 2020 with wins over Notre Dame, Liberty and Texas State.
- Earning national recognition during the preseason, Maddie Penta was one of 50 student-athletes named to the watch list for USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year.
- Dipping into the transfer portal during the offseason, the Tigers brought in three Tigers that are in the mix for starting jobs: Annabelle Widra (Michigan), Icess Tresvik (North Carolina A&T) and KK McCrary (Tennessee).

- » After posting the second 40-win season in Coach Dean's tenure on the Plains and more than tripling its offensive production a season ago, Auburn softball returns a loaded roster that's looking to build on the foundation set in 2022.
- » The journey to Oklahoma City begins in Clearwater, as Auburn is set to compete in the NFCA Leadoff Classic at the Eddie C. Moore Complex.
- » Auburn opens the tournament on Friday, Feb. 10 with a doubleheader against St. John's and Fordham. Auburn will also face Pitt, Indiana and Illinois over the three-day tournament.
- » This marks the second time since the 2020 season that the Tigers have opened their season with the NFCA Leadoff Classic. Auburn went 3-2 in the tournament in 2020 with wins over Notre Dame, Liberty and Texas State.
- » All five contests will be streamed for free via the Game Charger app while JJ Jackson will have the radio call for every game on the Auburn Sports Network.

AN AUBURN WIN WOULD...

» Be Auburn's ninth season-opening win over the last 10 seasons.

INSIDE THE SERIES: NFCA LEADOFF CLASSIC FIELD

- » Auburn is meeting St. John's for the fourth time in program history. The Red Storm competed in the Tiger Invitational last season with Auburn picking up a pair of run-rule victories over opening weekend.
- » The Tigers have won all three previous meetings by the run rule and has outscored the Red Storm 32 to 0. Friday's meeting will be the first between the two squads at a neutral site.

FORDHAM

» The Tigers are renewing their history against the Rams after a seven-year hiatus. The lone meeting in program history happened in Clearwater on Feb. 21, 2016 with Auburn knocking off Fordham 18-1 in five innings.

PITT

» Auburn is meeting Pitt for the first time on the softball diamond. Under head coach Mickey Dean, Auburn is 17-1 in meetings against first-time opponents.

INDIANA

- » The most frequent opponent for the Tigers among the field, Auburn holds a 4-0 advantage over Indiana. The two teams meet twice in 2000, once in 2009 with the most recent meeting coming on the Plains in 2016 as Auburn held on for an 8-7 victory in eight innings.
- » All four previous meetings have been decided by two runs or less with three one-run victories for Auburn.

ILLINOIS

- » Auburn is looking to take the advantage in the all-time series against Illinois as the series is currently tied up at one game apiece.
- » Both previous meetings have come in Clearwater with the most recent during the 2020 season with the Illini squeaking out a 2-0 victory.

- » Penta returns to the circle after leading the SEC in wins (24), innings pitched (195.0) and earned run average (1.76). The right-handed finished second in the league with 269 strikeouts to become just the seventh pitcher in program history to record 250+ strikeouts in a season. Penta went on the set the sophomore strikeout record.
- » Bringing the power to the plate, 20 of Ellis's 45 hits went for extra bases as she led all freshmen and finished third overall in the SEC with 20 home runs a mark that broke All-American Kasey Cooper's freshman record. Adding eight doubles and a triple to her power numbers, Ellis closed the season tied for fifth in Auburn single-season history with a .772 slugging percentage. Last season, Penta recorded the most strikeouts by any Tiger since 2010 and just the seventh Tiger in program history to hit 250+ strikeouts in a season.
- » Etching her name on both freshman, sophomore and single-season records, Penta will enter 2023 with her name already on the top 10 in numerous career rankings. - » Needing a dramatic uptick on the offensive side of the ball, Auburn tripled its home run production behind some impressive work in the weight room and a talented freshman class looking to build off the foundation it set.
- » Aubum's 86 home runs last season were the third most by any Aubum team behind only the 2016 and 2015 teams. More impressive is that 38 of Aubum's 86 home runs last season came against Southeastern Conference opponents, a record for the Tigers in legage play.
- » Auburn closed the 2022 season ranked in the top five in the Southeastern Conference in botting average, slugging percentage, doubles, triples, home runs and total bases.
- » Twelve different Tigers have gone yard this season with 11 student-athletes hitting multiple home runs. The top three freshman home run producers in program history Bri Ellis (20), Nelia Peralta (10) and Jessie Blaine (9) all return for sophomore campaigns.

