- » No. 20 Auburn hosts Yale in a first-time meeting between the two schools on Saturday afternoon. It will be the last contest for the Tigers heading into final exams week.
- » Auburn has won its last three-straight games and claimed its 100th win over the last five years the most victories in the SEC during that time span - in an 85-68 second-half defensive rout of UCF on
- » The Tigers currently rank No. 9 in the nation and tops in the SEC in blocked shots per game (6.6 bpg) behind sophomore big man Walker Kessler, who ranks 12th and No. 1 in the league in the category (3.43 bpg.). He has turned in three double-double performances this season – all in the last four contests. Kessler has also made five-or-more blocked shots in three of his first seven games in an Auburn uniform.
- » Defensively, AU has forced its opponents to commit 75 turnovers over the last four games resulting in 80 of its points (average of 4.3 ppg off turnovers).
- » Auburn also ranks No. 16 nationally in steals per game (10.4 avg.) behind sophomore guard K.D. Johnson, who is third in nation and first in the SEC in the category (3.00 avg.).
- » Jabari Smith extended his double-digit scoring streak to four-consecutive games with a game-high 20 points versus UCF. It marked his fourth 20-point outing of his young career.
- » Five non-conference games remain in the month of December to prepare Auburn for one of the toughest seasons of SEC play. The Tigers are one of six conference schools currently ranked in the Top 25 next to No. 9 Kentucky, No. 10 Arkansas, No. 13 Tennessee, No. 14 Florida and No. 16 Alabama.

- Has advanced to postseason play in 20 of 26 years as a head coach. In 2019-20, had a second-place finish in the SEC with a 25-6 record, including 12-6 in league play, that would be 21 of 25 years in the postseason not been canceled due to COVID
- Set single-season wins records at four different schools (29 at Southern Indiana in 1995; 26 at Wisconsin-Milwaukee in 2005; 31 at Tennessee in 2008; 30 at Auburn in 2019)
- Pearl has achieved a top-5 national ranking at Southern Indiana, Tennessee and Auburn. He has been in the top five in 10 seasons (1994-2001 at Southern Indiana, 2007-08 at Tennessee, 2019-20 at Auburn)
- Bruce Pearl's teams have led their conference in scoring 17 of the 26 years that he has been a head coach. His squads were the SEC's scoring champion in four of his six seasons at Tennessee, averaging 77.4 ppg while allowing 70.5 ppg
- One of 12 coaches to lead three different DI programs to the Sweet 16, joining Rick Barnes, Gene Bartow, John Calipari, Lon Kruger, Frank McGuire, Ralph Miller, Rick Pitino, Bill Self, Tubby Smith, Eddie Sutton and Bruce Weber. Including his stint at DII Southern Indiana, Pearl is one of only three coaches to take four programs (with three at the DI level) to the Sweet 16, joining Lon Kruger and Eddie Sutton
- With the win over Kentucky that sent Auburn to its first Final Four in program history, Pearl notched his 100th win as head coach of the Tigers. He is the first coach in Auburn history to have 100 wins in his first five seasons
- Bruce Pearl is the 11th coach in SEC history to win four conference crowns (overall or division) in a 10-year span. He is on the same list as Adolph Rupp (UK), Babe McCarthy (MSU), Billy Donovan (UF), Dale Brown (LSU), Joe Hall (UK), John Calipari (UK), Nolan Richardson (ARK), Rick Pitino (UK), Rick Stansbury (MSU) and Tubby Smith (UK)
- Auburn sold out of season tickets for the seventh consecutive year in 2021-22 (excluding COVID restricted seating season of 2020-21), all under Pearl, to continue the school record streak. Prior to Pearl, the only other time the Tigers sold out of season tickets came was 1999-2000
- $\bullet$  In 26 full years as a head coach, Bruce Pearl's teams have finished either first or second in conference play 17 times
- $\bullet$  At the Division I level, Pearl's teams have topped the 100-point mark 22 times, including a high of 124 in 2009 as well as 121 in the 2007 NCAA Tournament. In his second year as a coach at Southern Indiana the team averaged 101.7 ppg
- In the past five seasons, Auburn has the best non-conference record in the SEC during the regular season at 53-7 (.883), while scheduling regular NCAA Tournament teams in Arizona, Davidson, Dayton, Duke, Iowa State, Middle Tennessee, Murray State, Oklahoma, Texas Tech, UConn and Xavier
- His teams have been just as successful off the court as Auburn has had 32 graduates in six years the most in the SEC. In 2018, Auburn received an Academic Progress Rate Public Recognition Award marking the first time the Tigers have been honored since the award began tracking data in 2004. The NCAA annually honors teams earning multiyear Academic Progress Rates in the top 10 percent of all squads in each sport

