GAME 13 No. 12 MIZZOU (10-2, 4-2) at AUBURN (9-7, 3-5) STORYLINES

- Mizzou is coming off a statement victory on Saturday after upending No. 6 Tennessee, 73-64, on the road. It was the Tigers' first win in Knoxville since 1972 and the first road win over a No. 6 team since beating No. 3 Baylor in 2011-12. Mizzou now has four true road wins, three wins over Top 25 teams and five Quad 1 victories this season.
- The last time Mizzou had a pair of wins over Top 6 teams in the same campaign was 2011-12 (Baylor twice).
- Mizzou is one of three teams nationally with both four true road wins and three ranked wins, joining Baylor and Ohio State. Mizzou and Gonzaga are the only teams in the country with five Quad 1 victories.
- Mizzou has won three straight league games for the first time since 2017-18. That season was also the last time Mizzou had four true road wins. Three of those wins came by double-digits. The last time Mizzou had three true road victories by a double-digit margin in an entire season was 2006-07.
- Mizzou has now won five games away from home, including a neutral site victory over ranked Oregon. Before Cuonzo Martin's arrival, Mizzou hadn't won a true road game since 2014. The Tigers have 13 such wins in the Martin era & at least four in a season for the second time under his guidance.
- Mizzou and Auburn are deadlocked at 6-6 in the all-time head-to-head series. Mizzou is looking for its second all-time win on the road against Auburn and first since 2014. A win would give Mizzou back-to-back wins in the series for the first time since 2013-14.
- The Tigers check in at No. 23 in the latest NET rankings. Eleven of Mizzou's 12 opponents are in the NET's Top 135. Thanks to the tough schedule and Mizzou taking advantage of those opportunities, ESPN's Basketball Power Index ranks Mizzou's strength of record fifth nationally and the Tigers clock in at No. 3 nationally in the RPI.
- Mizzou checked in at No. 12 in the Jan. 25 AP Top 25 poll. That marks seven consecutive weeks for the Tigers in the poll, their longest streak since 2012-13. All seven weeks have included Mizzou in the Top 20. No. 12 matches the Tigers' highest ranking this season and the highest since Jan. 7, 2014.
- Mizzou's defense continues to be stifling. The Tigers held Texas A&M to 52 points, its lowest output of the season. Five of Mizzou's 12 opponents have scored their season-low against the Tigers. Tennessee was Mizzou's 19th consecutive opponent to score fewer than 80 points. Cuonzo Martin's squad leads the SEC in both 3-point field goal percentage defense and overall field goal percentage defense.
- Redshirt senior Dru Smith racked up his second SEC Player of the Week honor on Monday. He is the only player in the SEC with two outright Player of the Week honors this season. Dru enters Tuesday needing just five points to reach 1,000 for his career. He's scored in double figures in four consecutive games.
- Mizzou forward Jeremiah Tilmon, Jr., has been dominant of late, riding perhaps the best stretch of his career to open SEC play. He's shooting 71 percent from the floor while averaging 16.6 points, 8.4 rebounds and 1.7 blocks per game during the last five games. Tilmon has four double-doubles in the last seven games.

