SETTING THE SCENE

- The Memphis Tigers hit the road for the first time in December for a neutral-site tilt against Auburn Saturday afternoon at 4 p.m. (CT) in Atlanta as part of the day-long Holiday Hoopsgiving showcase.
- The Tigers have won three-straight games to open the month after play in the Bad Boy Mowers Crossover Classic Thanksgiving week.
- Auburn enters the game with a 2-2 record, with one of those losses coming against top-ranked Gonzaga, 90-67 on Nov. 27.
- Auburn's last game was a 90-81 win over in-state foe South Alabama at home last Friday.
- Memphis assistant coach **Tony Madlock** spent four seasons as an assistant coach at Auburn on Tony Barbee's staff (2010-11 to 2013-14).
- Auburn junior guard **Jamal Johnson** averaged 6.9 points and 3.3 rebounds in 34 games for Memphis as a freshman during the 2017-18 season.
- Auburn freshman forward **Chris Moore** is a native of West Memphis, Ark.
- Memphis head coach **Penny Hardaway** is returning to Atlanta, where he won a gold medal with Team USA in the 1996 Olympics as a 25-year-old third-year pro coming off a 21.7 point, 7.1 assist per game season with the Orlando Magic.
- Freshman **Moussa Cisse** posted career highs in scoring (14 points), rebounding (13 rebounds) and blocked shots (4 blocks) in Tuesday's game against Mississippi Valley State.
- Cisse's 48 rebounds this season lead the Ameri-

can Athletic Conference and rank 16th nationally, and his 13 blocked shots also lead the American and are seventh nationally.

- Also in Tuesday's game, sophomore **Lester Quinones** had a double-double (14 pts, 11 rebs), and Quinones and Cisse have had double-doubles in the same game twice this season.
- Memphis nearly doubled the Delta Devils on the boards Tuesday night (57-29), including a 22-6 edge on the offensive glass.
- The Tigers are 3-0 this season when outrebounding their opponent and 1-2 when being outrebounded.

AGAINST THE TIGERS

- Memphis and Auburn are meeting for just the second time in history.
- The lone previous meeting came in the 1952-53 season, with Auburn recording a 78-64 victory in Houston.
- Memphis owns a 99-65 advantage over current SEC institutions. A win over Auburn Saturday would mark the program's 100th victory over current members of the conference.
- Memphis went 2-1 against SEC foes last season, including wins against Ole Miss and Tennessee and a loss to Georgia.

PICKING UP WHERE WE LEFT OFF

- After ending last season as the nation's best defense by opponent's field goal percentage (36.1), the Tigers are back at it on the defensive end again in 2020-21.
- So far this season, the Tigers rank ninth in the nation in adjusted defensive efficiency (an estimate of the points allowed per 100 possessions against the average D-I offense).
- The Tigers' adjusted defensive efficiency in 2019-20 ranked fifth in the country.
- Memphis is third in the nation this season in percentage of the opponent's shots it has blocked (19.3) and 11th in total blocks per game (6.5).
- A season ago, the Tigers ranked fifth nationally in blocked shots per game (5.9) and sixth in block percentage.
- In terms of raw numbers, the Tigers lead the nation this year in total blocks, rank third in total rebounds, and sit seventh in total steals.

BACK AT THE FORUM

- After starting the season with three neutral-site games in Sioux Falls, S.D., the Tigers opened December with three-straight home games where they went 3-0.
- In these games the Tigers averaged 87.3 points per game and held opponents to an average of 59.7 points per contest.
- Furthermore, Memphis outrebounded its foes by an average of 14 per game and had 12.3 steals and 8.7 blocks per game.
- Four Tigers averaged double figures to open the month (Nolley II, 16.3 ppg; Jeffries, 14.7 ppg; Quinones, 14.3 ppg; Cisse, 10.0 ppg).
- Cisse also averaged 11.0 rebounds per game.

