### » QUICK HITTERS

- Auburn's offense scored two runs on six hits in the first two games of the season and has tallied 25 runs on 26 hits in the last two contests.
- The Tigers pitching staff has allowed six runs (five earned) on 15 hits in the first four games.
- It's the second straight season Auburn has allowed six runs (five earned) through the first four.
- The 15 hits allowed in a four-game span are the fewest since 2015 (Radford, Georgia Tech).
- The staff leads the league in hits allowed and average against (.135) and his second in ERA (1.29).
- Auburn is 70-22 (.761) against non-conference opponents in the regular season since the start of the 2018 season, including 37-11 (.771) on the weekend.
- Sonny DiChiara hit his first career Auburn home run and the 42nd of his collegiate career Wednesday. He's tied for fourth among active players in the category.
- Bryson Ware hit his first career grand slam and drove in a career high six runs vs. Troy.
- This weekend marks the first time Auburn and Yale have played since 1923.

**Butch Thompson enters his seventh season at the helm of the program in 2021, posting a record of 179-142 in his first six seasons. He led the program to the first College World Series appearance in 22 years in 2019 and took the Tigers to three straight regionals for the first time since 2001-03.**

Butch Thompson was named Auburn's head baseball coach on October 22, 2015 and enters his seventh season with the Tigers in 2021.

Thompson, who spent three seasons as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Auburn from 2006-08, returned to The Plains after seven seasons at Mississippi State as both associate head coach and pitching coach.

A native of Amory, Miss., Thompson has coached 31 Division I All-Americans and 40 all-conference performers. He has seen 18 of his former pitchers make their Major League Baseball debuts, including 12 since 2014. Thompson has also turned 33 pitchers who went undrafted out of high school into MLB draft picks.

Thompson had three pitchers drafted in the first 11 rounds in 2014 and five pitchers drafted, including three in the top 10 rounds, in 2013. He added a first-round selection in the 2016 draft, a third-round pick in Keegan Thompson in 2017 and the first No. 1 overall pick in program history in Casey Mize in 2018. With Tanner Burns also going as a supplemental first round pick in 2020, Auburn became one of four programs with a pair of pitchers drafted in the first round from 2018-20.

Along with his pitching pedigree, Thompson is also considered one of the top recruiters in the country. Since 2003, he has secured 14 recruiting classes that were ranked in the top 10 by either Baseball America or Perfect Game, including the No. 5 signing class in 2017 and a program record No. 4 class in 2018. His classes signed from 2006-08 at Auburn each ranked in the top 18 nationally, including the No. 5 class in 2008, which included All-American and SEC Player of the Year Hunter Morris.

In 29 years of coaching at the collegiate level, including 20 in the Southeastern Conference, Thompson has coached eight College World Series participants, including leading the Tigers to the program's first trip to the College World Series in 22 years in 2019. Thompson has also coached one national champion and a national runner-up, won nine conference championships and made 17 postseason appearances. He has also served as an assistant under three National Coach of the Year recipients.

Thompson was named the 2006 Fellowship of Christian Athletes SEC Coach of the Year while at Auburn and the 2014 Baseball America and American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA) National Assistant Coach of the Year while at Mississippi State.

Thompson has returned the Tigers to prominence in five seasons on The Plains as he has guided the team to a 179-142 overall record and took the team to three straight NCAA Tournament appearances for the first time since 2001-03, including back-to-back super regionals for the first time in program history. After advancing to the College World Series in 2019 and a winner-take-all game three in the Gainesville Super Regional in 2018, the Tigers finished those respective seasons ranked as high as No. 8 and No. 9. It marked the third time in program history the team has finished back-to-back seasons in the top 10.

Entering the 2019 postseason as the No. 2 seed in the Atlanta Regional, Auburn became the only program to sweep a regional on the road in each of the last two seasons before also becoming the first team to defeat North Carolina in a Chapel Hill Super Regional in 2019, punching its ticket to Omaha for the first time since 1997.

In seven seasons at MSU, Thompson made four NCAA regional trips, two Super Regionals, won the SEC Tournament and advanced to the College World Series finishing as NCAA runner-up in 2013. In three of his last four seasons in Starkville, the Bulldogs' staff ERA finished no higher than 3.06. Thompson's 2013 pitching staff was one of two nationally to finish in the top 15 in ERA, strikeouts per nine innings and hits allowed per nine innings.