- Auburn recently secured its fourth perfect APR score of 1,000 in mid-May, something that has never been accomplished in program history
- $\bullet$  In the past five years, Auburn men's basketball has averaged an APR of 995 (out of 1,000). In the previous four seasons before Pearl and his staff arrived, Auburn's APR average score was 940
- Pearl started AUTLIVE at Auburn in 2015-16 to benefit cancer patients in the fight to beat cancer. AUTLIVE raises the awareness of cancer prevention and detection while t-shirt sales and donations raise money to benefit cancer patients. He initiated the OUTLIVE program in 2009 at Tennessee in recognition of former Vol Chris Lofton, who beat testicular cancer through early diagnosis and treatment and went on to play the entire 2007-08 season while recovering from his battle with the disease
- On Dec. 19, 2019, Children's Harbor in Birmingham, Ala. dedicated their on-site basketball court in honor of the charitible work done by Coach Pearl and the Pearl family over the last six years.
- Bruce Pearl has raised over \$1.2 million in only six golf tournaments at Auburn. Pearl and his wife, Brandy, have remarkably raised \$770,000 in the last three years benefitting Children's Harbor in Birmingham through the Bruce Pearl Fore the Children Golf Classic. The mission of Children's Harbor is to help children with serious illness and their families
- $\bullet$  The Bruce Pearl Family Foundation in conjunction with L5 Foundation, an organization dedicated to addressing the essential and basic needs of cancer patients, donated \$20,000 to five charities in a ceremony in Knoxville in August 2015
- The Pearl family announced on Feb. 27, 2007, a \$100,000 donation to endow a scholarship in the name of former Tennessee player Dane Bradshaw. The Dane Bradshaw Athletic Scholarship Endowment is awarded to the male or female student-athlete at UT who best epitomizes the characteristics of the 2006-07 senior captain

#### THE BOOK ON YALE

- » Yale was picked as the favorite to win the Ivy League with seven first-place votes in the preseason media poll.
- » Before their cancelled season last year, the Bulldogs had won the Ivy League regular-season championship title four of the last six seasons.
- » Yale is led by its top returning scorer in senior guard Azar Swain (18.9 ppg), who earned All-Ivy First Team honors in 2019-20 when he set the school's single-season record for most 3-pointers made (93).
- » The Bulldogs like to shoot the 3 and currently rank No. 36 in the country in 3-point field goals made (74) and No. 16 in 3-point attempts (228).

#### **SERIES NOTES**

» The Tigers and Bulldogs will meet for the first time on the hardwood on Saturday. Auburn is 6-1 all-time versus the Ivy League (Columbia 2-0, Cornell 1-0, Dartmouth 1-0, Harvard 0-1 and Penn 1-0).

#### **TIGER SIDEBAR**

» Auburn Assistant Coach Ira Bowman is no stranger to the Ivy League. He played at Penn from 1994-96 and was an assistant coach for his alma mater from 2012-18, prior to join the Tiger staff.

#### AN AUBURN WIN WOULD ...

- » Keep the Tigers undefeated at home this season (4-0), where they are averaging 9,121 fans per game at Auburn Arena.
- » Give Auburn its third win over a first-time opponent this season next to Morehead State and Loyola Chicago.

#### 36 IN A ROW

» Auburn has won 36 consecutive non-conference games at Auburn Arena. It's last non-conference home loss was Jan. 20, 2016 vs. Oklahoma State (63-74). Bruce Pearl is 46-3 at Auburn in non-conference home games.

#### ON THE RUN

» The Tigers have used two big runs this season to lead them to victory. Against Southern Indiana, AU used a 22-0 run to secure a 68-54 win over the Screaming Eagles in exhibition play on Nov. 5. On the road at USF, Auburn went on a 15-0 run in the second half, for a 58-52 comefrom-behind victory.