NOLLEY II ON WOODEN WATCH LIST

- Redshirt-sophomore **Landers Nolley II** has a spot on the 2021 John R. Wooden Award Pre-season Top 50 Watch List.
- The award is given annually to the most outstanding player in men's basketball.
- Nolley II is one of two players from the American Athletic Conference on the Watch List (Caleb Mills, Houston)
- Both **Precious Achiuwa** and **James Wiseman** represented Memphis on the Watch List in 2019-20, and Achiuwa was on the midseason Top 25 list.
- The Top 50 Watch List will be culled to a mid-season list, a late season list, and a National Ballot as the season progresses, with nearly 1,000 national voters ranking 10 choices to determine the All American Team and the Wooden Award winner.

JEFFRIES AND JULIUS

- Sophomore **D.J. Jeffries** is one of 20 players nationally on the watch list for the 2021 Julius Erving Award, which is presented annually by the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame to the top small forward in Division I basketball.
- Jeffries appeared in 19 games as a freshman with 13 starts, averaging 10.8 points and 4.3 rebounds.
- The watch list for the award will be reduced to 10 players in January and five finalists in February, with the winner announced on April 9.
- A season ago, Memphis' **Precious Achiuwa** was also on the preseason watch list for the award and was named a finalist at the season's mid-season point.

THE GLUE GUY

- No player on the Memphis roster has appeared in more games for the Tigers than junior **Alex Lomax**.
- The Memphis native played in all 31 games last season and in 35 of Memphis' 36 games as a freshman in 2018-19.
- He led the Tigers in assists (132, 4.3 per game) and steals (46, 1.5 per game) last season.
- It's fitting that Lomax is an extension of head coach **Penny Hardaway** on the court, as Hardaway has coached Lomax since fifth grade, including four seasons at East High School before joining the Tigers.

LOMAX DISHIN' IT OUT

- Junior **Alex Lomax** is one of The American's assists leaders, but he also climbed the charts for most assists by a sophomore in program history.

QUINONES THE CONSISTENT

- Although overshadowed by his teammate **Precious Achiuwa**, **Lester Quinones** had quite a freshman campaign and was named to the AAC All-Freshman Team.
- Since his return from an early-season injury just before New Year's, the 6-foot-5 guard has been one of the squad's most consistent performers.
- Quinones had 12 double-figure scoring performances in his 18 conference outings, including a career-high tying 21 points versus Temple.
- He also grabbed four or more rebounds from his guard spot in eight contests.
- In conference play, Quinones was second on the team in both scoring and minutes played.

MOUSSA READY TO ROLL

- Freshman **Moussa Cisse** is already turning heads entering his first season as a Tiger.
- Ranked the No. 2 center in the nation by 247Sports Composite, Cisse, a five-star recruit, was voted the AAC's Preseason Rookie of the Year.
- He is also one of 20 players nationally selected to the 2021 Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Center of the Year Award watch list.
- One of the top recruits in the country, Cisse led Lausanne Collegiate School to the 2019-20 Tennessee Division II-A state title and was named Tennessee's Mr. Basketball in Division II-A.
- In his final high school season, he averaged 18.4 points, 15.3 rebounds, and 9.2 blocks per game, and he posted 17 triple-doubles.
- Recognized as a premier defender, shot-blocker, and rebounder, Cisse has a wingspan of 7 feet, 4 inches and a standing reach of 9 feet, 4 inches.
- Cisse turned 18 years old on Sept. 10, 2020.

