2009 - SOPHOMORE YEAR

Auburn's starting left fielder in 55 games ... Led the team with 15 multi-RBI games ... 17 home runs was second on the team and gave him 27 for his career ... Raised his average from .255 on Apr. 8 to .302 on April 29, hitting .404 (21-for-52) in a 14-game span with six HR and 20 RBI ... Had a monster game against South Alabama on April 15, hitting three home runs and finishing the day a perfect 4-for-4 with a career-high six RBI ... His three-homer game was the first by a Tiger since Josh Etheredge did it against Kentucky in 1996 ... Also had Auburn's first successful steal of home since Clete Thomas did it against UAB in 2004 ... Had a season- and career-long 11-game hitting streak from Feb. 28 - March 15 [Gm 1] ... During the streak he hit .349 (15-for-43) with four doubles, a triple and six home runs, driving in 15 and scoring 15 runs ... Had his first multi-homer game of the season in the series opening game with Brown and hit the third of Auburn's four first-inning home runs ... Finished the series-opening game against Brown 2-for-4 with a then-season high four RBI ... Had a bases-clearing, three-run double in the first inning of the Max Capital City Classic against Alabama ... First-inning home run against Western Kentucky was the second in Auburn's three-homer first ... Hit home runs in both of Auburn's wins over Vanderbilt, hitting a two-run shot in the second inning on Saturday and a two-run shot in the fifth on Sunday ... Finished the series with a team-high four RBI ... Went 2-for-4 with a double, a homer and two RBI in Auburn's 8-7, 11-inning comeback win over Florida in the series opener ... Hit his 13th home run of the season at LSU and finished the series with a team-high five RBI, driving in a run in each game with three on Sunday ... Knocked in three with his 14th HR of the season in the 26-6 win over Troy ... Had a pair of sac flies in the 13-8 win at Troy ... Hit two two-run home runs in series finale at Kentucky ... It was the third multi-homer game of the season and fourth of his career ... Had the

