» QUICK HITTERS

- Auburn defeated Vanderbilt in two of three games last weekend to secure its third straight SEC series win for the first time since 2017. The Tigers haven't won four straight since 2013-14.
- Dating back to the final two series of last season, the Tigers have won four straight SEC road series for the first time since 1996-97. The team hasn't won five straight since 1994-95.
- Auburn is one of four teams in the league to win three of the first four SEC series, including the only team from the SEC West with two of its three series wins coming away from home.
- The team is 9-3 in games away from Plainsman Park, including 4-2 in league play.
- The nine wins are tied for the most and the .750 winning percentage is second in the SEC.
- The Tigers' win in the series opener against Vanderbilt marked head coach Butch Thompson's 200th win in an Auburn uniform. He is the third Auburn coach to accomplish the feat (Nix, Baird).
- Auburn is 93-113-1 all-time against Mississippi State, including 35-59 on the road, but has won two of the last three series in Starkville (2015, 2017).

Butch Thompson enters his seventh season at the helm of the program in 2021, posting a record of 179-142 in his first six seasons. He led the program to the first College World Series appearance in 22 years in 2019 and took the Tigers to three straight regionals for the first time since 2001-03.

Butch Thompson was named Auburn's head baseball coach on October 22, 2015 and enters his seventh season with the Tigers in 2021.

Thompson, who spent three seasons as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Auburn from 2006-08, returned to The Plains after seven seasons at Mississippi State as both associate head coach and pitching coach.

A native of Amory, Miss., Thompson has coached 31 Division I All-Americans and 40 all-conference performers. He has seen 18 of his former pitchers make their Major League Baseball debuts, including 12 since 2014. Thompson has also turned 33 pitchers who went undrafted out of high school into MLB draft picks.

Thompson had three pitchers drafted in the first 11 rounds in 2014 and five pitchers drafted, including three in the top 10 rounds, in 2013. He added a first-round selection in the 2016 draft, a third-round pick in Keegan Thompson in 2017 and the first No. 1 overall pick in program history in Casey Mize in 2018. With Tanner Burns also going as a supplemental first round pick in 2020, Auburn became one of four programs with a pair of pitchers drafted in the first round from 2018-20.

Along with his pitching pedigree, Thompson is also considered one of the top recruiters in the country. Since 2003, he has secured 14 recruiting classes that were ranked in the top 10 by either Baseball America or Perfect Game, including the No. 5 signing class in 2017 and a program record No. 4 class in 2018. His classes signed from 2006-08 at Auburn each ranked in the top 18 nationally, including the No. 5 class in 2008, which included All-American and SEC Player of the Year Hunter Morris.

In 29 years of coaching at the collegiate level, including 20 in the Southeastern Conference, Thompson has coached eight College World Series participants, including leading the Tigers to the program's first trip to the College World Series in 22 years in 2019. Thompson has also coached one national champion and a national runner-up, won nine conference championships and made 17 postseason appearances. He has also served as an assistant under three National Coach of the Year recipients.

Thompson was named the 2006 Fellowship of Christian Athletes SEC Coach of the Year while at Auburn and the 2014 Baseball America and American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA) National Assistant Coach of the Year while at Mississippi State.

Thompson has returned the Tigers to prominence in five seasons on The Plains as he has guided the team to a 179-142 overall record and took the team to three straight NCAA Tournament appearances for the first time since 2001-03, including back-to-back super regionals for the first time in program history. After advancing to the College World Series in 2019 and a winner-take-all game three in the Gainesville Super Regional in 2018, the Tigers finished those respective seasons ranked as high as No. 8 and No. 9. It marked the third time in program history the team has finished back-to-back seasons in the top 10.

Entering the 2019 postseason as the No. 2 seed in the Atlanta Regional, Auburn became the only program to sweep a regional on the road in each of the last two seasons before also becoming the first team to defeat North Carolina in a Chapel Hill Super Regional in 2019, punching its ticket to Omaha for the first time since 1997.

In seven seasons at MSU, Thompson made four NCAA regional trips, two Super Regionals, won the SEC Tournament and advanced to the College World Series finishing as NCAA runner-up in 2013. In three of his last four seasons in Starkville, the Bulldogs' staff ERA finished no higher than 3.06. Thompson's 2013 pitching staff was one of two nationally to finish in the top 15 in ERA, strikeouts per nine innings and hits allowed per nine innings.



In addition to his experience at Auburn and Mississippi State, Thompson also spent four seasons at Georgia from 2002-05, including a trip to the College World Series in 2004. While there, he guided the development of future Major Leaguers Josh Fields, Mitchell Boggs and Brooks Brown.

Thompson launched his coaching career as pitching coach and top assistant at Huntingdon College (Ala.) in 1993, before returning to his alma mater in Birmingham, where he helped lead the Panthers to back-to-back Southern States Conference Championships and in 1995 coached BSC to its first NAIA World Series berth.