- » Ellis led the team and ranked third in the SEC with 20 home runs to surpass Kasey Cooper (2014) for the program's freshman home run record. Ellis also finished tied for second in single-season history for home runs.
- » Taking down one Cooper record over the course of her freshman campaign, Ellis will need to slug 19 home runs in 2023 to take down the program's sophomore record held by Cooper. MS. STEAL YOUR BASE - UPDATE

- » The speedster is returning for her junior campaign ready to wreck havoc on the bases. Makayla Packer led the team last season with 21 steals on 25 attempts. Packer finished seventh overall in the league in total steals while finishing sixth with an average of 0.42 stolen bases per game.
- » After recording the second most steals by a Tiger freshman in her debut season, Packer shattered the program's sophomore record for steals, surpassing Shannon Anderson's record of 19 that had stood since 2003. Her steals total last season stood tied for third in a single season at Auburn.
- » Packer enters her junior season with the program's highest career stolen base percentage (.902) while ranking in the top five in program history for career steals. 





HEAD COACH MICKEY DEAN

Mickey Dean enters his sixth season as the head coach of the Auburn softball program. In 16 years at the collegiate level, Dean has coached 11 NCAA Tournament teams, including one super regional participant, and won nine conference championships. He is one of four active head coaches to led three different programs to the NCAA Tournament

A native of Elkton, Va., Dean has guided 81 all-conference players, 45 all-region honorees and eight all-Americans, including 2017 National Player of the Year, Megan Good. He has also been touted as the conference coach of the year eight times.

During his time on the Plains, Dean has guided the Tigers to \boldsymbol{a} 163-90 overall record behind a pair of 40-win seasons. He has quided the Tigers to four NCAA Regional appearances. Dean's resume at Auburn also includes five NFCA All-Region selections and five All-SEC selections. During his tenure, Bri Ellis became the program's first undisputed SEC Freshman of the Year. He also guided slugger Kendall Veach to All-America honors from Softball America in 2019.

Dean's fifth season on the Plains featured a massive overhaul to the program's offense. After opening the season with a 24-1 record, the Tigers would end 2022 with a total of 40 victories, including top-10 wins over No. 8 Kentucky and No. 7 Florida. Dean also helped Auburn to the program's 900th victory with a 10-0 victory at Jacksonville State on Feb. 23, 2022. The Tigers earned a postseason berth as the two-seeded team at the Clemson

More than tripling its home run numbers from a season ago, Auburn finished 14th in the nation with 86. The mark was the third highest total in a season in school history. Auburn's offense was also highlighted with top-five season performances in team batting average, slugging percentage, runs scored, triples, home runs, RBI and total bases.

Auburn's revitalized offense was due in part to the 2022 freshman class. Auburn's top three RBI producers of the 2022 season were freshmen Bri Ellis, Nelia Peralta and Jessie Blaine. Ellis was the breakout star as she shattered the program's freshman home run record with 20, the third most in the SEC. A top-10 finalist for Schutt Sports/NFCA National Freshman of the Year, Ellis was also tabbed to Extra Inning Softball's All-Freshman Team and added Second Team All-SEC honors after leading the Tigers in home runs, RBI and slugging percentage.

Due to injuries in the pitching circle, Maddie Penta became the workhorse in the circle for the Tigers and shattered records along the way to become the program's pitcher to ever earn NFCA First Team All-Region honors. Penta led the SEC in victories (23) and finished second in strikeouts (258). She was the first pitcher since 2010 to surpass 250 strikeouts in a season and went on to set the program's sophomore strikeout record. Penta finished in the top five in four Auburn single-season pitching records, including wins, starts, strikeouts per seven innings and lowest batting average against. Her efforts also earned her First Team All-SEC accolades.

