### >> QUICK HITTERS

- Wednesday's win at Jacksonville State marked Auburn's sixth comeback win this season.
- The team's 10-game unbeaten streak is its longest since winning 15 games in a row in 2019.
- The pitching staff has held the opponent to three or fewer runs in three straight games, turning in a 2.00 ERA six earned runs in 27.0 innings during the span.
- Starting pitching has turned in 10.2 scoreless innings with two hits, three walks and 14 strikeouts in two games this week.
- Auburn's offense has double digit hits in seven of the last 10 games and is hitting .335 with 93 runs on 114 hits during the stretch.
- Cole Foster, Ike Irish and Bryson Ware are hitting a combined .482 (54-for-112) in the last 10 games.
- This weekend's matchup marks a rematch of the 2022 Auburn Regional opener in which Auburn scored 11 runs with four homers in the first inning and ultimately won 19-7.
- The Tigers are 3-0 all-time against Southeastern, outscoring the Lions 46-14 in the series.

Butch Thompson enters his eighth season at the helm of the program in 2023, posting a record of 222-164 in his first seven seasons. He has led the program to the College World Series in two of the last three postseasons.

Butch Thompson was named Auburn's head baseball coach on October 22, 2015 and enters his eighth season with the Tigers in 2023.

Thompson has returned the Tigers to prominence in seven seasons on The Plains as he has guided the team to a 222-164 overall record and has advanced to the NCAA Tournament four of the last five postseasons, including three Super Regional appearances in the last four years and two trips to the College World Series in the last three postseasons.

Thompson, who spent three seasons as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Auburn from 2006-08, returned to The Plains after seven seasons at Mississippi State as both associate head coach and pitching coach.

A native of Amory, Miss., Thompson has coached 33 Division I All-Americans and 43 all-conference performers. He has seen 20 of his former pitchers called up to Major League Baseball, including 14 since 2014. Thompson has also turned 38 pitchers who went undrafted out of high school into MLB draft picks.

Along with his pitching pedigree, Thompson is also considered one of the top recruiters in the country. Since 2003, he has secured 15 recruiting classes that were ranked in the top 10 by either Baseball America or Perfect Game, including the program record No. 4 class in 2017 and No. 5 class in 2022. His classes signed from 2006-08 at Auburn each ranked in the top 18 nationally.

In 30 years of coaching at the collegiate level, including 21 in the Southeastern Conference, Thompson has coached nine College World Series participants, including leading the Tigers to the program's first trip to the College World Series in 22 years in 2019 and taking the team back for the second time in three postseasons in 2022. Auburn is one of six program to appear in two of the last three College World Series, and Thompson is one of five active SEC coaches who have taken their program to a pair of College World Series in a three-year span. Thompson has also coached one national champion and a national runner-up, won nine conference championships and made 18 postseason appearances.

Thompson was named the 2006 Fellowship of Christian Athletes SEC Coach of the Year while at Auburn and the 2014 Baseball America and American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA) National Assistant Coach of the Year while at Mississippi State.

During his tenure with the Tigers, Thompson has led the team to three straight NCAA Tournament appearances from 2017-19 for the first time since 2001-03, including back-to-back super regionals in 2018 and 2019 for the first time in program history. Auburn has finished five of Thompson's seven seasons in the top 25, including three in the top 10. The No. 5 national ranking to finish 2022 was tied for the second highest mark in program history.

The 2022 season marked one of the most successful in recent program history as the Tigers went 43-22 overall and 16-13 in SEC play. The 43 wins were tied for the most since 1999, and the winning conference record marked the Tigers' third under Thompson after doing so just once from 2004-15.

Auburn went 37-18 in the regular season and lost back-to-back games on just three occasions before being selected as a regional host for the first time since 2010. The Tigers swept Southeastern, Florida State and UCLA in the regional, outscoring them 51-18 in the process, before becoming the first team to defeat Oregon State in a home super regional by taking down the Beavers in a dramatic winner-take-all game three. Auburn moved on to Omaha and defeated Stanford 6-2 to secure the program's first College World Series win since 1997.

In seven seasons at MSU, Thompson made four NCAA regional trips, two Super



Regionals, won the SEC Tournament and advanced to the College World Series finishing as NCAA runner-up in 2013. In three of his last four seasons in Starkville, the Bulldogs' staff ERA finished no higher than 3.06. Thompson's 2013 pitching staff was one of two nationally to finish in the top 15 in ERA, strikeouts per nine innings and hits allowed per nine innings.

In addition to his experience at Auburn and Mississippi State, Thompson also spent four seasons at Georgia from 2002-05, including a trip to the College World Series in 2004. While there, he guided the development of future Major Leaguers Josh Fields, Mitchell Boggs and Brooks Brown.