CROSSOVER CLASSIC REWIND

- The Tigers went 1-2 in the Bad Boy Mowers Crossover Classic Thanksgiving week, winning their opener against Saint Mary's before losing to Western Kentucky and VCU.
- Boogie Ellis** led the way for Memphis, scoring in double figures in each game, including coming off the bench to score a career-high 24 points with six 3-pointers against Saint Mary's.
- One of the premiere early-season tournaments this year, the Crossover Classic field boasted a

- combined 131 NCAA Tournament appearances, 39 Sweet Sixteen trips, and six Final Fours.
- Seven of the eight teams in the tournament won at least 20 games last season, and the eighth, Western Kentucky, won 19.
- Five teams were in the top-50 of the NCAA's NET rankings in 2019-20 (West Virginia, 17; Saint Mary's, 31; Utah State, 40; Wichita State, 41; Northern Iowa, 48)
- Memphis was ranked 59th, WKU was at 123, and South Dakota State checked in at 126.

LIKE FATHER, LIKE SON

- The Tigers have a unique relationship on their bench in 2020-21.
- Penny Hardaway** is in his third year as the Tigers head coach, and on the squad is his son, redshirt-sophomore **Jayden**.
- The Hardaways are one of 18 father-son tandems in NCAA Division I basketball this season.
- Interestingly, after just six games this season, the Hardaways had matched up against the Stansburys (WKU) and the Hunters (MVSU).

TIGERS PICKED SECOND IN CONFERENCE PRESEASON POLL

- In the American Athletic Conference preseason poll, Memphis was picked to finish second in the league by the conference's coaches.
- The Tigers received two first-place votes and 90 total voting points.
- Houston is picked to win the conference with nine first-place votes and 99 total points.
- Following Houston and Memphis, SMU, Cincinnati, and USF rounded out the top five.
- In addition to the predicted order of finish, Tigers sophomores **D.J. Jeffries** and **Landers Nolley II** were selected to the preseason All-AAC Second Team, and freshman **Moussa Cisse** was voted the league's Preseason Rookie of the Year.

WHAT A DIFFERENCE A YEAR MAKES

- Eight of the 13 players on Memphis' roster have started at least 13 games at the Division I level.
- That list includes **Damion Baugh** (25), **Boogie Ellis** (27), **D.J. Jeffries** (13), **Alex Lomax** (15), **Landers Nolley II** (29), **Lester Quinones** (23), **Lance Thomas** (13), and **DeAndre Williams** (15).
- A season ago, the Tigers roster featured seven new signees, two redshirt-freshmen, and one transfer who was eligible.
- According to KenPom.com, Memphis had the youngest team in NCAA Division I basketball in 2019-20.

SUPER SOPHOMORES

- In a stark contrast to last season's wealth of newcomers, the 2020-21 Tigers are anchored by a strong sophomore class that contributed significantly as freshmen.
- The Tigers return four sophomores — **D.J. Jeffries**, **Lester Quinones**, **Boogie Ellis**, and **Damion Baugh** — who averaged at least 20 minutes per game on the 2019-20 squad.
- Fellow sophomores **Malcolm Dandridge** and **Jayden Hardaway** are also back after appearing in 20-plus games for Memphis last season.
- Memphis' sophomore class added guard **Landers Nolley II**, a transfer from Virginia Tech, who averaged 15.5 points, 5.8 rebounds and 2.4 assists for the Hokies last season and was named to the Atlantic Coast Conference All-Freshman Team.

WHAT THE TIGERS DID A YEAR AGO

- Memphis posted a 21-10 overall record and a 10-8 American Athletic Conference mark.
- The Tigers finished sixth in the league's regular season.
- The Tigers were poised for AAC Tournament play, before the championship and the remainder of the season was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
- Of its 18 conference games, 14 were decided by single digits and eight by five or fewer points.
- In fact, Memphis' last nine games were decided by single digits, including overtime contests at Cincinnati and Tulane.
- To take it further, 12 of the Tigers' last 13 games were decided by single digits, including seven by five or fewer points.

DE-FENSE! DE-FENSE!