In his fourth season at Auburn, Dean navigated the Tigers through the uncertainties of playing a season during the heart of COVID-19 pandemic. He carried Auburn to 27 victories, highlighted by the program's first victories in Columbia, Mo., College Station, Texas, and Baton Rouge, La., since 2015. The Tigers also upset No. 12 Kentucky picking up the series win at Jane B. Moore Field.

Dean would earn his 100th victory as head coach of the Tigers on Feb. 20, 2021, as Auburn upset No. 10 South Carolina 5-4 in nonconference competition during the Osprey/Dolphin Invitational in Jacksonville, Fla. Dean would add his 600th career head coaching victory on April 25, 2021, when Auburn took a 3-1 victory over Ole Miss in Oxford, Miss.

The 2021 season was highlighted by the breakout performances

from pitching freshman duo Shelby Lowe and Maddie Penta. The pair combined for a total of five SEC Freshman of the Week honors becoming just the second and third Auburn freshman pitchers to win the award multiple times in a season. Penta set the program record with three freshman weekly honors from the league office.

After becoming the first Auburn freshman pitcher to toss a no-hitter in a season opener in Auburn's 8-0 win over Southeast Missouri State, Penta would close her debut season with a pair of no-hitters. Penta would toss Auburn's first seven-inning no-hitter since 2012 in a 5-0 victory over IUPUI. She was the first Auburn pitcher since Marcy Harper in 2014 to pitch multiple no-hitters in the same season.

Lowe turned in one of the most dominating pitching performances by an Auburn freshman in school history. Lowe closed the year setting Auburn's single-season record for fewest walks allowed per seven innings (1.18), while also ranking sixth in single-season history for earned run average (1.48), eighth for longest scoreless innings streak (24.1) and 10th in strikeouts (179) and complete games (15). Her 179 strikeouts were the most by an Auburn pitcher in over a decade. Lowe recorded the second most strikeouts and second lowest ERA by an Auburn freshman pitcher in program

Lowe and Penta both surpassed 100 strikeouts during their freshman campaigns, marking the first time in school history that Auburn had two freshman pitchers surpass 100+ strikeouts in the

The duo was honored alongside fellow freshmen Makayla Packer and Sydney Cox as members of the 2021 SEC All-Freshman Team, setting Auburn's program record with the four selections. Lowe added All-SEC Second Team honors to become the only freshman pitcher in program history to be honored with all-conference honors during their debut season. Maddison Kopeke rounded out the SEC accolades with a selection to the SEC All-Newcomer Team.

Lowe would go on to be one of 15 finalists for the Schutt Sports/ NFCA Division I National Freshman of the Year award and would secure NFCA All-Southeast Region Third Team honors.

Dean's third season at Auburn was shortened due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Before the 2020 season was halted, Dean helped the Tigers to 16 wins, highlighted by victories over No. 25 Northwestern and No. 16 Minnesota. The Tigers made program history on March 2, 2020, when Alyssa Rivera (Player), Samantha Yarbrough (Pitcher) and Carlee McCondichie (Freshmen) swept the SEC's weekly awards. It marked the first time Auburn has swept all three SEC awards.

Auburn closed the 2019 season with a 39-21 overall record, earning its sixth straight NCAA Tournament bid. The Tigers closed the conference slate with a 10-14 mark and earned a spot in the 2019 SEC Softball Tournament semifinals. Dean guided Kendall Veach to All-SEC and NFCA All-Region team honors. The program made history as the senior class was drafted in the 2019 National Pro Fastpitch Draft.

Dean led Auburn to a 15-0 start to open the 2018 season, which tied the best start in program history and were the most wins in SEC history among first-year head coaches. He earned his 500th career win during the Wilson/DeMarini Classic when Auburn earned a shutout win over Western Illinois on Mar. 4. He led the Tigers to their 800th win in program history with a 2-1 victory over Kennesaw State on April 4.

A 1987 graduate of Elon University, Dean was a pitcher on the baseball team where he was a four-year letterwinner.

Dean and his wife, Liz, and have two adult children: Isaac and Eli.