In addition to his experience at Auburn and Mississippi State, Thompson also spent four seasons at Georgia from 2002-05, including a trip to the College World Series in 2004. While there, he guided the development of future Major Leaguers Josh Fields, Mitchell Boggs and Brooks Brown.

Thompson launched his coaching career as pitching coach and top assistant at Huntingdon College (Ala.) in 1993, before returning to his alma mater in Birmingham, where he helped lead the Panthers to back-to-back Southern States Conference Championships and in 1995 coached BSC to its first NAIA World Series berth.

Thompson left BSC briefly to serve as head coach at Jefferson State Community College in Birmingham in 1997. While at JSCC, he was honored as the Regional Tournament Coach of the Year, the ABCA Alabama Junior College Coach of the Year and the Southeast Region Coach of the Year after guiding JSCC to a 39-21 mark, the AJCAA Region 22 State Championship and a third-place finish in the NJCAA Division II World Series.

He returned to Birmingham-Southern as top assistant the following season, beginning a four-year run during the most successful span in BSC baseball history. The Panthers won 196 games and four TranSouth Conference Championships and made three-consecutive appearances in the NAIA World Series. BSC's 2001 team posted a school-best 55-11 mark and captured the NAIA National Championship.

In 2002, Thompson joined the SEC baseball coaching fraternity as a pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at Georgia and has been a part of the league for the past 17 seasons.

Thompson currently serves as the large-school representative for the Alabama Baseball Coaches Association and is an All-American committee member representing the South region for the ABCA.

Thompson prepped at Amory (Miss.) High School and later starred as a pitcher at Itawamba (Miss.) Community College from 1989-90. He is a member of both the ICC Athletic Hall of Fame (Class of 2014) and MACCC Hall of Fame (Class of 2021).

Thompson earned a Bachelor's Degree in History at BSC in 1992 and completed a Master's Degree in Sports Administration at UAB in 1996. He is married to the former Robin Ashe of Birmingham, Ala., and they are the parents of three daughters --- Anna, Olivia and Madelyn Gail.

**PITCHING ON POINT**

- The Auburn pitching staff has allowed six runs (five earned) on 15 hits through four games.
- It marks the second straight season Auburn has allowed six runs (five earned) in the first four games.
- The four earned runs allowed in the State Farm Showdown last weekend were the fewest in three games against Power 5 competition since 2019 (Tennessee).
- Auburn's 15 hits allowed through four games are the fewest since also allowing 15 hits in four games against Radford and Georgia Tech in 2015.
- Six pitchers have made their Auburn debuts this season and have turned in a 0.71 ERA with 13 strikeouts in a combined eight appearances and 12.2 innings.

**SOLID STARTS**

- Starting pitchers Tommy Sheehan, Joseph Gonzalez and Trace Bright went 2-0 and didn't allow an earned run with 11 strikeouts in 11.0 innings of work in Arlington.
- Senior transfer Jordan Armstrong is set to earn his first career start along Gonzalez and Bright this weekend.
- Gonzalez and Bright turned in near identical lines in their starts in Arlington last weekend.

**THE ARMSTRONGS**

- John and Jordan Armstrong made a combined three relief appearances and didn't allow a run in 5.2 IP in Arlington.
- John was the only Auburn pitcher to make a pair of appearances and inherited two runners with one out in each of his trips to the mound, only allowing two to score.
- Jordan came out of the bullpen in the season opener and held Oklahoma scoreless and to only one hit in 4.0 IP.

**HEATING UP**

- Auburn's offense has totaled 25 runs on 26 hits in the last two games after scoring two runs on six hits in the first two.
- Five of the team's first seven hitters Wednesday vs. Troy collected multiple hits - Rambusch, DiChiara, Moore, Ware, Foster.

