## **FIVE KEYS TO THE GAME**

#### **DIALED IN DEFENSE**

▶ The MT defense has been stout over the last two games and is only allowing opponents to shoot 32.8 percent from the field and 28.9 percent from beyond the three-point line. The solid effort has vaulted MT to 36th nationally in defensive rebounds per game (29.1), 63rd in field goal percentage defense (39.2) and 78th in scoring defense (66.0 ppg).

### CHAMPIONSHIP PEDIGREE

▶ Since 2010. Middle Tennessee has been one of the best teams in their respective conference. In fact, the Blue Raiders have won four league championships in six years. MT went 13-5 in conference games during the 2009-10 season and were crowned champion of the Sun Belt. The Blue Raiders followed that feat with a 14-2 mark in 2011-12 and a 19-1 record in 2012-13 - their last in the SBC. MT transferred its success over to C-USA and won the league in its first year as a member.

#### HAIL HARRIS


▶ Darnell Harrishas been on a tear as of late in a veraging 18.5 points over his last two games. The big-man set a new career-high with three blocks against VCU and then eclipsed that with four stuffs versus South Alabama. Harris is shooting 56.5 percent from the floor and 66.7 percent from deep over the stretch.

#### WELCOME BACK


▶ Saturday's game will mark the fourth time that Middle Tennessee has played in Bridgestone Arena (formerly the Sommet Center). The Blue Raiders fell to No. 2 ranked Memphis, 65-41, in 2007 and to No. 9 Tennessee, 75-54, in 2009. However, MT bounced back to win a, 56-52, thriller over Vanderbilt at the Nashville arena in 2012. Current grad assistant Kerry Hammonds had 11 points against Vandy.

### TRIPLE-DOUBLES

▶ Just last season, Middle Tennessee did not have a single player average over 10 points per game. Reggie Upshaw was close at 9.9, but this season MT has three players in double-figures in Giddy Potts (14.3), Darnell Harris (12.1) and Upshaw (10.9). Perrin Buford is next at 9.4 ppg.



## SERIES HISTORY

▶ MT will take on AU for only the fourth time in program history. The Tigers hold a 3-0 edge in the series and won last year's meeting in Auburn. This will be the first time that MT has hosted AU as the Blue Raiders have traveled to the Plains the last two meetings following the Tigers' win in Puerto Rico in 2004.




### **BUFORD'S BEST**

▶ Through his first 22 games as a Blue Raider, Perrin Buford was averaging just 5.8 points, 2.6 rebounds and 13.6 minutes per game. In his last 21 games stretched over two seasons, Buford is averaging 10.8 points, 4.8 rebounds and 23.67 minutes per contest.




### **KEEPING PACE**

▶ MT has 48 total wins since 2013-14 - the first year the team joined the C-USA. That mark trails only La Tech (58) and UTEP (51) among league schools.



### STIFF COMPETITION

▶ This season, the Blue Raiders scheduled a tough non-conference schedule that features six teams that had a winning record in 2014-15. The combined record of the scheduled non-conference foes in 2014-15 was 187-143. In addition, MT will face nine teams that reached the postseason a year ago.



### **GREAT ALASKAN CHAMPS**

▶ On Nov. 26-28, MT traveled to the Great Alaska Shootout for a trio of games and came away with a championship. The three-game sweep was just the second regular-season tournament title of the 14-year Kermit Davis era. Following the game, Perrin Buford, Giddy Potts and Reggie Upshaw were all named to the All-Tournament Team.





### **GOING STREAKING**

▶ The Middle Tennessee men's basketball team has made a three-pointer in 609 consecutive games. The streak spans over 19 seasons and the last time MT did not make a three was Jan. 14, 1995 against Murray State.


### A RECORD-SETTING PACE

▶ Since 2011-12, MT's three-point attempts have risen every year. MT is on pace to break the school record of 682 if the team plays three or more postseason games.