- During a season in which Memphis battled its share of obstacles, one constant remained from start to abrupt finish.
- Memphis ended the season as the nation's top-ranked field goal-percentage defensive team, limiting its opponents to 36.1 percent shooting. Virginia, a traditionally strong defensive program, finished second at 36.9 percent.
- Opponents also struggled against the Tigers from long range, shooting 28 percent (193-of-690) from 3-point distance, which ranked fifth nationally.
- The Tigers also ranked fifth nationally in blocked shots per game (5.9).

THANKS FOR THE 20...

- With their win over Tulane on Feb. 29, 2020, the Tigers posted victory No. 20 on the season.
- It was Memphis' third-straight, 20-win campaign and its second-consecutive under head coach **Penny Hardaway**.
- The 20-win campaign also was Memphis' 17th of the 2000s.
- The following tracks the head coaches with back-to-back, 20-win seasons in their first two years since World War II:

- Thanks to a win over Wichita State on March 5, 2020, the Tigers secured their 10th American Athletic Conference win of the season. Memphis finished with a 10-8 league mark.
- The 10-plus win campaign in conference play was Memphis' third-straight and a second-consecutive under head coach **Penny Hardaway**.
- The conference 10-plus win season also was the Tigers' 17th of the 2000s.
- The only three non-10 win seasons in conference play came in 2004-05 (9-7 C-USA/John Calipari), 2015-16 (8-10 AAC/John Pastner), and 2016-17 (9-9 AAC/Tubby Smith).

HOME COURT ADVANTAGE

- The Tigers under head coach **Penny Hardaway** continue to draw impressive crowds to FedExForum.
- In Hardaway's second season in 2019-20, the Tigers attracted 16,312 per game to rank ninth nationally in average attendance.
- Kansas (16,388) barely eclipsed Memphis for eighth place, while the Tigers averaged slightly more per game than Indiana (16,300).
- Memphis ranked first among American Athletic Conference programs.
- Cincinnati was second at 11,100 per game, while Wichita State was third at 10,315 per game.
- The total represented a 2,247-per-game increase, which ranked second nationally.
- In Hardaway's first season of 2018-19, the Tigers were first nationally in increased attendance.

A PAIR OF FIRST-ROUNDERS

- Former Tigers **James Wiseman** and **Precious Achiuwa** were selected in the first round of the 2020 NBA Draft.
- Wiseman was taken by the Golden State Warriors with the No. 2 pick while Achiuwa went to the Miami Heat at No. 20, marking the second time in Memphis history two former Tigers have been selected in the first round of the same NBA draft.
- Wiseman averaged 19.7 points and 10.7 rebounds in three games for the Tigers last season after coming to Memphis as a consensus five-star recruit and the No. 1 recruit in the 2019 class, according to ESPN and Rivals.
- Achiuwa started all 31 games for the Tigers in 2019-20 and led the team with 15.8 points and 10.8 rebounds per game.
- He was named American Athletic Conference Player and Freshman of the Year, becoming the first player in AAC history to earn both honors.
- He was one of only 16 players in the nation to average a double-double last season and the only freshman among the top 10 conferences in college basketball to do so.
- The last, and only other, time Memphis had two NBA first rounders was in 2006 (Rodney Carney, No. 16 to Chicago; Shawne Williams, No. 17 to Indiana).

TIGERS CELEBRATE 100TH SEASON

- Memphis is in its 100th season of basketball.
- The Tigers began play in 1920-21 and fielded a squad every season through 1942-43.
- Memphis, as most other colleges across the nation, did not play in 1943-44 due to World War II.
- The Tigers resumed action in 1944-45 and have played every season since.

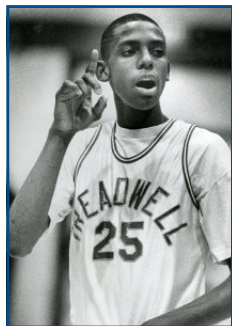

TIMELINE**

A former prep standout at Treadwell High, he averaged 36.6 points and 10.1 rebounds as a senior in 1990 and was named *Parade Magazine* National High School Player of the Year.



