> Auburn wraps up its regular season non-conference schedule with a short trip to Alabama State Wednesday evening at Lagoon Park.

> The Tigers tout a 14-4 record away from Jane B. Moore Field in 2017. In those 18 games, Victoria Draper leads the team with a .320 average. Kendall Veach and Carlee Wallace have provided the pop in the lineup with 11 and nine extra-base hits, respectively. The duo has also combined for 27 RBI. Kaylee Carlson holds a 1.48 ERA and has tossed nine complete games, including three shutouts, while holding opponents to hit just .227. Carlson also has struck out 35 in games away from The Plains.

> The Tigers lead the nation in double plays with 36 and average 0.77 per game. The next closest teams are Campbell and UT Arlington, who each have 29 and 28, respectively.

> Kasey Cooper became the second player in SEC history to amass 250 hits and 250 RBI in a career. She joined Alabama's Charlotte Morgan as the only members in the 250 club.

> Cooper was also named a finalist for the Senior CLASS Award. She is one of just 10 finalists and is the first player in program history up for the award.

CLINT MYERS » HEAD COACH

With the reputation of taking a program and turning it into a perennial power, head coach Clint Myers has taken Auburn softball to unprecedented heights in just three years.

Myers has guided the Tigers to back-to-back Women's College World Series appearances in the past two campaigns, when the previously best finish came with a showing at a regional final in 2006.

Since his appointment following the 2013 season, Auburn has broken 21 records, including 16 on offense, and led the nation in a plethora of categories.

Myers has coached nine All-Americans, with three coming in each of his seasons on The Plains. Before his arrival, the Tigers had five players who were tabbed All-Americans in the previous 17 campaigns.

In comparison with rivals in the conference, Myers has coached nine All-SEC performers, even setting a program record with four in 2015. Between 1997-2013, Auburn had never placed multiple players on the all-conference team lists. Since then, the Tigers have had three, four and two representatives in successive years under Myers.

As impressive as Myers' teams have been on the field, the program has taken a giant leap forward off of it.

Under Myers, Auburn has placed three on Academic All-America and Academic All-District lists, something that had never been done previously. In 2016, the Tigers had 24 honorees on the Academic All-SEC list. Kasey Cooper also became the first player in softball history to be named the SEC Scholar-Athlete of the Year and the NCAA Elite 90 winner.

A 1976 graduate of Arizona State, Myers was a member of the Sun Devil baseball team from 1970-73 and played on the College World Series runner-up squads in 1972 and 1973. He was later selected by the St. Louis Cardinals in the third round of the 1973 Major League Draft.

Myers and his wife, Katie, have two sons, Casey and Corey. They also have three grandchildren; grandsons, Cole and Christian, and granddaughter, Carlee.

INSIDE THE SERIES: ALABAMA STATE

» The Tigers and Lady Hornets have squared off in eight separate occasions with Auburn coming out on top in all eight meetings. In total, Auburn has outscored Alabama State 82-12, good for an average margin of victory of 8.8. The Tigers have averaged 10.3 runs per game, while limiting the Lady Hornets to 1.5 runs per contest.

CAREER VERSUS THE LADY HORNETS

» Ten players on the 2017 squad have recorded at least one hit against Alabama State in their careers. Madi Gipson and Kendall Veach have each tallied two hits and three RBI to pace the offense against the Lady Hornets. Victoria Draper and Carlee Wallace have both crossed the plate twice and added a hit of their own.

» In the circle, Jenna Abbott and Kaylee Carlson have amassed two strikeouts apiece and have not allowed one hit.

AN AUBURN WIN WOULD...

» A win by Auburn would give the Tigers their ninth consecutive win over Alabama State. Auburn has started 9-0 versus an opponent against two other foes in program history (Alabama A&M and Mercer).

LAST 10

» In the last 10 games, Auburn has outscored the opposition 36-31, including two shutouts. The Tigers have notched 20 extra-base hits, including 12 doubles, three triples and five home runs. Kasey Cooper and Carlee Wallace pace the club with four each.

» In the circle, Kaylee Carlson has tossed three wins with a 1.53 ERA and five complete games. She's tallied 18 strikeouts in that span.

PLAYER TO WATCH: VICTORIA DRAPER

» Junior outfielder Victoria Draper has found success against non-conference opponents in her career. Draper has batted .357 with a .434 on-base clip against teams outside of the SEC in her time on The Plains. In those games, the Moulton, Ala. native has 11 stolen bases, too. In 2017, Draper has been involved in nine game-winning plays, including five versus non-SEC programs.

START IT UP

» Carlee Wallace has embraced her new role as the primary leadoff hitter for the Tigers this season. Since her shift to the top of the lineup, the junior has led the team with a slash line of .390/.500/.714 while scoring 27 runs. The Alpine, Calif. product has amassed a team-high 41 hits, including 13 doubles, three triples and five home runs to go along with 35 RBI. Wallace has hit a scalding .588 when leading off an inning and successfully advanced runners at a .725 clip in 2017 over that span.

PERFECT PERFORMANCE

» Junior pitcher Kaylee Carlson tossed the second perfect game in program history (and first since Holly Currie in 2005) against Ohio State. In the contest, Carlson threw just 66 pitches (41 strikes) and threw a first-pitch strike to all 18 batters she faced. The Garden Grove, Calif. native never reached a 3-ball count in the outing.

IN GOOD COMPANY

» Senior Kasey Cooper became the second player in SEC history to reach 250 hits and 250 RBI in a career, joining Charlotte Morgan of Alabama. Cooper, who has 259 RBI, needs just six RBI to break the SEC record of 264 in a career, currently held by the aforementioned Morgan.

A CLASS OF HER OWN

» Senior Kasey Cooper was selected as a finalist for the Senior CLASS Award. The annual award is given to the player who excels in community, classroom, character and competition.

» Cooper was also selected as a candidate for the prestigious SEC McWhorter Award.

THREE NAMED TO POTY WATCH LIST

» Kaylee Carlson, Kasey Cooper and Makayla Martin were tabbed to the USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year Watch List.

» Auburn tied for the most representatives on the list, joining Arizona, Florida, Florida State and Oklahoma who each had three players chosen.

LOADED SCHEDULE

» Auburn is set to face a challenging schedule as 35 of its games will be against teams that made the NCAA Tournament a season ago, including 10 contests versus teams that made the Women's College World Series.

» The Tigers are set to face 15 opponents who were ranked or receiving votes in the annual preseason polls, including five inside the top 10. Auburn has six SEC opponents who are inside the top 25 on the docket with four of them being road fixtures.

TIGERS OPEN SEASON AT NO. 2

» The Auburn softball program achieved another first when it was picked No. 2 in the nation in both the USA Today/NFCA Coaches Poll and USA Softball/ESPN.com Poll. The Tigers closed the 2016 campaign as the second-ranked team in the country after reaching the Women's College World Series Championship Series for the first time ever.

» Auburn softball's Kasey Cooper was picked to the Preseason All-SEC Team, the league office announced Wednesday with the unveiling of its 10th annual list for the upcoming 2017 season.

» The 2016 SEC Player of the Year was one of six seniors to be selected to the team that also included six juniors and three sophomores.