JEREMIAH TILMON'S MONSTER STRETCH

- Senior **Jeremiah Tilmon, Jr.**, returned for a fourth season in Columbia after testing the NBA Draft waters over the summer. The seasoned big man has made 86 starts, played in 93 games and netted 864 points as a Tiger.
- Tilmon entered his senior campaign with six career double-doubles. He has four in the past seven games after a 14-point, 10-rebound, three-block performance at Texas A&M and a 19-point, 10-rebound, three-block outing vs. South Carolina.
- He is the first Tiger with three blocks in back-to-back games since Jontay Porter in 2018. Tilmon is tied for ninth all-time in program history with 89 blocks. He is 11 swats shy of becoming the eighth Tiger ever with 100 career blocks.
- Tilmon went 8-for-11 vs. South Carolina. He added a career-best three steals during the dominant outing, becoming just the fourth Tiger with 18 points, three steals and three blocks in a game (Steve Stipanovich, Doug Smith twice & Ricky Frazier).
- In the past five games, Tilmon is averaging 16.6 points and 8.5 rebounds, while shooting 71 percent from the field.
- He's been on a torrid stretch to begin league play, shooting an SEC-high 67.9 percent from the field (36-of-53) while averaging 16.0 points per game (12th in the SEC) and 7.7 boards per outing (third in the SEC). The current all-time SEC record for field goal percentage in league games only is 71.2 percent, set by Alabama's Bobby Lee Hurt in 1984.
- Tilmon's four double-doubles already matches his career-high for a season. A fifth would be the most by a Tiger in a season since Jordan Barnett in 2017-18. He's one of just 72 players nationally with four double-doubles in 2020-21.
- Tilmon had arguably the best performance of his career at Arkansas, scoring a career-high 25 points - the most by any Tiger in a game this season. He added 11 rebounds, securing his eighth career double-double. Tilmon limited the opposing center to 0-for-11 shooting in a total all-around dominating effort. He followed with 16 points, on 8-of-10 shooting, at Mississippi State and snagged six rebounds. He is just the second Tiger since 2010 to post a 25-point, 11-rebound game, joining Jordan Geist.
- Tilmon's team-best 7.8 rebounds per game clip ranks sixth in the SEC for all games and is the highest by a Tiger since Alex Oriakhi in 2012-13. In his 19 career games with at least eight rebounds, Mizzou is 17-2.
- Tilmon secured his seventh career double-double with 12 points and 10 rebounds vs. Bradley. He made the game-winning 3-point play with 1.0 second left, converting a tough bucket and draining a free throw to push the Tigers to a 1-point win. It was the first game-winning bucket of his career, including high school and childhood.
- Through 12 games, Tilmon leads Mizzou in rebounding (7.8) and field goal percentage (.635). That ranks ninth nationally this season. He is one of the nation's most efficient scorers, shooting 57 percent for his career, which ranks fourth all-time at Mizzou and 29th nationally among all active players. He shot 58.9 percent a season ago from the floor.
- He's on pace to become the first Mizzou player in more than 30 years to shoot at least 54 percent in all four seasons.
- He launched the 2020-21 campaign with a career-high 12 boards and eight points on 4-of-5 shooting vs. Oral Roberts. Tilmon then dominated the paint vs. No. 21 Oregon, scoring 11 points and snagging nine boards. He tallied eight points and nine boards vs. Liberty. He's chipped in at least seven points in 12 of the last 14 games.
- When Jeremiah scores at least 13 points, Mizzou is 18-5 in his career. When he reaches 16 points, Mizzou is 10-0.

TOUGH, CUONZO DEFENSE

- Mizzou improved to 27-0 in the Cuonzo Martin era when holding opponents to 59 or fewer points after limiting the Aggies to a season-low 52 points on Jan. 16.
- Mizzou is continuing its reputation of tough, hard-nosed defense under Martin. Through 12 games, Mizzou ranks 20th nationally and first in the SEC in 3-point field goal percentage defense, holding opponents to 28.6 percent shooting from beyond the arc. Opponents are making just 5.9 3-pointers per game.
- Mizzou held Arkansas to season-lows for points scored (68) and field goal percentage (.268); the Tigers have held five opponents to a season-low point total (ORU, at Wichita State, Liberty, at Arkansas, at Texas A&M) and their defense has held the opponent to a season-low shooting from the floor three times (at WSU, Liberty, at Arkansas).
- Mizzou has not allowed an opponent to reach the 80-point mark this season, and has held its foe to 79 or fewer points in 19-straight games and 41 of its last 43 overall. LSU (82) and Alabama (88) are the only teams to score more than 79 points against the Tigers in the last 42 games, both of which did so on their home floors a year ago.
- Mizzou held Arkansas to its worst shooting game ever at Bud Walton Arena at 26.8 percent in the Tigers' 81-68 win on Jan. 2. It marked the worst shooting game for a Tiger opponent in a conference game since Georgia shot just 25.5 percent from the floor in a 64-39 Mizzou win at Athens, March 6, 2019, and worst overall since Chicago State hit 24.4 percent in a 91-33 Mizzou win in Columbia, Dec. 30, 2019.
- The Tigers are holding opponents to 39.6 percent shooting from the field overall, which also leads the SEC & ranks 38th nationally. Seven of Mizzou's 12 opponents thus far have shot worse than 40 percent from the field.
- Mizzou is also cleaning up on the glass, thanks in large part to Jeremiah Tilmon, Jr. Mizzou is 8-0 this season and 47 of the Tigers' 60 wins during the Martin-era have come when they have won the rebounding battle.

THE CUONZO EFFECT

- In the previous three seasons before Cuonzo's arrival, Mizzou won 27 total games, 0 against ranked teams and 0 true road games. Twelve games into his fourth season on campus, Martin has won 60 total games, seven against ranked opponents and racked up 13 true road wins.
- He and the Tigers are being recognized nationally this season. Thus far, Martin was named National Coach of the Week, Mizzou was named National Team of the Week and Mark Smith and Dru Smith have earned three combined SEC Player of the Week awards (Dru 2, Mark 1) The squad nabbed two straight SEC weekly honors for the first time since Feb. 2018.