#### **60 IS THE MAGIC NUMBER**

▶ The Blue Raiders' hallmark the last few years has been their defense and have hung their hats on limiting opposing offenses. Because of their tenacity on that side of the floor, MT has not had to put up a ton of points in order to win games. In fact, Middle Tennessee's magic number has been 60. Over the last four-plus seasons, MT is 72-12 when scoring 60 or more points in a game.



### MT SLOTTED THIRD BY C-USA COACHES

▶ The Middle Tennessee men's basketball team was slotted third in the 2015-16 C-USA Preseason Poll released on Oct. 7. The order of finish was selected by the league's head coaches (they were not allowed to vote on their own team).

▶ UAB (which won the league last season) was predicted first and garnered 11 first-place votes. Old Dominion was picked second and earned the remaining three first-place votes. UTEP and LA Tech rounded out the top five, while WKU, Rice, North Texas, Marshall, and FIU held the 6-10 spots. Charlotte (11th), FAU (12th), UTSA (13th) and Southern Miss (14th) rounded out the league voting.

▶ The third-place ranking represents the highest mark for the Blue Raiders who are entering their third year in Conference USA. MT finished 9-9 in league play last season and went 13-3 in 2013-14 en route to a regular-season crown.

## **UPSHAW NAMED TO C-USA PRESEASON TEAM**

- ▶ Blue Raider Reggie Upshaw was named to the Preseason All-Conference Team, released on Oct. 7. The team was selected by the league's head coaches (they were not allowed to vote for their own players).
- ▶ Upshaw represents the Blue Raiders on the league's preseason squad. The forward was MT's leading scorer (9.9 ppg) and rebounder (7.0) in 2014-15 as a sophomore. His rebounds are fourth-most among returners in C-USA. The Chattanooga, Tenn. native also was the team-leader in blocks (35) and third in assists (57).
- ▶ In addition, Upshaw led the Blue Raiders in scoring in eight contests and rebounding in 17 games. The big-man added four double-doubles to last season's campaign.

## MT AMONG NATION'S TOP ACADEMIC TEAMS

- ▶ The Middle Tennessee men's basketball team earned the highest possible marks from the NCAA in its recent Graduation Success Rate (GSR) report. The report details the percentage of players who enrolled in college between 2005 and 2008 and graduated within six years.
- ▶ The Blue Raiders were one of just 47 Division I programs to earn a perfect 100 in GSR, meaning every student-athlete that took the floor for MT during the four-year span has earned his degree.
- ▶ Middle Tennessee has also been a top-rated program on the court. Of the 47 teams with a perfect GSR in the latest report, MT ranks fourth in wins from 2011-15 with 98. Duke (118) and Kansas (115) top the list, but MT does have more victories than powerhouses Villanova (95) and Notre Dame (94).

### **LAST TIME OUT**

- ▶ Behind stellar defensive play and a record-setting performance by Giddy Potts, Middle Tennessee (5-2) grinded to its first win of the 2015-16 season inside the Murphy Center, 68-55, over Sun Belt foe South Alabama.
- ▶ Potts dropped 17 points on 6-of-10 shooting, including a scorching 5-of-8 mark from three-point territory. He also added a career-high 14 rebounds, giving the sophomore guard his first-career double-double as a Blue Raider, and the first double-double for an MT guard since Marcos Knight in 2013 against FIU.
- ▶ On the defensive side of the ball, the Blue Raiders held South Alabama to 33.9 percent shooting (20-of-59) from the field, and 23.1 percent (3-of-13) from three-point range.
- ▶ It's the second-consecutive game that the Blue Raiders have held an opponent to under 35 percent shooting from the floor, as they held VCU to 31.7 percent on Dec. 2.

### MT INKS ANTWAIN JOHNSON TO NLI

- ▶ Middle Tennessee picked up one signee on Nov. 11 in Antwain Johnson (Malone, Fla. / Chipola College) who will have three years of eligibility remaining.
- ▶ Johnson will play out this season at Chipola after he committed to the Indians following a standout career at Malone HS where he helped his team win a state championship by averaging 29 points per game.