**SONNY STARTS SLUGGING**

- Senior transfer Sonny DiChiara is tied for the SEC lead in doubles (4) while ranking second in average (.636) and on-base percentage (.706) and fourth in slugging (1.273).
- Five of DiChiara's first seven hits are for extra bases - four doubles, one home run - and he has multiple hits in three of the first four games.
- DiChiara has reached base multiple times in all four games and has reached safely in eight of his last nine trips to the plate - a sacrifice fly was his only time being putout in the last two games.

**RAMBUSCH RAKES**

- Junior college transfer Blake Rambusch, who ranked 11th in the NJCAA with a .444 average a season ago, has three hits in back-to-back games and has scored six runs in the last two.
- The redshirt junior has reached base in 61 of the last 62 games dating back to the final 13 games of his freshman season at Grayson College in 2019.

**BIG FLY FROM B-WARE**

- Junior outfielder Bryson Ware hit his first career grand slam in the first inning of Wednesday's 13-1 win against Troy.
- The grand slam was just the third by an Auburn player since 2018.
- Ware ultimately drove in a career high six runs in the contest.

**SPEED KILLS**

- Redshirt junior outfielder Josh Hall executed a straight steal of home in last Sunday's win vs. Kansas State.
- It marked the first time an Auburn player stole home since Justin Hargett pulled it off against Davidson on Mar. 3, 2010.

**LIKE FATHER, LIKE SON**

- Senior infielder Brody Moore is the son of former Auburn and All-SEC shortstop Brandon Moore (1991-94).
- After wearing No. 19 and playing second base/utility in his first three seasons on the Plains, Brody has a new number and position in 2022 - No. 4 and shortstop - just like his dad.
- Brody is 3-for-7 and has scored five runs in the last two games.
- Brandon hit .332 in four years and 242 games in an Auburn uniform. Brody is a .306 career hitter in parts of three seasons and 83 games.

**BURKY AND SKIP IN THE BULLPEN**

- Junior Blake Burkhalter and senior Carson Skipper were two of nine SEC relievers named to the NCBWA Stopper of the Year Watch List.
- Auburn is one of two SEC programs with multiple honorees.
- It marks the fifth straight season an Auburn pitcher has been recognized on the list, including the second straight for Skipper.

**ONE-RUN AFFAIRS**

- After going 6-11 one-run games last year, Auburn won its first one-run affair by defeating No. 12 Texas Tech last Saturday in Arlington, Texas.
- A year ago, thirteen of Auburn's 30 SEC games, including seven of its first 10, were decided by one run and seven more were decided by two runs.
- The Tigers went 4-9 in one-run games and 6-14 in games decided by two runs or less in league play.

**BIG SHOES TO FILL**

- Auburn is forced to replace its top three hitters and five everyday starters from a year ago in shortstop Ryan Bliss, third baseman Rankin Woley, first baseman Tyler Miller and outfielders Steven Williams and Judd Ward.
- The quintet combined to hit .296 with 192 runs, 50 doubles, 58 home runs and 191 RBI.

**TWENTY-SIX YEARS IN THE MAKING**

- Volunteer assistant and pitching coach Tim Hudson, who began his time on the Plains as a player in the fall of 1995, recently earned his degree in interdisciplinary studies with emphases on health promotion and philanthropy studies on Dec. 11, 2021.

**MLB SUCCESS ON STAFF**

- Auburn's coaching staff has 54 years of experience in professional baseball, including 32 years in the MLB between pitching coach Tim Hudson (17 years), hitting coach Gabe Gross (seven years), strength coach Chris Joyner (eight years).
- Other members of the coaching and support staff with professional experience include assistant coach Karl Nonemaker, director of player development Aaron Everett and athletic trainer Anthony Sandersen.

**AUBURN IN THE MLB DRAFT**

- The 2021 MLB Draft marked the 47th consecutive year Auburn had at least one player selected, tied for the longest active streak in the SEC.
- Ryan Bliss was drafted by the Arizona Diamondbacks in the second round with the 42nd overall pick in last year's draft, becoming the fifth-highest position player and ninth-highest draft pick overall in Auburn history.
- It marked the sixth straight season Auburn had a top-five-round pick, marking the first time in program history to accomplish the feat.

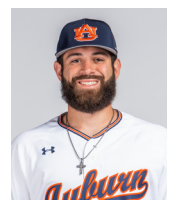