A two-time All-American and two-time Great Midwest Conference Player of the Year, Hardaway averaged 22.8 points, 8.5 rebounds, 6.4 assists and 2.4 steals in 1992-93.

Hardaway remains the only Memphis player to have two career triple-doubles and his 1,319 points (in only two seasons) rank 17th on the school's career scoring list. The 729 points he scored during

the 1992-93 season are the most by a junior in Tigers history.

In his two seasons, Hardaway led the team to a 43-23 record – including eight wins over nationally ranked schools -- and directed the Tigers to two NCAA Tournament appearances, including an Elite Eight trip in 1992.

After his junior year, Hardaway declared for the NBA Draft and began a 14-year pro career with the Orlando Magic (1993-99), the Phoenix Suns (1999-2004), the New York Knicks (2004-06) and the Miami Heat (2007).

The No. 3 pick in the 1993 NBA Draft, Hardaway quickly rose to stardom with the Magic. He averaged 16.6 points, 6.6 assists and 5.4 rebounds in his first season and was named to the NBA All-Rookie Team.



During the 1994-95 season, he averaged 20.9 points and 7.2 assists, started the NBA All-Star Game and was named to the All-NBA First Team, while leading Orlando to the NBA Finals against the Houston Rockets. Hardaway averaged 25.5 points and eight assists in the series.



After the 1995-96 season, he played on the U.S. Olympic basketball team that won a gold medal in Atlanta, Ga.

Hardaway had a successful run at East High School, which won state titles in 2016, 2017 and 2018. With Hardaway as head coach, the Mustangs defeated Whitehaven High for the 2018 Class AAA championship.



Hardaway returned to his alma mater and becomes the school's 19th head coach and the third former Tiger player to hold the position.

- The last, and only other, time Memphis had two NBA first rounders was in 2006 (Rodney Carney, No. 16 to Chicago; Shawne Williams, No. 17 to Indiana).
- Memphis, Kentucky, and North Carolina are the only schools to have players selected each of Nos. 1-7 in NBA Draft history.

FEDEXFORUM THE HOME OF THE TIGERS

The 2020-21 season marks the 17th for the Tigers in their home arena, FedExForum, which officially opened in September 2004. Located just a few feet off Beale Street on historic Highway 61, FedExForum rises to extend the heart of the Memphis entertainment district.

Memphis plays its home contests in the 18,400-seat arena, which served as host for 2019 American Athletic Conference Championship. It also will be the site for the 2024 NCAA Tournament First and Second Rounds. Since it opened in 2004, FedExForum has hosted six Conference USA Tournaments, three NCAA Men's South Regionals (2009, 2014, 2017), two American Athletic Conference Tournaments (2014, 2019) and one NCAA Women's South Regional (2010).

At 135 feet high, FedExForum provides a backdrop for historic Beale Street. The 805,850 square-foot arena, covering 13.8 acres, features five levels as well as state-of-the-art locker rooms and facilities for sports teams, as well as an exceptional dining and entertainment experiences for its patrons.

LAURIE-WALTON FAMILY BASKETBALL CENTER OPENED NOV. 17, 2017

Memphis men's basketball moved into its new practice facility, the Laurie-Walton Family Basketball Center, Nov. 17, 2017. It is a comprehensive, 62,000-square-foot training facility on the University's Park Avenue Campus.

This stand-alone facility encompasses offices, locker rooms, 3,250-square-foot weight room, training facilities, two NCAA regulation courts, as well as spaces for student-athletes to study, train, eat and develop.



In addition, the history of Memphis basketball is showcased via a large atrium in the grand lobby known as Traditions Hall, a 7,300-square-foot area that will double as a museum designed to be an interactive celebration of Tigers basketball for the general public.

The new practice facilities, part of the University's "Time to Shine" capital campaign, represent a major commitment from the University and Memphis community to compete at the highest level.