### DAVIS NAMED ONE OF NATION'S TOP X'S AND O'S COACHES

- ▶ This offseason, coachstat.net ranked the top 25 X's and O's Head Coaches from around the NCAA. Middle Tennessee's Kermit Davis was placed 13th on the list ahead of big-names Chris Mooney (Richmond), Fran McCaffrey (Iowa) and Ben Howland (Mississippi State).
- ▶ From the publication: "Who says you can't teach rebounding? Kermit does it like no-other, along with every other defensive scheme."

#### DARNELL HARRIS (6-8, 231, SENIOR, FORWARD)

- Has led the team in scoring in three of the last four games.
- ► Set a new career-high with three blocks against VCU (Dec. 2) and then had four versus South Alabama (Dec. 5).
- ▶ Is shooting 56.5 percent from the floor and 66.7 percent from deep in his last two games.
- Transferred in from Northwest Florida State prior to 2014-15.
- Won MT's three-point contest at "Murphy Madness".
- Was more of an outside scorer as a junior, but will be asked to do more inside this season due to the graduation of Jacquez Rozier.

#### PERRIN BUFORD (6-6, 220, SENIOR, GUARD/FORWARD)

- Led the team in points with 18 against UAA (Nov. 26). He had 10 points on the year before that game.
- $\blacktriangleright$   $\;$  ls fourth in points per game (9.4) and is tied for the the team lead with eight blocked shots.
- Came one point shy of his first career double-double in the opener at Murray State (Nov. 17) but still managed 10 rebounds and three steals.
- Averaged 12.7 points per game in the Great Alaska Shootout and was named to the All-Tournament Team.
- ▶ Transferred in from Southwest Tennessee State prior to 2014-15.
- From Feb. 5 onward, Buford was playing over 24 minutes per game and his 160 points were tops on the team in 2014-15.
- ls the team's vocal leader. He also leads by example and his work-ethic has been reported by several media outlets.
- Has battled a right knee injury the past five games.

#### 3 JOSHUA PHILLIPS (6-8, 230, JUNIOR, FORWARD)

- ▶ Had his finest game of the yr. against UAA (Nov. 26) with 9 points and eight rebounds.
- Recorded his second career start in the opener at Murray State (Nov. 17) and had an allev-oop slam.
- Is one of just three players on MT's team to play more than one season as a Blue Raider.
- Missed 16 games as a sophomore due to a foot stress fracture injury.
- ▶ Coach Davis called Josh "our most improved player" at this season's preseason press conference

#### 4 XAVIER HABERSHAM (6-6, 205, R-JUNIOR, FORWARD)

- ▶ All five of his makes have been threes and is shooting 45.5 percent from deep.
- ▶ Missed the UAA game (Nov. 26) due to a sore hamstring.
- ▶ Saw the first minutes of his MT career in the opener at Murray State (Nov. 17) and scored his first career points with a three-pointer.
- ▶ Redshirted the 2014-15 season.

#### JACOB IVORY (5-9, 168, SOPHOMORE, GUARD)

- ls expected to see major minutes this year as one of the team's three point guards.
- ▶ Played in 22 games and made five starts as a true freshman.
- ▶ Despite his frame (5-9, 168 lbs.), prefers to go inside the arc for points.
- Is one of the team's toughest players and best on-ball defenders.

#### 10 JAQAWN RAYMOND (6-4, 200, R-SENIOR, GUARD)

- Racked up a team-best 16 assists in the Great Alaska Shootout and had six against UNC Asheville (Nov. 27), the most from a Blue Raider this season.
- ▶ Started for the injured Jacob Ivory in the opener at Murray State (Nov. 17) and had four points and two assists.
- ▶ Is by far the team's leading assist-getter with 23 on the campaign and 21 have come in the last five games.
- ▶ Played in all 36 games in 2014-15, making a team-high 29 starts at point guard.
- ls one of just three players on MT's team to play more than one season as a Blue Raider.
- ▶ Played his freshman season at NC State and then sat out the 2012-13 due to NCAA transfer rules.
- Despite starting 29 games as a junior, Coach Davis has stated that the point guard position is open between three players (Raymond, Ivory and Copeland).