SHARPSHOOTER IS BACK

- Mark Smith was named SEC player of the Week on Dec. 14 after leading Mizzou to a pair of wins over No. 21 Oregon at a neutral site and Wichita State on the road, averaging 17 points, 3.5 rebounds and 2.0 assists while ripping the nets to the tune of 52.6 percent shooting from the field, 45.4 percent shooting from 3-point range and a perfect 9-of-9 clip at the foul line.
- He followed that week with 17 points on four threes vs. Liberty, but only reached double figures one time since Dec. 9 (11 points at Arkansas) before Tuesday's explosion. Against South Carolina, Mark poured in 18 points on three trifectas. Mizzou improved to 6-0 on the season when he reaches double figures. The Tigers went 8-3 when he did so last season.
- Mark led the SEC in 3-point field goal percentage as a sophomore, and shot 37 percent from beyond the arc as a junior. Mark has made three or more 3-point buckets in 24 of his 55 appearances in a Mizzou uniform with the Tigers posting a 16-8 record in those games. He is key to Mizzou's success.
- In his three seasons at Mizzou, Mark is shooting 39.8 percent from beyond the arc. The last Tiger to shoot that well from 3-point range over multiple seasons was Marcus Denmon (40.4 percent) from 2009-12.

BALANCED ATTACK

- A key to Mizzou's success has been experience. Martin's squad features one of the most experienced rosters in all of college basketball, returning 88.13 percent of its scoring from a season ago, which ranks third among all Power 5 conference teams, trailing only Texas and UCLA. The returners are responsible for 99.7 percent of Mizzou's points through 12 games. Eight Tigers are averaging 14.0 minutes or more thru 12 games, with six contributing at least 6.8 points and four posting at least 11.2 points on the season. Four different Tigers have led Mizzou in scoring in a game this season.
- Mizzou's veteran squad has been good recently under Martin in bounce-back games, going 6-1 in its last seven games coming off a loss. The roster features three players with 700+ career points (Dru Smith, Jeremiah Tilmon and Drew Buggs) and six with 500+ career points (Smith, Tilmon, Buggs, Xavier Pinson, Mark Smith and Javon Pickett). Mizzou's 12-man roster features 10 players with at least junior (or redshirt sophomore) eligibility standing, making Mizzou the SEC's oldest team.

BUGGS, PICKETT & MITCH ROUND OUT THE DEEP ROTATION

- Coach Martin also bolstered his backcourt in the offseason with the addition of Hawaii transfer Drew Buggs, who set the Rainbow Warriors' all-time career assists record with 437 dimes. Buggs dished a season-high five assists with just one turnover vs. Liberty and had four assists at Arkansas, becoming just the 16th active Division I player with 450+ assists. His 464 career assists rank 21st among all active players. Buggs scored a season-high six points in the Tigers' most recent outing vs. South Carolina. His assist-to-turnover ratio is 3.8 (27 assists, seven turnovers).
- After starting 62 games through his first two campaigns, Martin has asked junior Javon Pickett to come off the bench this season. Pickett, well-known for his relentless work ethic, has responded by becoming Mizzou's fifth-leading scorer with 7.4 points per game. Pickett trails only Tilmon on the team in field goal percentage, making 51.4 percent of his attempts, including a 33-for-55 (.600) effort from 2-point range. He's coming off a 12-point outing at Texas A&M and an eight-point effort vs. South Carolina, improving Mizzou's record to 11-1 when he reaches double figures over the last two seasons. He finished with 14 points, on 6-of-8 shooting, vs. No. 6 Illinois. In three career games vs. the Illini, he's 3-0 while averaging 15.7 points and 5.0 rebounds and shooting 68.9 percent (20-of-29 FGs). Thru 10 games, Pickett has produced four double-figure scoring efforts. Pickett had 11 points in 20 minutes vs. ORU in the season-opener, then netted 13 in 21 minutes against No. 21 Oregon before the season-high 14 points vs. Illinois.
- Fifth-year senior Mitchell Smith has also embraced coming off the bench, playing the fifth-most minutes on the team. He's chipping in 4.7 points and 4.7 rebounds (the third-most on the squad). Smith is the energy guy, who brings the emotion and has the ability to guard all five positions at 6-foot-10.

