Series History | Indiana Leads 1-0 | Last Meeting: L, 90-107, on March 14, 1987, in Indianapolis, Ind.

» Auburn (5-2, 0-0 SEC) goes up against one of the most storied programs in college basketball as it faces Indiana (7-1, 2-0 Big Ten) in a marquee matchup on the hardwood Saturday afternoon at State Farm Arena, home of the NBA's Atlanta Hawks.

» This will be the third-straight Holiday Hoopsgiving appearance for the Tigers as well as for senior guard K.D. Johnson, an Atlanta native, who previously starred at SW DeKalb High School. He is among the Atlanta pipeline of recruits to Auburn in recent years next to current and former NBA players - Chuma Okeke, Jared Harper, Isaac Okoro, Sharife Cooper, Jabari Smith and Walker Kessler.

» Auburn early signee Jahki Howard, the best dunker currently in high school basketball, resides in the Norcross area and plays for Overtime Elite. He continues that pipeline of top talent from Hotlanta to The Plains.

» The Tigers are fresh off final exams this week and look to bounce back from a 69-64 road setback at Appalachian State on Dec. 3 in Boone, N.C.

» Saturday's game is one of two back-to-back, neutral-site contests for the Tigers as they take on UNC Asheville up next in the Rocket City Classic on Dec. 13 in Huntsville, Ala.

» This is only the second all-time meeting between the Tigers and Hoosiers. In both programs' last outing, top-seeded IU defeated eighth-seeded Auburn, 107-90, in Indianapolis in the second round of the 1987 NCAA Tournament on the way to winning the national championship title.

» This is Bruce Pearl's first-ever meeting versus an Indiana squad in his head coaching career. His prior meetings with the Hoosiers was as an assistant coach under Dr. Tom Davis at Iowa from 1986-1992. Pearl also coached alongside Tim Knight, oldest son of the late IU legend Bobby Knight, while on Davis' staff at Stanford from 1982-86.

A LOOK AT THE HOOSIERS

- » Indiana is led by Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Award Watch List member Kel'el Ware, who is averaging 17.1 points per game and shooting 63.9 percent from the floor (ranks 27th nationally in field-goal percentage) and 9.4 rebounds per game.
- » Indiana is currently ranked No. 21 in the country shooting 50.4 from the floor, while Auburn is No. 15 nationally holding opponents to a 37.3 field-goal percentage.
- » The Hoosiers are off to a 2-0 Big Ten Conference start having beaten Maryland, 65-63, in their league opener on Dec. 1 and Michigan, 78-75, four days later in Ann Arbor, Mich.

HOLIDAY HOOPSGIVING HISTORY

- » Auburn is 2-1 all-time in Holiday Hoopsgiving games. The Tigers beat Memphis, 74-71, in 2020 and Nebraska, 99-68, in 2021. Last season, Memphis bested AU, 82-73, at State Farm Arena.
- » This will be the largest crowd Auburn will play in front at State Farm Arena in a Holiday Hoopsgiving game. More than 11,000+ tickets have been sold in the 16,600 capacity venue a mixture of Auburn "Road Witnesses" and Indiana Hoosiers fans.
- » Fellow SEC member Mississippi State plays Tulane in the game prior to the AU-IU showdown.

TIGERS VS. THE BIG TEN

- » The Tigers are 3-1 all-time against the Big Ten Conference in the Bruce Pearl Era (2014-Present), but 8-1 all-time versus the current configuration of the league.
- » Auburn has won three-straight games over Big Ten opponents:

Dec. 11, 2021 - No. 18 Auburn 99, Nebraska 68, Holiday Hoopsgiving, Atlanta, Ga. Nov. 23, 2022 - No. 13 Auburn 43, Northwestern 42, Cancun Challenge in Cancun, Mexico March 16, 2023 - Auburn 83, Iowa 75, NCAA Tournament First Round, Birmingham, Ala.