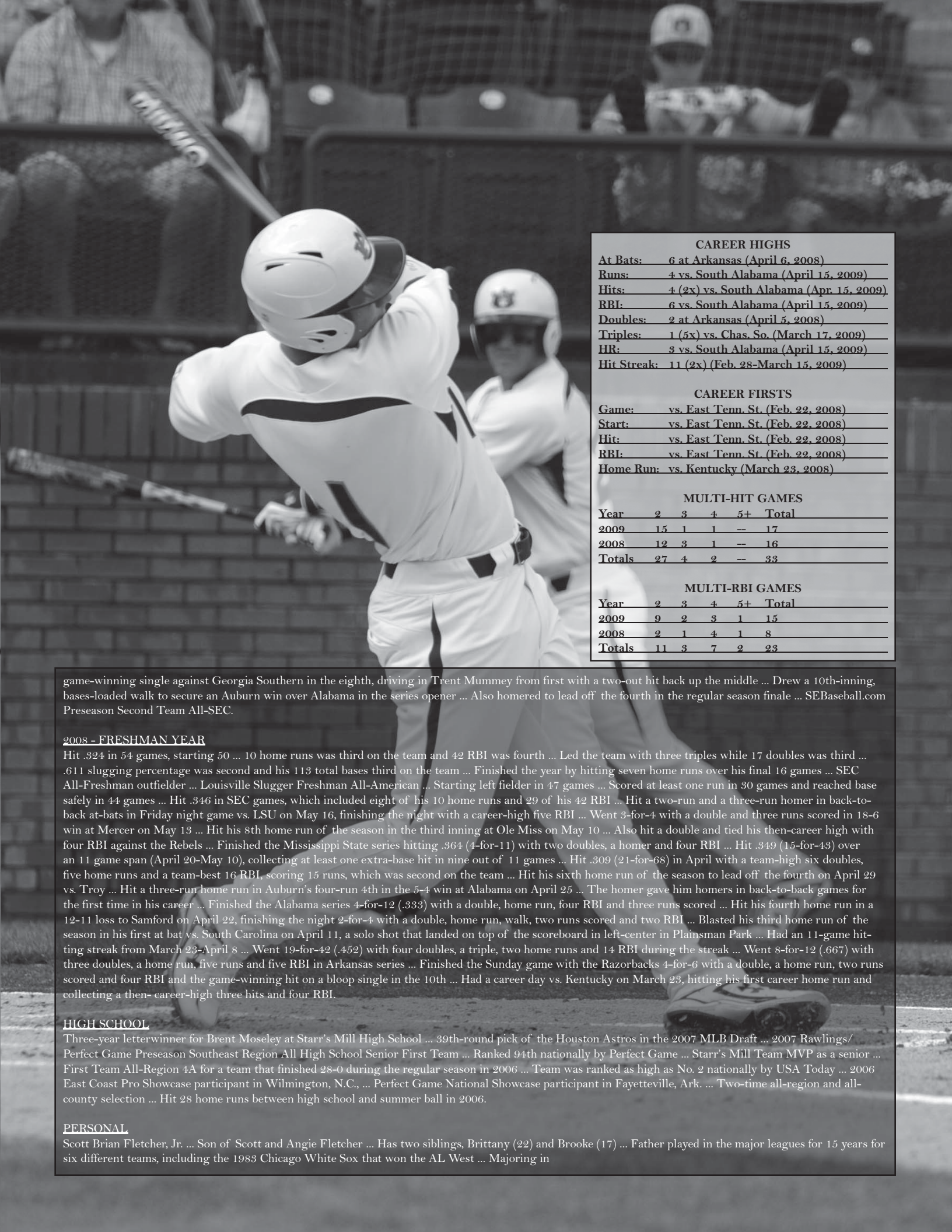

2008 - FRESHMAN YEAR

Hit .324 in 54 games, starting 50 ... 10 home runs was third on the team and 42 RBI was fourth ... Led the team with three triples while 17 doubles was third611 slugging percentage was second and his 113 total bases third on the team ... Finished the year by hitting seven home runs over his final 16 games ... SEC All-Freshman outfielder ... Louisville Slugger Freshman All-American ... Starting left fielder in 47 games ... Scored at least one run in 30 games and reached base safely in 44 games ... Hit .346 in SEC games, which included eight of his 10 home runs and 29 of his 42 RBI ... Hit a two-run and a three-run homer in back-to-back at-bats in Friday night game vs. LSU on May 16, finishing the night with a career-high five RBI ... Went 3-for-4 with a double and three runs scored in 18-6 win at Mercer on May 13 ... Hit his 8th home run of the season in the third inning at Ole Miss on May 10 ... Also hit a double and tied his then-career high with four RBI against the Rebels ... Finished the Mississippi State series hitting .364 (4-for-11) with two doubles, a homer and four RBI ... Hit .349 (15-for-43) over an 11 game span (April 20-May 10), collecting at least one extra-base hit in nine out of 11 games ... Hit .309 (21-for-68) in April with a team-high six doubles, five home runs and a team-best 16 RBI, scoring 15 runs, which was second on the team ... Hit his sixth home run of the season to lead off the fourth on April 29 vs. Troy ... Hit a three-run home run in Auburn's four-run 4th in the 5-4 win at Alabama on April 25 ... The homer gave him homers in back-to-back games for the first time in his career ... Finished the Alabama series 4-for-12 (.333) with a double, home run, four RBI and three runs scored ... Hit his fourth home run in a 12-11 loss to Samford on April 22, finishing the night 2-for-4 with a double, home run, walk, two runs scored and two RBI ... Blasted his third home run of the season in his first at bat vs. South Carolina on April 11, a solo shot that landed on top of the scoreboard in left-center in Plainsman Park ... Had an 11-game hitting streak from March 23-April 8 ... Went 19-for-42 (.452) with four doubles, a triple, two home runs and 14 RBI during the streak ... Went 8-for-12 (.667) with three doubles, a home run, five runs and five RBI in Arkansas series ... Finished the Sunday game with the Razorbacks 4-for-6 with a double, a home run, two runs scored and four RBI and the game-winning hit on a bloop single in the 10th ... Had a career day vs. Kentucky on March 23, hitting his first career home run and collecting a then-career-high three hits and four RBI.