Thompson launched his coaching career as pitching coach and top assistant at Huntingdon College (Ala.) in 1993, before returning to his alma mater in Birmingham, where he helped lead the Panthers to back-to-back Southern States Conference Championships and in 1995 coached BSC to its first NAIA World Series berth.

Thompson left BSC briefly to serve as head coach at Jefferson State Community College in Birmingham in 1997. While at ISCC, he was honored as the Regional Tournament Coach of the Year, the ABCA Alabama Junior College Coach of the Year and the Southeast Region Coach of the Year after guiding JSCC to a 39-21 mark, the AJCAA Region 22 State Championship and a thirdplace finish in the NICAA Division II World Series.

He returned to Birmingham-Southern as top assistant the following season, beginning a four-year run during the most successful span in BSC baseball history. The Panthers won 196 games and four TranSouth Conference Championships and made three-consecutive appearances in the NAIA World Series. BSC's 2001 team posted a school-best 55-11 mark and captured the NAIA National Championship.

In 2002, Thompson joined the SEC baseball coaching fraternity as a pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at Georgia and has been a part of the league for the past 17 seasons.

Thompson currently serves as the large-school representative for the Alabama Baseball Coaches Association and is an All-American committee member representing the South region for the ABCA.

- The Lions lead the country in hit by pitches (56) and rank top 10 in the country in stolen bases (47), on-base percenatge (.458) and walks (92).
- Fifth-year outfield Tyler Finke leads the team with a .375 average and ranks third in the country with 15 stolen bases. He tied the program record for stolen bases this week.
- On the mound, the Lions have turned in three shutouts this season, good for the second most in the country, and have posted a 4.55 ERA in 110.2 innings.
















### **ALL KIRBY DOES IS CRUSH**

- Justin Kirby homered six times through his first eight games in an Auburn uniform, marking the most home runs through eight games since at least 1993.
- His first six hits this season were all home runs, and 11 of his 12 hits so far have gone for extra bases.
- His .720 slugging percentage is good for second on the team.

### THREE KEYS TO THE GAME

- Auburn's points of emphasis this season are producing the biggest inning, fewest freebies and most baserunners.
- The team that has produced the biggest inning this year is 12-0 and the one game with an equal biggest inning ended in a tie.
- The team that has issued the fewest freebies this year is 8-3-1. One game was tied for freebies.
- The team that has produced the most baserunners this year is 10-2-1.

### **CONSISTENCY IS KEY**

- Despite having the No. 6 strength of schedule in 2022, Auburn didn't lose more than back-to-back games last season and dropped just two games in a row on three occasions.

- He recorded his 200th career hit with a first-inning double vs. Lipscomb last Friday also marking his 200th career game played becoming the first Auburn player to reach the career mileston since 2016.

- Kason Howell is tied for the NCAA active lead in career doubles (54) and ranks fourth in games played (203) and fifth in at-bats (739).
- Justin Kirby ranks tied for sixth in doubles (46) and 10th in total bases (334).
- Tommy Vail is the NCAA active leader in H/9.0 IP (4.94) and leads the country in the category this season (0.68).

### **CAPTAIN AMERICA**

- Junior pitcher Joseph Gonzalez returns to lead the pitching staff after leading Auburn with seven wins and a 3.22 ERA in 2022.
- Last year, Gonzalez became the first Auburn pitcher to turn in four straight SEC quality starts since 2018 and the first two win four straight SEC starts since 2015.
- Following the season, he represented our country with the USA Baseball Collegiate National Team, leading them to a bronze medal while not allowing an earned run or a walk in 11.2 innings of competition.

### STOPPERS OF THE YEAR

- John Armstrong and Chase Isbell were two of 17 SEC pitchers named to the NCBWA Stopper of the Year Award Watch List.
- Armstrong has earned a win in four straight appearances and leads the country in the category.



### THE ROAD TO OMAHA

- Auburn advanced to the College World Series for the second time in the last three postseasons in 2022.
- The Tigers hosted a regional for the first time in 12 years and swept the likes of Southeastern, Florida State and UCLA by a combined score of 51-18, marking the most runs by a SEC team in a three-game regional.
- The team then became the first program to defeat Oregon State in a home super regional, and secured the program's first win in Omaha since 1997 with a 6-2 win against Stanford.

### THE 2022 MLB DRAFT WAS A DANDY

- Auburn had eight players selected in the 2022 MLB Draft, all previously undrafted.
- The eight draft picks were the second most in program history, third most in the SEC and tied for the fifth most in the country.
