Opening statement...

"First of all, Texas A&M, hats off to them. They're a very good football team. This is a very tough place to play. I'm really proud of our team. They showed a lot of guts. They showed a lot of heart. They played Auburn football. I really felt like we won both lines of scrimmage and really felt like that was the key to the game. The other thing we talked about is getting off to a fast start. We were able to get off to a fast start and kind of took the crowd out early. They came back and the crowd got involved in the second half. They didn't quit. They fought until the end. We had to recover an onside kick. I thought our special teams did a super job. We had some big returns. [Christian] Tutt had the big one that set up, I believe, a touchdown.

"We had multiple guys carry the football. We didn't have any turnovers and that's really hard to do. We had two quarterbacks carry the ball. We had multiple running backs carry the football and I think that's good. You saw Boobee [JaTarvious] Whitlow fresh in the second half and that one touchdown run, he really imposed his will. Our offensive line, hats off to those guys. They weren't 100 percent, but they battled. It's a very quality win for us. This is a big win in a lot of different ways. From the standpoint it's their first conference game. Our schedule is a handful. I think everybody knows that. But it was a quality win. I'm really proud of our team. We still have areas we've got to improve on. Our quarterback, he's growing up before our eyes. I mean, first road start in this environment against that team, he did a really good job for us. He protected the football and, of course, the very last play was a huge zone read, and he had enough heads to him to get the first down and slide. So, you see him growing up before your eyes. I'm really happy with our team, and like I said, hats off to Texas A&M. They're a very good football team with a lot of good players."

On the first three possessions...

"We felt strongly they were going to blitz us and that they were going to put pressure on Bo [Nix]. Strategically we were going to get the ball to the perimeter and sure enough on that reverse they did exactly that. We had another perimeter run that they blitz us on, and they even were able to blitz us on the Wildcat call. But that changed the game and then they decided to turn to more of a base. They are a good defense, matter of fact they are a really good defense. For us to have had that many rushing yards says a lot about our offensive line, running back and our quarterbacks."

On scoring in the fourth quarter...

"That was a type of drive that wins the game on the road. That was the best drive we have had this whole season and I feel like that since they knew we were going to run it. We were able to methodically run the ball. I can't remember if we threw it on that deal or not, but we came out with seven. Our young team is growing up. We're still not there yet but they are finding some confidence along the way. I will say this, we had to play our best game to have a chance to win here and we played our best today to do just that. That is encouraging for me to see about our future this season."

"It was great because now they have to cover the whole field. Especially with our other weapons on the field. It's really good to have him back and get back into the flow of things"

On the scoring drive in the fourth quarter...

"That was a statement drive for us. I thought we ran right at them. All game we were kind of dink and dunk and in that moment, we decided to run right at them. 'You can stop it and try,' but it was just a statement drive for sure."

On the opening road victory in SEC play...

"It is just awesome and something that we have been practicing and looking forward to stopping the run and just get them out of their game plan. Their game plan wasn't to come out and run and gun. We have just got to make sure that we prepare for everything and just come out and play faster and harder."

On Auburn's run defense...

"I think we have got a pretty good thing going against the run. In the SEC, you have got to stop the run to win. Everybody knows that. It is not even a secret. What we are doing right now, we have to just build on it and do it."

Texas A&M Head Coach Jimbo Fisher

Opening statement...

"First off, give Auburn credit. They came in here and played very well early. Got the tempo of the game the first drives of the game. Played very well and got good momentum in the football game. They're a very good football team. I thought our kids played hard. We didn't play as well as we wanted to, but our kids battled. We played. We competed in the game. We had some opportunities in the game on offense, on defense and in special teams to make some plays. And we just were three, four, five plays short. That's what it comes down to when you play really good teams. We have to play better and that all starts with me. It all starts with me as a coach to coach them better, put them in a better position to do those things. That's the responsibility. It's on me. I'll get them right. We don't have a bad football team. We just got to play better. I got to get them to play better. That's my job."

On the offensive line...

"I'm going to have to look it and evaluate it. We'll have to look and evaluate why we were stopped. We had some momentum things. In the second half, we got behind and had to throw after we thought we had some adjustments made the second half. They had the first run and got it popped and we got it. But then when they got up three scores, it changed our momentum of trying to get it going. And we'll have to look at that and evaluate it and then we'll go. We've got to do a better job."

On trying to put pressure on Bo Nix...

"We never put him in a situation where he had to depend on throwing the football and doing things as a quarterback. They did at the end, but they were able to run the ball, stay in the RPO game, the nickel and dime throws that kept a lot of pressure. He scrambled and did a good job. He pulled the ball and ran with legs very good in the game. What did he throw for? I'm trying to think. But he was 12-for-20, 100 yards. Didn't make any mistakes. We let them get the lead and never put the pressure where you could get them into having to throw the football and put that pressure on. So, Bo did a good job, and they did a good job of getting ahead of us and keeping the momentum of the game."

On keeping the team focused through a difficult schedule...

"I don't think it's very hard at all. We've just got to play better. Like I said before, going into this, I thought Auburn was as good as any of those teams. I did going in. I remember we played them last year, and I knew what kind of players they had on defense and offense coming back. To me, they're the same caliber football team, and always have been. So, I don't think it's focus. We've just got to learn to play better and rise to those situations. And I've got to do a better job as a coach."

Kellen Mond, QB, Jr.

On the slow start and having to overcome a big deficit...

"I feel like that's always hard. I feel like, even since last year, one of the biggest things that we need to focus on is getting started early. Whether that be in the running game or the pass game, but just putting points up on the board early and putting pressure on the opposing team instead of us always playing behind or always equal, just putting pressure on the other team so that they have to drive and go 90, go 80 on our defense. So that's something that we're going to have to clean up."

On racking up more yards in the second half if it had anything to do with Auburn's defense...

"I think that was a big part on us, just playing with more focus, playing with more detail and just getting lined up quick. We always talk about just running our base stuff. We just had to execute. So I feel like, when the game is on the line, that's how we have to play in the first half, just like the game is on the line."

On trying to get the run game using his legs moving forward...

"Sometimes it comes off scrambles or sometimes it's designed runs or even zone reads. So just being versatile like that. You know, we'll look at the film and see what we think we could do better as an offense and see if I need to be involved more in the run game. We don't really know as of right now, but we'll figure it out as offense."

On Auburn's offense...

"We knew when they came out, they were going to try to do a lot of trickery things. We know we just have to be sound and disciplined. One thing with that is we weren't. And that's the big thing on us. We have to be more disciplined, and we have to work on it. We'll be better next week."

On if Auburn's last drive had the defense gassed...

"Yeah, it was a lot of little things, like missed assignments or missed tackles. Little things like that that they just end up driving down the field, first downs here, first downs there. Stuff like that can't happen."

On losing despite having better stats...

"It's very frustrating when you game plan all week and you go out there and you see what you want to see in terms of coverage, in terms of matchups. We just can't execute down there in the red zone. We moved the ball pretty well, I thought. We just had false starts. We had two false starts that just killed the drives. Just can't have certain things like that."

On regrouping after starting 2-2...

"It's really important to stay together here. This is a time where we have to really come together and just stay as a family. And, honestly, we don't have to do anything special. It's just fundamentals. Nothing special got us beat tonight. We've just got to go back to our fundamentals and get back to practicing right. Practice is very important because it translates over to the game. So just focus on that."