DOMINATING THE PAINT

- » Auburn has scored a season-high 42 points in the paint the last two games against Virginia Tech and Appalachian State combined. The Tigers have also scored 40+ points in the paint in three-straight games after totaling 40 paint points against Alabama A&M on No. 21.
- » Over that stretch, AU has averaged 41.3 points in the paint per game. For the season, the Tigers are averaging 37.7 points per game in the paint, which is 48.0 percent of the team's total points.
- » The Tigers have outscored their opponent in the paint in 6-of-7 games this season and were even with St. Bonaventure in paint points. Auburn is plus-68 (9.7 ppg) on points in the paint for the season.

LIGHTING UP THE SCOREBOARD

- » Auburn is fifth in the SEC averaging 78.6 points per game this season. Nine Tigers have scored in double figures in at least one game this season.
- » The Tigers also rank third in the league in scoring defense (65.43) the only SEC team ranked in the Top 5 in both scoring offense and scoring defense.

TIGERS ON THE NATIONAL SCENE

» The Tigers currently rank No. 11 nationally in assists per game (18.4, 2nd in SEC), No. 11 in bench points per game (35.57 ppg, 1st in SEC), No. 16 in blocked shots per game (5.7, 4th in SEC), 15th in field-goal percentage defense (37.3%, 2nd in SEC) and No. 20 in three-point field-goal percentage defense (26.7%, 2nd in SEC).

TIGERS IN THE RANKINGS

- » Entering the 2023-24 season, Auburn has received preseason billing at No. 15 in the Ken Pomeroy Ratings, No. 15 by Evan Miya and No. 24 by The Athletic.
- » For the fifth-straight week, the Tigers are receiving votes in the Coaches Top 25 Poll. KenPom also has AU ranked No. 17 overall, while No. 33 in offensive efficiency and No. 15 in defensive efficiency.

SHARING THE ROCK

- » Auburn ranks No. 12 nationally and second in the SEC averaging 18.4 assists per game. The Tigers have recorded at least 18 assists in their first five games this season and have dished out at least 17 assists in all but one game. They are one of 11 NCAA Division I teams with at least six games with 17+ assists.
- » Sophomore back-up point guard Tre Donaldson leads Auburn in the category and ranks 12th in the SEC with 3.4 assists per game, while Aden Holloway is tied for 13th in the league averaging 3.3 assists per game.
- » Donaldson scored a career-high tying 12 points and matched his season highs with five assists, three rebounds and one steal at Appalachian State on Dec. 3. He was 2-of-5 from 3-point range against the Mountaineers. It was Donaldson's second game in double figures this season (10 points vs. Notre Dame on Nov. 16) and the fourth of his career.
- » Auburn recorded a season-high 22 assists on 31 field goals versus Notre Dame on Nov. 16.
- » In the Bruce Pearl Era, his 2019-20 squad dished out 27 assists versus CSUN on Nov. 15, 2019. The school record for most assists in a single game is 33 against Troy in 1991 and versus LSU in 1994.

3-POINT DEFENSE

- » Auburn is tied for 17th in the country in three-point field goal percentage defense, allowing opponents to shoot only 26.7 percent from behind the arc this season.
- » Prior to Appalachian State shooting 8-of-17 from deep in the Tigers' last game, Auburn had held its last four opponents to 14-of-85 (16.5 pct.) from long range.



