AT THE STARTING LINE

- The second meet of the 2011 season finds the Tigers cross country team at home for the Auburn Invitational. 11 teams will make the trip to Auburn for the event that will be held at Conway Acres Farm. The competition is highlighted by Florida State, Southern Miss and Georgia State as well as in-state opponents Samford, Troy, UAB and Alabama State.
- After sitting out the opening race, highly-touted freshman Kane Grimster is expected to make his debut on the men's side. Additionally, team captain and senior Joby Peake along with sophomore Niklas Buhner will also make their 2011 debuts.
- Freshman Samantha Berggren will run for the first time in 2011 on Friday.

OPENING WEEKEND A SUCCESS

- Both the men's and women's teams brought home team titles in the season opening meet at Troy on September 3. The men topped the standings with 44 points, while the women tied South Alabama with 34 points.
- Sophomore Elizabeth Briasco crossed the finish line first with a time of 11:08.17 in the 3200m run. She was followed closely behind by newcomer Alyssa Fisher who clocked in at 11:15.36.

Mark Carroll

Head Cross Country Coach
Third Season

Head Coach Mark Carroll enters the 2011 campaign, his third with Auburn, ready to take the Tigers' program to the next level in the world of collegiate cross country.

2010 featured three of Carroll's runners earning first team All-SEC honors after solid performances at the conference championships – highlighted by second place finishes from Ben Cheruiyot and Holly Knight.

Additionally, both Cheruiyot and Knight advanced to the 2010 NCAA Championships.

In his first season with Tigers in 2009, Carroll tutored Felix Kiboiwo and Cheruiyot to All-American accolades as the men's team placed 25th at the NCAA Cross Country Championships. The Auburn men also brought home two third-place finishes from the NCAA South Regional and SEC Championships, and Kiboiwo took medalist honors for the third time of his career at the NCAA South Regional.

With Carroll at the helm, the Auburn women finished in the Top 10 at five of their six meets for the 2009 season. Carroll led the Lady Tigers to a sixth-place finish at the NCAA South Regional and a seventh-place finish at the SEC Championships.

Prior to joining the Auburn staff, Carroll was the US Athlete Manager for Athletics Ireland, where he guided Gareth Turnbull, Mark Christie and Liam Reale to becoming one of the top Irish running trios in the nation while also training several other Irish runners stateside.

Before coaching Carroll was a world-class distance runner specializing in the 3,000 and 5,000-meters. As a 19-year old, the Cork, Ireland native, earned the first major title of his career, capturing the 1991 European Junior Title in the 5K in Thessalonika, Greece.

In 1998 he won bronze at the European Track & Field Championships held in Budapest. In 2000, he won the European Indoor 3K title. In that same year, Carroll posted the top mile time of his career (3:50.3) in Oslo, Norway.

Carroll is a four-time IAAF World Track and Field member, and holds the Irish-national record in the 3K (7:30.36), which he set in 1996, as well as the 5K (13:03.93) set in 1998. He also held the national record of 27:46.42 in the 10K that was set in 2000, a record that has since been broken.

He has participated in several marathons in the later stages of his career, highlighted by a sixth-place finish in the 2002 New York Marathon. His time of 2:10.54 sits only 61 seconds off of the Irish national record of 2:09.17.

Carroll was a member of the 2000 and 2004 Ireland Olympic Team. He competed in the 5K both years, and in 2000 just missed qualifying for the finals by one place.

During his collegiate days at Providence College, Carroll earned six All-American honors as well as seven Big East titles (cross country; 1,000 meters; 1,500 meters; 3,000 meters (twice); distance medley relay and 4 x 800 meters). His crowning achievement as a Friar came when he won an NCAA Indoor Championship title in the 5,000-meters.

Carroll holds a USTFCCA level two coaching certificate that he acquired in 2008.

He married the former Amy Rudolph in October of 2005. Rudolph, an accomplished runner in her own right, is a two-time Olympian, as well as a U.S. Indoor Champion in the 3,000-meter run.

2010 SEASON IN REVIEW

High hopes for 2010 after a solid 2009 season gave way to frustration, but despite an under-achieving Fall output by both the men's and women's teams there were solid performances by a pair of individuals. Senior Ben Cheruiyot and departed former runner Holly Knight posted top 10 finishes at the NCAA South Regional in Tuscaloosa and earned berths in the NCAA Championships.

Both Cheruiyot (24:01.36) and Knight (20:49.39) placed second in their respective races at the conference finale hosted by South Carolina. That would be just one of the solid showings by the pair over the course of the 2010 campaign. Knight was joined by fellow senior Stephanie Barnes (21:15.86) in the top 10 at SEC's. The Clevedon, England-native posted a seventh-place finish.

For their efforts, the trio each earned All-SEC recognition.

The season started with a strong showing from both sides at the Troy Invitational in early September with the men finishing first and the women taking second place. Auburn's Barnes and Stephanie Briasco placed one and two to clinch the win.

Knight picked up her first race win of the season in Tuscaloosa the following week, while Cheruiyot finished third as both teams finished fourth in the Crimson Classic. The Tigers closed out September with another pair of fourth-place finishes, highlighted by a pair of race wins from Knight and Cheruiyot.

The pair of wins at the Brooks Memphis Twilight Cross Country Classic earned the duo SEC Cross Country Athletes of the Week.

The final regular season race of 2010 featured the tandem both setting season highs - including a personal best by Cheruiyot. The Kenyan crossed the finish line with a mark of 29:21.06, while his female teammate, Knight, came across in 16:50.25 for a third place finish.