DRU & X IN THE BACKCOURT

- Dru Smith, a Preseason second-team All-SEC selection by both the league's coaches and the media, is one of the nation's best defenders. He's swiping 1.9 steals per game this season and his 2.1 steals per game over his time as a Tiger ranks second all-time at Mizzou. He is a two-time SEC Player of the Week, the only player in the league with two outright POTW awards this season. He enters Tuesday night's game at Auburn needing just five points to reach the 1,000-career point plateau.
- Dru has scored in double digits in nine of 12 games this season. He tallied 16 points, six boards, six assists and four steals in one of the best all-around performances of his Tiger career at Texas A&M. He is the only Tiger in the last decade to hit all those marks in the same game. Dru followed with 16 on just six shots vs. South Carolina on Tuesday. Only Dru, Jordan Geist, Keith Shamburger, Alex Oriakhi and Kim English have done that in a Mizzou uniform in the last decade. He chipped in 18 points and had zero turnovers at No. 6 Tennessee.
- He opened the campaign by stuffing the stat sheet vs. ORU with 16 points, six assists, five rebounds and four steals, shooting 5-of-9 from the field, then followed with three steals, 11 points, four boards and four assists in a team-high 31 minutes vs. No. 21 Oregon. Dru posted 14 points, four assists and two dimes at Wichita State and a team-high 18 points vs. Illinois.
- The redshirt senior point guard finished his first season as a Tiger in 2019-20 with 393 points, 131 boards, 121 assists and 64 steals. The last two SEC players to reach those marks in each category in the same campaign: Ben Simmons and John Wall. He became just the second SEC player since 1992 to average 12.7 points, 3.9 assists, 2.1 steals and 4.2 rebounds alongside Georgia's Katu Davis in 1995-96.
- In his 93-game career, Dru has only gone two games without recording an assist (Dec. 3, 2016), giving him a dime in 84 of the last 85 games. He's posted 83 multi-assist outings in his last 87 games. Dru has started 64-straight games including all 42 of his Mizzou career. Dru's 87.7 percent clip from the free throw line ranks 10th nationally among all active players.
- An electric playmaker, Xavier Pinson has averaged 16.1 points over his last 17 games while producing 15 double-figure scoring games in that span, six of which have been 20-point or better efforts, after a 22-point outburst vs. No. 21 Oregon, 23 points at Arkansas and season-high 27 points at No. 6 Tennessee. The 27 points on Saturday marked the most by a Tiger this season and the most scored by an individual player against Tennessee all season. Pinson erupted for 19 second-half points against Oregon and finished with four rebounds and three dimes. He scored his 23 points at Arkansas on just 11 field goal attempts, just the 10th different Tiger to do so in a game since 2010.
- At Tennessee, Pinson scored 27 points on 10-of-14 shooting, hitting all three of his 3-point attempts and all four of his free throw attempts. The Chicago native has reached double figures 15 times in Mizzou's last 19 games, including nine of 12 this season. Mizzou is 14-5 in those 19 contests.
- Pinson's ability to attack the rim, get fouled and convert at the foul line has been a weapon for Mizzou. Pinson has made a team-best 62 trips to the foul line, 20 more than any other Tiger guard. He's made 80.6 percent of his attempts this season. Pinson made 12-of-15 free throws at Arkansas, the most in a game by a Tiger this season. When Pinson has earned 10+ trips to the free throw line in a game in his career, Mizzou is 6-0. Pinson's 196 career assists ranks sixth among all active SEC players.

MIZZOU MADE IN THE NBA

- In June of 2018, Michael Porter, Jr., was selected 14th overall by the Denver Nuggets, becoming the Tigers' first NBA First-Round selection since DeMarre Carroll was taken 27th overall in 2009. Porter, Jr., was Mizzou's highest NBA Draft pick since Keyon Dooling was selected 10th by the Orlando Magic in 2000.
- Jordan Clarkson is averaging 14.8 points per game over his career, the highest average of any former Mizzou player. Clarkson put up 15.6 points per game in 2019-20 with the Utah Jazz. he's averaging 17.8 per game this, which is the highest among any 6th man in the Western Conference. Former All-SEC forward Jontay Porter, who played for Cuonzo Martin, recently inked a 3-year, 6-million dollar deal with the Memphis Grizzlies, giving Mizzou three NBA pros.
- Mizzou also has a host of former Tigers overseas, including a trio of recent graduates under Martin - Jordan Barnett, Jordan Geist and Kassius Robertson. Barnett and Geist are both in Germany and Robertson is a standout in Spain.

2018-19 (FRESHMAN):

- Played in all 32 games as a freshman, making four starts and logging 22.8 minutes per game largely off the bench.
- Averaged 7.1 points per game and finished with 226 total points, 49 rebounds, 17 assists and 73 made field goals.
- Set a new Mizzou freshman record for single-season made 3s with 53 triples, passing Kareem Rush (46 in 1999-00).