#### PRESEASON HONORS AND WATCH LIST

- » A pair of Tigers appear on some of the nation's top watch lists. Freshman Jabari Smith is a menber of the John Wooden Preseason Top 50 Watch List which identifies 50 players for national player of the year and all-America honors. Smith also is on the Karl Malone Award Watch List which is presented each year to the country's top power forward. Sophomore center Walker Kessler is on the Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Award Watch List, given annually to the nation's top center.
- » Allen Flanigan was named to the Coaches' Preseason All-SEC first team while Jabari Smith was named to the second team. Smith, the highest rated player ever signed at Auburn, was the only freshman to be voted on either team.

#### ON TO THE LEAGUE

» Auburn lost four of its top six scorers from last season including a pair of NBA Draft picks in guard Sharife Cooper (20.2 ppg, 8.0 apg) and forward JT Thor (9.4 ppg, 5.0 rpg). Thor was a first round pick of the Charlotte Hornets, while Cooper was a second rounder to the Atlanta Hawks.

#### TRACKING THE TIGERS

- » Auburn has the best overall record in the SEC since 2017 (100-39).
- » From 2017-20, Auburn was one of four major programs to win at least 25 programs each year joining Duke, Kansas and Kentucky.
- » Made its first NCAA Final Four appearance in 2019

#### PLAYER TO WATCH: WALKER KESSLER

Sophomore forward Walker Kessler registered a season-high 17 points and career-high 14 rebounds (four on the offensive glass) against UCF. It marked his third double-double outing in the last four contests for the Tigers. He also saw a career-best 31 minutes of action versus the Knights.

- » Auburn's 4 NBA Draft picks in last three years is tied for seventh most nationally and third in the Southeastern Conference.

#### FLANIGAN OUT

» Auburn junior guard Allen Flanigan had a successful procedure in early September to repair his right Achilles after suffering a non-basketball related trauma. Flanigan's surgery was performed at the Andrews Sports Medicine & Orthopedic Center at St. Vincent's Hospital in Birmingham. The SEC's fourth leading returning scorer, Flanigan is expected to miss 12-14 weeks. » As a sophomore in 2020-21, Flanigan averaged 14.3 points, 5.5 rebounds and 2.9 assists while starting in all 27 games. The most improved scorer in the SEC last season, Flanigan was one of three players in the league to average 14.0 points, 5.0 rebounds and 2.5 assists per game.

#### SEC IN STRETCH

» Babatunde "Stretch" Akingbola represented Auburn at this year's Southeastern Conference Basketball Leadership Council that was held in September. The council consisted of one male representative and one female representative from each of the SEC's 14 institutions. The goal of the leadership council is for student-athletes to serve as a conduit of communication from their teams to the conference office on issues related to student-athlete experience, student-athlete wellness, and to provide feedback on proposed rules governing the SEC and NCAA.

#### NABC TABS TIGERS FOR ACADEMICS

» The 2020-21 Auburn men's basketball team was named a recipient of the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) Team Academic Excellence Award. The award, created by the NABC Committee on Academics, recognizes outstanding academic achievement by a team with a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 or better. The Tigers earned the award for the first time since its inception in 2013 and were one of only two Southeastern Conference teams to garner recognition, in addition to Tennessee.

#### PEARL RISING IN SEC RECORD BOOK

» Through his tenures as head coach at two SEC schools - Auburn and Tennessee - Bruce Pearl is among the Top 15 coaches in conference history in terms of wins at SEC schools only and SEC regular season wins. Below is where he stands in the SEC coaching ranks all-time:

» Auburn is 72-218 against teams from the AP Top 25 all-time. Three years ago, the Tigers set a program record by defeating six top-25 teams, including five in a row from the SEC Tournament title to a trip to the Final Four.

#### AUBURN AS A RANKED TEAM

» Auburn enters 2021-22 ranked No. 22 in the preseason Associated Press Top 25 poll, marking the seventh time in school history it has appeared in the preseason poll. It is the third time in the Pearl Era, all in the last four years, that the Tigers have been ranked to begin the season.

» Under Bruce Pearl, the Tigers are 64-21 when ranked, including a 6-1 mark in 2021-22.

#### BEST 5 YEAR RUN IN SCHOOL HISTORY

» Auburn won 112 games between 2016-17 and 2020-21, which is the best five-year win total in school history. The Tigers entered the 2021-22 season with 94 wins over the last four years, needing 19 wins this season to set the new mark.