Thompson left BSC briefly to serve as head coach at Jefferson State Community College in Birmingham in 1997. While at JSCC, he was honored as the Regional Tournament Coach of the Year, the ABCA Alabama Junior College Coach of the Year and the Southeast Region Coach of the Year after guiding JSCC to a 39-21 mark, the AJCAA Region 22 State Championship and a third-place finish in the NJCAA Division II World Series.

He returned to Birmingham-Southern as top assistant the following season, beginning a four-year run during the most successful span in BSC baseball history. The Panthers won 196 games and four TranSouth Conference Championships and made three-consecutive appearances in the NAIA World Series. BSC's 2001 team posted a school-best 55-11 mark and captured the NAIA National Championship.

In 2002, Thompson joined the SEC baseball coaching fraternity as a pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at Georgia and has been a part of the league for the past 17 seasons.

Thompson currently serves as the large-school representative for the Alabama Baseball Coaches Association and is an All-American committee member representing the South region for the ABCA.

Thompson prepped at Amory (Miss.) High School and later starred as a pitcher at Itawamba (Miss.) Community College from 1989-90. He is a member of both the ICC Athletic Hall of Fame (Class of 2014) and MACCC Hall of Fame (Class of 2021).

SCOUTING THE BULLDOGS

- Mississippi State enters the weekend with a 19-15 overall record and 4-8 mark in SEC play.
- Offensively, Mississippi State is hitting .272 as a team with 59 homers, the third most in the league. Grad transfer RJ Yeager leads the way with a .314 average.
- On the mound, the Bulldogs have turned in a 5.23 staff ERA and have struck out 377 batters, the second most in the conference.

STRONG SEC START

- Auburn's 7-5 start in SEC play has the Tigers one game out of first place in the SEC West and is tied for the team's best start since 2017 (8-4).
- The Tigers are one of four SEC teams to win three of its first four conference series, including the only team from the SEC West and one of three teams in the league to win three of the first four series with two road series wins.
- The team has won three straight SEC series for the first time since 2017. Auburn hasn't won four straight since the final two series of 2013 and first two series of 2014.

ROAD WARRIORS

- Auburn is 9-3 in games away from home this season, including 4-2 in league play.
- The nine wins are tied most in the SEC and the .750 winning percentage is second best.
- Dating back to the final two series of last season, the Tigers have won four straight SEC road series for the first time since 1996-97.

MOVING ON UP

- Auburn entered all six major polls this week, being ranked anywhere from No. 14 in Collegiate Baseball to No. 23 in the NCBWA poll.
- The Tigers are 6-4 against ranked opponents this season, including 5-2 against teams ranked No. 12.
- Three of the first four SEC series came against ranked opponents, and all 10 games against ranked opponents have come against teams ranked No. 12 or higher at the time.

SONNY KEEPS ON SLUGGING

- A Golden Spikes List Midseason Watch List honoree and D1 Baseball Midseason First Team All-American, DiChiara leads the country in on-base percentage (.585) and slugging (.917) and is third in average (.438).
- DiChiara has reached base in all 29 games this season and in 31 games dating back to the final two games of last season in the Starkville Regional. He has reached multiple times in 26 of 29 games, including 11 of 12 in SEC play.
- DiChiara hit his 50th career home run in last Saturday's middle game vs. Vanderbilt and turned in his ninth career multi-homer game in the series finale. He is third among NCAA Division I active players with 52 career homers.

GONZO GIVES US A GEM

- Gonzalez turned in Auburn's first SEC complete game since Casey Mize struck out 15 batters in a complete game against Vanderbilt on May 4, 2018.
- The sophomore righty matched a career best with eight strikeouts and didn't issue a walk.
- He threw 81 of his 104 pitches for strikes.

ONE-RUN AFFAIRS

- After going 6-11 one-run games last year, Auburn has already matched its one-run win total from a season ago, going 6-3 in one-run games this season.
- A year ago, thirteen of Auburn's 30 SEC games, including seven of its first 10, were decided by one run and seven more were decided by two runs.
- The Tigers went 4-9 in one-run games and 6-14 in games decided by two runs or less in league play.

COMEBACK KIDS

- Auburn's six-run comeback win against South Alabama on Mar. 22 marked the team's largest comeback win since defeating Florida A&M after trailing 7-0 on Feb. 22, 2017.
- The win in the series opener at Texas A&M on Mar. 25 marked the team's first in SEC play when trailing after eight innings since the final game of the 2019 regular season.
- The Tigers have won 12 games in which they have trailed this season.

RAMBUSCH RAKES

- Junior college transfer Blake Rambusch, who ranked 11th in the NJCAA with a .444 average a season ago, leads the SEC and is 18th in the NCAA with 52 hits this season.
- Rambusch has a hit in 29 of 33 games this season and leads the team with 17 multi-hit games, including 11 of the last 17 contests.
- The redshirt junior has reached base in 89 of the last 90 games dating back to the final 13 games of his freshman season at Grayson.
- Rambusch snapped a 17-game hitting streak in the series finale at LSU on Apr. 2. The 17-game hitting streak was the longest by an Auburn player since Anfernee Grier collected a 22-game streak from the end of 2015 to the beginning of 2016.