PLAYER TO WATCH: JOHNI BROOME

- » Johni Broome has led Auburn with back-to-back double-double performances against Virginia Tech in the inaugural ACC/SEC Challenge and Appalachian State. He poured in a game-high 21 points, 13 rebounds and two blocks against the Mountaineers. It was Broome's second-straight double-double after a dominate 30-point, 13-rebound performance in Tigers' victory over the Hokies.
- » The junior big man has recorded four double-doubles on the season and 50 for his career. The App State game was the second time in his career Broome has posted consecutive games of 20 points and 10 rebounds and the first time since the 2021-22 season when he scored 24 points and grabbed 13 rebounds at ETSU and followed that up with 20 points and 12 rebounds at Xavier, while playing for Morehead State.
- » Broome, who was invited to the NBA Draft Combine this summer in Chicago, is currently the fourth-leading scorer in the SEC (18.3 ppg). He is also tied for second in the league in rebounding (9.1) and fifth in field-goal percentage (.570). He is the only league player ranked in the Top 5 in both the scoring and rebounding columns.
- » With his next block (275th of his career), Broome would move into a tie for 99th for most career blocks made by a college basketball player since 1992.

FRESHMAN PHENOM

- » Freshman Aden Holloway is one of 13 NCAA Division I freshmen including one of six from a power conference, averaging 10.0 points, 3.0 assists and shooting at least 75.0 percent from the free-throw line this season. He has scored in double figures in four of his first seven career games.
- » For the season, Holloway is tied for seventh in the SEC averaging 2.14 three-pointers per game. He is also tied for 13th among league leaders in assists (3.3 avg.).
- » With his two starts in Brooklyn against Notre Dame and St. Bonaventure, point guard Aden Holloway became the 15th different freshman to start a game for Auburn in Bruce Pearl's 10 seasons as head coach on The Plains. Jabari Smith leads all Auburn freshmen under Pearl with 34 starts in 2021-22. The group has combined to start 261 games.

WILLIAMS WINNINGEST PLAYER IN PROGRAM HISTORY

- » After graduating with a bachelor's degree in kinesiology in May, Jaylin Williams chose to come back for his fifth and final year on The Plains. Last season, he was the team's third-leading scorer (11.2 ppg) and third-leading rebounder (4.7 rpg) in 2022-23.
- » With the Tigers' win over Southeastern Louisiana on Nov. 10 at Neville Arena, Williams became the winningest player in program history with 88 career (and now 92) victories to date. He was previously tied with former Tigers Allen Flanigan (2019-23), Anfernee McLemore (2016-20) and Scott Pohlman (1997-2001).
- » Entering the season with 107 career games played, he needs to appear in 20 games this season to crack Auburn's career games played list and is now 20 games (114) behind Frankie Sullivan's record of 134 games played from 2009-13.

» K.D. Johnson (Georgia-Auburn combined) and Jaylin Williams are all closing in on 1,000 career points. Johni Broome (1,579), Chaney Johnson (1,225) and Denver Jones (1,004) have already reached that milestone in their combined Morehead State-Auburn, UAH-Auburn and FIU-Auburn careers respectively.

» Williams would become the 39th player in program history to gain entrance into the 1,000-Career Point Club - the first in five years since Bryce Brown (8th, 1,673) and Jared Harper (13th, 1,227) did so during their senior campaigns that ended in the 2019 national semifinals.

2024 SIGNING CLASS

The Tigers signed two top recruits in the early signing period - five-star Tahaad Pettiford and Jahki Howard.

Rated the No. 2 point guard and No. 21 overall player in the Class of 2024 by 247 Sports, Pettiford played AAU basketball for New Heights Lightning on the EYBL circuit, shooting 33.5 percent from the 3-point line and averaging 13.3 points per game. He burst onto the scene over the summer as one of the best scoring guards in the country.

One of the most athletic players in his class, Howard is a four-star recruit rated No. 85 overall and No. 20 at his position by 247 Sports. Known as the best dunker in high school basketball going viral on social media, he is currently averaging 15.9 points, 5.3 rebounds, 1.4 assists, 1.9 steals and 0.5 blocks per game in the preseason for Overtime Elite.