#### EDWARD SIMPSON (6-2, 195, SOPHOMORE, GUARD)

- Started every game of the Great Alaska Shootout over Buford who hard a sore knee.
- Averaged eight points per game during the shootout and was one of five Blue Raiders to score in double-figures against UNC Asheville (Nov. 27), finishing with 11 points.
- ▶ Has a team-best 3.2 assist-to-turnover ratio.
- Has worn a mask in his first seven games to protect a hair-line fracture on his nose.
- ▶ Chose MT over academic powerhouses Yale and Boston Univ.

#### Chase Miller (6-2, 175, FRESHMAN, GUARD)

- Is one of the team's two walk-ons and one of the team's two freshmen.
- Praised by coaches for his shooting touch around the arc.

#### Aldonis Foote (6-6, 210, JUNIOR, GUARD)

- Scored a season-high six points and had a strong dunk against UAA (Nov. 26).
- Was a late addition to the team, enrolling on Aug. 27.
- Averaged nine points and 4.5 rebounds in two years at Trinity Valley CC.
- Is the team's top defender according to his teammates and one of its most physical players.

#### 20 Giddy Potts (6-2, 220, SOPHOMORE, GUARD)

- ▶ Was named to the Great Alaska Shootout All-Tournament Team after averaging 13.7 points per game.
- Scored 10-plus points in each of the first five games this season.
- ▶ Became the first MT guard since Marcos Knight in 2013 to get a double-double with 17 points and 14 boards against South Alabama (Dec. 5).
- ▶ Shooting 53.2 percent from the field, while the rest of the team is at 42.3 percent.
- ▶ Tallied 50 of his 237 points in a two-game span last year, earning C-USA Player of the Week.
- ▶ Was named to the C-USA All-Freshman Team in 2014-15.

#### Jacorey Williams (6-8, 205, REDSHIRT, FORWARD)

- Will redshirt this season to play one season after transferring from Arkansas.
- Won MT's dunk contest at "Murphy Madness".

#### 24 Quavius Copeland (6-0, 175, SOPHOMORE, GUARD)

- ▶ Made the first start of his career at Tennessee State (Nov. 21) and had 15 points.
- ► Has started five games at point guard for MT and is fifth on the team in points per game (6.1).
- ls the team's fastest player with the ball and off the dribble.
- ▶ Possesses a solid stroke and was the team's leading assist-getter in the Bahamas this summer.

#### 25 KARL GAMBLE (6-9, 220, FRESHMAN, GUARD)

- ▶ Had the best game of his MT career against South Alabama (Dec. 5) with three points and five rebounds in 14 minutes.
- Scored the first point of his career at the free throw line at Tennessee State (Nov. 21).
- ls one of the team's two freshmen and the only one on scholarship.
- ▶ Has been praised as "maybe the best freshmen we have ever had here" by Coach Davis.
- ls a true low-post scorer who has surprised teammates with his skill and toughness.
- Mother played college basketball at South Carolina State.

#### 30 REGGIE UPSHAW (6-7, 232, JUNIOR, FORWARD)

- Was the team's top performer against Toledo (Nov. 28), finishing with 17 points.
- Named to the Great Alaska Shootout All-Tournament Team after averaging 12 points per game.
- ls leading the team with 7.6 rebounds per game and is second in points (10.9).
- Has played the most minutes per game for MT (28.6).
- Led the squad in points (9.9) and rebounds (7.0) in 2014-15.
- Named to the Preseason All-CUSA Team this summer.
- ls in his third season as a primary starter and was second on the team as a sophomore with 57 assists.
- ▶ His hair adds an extra 4" to his height.

#### STEPHEN STRACHAN (6-3, 190, JUNIOR, GUARD)

- ls one of the team's two walk-ons and the team's only foreign born player.
- ▶ This is his third school in three years after transferring from Faulkner (2014) and Moberly Area CC (2015).