MIKEY MAKING THE MOST OF IT

- Freshman outfielder Mike Bello made his first start in the middle game against No. 1 Ole Miss on Mar. 18 and went 3-for-3 with four runs, a walk, hit-by-pitch and two RBI.
- Bello became the first Auburn freshman to reach base five times in a game since Steven Williams did so in the first game of the 2018 Raleigh Regional.
- Bello, who drove in the game-winning run vs. South Alabama on Mar. 22 and hit his first homer at Texas A&M on Mar. 26, is hitting .306 with 11 runs in league play since being inserted into the starting lineup.

NCAA ACTIVE RANKS

- DiChiara leads Auburn with 11 homers this season and is third among active players with 52 career home runs.
- Brooks Carlson is T-5th among active players with 257 career hits. He also ranks top 15 in doubles (52), RBI (155) and total bases (398).

LIKE FATHER, LIKE SON

- Senior infielder Brody Moore is the son of former Auburn and All-SEC shortstop Brandon Moore (1991-94).
- After wearing No. 19 and playing second base/utility in his first three seasons on the Plains, Brody has a new number and position in 2022 - No. 4 and shortstop - just like his dad.
- Brandon hit .332 in four years and 242 games in an Auburn uniform. Brody, who collected his 100th career hit against Middle Tennessee, is a .302 hitter in parts of four seasons and 111 games, including 99 starts.

HOWELL'S STAYING HOT

- Kason Howell went hitless in the first three games of the season but is hitting .341 with 12 doubles and 21 RBI in 30 games since.
- Howell, who has started 81 straight games in center field, has matched a career best with three hits on six occasions this season.
- He hit a walk-off homer to clinch the series against Yale three weekends ago. The walk-off homer was the first of Howell's career and the first by an Auburn player since Steven Williams in the 2019 Atlanta Regional.

BURKY AND SKIP IN THE BULLPEN

- Blake Burkhalter and Carson Skipper were two of nine SEC relievers named to the NCBWA Stopper of the Year Watch List, making Auburn one of two SEC programs with multiple honorees (Vanderbilt).
- It marks the fifth straight season an Auburn pitcher has been recognized on the list, including the second straight for Skipper.
- The duo is a combined 6-0 with a 3.35 ERA and 58 strikeouts to eight walks in 51.0 innings in 24 appearances.
- Burkhalter leads the SEC and is 13th in the NCAA with seven saves this season.

SELLOUT CROWDS

- Auburn has sold out three of its last six games at Plainsman Park, and the total attendance of 11,817 last weekend registers as the fourth largest all-time.
- The sellout in the series finale vs. Ole Miss marked the first since Feb. 16, 2019.
- The midweek sellout against Jacksonville State on Mar. 29 was the first midweek sellout in program history.

BIG SHOES TO FILL

- Auburn entered the 2022 season forced to replace its top three hitters and five everyday starters from a year ago in shortstop Ryan Bliss, third baseman Rankin Woley, first baseman Tyler Miller and outfielders Steven Williams and Judd Ward.
- The quintet combined to hit .296 with 192 runs, 50 doubles, 58 home runs and 191 RBI.

TWENTY-SIX YEARS IN THE MAKING

- Volunteer assistant and pitching coach Tim Hudson, who began his time on the Plains as a player in the fall of 1995, recently earned his degree in interdisciplinary studies with emphases on health promotion and philanthropy studies on Dec. 11, 2021.

MLB SUCCESS ON STAFF

- Auburn's coaching staff has 54 years of experience in professional baseball, including 32 years in the MLB between pitching coach Tim Hudson (17 years), hitting coach Gabe Gross (seven years), strength coach Chris Joyner (eight years).
- Other members of the coaching and support staff with professional experience include assistant coach Karl Nonemaker, director of player development Aaron Everett and athletic trainer Anthony Sandersen.

TIGERS IN THE PROS

- Four former players in Garrett Cooper (Marlins), Josh Donaldson (Yankees), Casey Mize (Tigers) and Keegan Thompson (Cubs) began the 2022 MLB season on Opening Day rosters and eight more start the season at Triple-A.

AUBURN IN THE MLB DRAFT

- The 2021 MLB Draft marked the 47th consecutive year Auburn had at least one player selected, tied for the longest active streak in the SEC.
- Ryan Bliss was drafted by the Arizona Diamondbacks in the second round with the 42nd overall pick in last year's draft, becoming the fifth-highest position player and ninth-highest draft pick overall in Auburn history.
- It marked the sixth straight season Auburn had a top-five-round pick, marking the first time in program history to accomplish the feat.

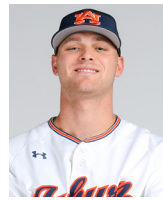

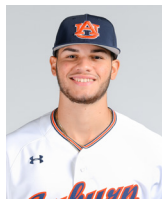