Tahaad Pettiford, G, 5-10, 175, Jersey City, N.J. (Hudson Catholic Regional High School)

"Tahaad is a very unique player. He is a gifted scorer with an unlimited range. Instant offense. He has tremendous speed, quickness and athletic jumping ability. Tahaad is a very tough cover and uses that athleticism to be a pest defensively. (Assistant Coach) Ira Bowman did a tremendous job of identifying Tahaad very early on in the recruiting process and developed a close, trusting relationship. Tahaad will have a Pied Piper effect on our program. Guys will want to play with him." – Head Coach Bruce Pearl

» Junior transfer Chaney Johnson pulled down 11 rebounds off the bench against Southeastern Louisiana on Nov. 10. He is the ninth player in Bruce Pearl's 10 seasons at Auburn to grab at least 11 boards in a game as a reserve and the first since Jaylin Williams had 11 rebounds versus Texas A&M on Feb. 12, 2022. For the season, Johnson is third on the team averaging 5.4 boards per game.

NOT A NEW KID ON THE BLOCK

- » Senior center Dylan Cardwell tied a career high with a game-high five blocks against Baylor. Cardwell is one of three players who ranks in the Top 10 in the SEC in blocked shots per game, while playing under 20 minutes per game. The mark is tied for 12th-most in a game in NCAA Division I so far this season. Cardwell previously set his career high against South Florida and George Mason in 2022.
- » His teammate Johni Broome, has blocked five shots in the last two games and ranks 10th in the SEC averaging 1.3 blocks per game this season. Auburn has blocked at least five shots in five of seven games this season.

ELITE IN THE SEC

» Auburn leads the SEC with a .715 winning percentage and is one game behind Tennessee for most wins in the league with 148 victories over the last six-plus seasons. The Tigers have also won the second-most SEC Championship titles (3) and second-most NCAA Tournament games (7) in that span behind Alabama's four titles and Arkansas' eight NCAA Tournament victories.

PEARL MOVES INTO THIRD ALL-TIME IN CAREER WINS AT AUBURN

» Bruce Pearl is in his 10th season as Auburn's head coach with a 178-113 record on The Plains. With the Tigers' win over Southeastern Louisiana on Nov. 10, he surpassed Sonny Smith, who led Auburn to a 173-154 mark in 11 seasons from 1978-89, for third all-time in program history. Joel Eaves leads the way with 213 wins from 1949-63 and Cliff Ellis, who led the Tigers to 186 victories from 1994-2004, is second.

RETURNING PRODUCTION

» Auburn returns 58.1 percent of its minutes, 60.2 percent of its scoring and 61.3 percent of its rebounding from last season. The Tigers return five of their Top 7 scorers – three of the five players, who averaged 20 minutes per game, and three of five players, who recorded at least 100 rebounds last season.

JOHNSON ENDS LAST SEASON ON HOT STREAK

» Last season, K.D. Johnson shot 16-of-29 (55.2%) from 3-point range over the last nine games shooting 25.3 percent (20-of-79) from long range in the first 24 games. Johnson averaged 10.6 points over the last nine contests of the season.

AUBURN vs. THE TOP 25

Auburn is 77-224 against AP Top 25 teams all-time including 18-28 under Bruce Pearl. The Tigers set a program record with six wins against ranked opponents during the 2018-19 season including five straight from the SEC Championship through their run to the Final Four. Additionally, Auburn is 103-32 as a ranked team in the Pearl Era.

IT JUST MEANS MORE

» Auburn was predicted to finish sixth in the preseason SEC media poll behind preseason favorite Tennessee, Texas A&M, Arkansas, Kentucky and Alabama.

WELCOME TO AUBURN'S BLOCK PARTY

» Auburn is the only team that has finished in the Top 25 in the country in blocked shots per game in each of the previous seven seasons. No other team has finished in the Top 25 in blocks per game in more than five seasons over that stretch. The Tigers have blocked 1,330 shots since the start of the 2016-17 season.

» The Tigers are averaging 5.7 blocks per game this season, which is ranked No. 18 nationally.

MR. DOUBLE-DOUBLE

- » Junior big man Johni Broome recorded his second-straight game with at least 20 points and 10 rebounds with 21 points and 13 rebounds at Appalachian State on Dec. 3, after posting a 30-point, 13-rebound performance against Virginia Tech on Nov. 29.
- »It was the second time in his career Broome has posted consecutive games of 20 points and 10 rebounds and the first time since the 2021-22 season when he scored 24 points and grabbed 13 rebounds at ETSU and followed that up with 20 points and 12 rebounds at Xavier, while at Morehead State. It is one of 17 30-point, 10-rebound games by a NCAA Division I player this season.
- » Broome has recorded 50 career double-doubles (14 of those at Auburn). His 30-point, 13-rebound outing versus the Hokies was the first 30-point/10-rebound game by an Auburn player since Mustapha Heron had 31 points and 10 rebounds vs. Winthrop on Nov. 24, 2017.
- » He is one of 20 NCAA Division I players to record a double-double in each of his team's first two games this season.
- » Broome has scored in double figures in 16-straight games including all seven games this season. He ranks second in the SEC averaging 9.1 rpg and fourth in scoring at 18.3 ppg. Broome is the only league player who is ranked in the Top 5 in both the scoring and rebounding columns.



HEAD COACH BRUCE PEARL



Auburn Head Coach Bruce Pearl is in his 10th season on The Plains

He has guided the Tigers to 178 wins in 10 seasons, the program's first-ever No. 1 ranking in both national polls and a memorable run to the NCAA Final Four in 2019

The three-time SEC Coach of the Year's accomplishments also include two Southeastern Conference regular-

season championships, one SEC Tournament championship and four NCAA Tournament berths with the Tigers.

Pearl currently ranks No. 13 among active NCAA Division I coaches in career wins (640) and No. 8 all-time among winningest SEC coaches with 323 career victories at Auburn and Tennessee combined.

During the 2022-23 season, the Tigers continued to make history finishing the season with a 21-13 overall record - the 11th-most wins in program history. Auburn has now turned in 20-win seasons in five of the last six years and is the second-winningest program in the SEC in that span.

Auburn was ranked a program-best 32-consecutive weeks in The Associated Press Top 25 Poll and as high as No. 11 in the country during the season. It was one of 10 schools to be ranked in the AP Top 25 throughout the 2022 calendar year.

For the third-consecutive school year, the Tigers achieved a team GPA of 3.0 or higher and received the NABC Academic Excellence Award under Pearl.

Six Tigers have been drafted into the NBA and developed by Pearl and his coaching staff including All-Americans Jabari Smith (No. 3 overall in 2022) and Walker Kessler selected (No. 22 overall in 2022). Both are currently playing in the league along with Chuma Okeke (No. 16 overall in 2019), Isaac Okoro (No. 5 overall in 2020), JT Thor (No. 37 overall in 2021) and Sharife Cooper (No. 48 overall in 2021).

Pearl's teams have been just as successful off the court as Auburn has had 37 graduates since 2014 - the most in the SEC.

In 29 seasons as a head coach, he has guided his teams to the NCAA Tournament 21 times and a 640-258 (.713) winning record.

Pearl is the only head coach (football or men's basketball) in SEC history to lead two programs to a No. 1 national ranking (Auburn in 2022 and UT in 2008). Additionally, he is just one of three head coaches to take four programs (three at the Division I level) to the Sweet 16, joining Lon Kruger and Eddie Sutton.

Through the Bruce Pearl Family Foundation, he and his wife, Brandy, remain committed to giving back to those in Alabama, providing support to children and families facing challenging and life-altering illnesses through Children's Harbor.

In 2015-16, Pearl started AUTLIVE at Auburn to benefit patients in the state of Alabama in the fight against cancer. AUTLIVE also raises the awareness of cancer prevention and detection.

A native of Boston, Mass., Pearl graduated cum laude from Boston College in 1982 with a bachelor's degree in business administration. He is the proud father of four children, Jacqui, Steven, Leah and Michael, and enjoys spending time with his grandchildren.




